Indeks harga seunit besi mencatatkan penurunan antara negatif 0.6 peratus hingga negatif 5.7 peratus pada September 2024

PUTRAJAYA, 10 Oktober 2024 – Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) menerbitkan laporan **SIARAN KHAS UNTUK KERJA-KERJA PEMBINAAN BANGUNAN DAN STRUKTUR, SEPTEMBER 2024**. Laporan ini menyediakan indeks harga seunit bahan binaan utama dan Indeks Kos Bahan Binaan Bangunan (IKB) mengikut kategori bangunan dan kawasan.

Dalam kenyataan hari ini, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin menyatakan indeks seunit harga besi merekodkan penurunan antara negatif 0.6 peratus hingga negatif 5.7 peratus bagi kebanyakan kawasan di Semenanjung Malaysia, Sabah dan Sarawak pada September 2024 berbanding bulan lepas. Penurunan tertinggi dicatatkan bagi Perak (-5.7%), diikuti dengan Kota Kinabalu (-2.3%) dan Pulau Pinang, Kedah & Perlis (-1.7%).

Tambahan itu, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia memaklumkan terdapat penurunan dalam indeks harga seunit keratan keluli & logam iaitu dengan peratus penurunan antara negatif 0.1 peratus hingga negatif 2.7 peratus bagi kebanyakan kawasan di Semenanjung Malaysia, Sabah dan Sarawak. Penurunan tertinggi telah direkodkan di Miri (-2.7%), diikuti dengan Sibul (-2.4%) dan Pulau Pinang, Kedah & Perlis (-1.6%).

Indeks harga seunit pasir pula mencatatkan peningkatan antara 0.5 peratus hingga 1.3 peratus bagi beberapa kawasan di Semenanjung Malaysia pada September 2024.

Namun begitu kadar kenaikan bagi indeks harga bahan ini adalah lebih rendah berbanding dua bulan sebelumnya. Selain daripada itu, indeks harga seunit simen juga merekodkan peningkatan antara 0.1 peratus hingga 0.9 peratus bagi kebanyakan kawasan pada September 2024 berbanding bulan lepas.

Perbandingan tahunan untuk tempoh September 2023 dan September 2024 pula menunjukkan indeks harga seunit simen merekodkan peningkatan antara 0.2 peratus hingga 2.9 peratus bagi kebanyakan kawasan di Semenanjung Malaysia, Sabah dan Sarawak. Peningkatan tertinggi dicatatkan bagi kawasan Selangor, W.P. Kuala Lumpur, Melaka dan Negeri Sembilan (2.9%), diikuti dengan Pahang (2.7%) dan Tawau (2.2%).

Selain daripada itu, perbandingan tahunan indeks harga seunit besi pula mencatatkan penurunan antara negatif 0.1 peratus hingga negatif 4.2 peratus pada September 2024 berbanding bulan yang sama tahun lalu bagi hampir semua kawasan di Semenanjung Malaysia, Sabah dan Sarawak.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia turut menyatakan bahawa purata harga simen (*Ordinary Portland*) mencatatkan penurunan kecil (-0.4%) dengan purata harga RM23.23 per 50 kg sekarung berbanding Ogos 2024 (RM23.33 per 50 kg sekarung). Manakala, purata harga seunit besi yang terdiri daripada bar bulat keluli lembut dan *Mycon 60 high tensile deformed bars* merekodkan penurunan (-1.0%) dengan purata harga RM3,667.96 bagi setiap tan metrik berbanding bulan sebelumnya (Ogos 2024: RM3,705.37 bagi setiap tan metrik).

IKB termasuk bar keluli mengikut kategori bangunan dan kawasan di Semenanjung Malaysia merekodkan penurunan kecil iaitu antara negatif 0.4 peratus hingga 2.3 peratus pada bulan September 2024 berbanding bulan sebelumnya. Penurunan bagi IKB termasuk bar keluli telah dicatatkan bagi hampir semua kategori bangunan kecuali Bangunan Kayu dan Cerucuk Kayu di kawasan Pulau Pinang, Kedah & Perlis, Perak dan Selangor, W.P. Kuala Lumpur, Melaka & Negeri Sembilan.

Namun begitu, terdapat sedikit peningkatan antara 0.1 peratus hingga 0.3 peratus bagi IKB termasuk bar keluli bagi beberapa kategori bangunan bagi Johor dan Pahang.

Selain daripada itu, IKB termasuk bar keluli di Sabah juga turut menunjukkan penurunan iaitu antara negatif 0.1 peratus hingga negatif 1.1 peratus bagi hampir semua kategori bangunan di Kota Kinabalu dan Sandakan. Selain daripada itu, IKB bagi hampir semua kategori bangunan di Tawau pula kekal tidak berubah.

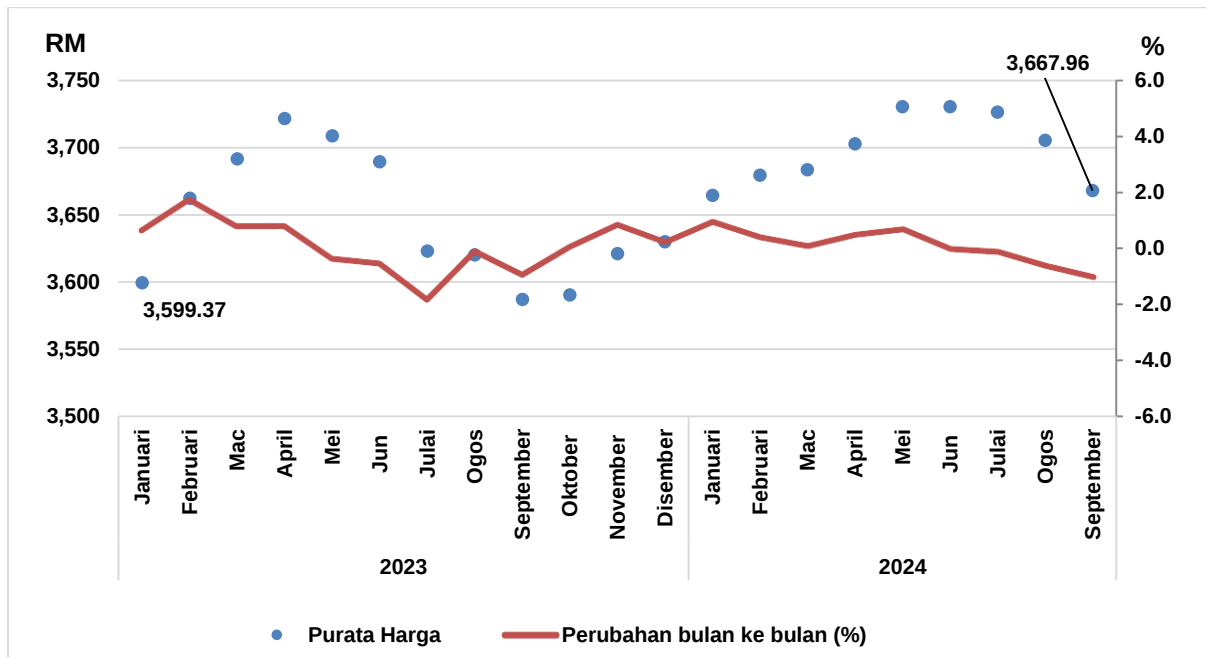
Perbandingan bulanan IKB termasuk bar keluli di Sarawak pada September 2024 juga mencatatkan penurunan kecil antara negatif 0.1 peratus hingga negatif 0.9 peratus bagi hampir semua kategori bangunan di Kuching dan Miri. Manakala IKB termasuk bar keluli bagi hampir semua kategori bangunan di Sibu pula mencatatkan peningkatan kecil iaitu antara 0.7 peratus hingga 1.4 peratus.

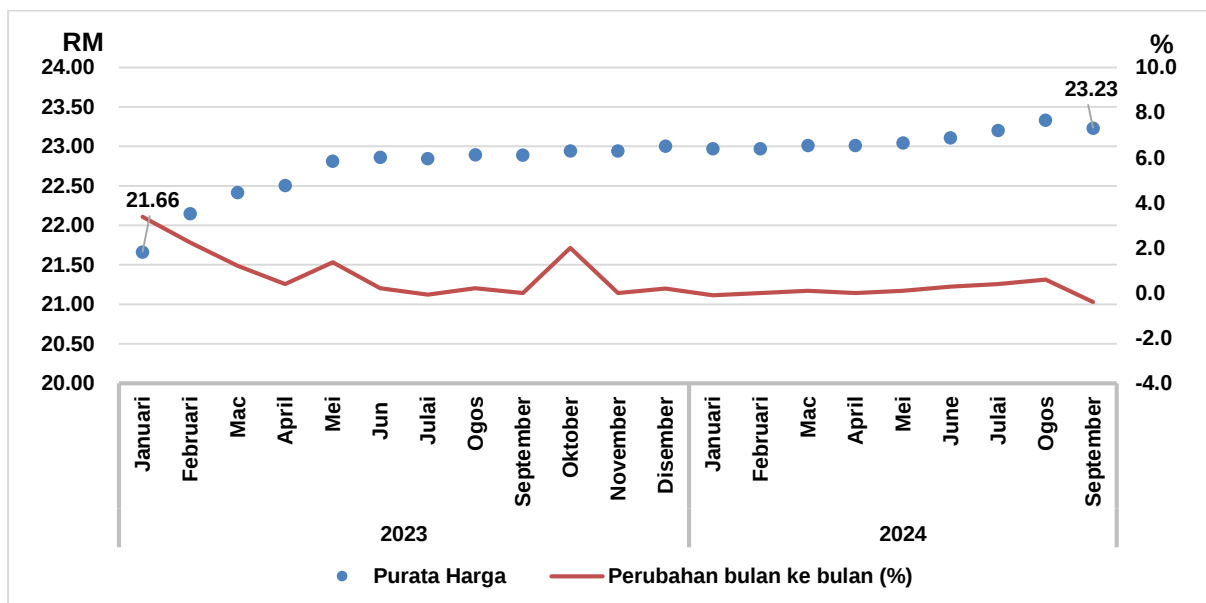

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BUILDING COST INDEX, MALAYSIA SEPTEMBER 2024

The unit price index of steel recorded a slight decrease between negative 0.6 per cent to negative 5.7 per cent in September 2024

PUTRAJAYA, October 10, 2024 – The Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) published **SPECIAL RELEASE FOR BUILDING AND STRUCTURAL WORKS, SEPTEMBER 2024**. This report provides the unit price index of major building materials and the Building Cost Material Index (BCI) by building category and region.

In a statement today, Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin mentioned that the monthly comparison showed a slight decrease in the unit price index of steel between negative 0.6 per cent to negative 5.7 per cent for almost all areas in Peninsular Malaysia, Sabah and Sarawak in September 2024 as compared to the previous month. The highest decrease was in Perak (-5.7%), followed by Kota Kinabalu (-2.3%) and Pulau Pinang, Kedah & Perlis (-1.7%).

Additionally, the Chief Statistician of Malaysia also informed that the unit price index of steel & metal sections recorded a decrease between negative 0.1 per cent to negative 2.7 per cent for almost all areas in Peninsular Malaysia, Sabah and Sarawak. The highest decrease was in Miri (-2.7%), followed by Sibu (-2.4%) and Pulau Pinang, Kedah & Perlis (-1.6%).

The unit price index of sand recorded an increase between 0.5 per cent to 1.3 per cent for several areas in Peninsular Malaysia in September 2024. However, the rate of

increase for the price index of this material is slightly lower as compared to the previous two months. Apart from that, the unit price index of cement also registered an increase between 0.1 per cent to 0.9 per cent for almost all areas in September 2024 as compared to the previous month.

An annual comparison for the period of September 2023 and September 2024 indicated that the unit price index of cement increased between 0.2 per cent to 2.9 per cent for almost all areas in Peninsular Malaysia, Sabah and Sarawak. The highest increase was recorded in Selangor, W.P. Kuala Lumpur, Melaka & Negeri Sembilan (2.9%), followed by Pahang (2.7%) and Tawau (2.2%).

Nevertheless, an annual comparison of the unit price index of steel recorded a decrease between negative 0.1 per cent to negative 4.2 per cent in September 2024 as compared to the same month last year for almost all areas in Peninsular Malaysia, Sabah and Sarawak.

The Chief Statistician of Malaysia also elaborated that the average price of cement (Ordinary Portland) recorded a marginal decrease (-0.4%) with an average price of RM23.23 per 50 kg bag as compared to August 2024 (RM23.33 per 50 kg bag). The average price per unit of steel, consisting of mild steel round bars and Mycon 60 high tensile deformed bars recorded a decrease (-1.0%) with an average price of RM3,667.96 per metric tonne as compared to the previous month (August 2024: RM3,705.37 per metric tonne).

The BCI with steel bars for all building categories recorded a slight decrease between negative 0.4 per cent to negative 2.3 per cent for almost all areas in Peninsular Malaysia in September 2024 compared to the previous month. A decrease in the BCI with steel bars was recorded for almost all building categories except for Timber Buildings and Timber Piling in the several areas of Pulau Pinang, Kedah & Perlis, Perak and Selangor, W.P. Kuala Lumpur, Melaka & Negeri Sembilan.

However, there was a slight increase between 0.1 per cent to 0.3 per cent for BCI with steel bars for several building categories in Johor and Pahang.

Apart from that, BCI with steel bars in Sabah also showed a slight decrease between negative 0.1 per cent to negative 1.1 per cent for almost all building categories in Kota Kinabalu and Sandakan. Meanwhile, the index for almost all other building categories in Tawau remained unchanged.

A monthly comparison of BCI with steel bars in Sarawak for September 2024 also registered a slight decrease between negative 0.1 per cent to negative 0.9 per cent for almost all categories of buildings in Kuching and Miri. However, BCI with steel bars for almost all building categories in Sibu showed a slight increase between 0.7 per cent to 1.4 per cent.

Chart 1: Average Price of Steel Bar, Malaysia, January 2023 – September 2024

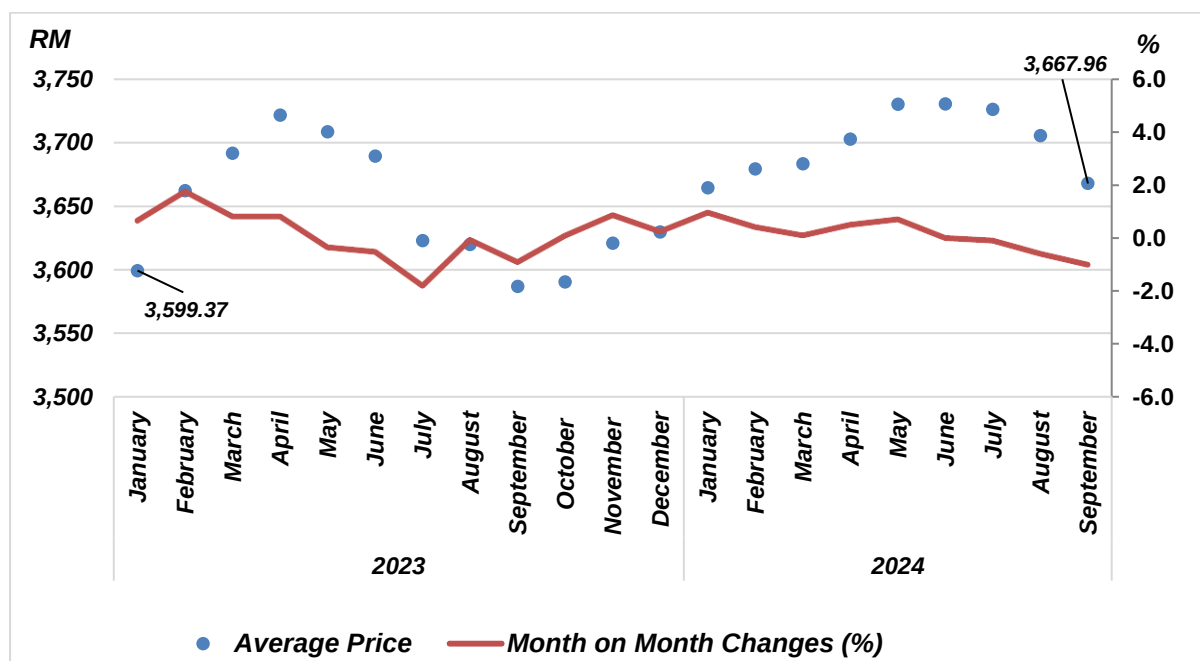
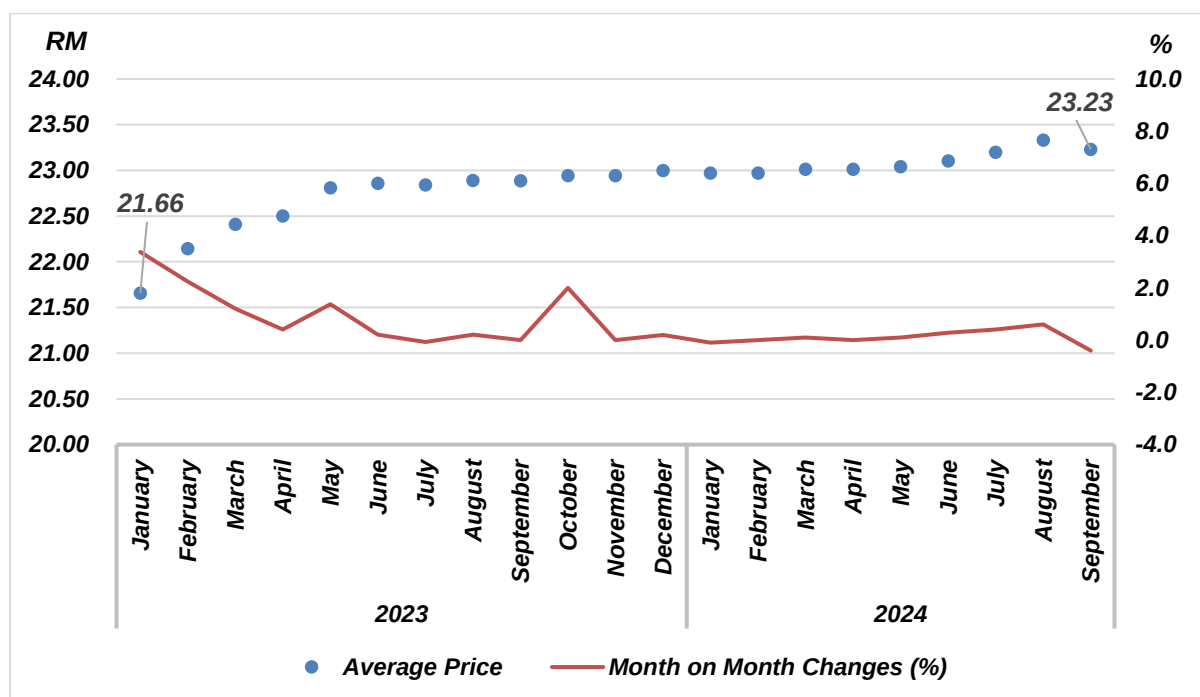


Chart 2: Average Price of Cement, Malaysia, January 2023 – September 2024
