PENAWARAN PEKERJAAN DIKLANKAN DALAM TALIAN DI MALAYSIA SUKU KETIGA 2025

Penawaran pekerjaan yang diiklankan dalam talian meningkat 108.8 peratus pada suku ketiga 2025, dengan 588,148 penawaran direkodkan

PUTRAJAYA, 28 APRIL 2026 – Bilangan penawaran pekerjaan dalam talian meningkat 108.8 peratus pada suku ketiga 2025 dengan 588,148 penawaran, mencatatkan penawaran tertinggi sejak suku ketiga 2021 (112.7 peratus), menurut Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) seperti dilaporkan dalam terbitan **Analisis Data Raya: Job Market Insights Penawaran Pekerjaan Diiklankan Dalam Talian di Malaysia, ST3 2025**.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin menyatakan, "Bilangan syarikat yang mengiklankan tawaran kerja pada suku ketiga 2025 meningkat kepada 77,615 berbanding 57,666 pada suku kedua 2025. Penawaran pekerjaan dalam talian tertumpu kepada kategori Profesional, merangkumi 45.6 peratus atau 268,178 penawaran pekerjaan pada suku ketiga 2025, berbanding 129,041 penawaran pekerjaan pada suku kedua 2025. Kategori Pengurus merekodkan 100,811 penawaran, diikuti oleh Juruteknik dan Profesional Bersekutu dengan 100,489 penawaran pekerjaan. Permintaan yang lebih tinggi diperhatikan bagi Profesional Pengiklanan dan Pemasaran (40,213 penawaran pekerjaan), diikuti Pengarah Urusan dan Ketua Eksekutif (35,606 penawaran pekerjaan), Profesional Pentadbiran Bersekutu (30,523 penawaran pekerjaan), Profesional Pentadbiran (18,860 penawaran pekerjaan) serta Akauntan dan Juruaudit (17,587 penawaran pekerjaan)."

Beliau menambah, “Sektor Perkhidmatan terus mendominasi dengan 77.2 peratus atau 454,225 penawaran pekerjaan pada suku ketiga 2025, berbanding 64.7 peratus pada suku kedua 2025. Subsektor Perdagangan Borong dan Runcit, Pembaikan Kenderaan Bermotor dan Motosikal merekodkan jumlah penawaran pekerjaan tertinggi dalam sektor Perkhidmatan dengan 164,899 penawaran. Seterusnya, diikuti Aktiviti Profesional, Saintifik dan Teknikal dengan 61,367 penawaran pekerjaan, Aktiviti Pentadbiran dan Perkhidmatan Sokongan dengan 44,928 penawaran pekerjaan, Aktiviti Pembuatan dengan 41,303 penawaran pekerjaan serta sektor Pembinaan dengan 39,039 penawaran pekerjaan.”

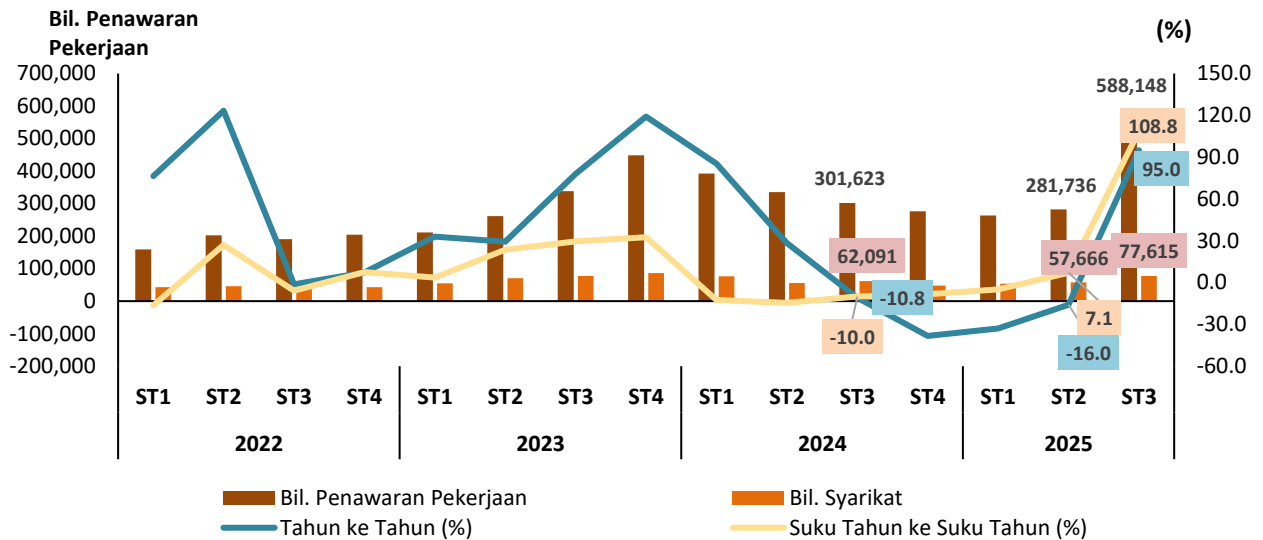
Menurut Ketua Perangkawan, “Tiga (3) penawaran pekerjaan tertinggi mengikut kumpulan pekerjaan (MASCO 6-digit) dalam bidang Pendidikan dan Latihan Teknikal dan Vokasional (TVET) pada suku ketiga 2025 ialah Pengurus Projek (5,780 penawaran pekerjaan), diikuti oleh juruteknik (5,296 penawaran pekerjaan) dan Eksekutif Pemasaran (4,732 penawaran pekerjaan). Dalam bidang Sains, Teknologi, Kejuruteraan dan Matematik (STEM), Juruteknik merekodkan bilangan penawaran pekerjaan tertinggi iaitu 5,296 penawaran pekerjaan, diikuti Juruukur Bahan (3,604 penawaran pekerjaan) dan Pengurus Akaun (3,119 penawaran pekerjaan). Bagi Senarai Pekerjaan Kritikal (COL), penawaran tertinggi adalah Pengarah Urusan dan Ketua Eksekutif (8,507), diikuti Profesional Pengiklanan dan Pemasaran (8,268 penawaran pekerjaan) serta Akauntan dan Juruaudit (8,044 penawaran pekerjaan).”

Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) sedang melaksanakan **Banci Ekonomi 2026 (BE2026)**, dengan tema “**Data Nadi Ekonomi Rakyat**”. Pelaksanaan Banci Ekonomi kali keenam ini berlangsung dari **5 Januari hingga 31 Oktober 2026**. BE2026 bertujuan untuk mengumpul data yang menyeluruh dan berstruktur daripada semua pertubuhan perniagaan berdaftar dan tidak berdaftar di Malaysia, bagi menilai prestasi, struktur serta ciri-ciri ekonomi negara secara komprehensif dan berasaskan bukti.

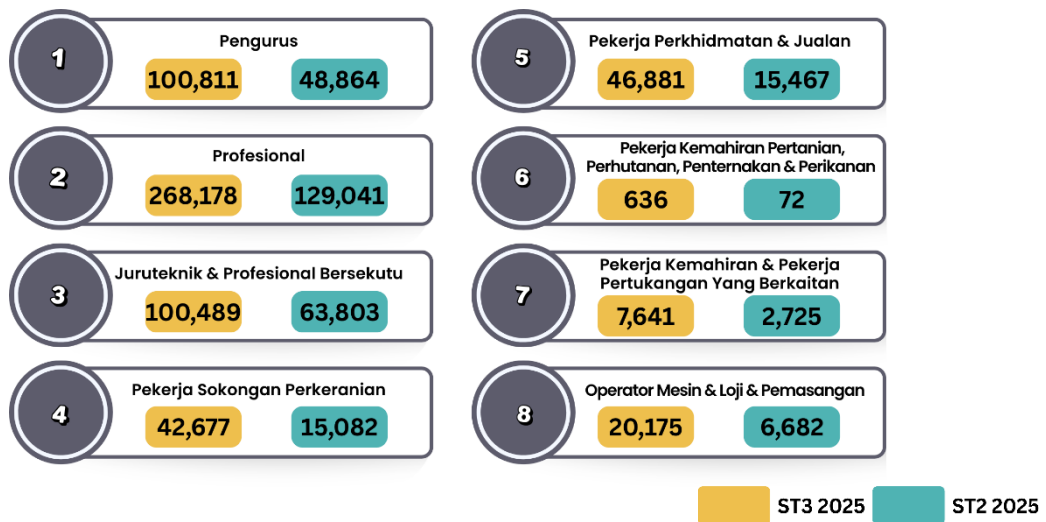

Carta 1: Penawaran Pekerjaan Diiklankan dalam Talian, ST1 2022 – ST3 2025



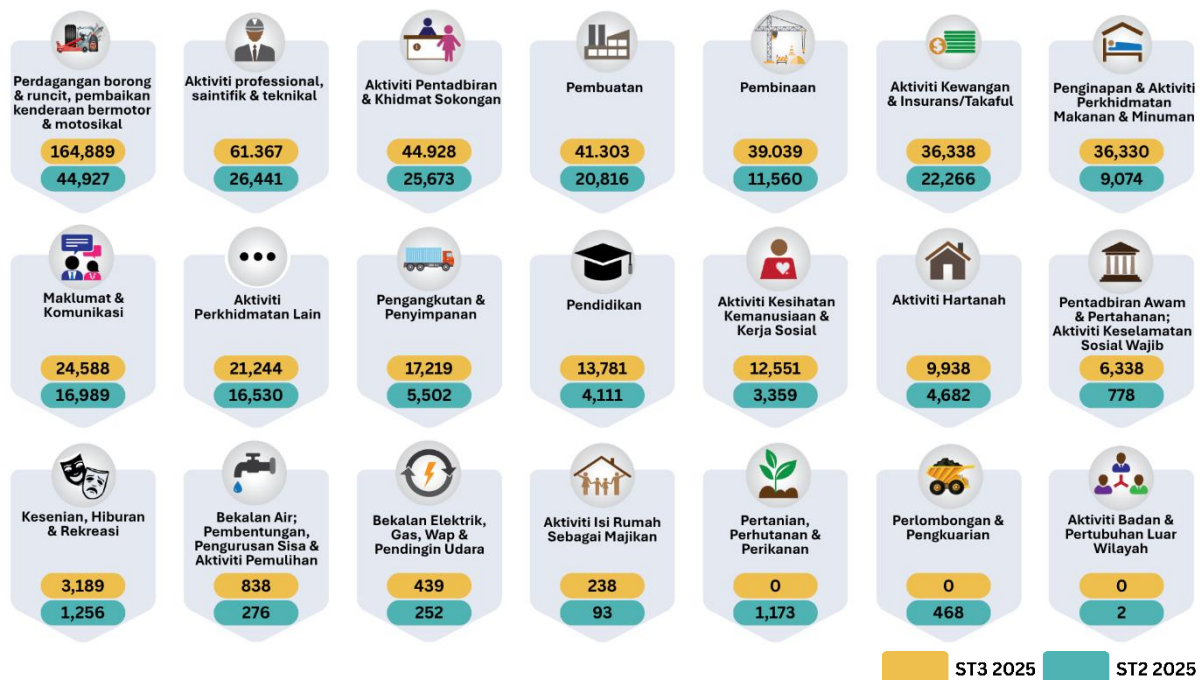

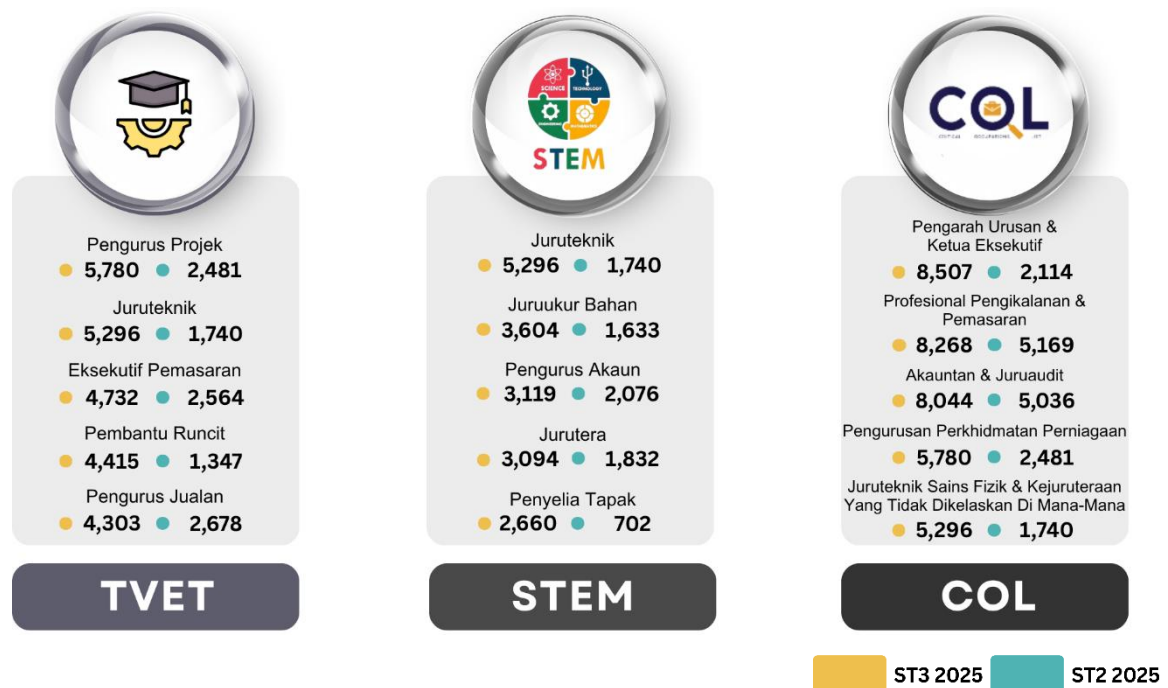

JOB OFFERINGS ADVERTISED ONLINE IN MALAYSIA THIRD QUARTER 2025

Online job offerings increased by 108.8 per cent in the third quarter of 2025, with 588,148 job offerings recorded

PUTRAJAYA, 28TH APRIL 2026 – The number of online job offerings increased by **108.8 per cent** in the third quarter of 2025, reaching **588,148 job offerings**, marking the highest ever since the third quarter of 2021 (112.7 per cent), according to the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) as reported in the release **Big Data Analytics: Job Market Insights – Online Job Offerings Advertised in Malaysia, Q3 2025**.

The Chief Statistician of Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, stated, "The number of companies advertising job offerings in the third quarter of 2025 rose to 77,615, compared to 57,666 in the second quarter of 2025. Online job offerings were concentrated in the Professional category, accounting for 45.6 per cent or 268,178 job offerings in the third quarter of 2025, compared to 129,041 job offerings in the second quarter of 2025. The Managers category recorded 100,811 job offerings, followed by Technicians and Associate Professionals with 100,489 job offerings. Higher demand was observed for Advertising and Marketing Professionals (40,213 job offerings), followed by Managing Directors and Chief Executives (35,606 job offerings), Administrative Associate Professionals (30,523 job offerings), Administrative Professionals (18,860 job offerings), as well as Accountants and Auditors (17,587 job offerings)."

The Chief Statistician further added, "The Services sector continued to dominate, accounting for 77.2 per cent or 454,225 job offerings in the third quarter of 2025, compared to 64.7 per cent in the second quarter of 2025. The Wholesale and Retail Trade; Repair of Motor Vehicles and Motorcycles subsector recorded the highest number of job offerings within the Services sector, with 164,899 job offerings. This was followed by Professional, Scientific and Technical Activities (61,367 job offerings),

Administrative and Support Service Activities (44,928 job offerings), Manufacturing (41,303 job offerings), and the Construction sector (39,039 job offerings)."

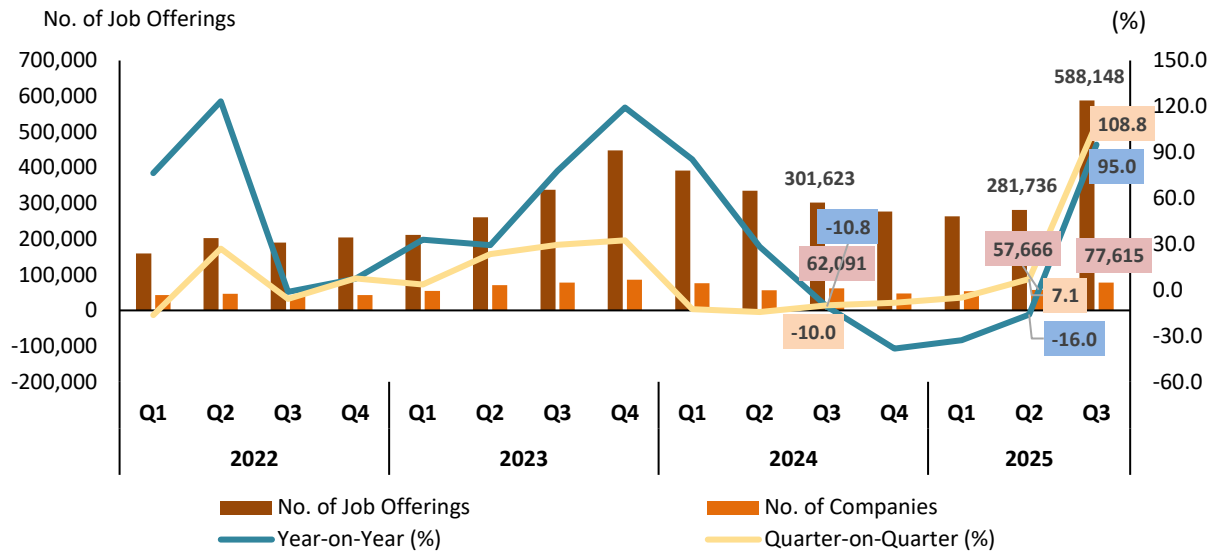
According to the Chief Statistician, "The top three job offerings by occupation group (MASCO 6-digit) in the Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) field in the third quarter of 2025 were Project Managers (5,780 job offerings), followed by Technicians (5,296 job offerings) and Marketing Executives (4,732 job offerings). In the Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) field, Technicians recorded the highest number of job offerings at 5,296, followed by Quantity Surveyors (3,604 job offerings) and Account Managers (3,119 job offerings). For the Critical Occupations List (COL), the highest job offerings were Managing Directors and Chief Executives (8,507 job offerings), followed by Advertising and Marketing Professionals (8,268 job offerings) and Accountants and Auditors (8,044 job offerings)."

*The Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) is conducting the **Economic Census 2026 (BE2026)**, with themed "**Data Nadi Ekonomi Rakyat**". The sixth Economic Census, will be carried out from **5th January to 31st October 2026**. BE2026 aims to collect comprehensive and structured data from all registered and unregistered business establishments in Malaysia to assess the nation's economic performance, structure and characteristics in an evidence-based manner.*

***Malaysia** has, for the first time, successfully secured the **top position** globally in the biennial **Open Data Inventory (ODIN) 2024/25** report released by Open Data Watch (ODW), surpassing 197 other countries. This achievement marks a significant leap from its 67th position in the ODIN 2022/23 assessment.*

Q3 2025 & Q2 2025**

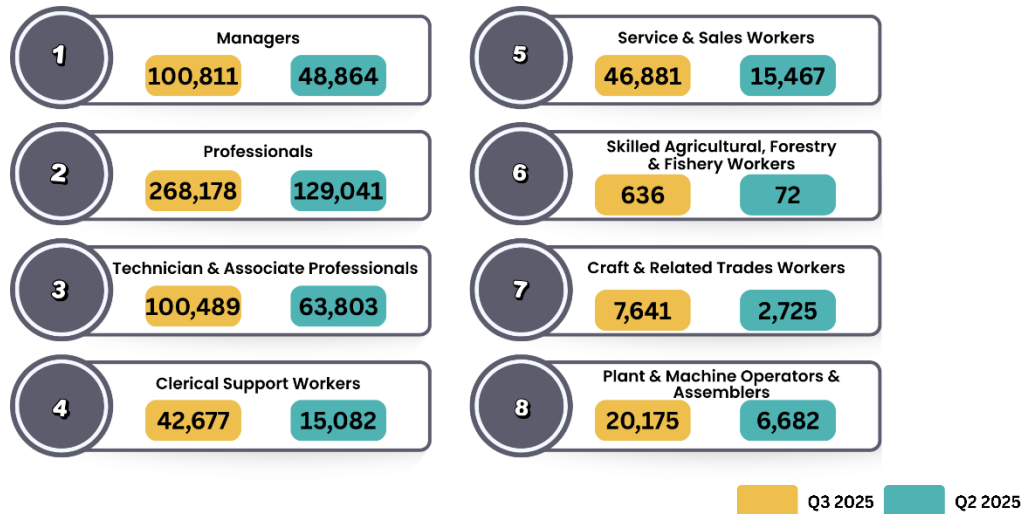


Exhibit 2: Job Offerings Advertised Online by Hottest Job, Q3 2025 & Q2 2025



Exhibit 3: Job Offerings Advertised Online by Economic Activity Q3 2025 & Q2 2025

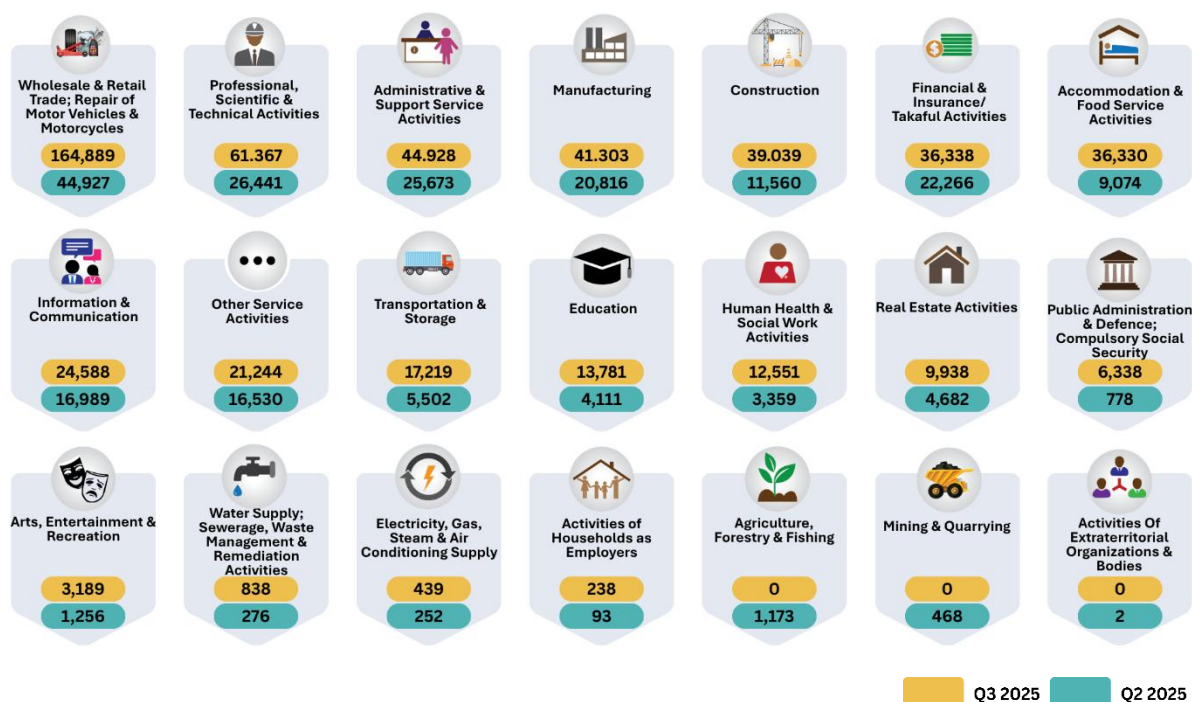
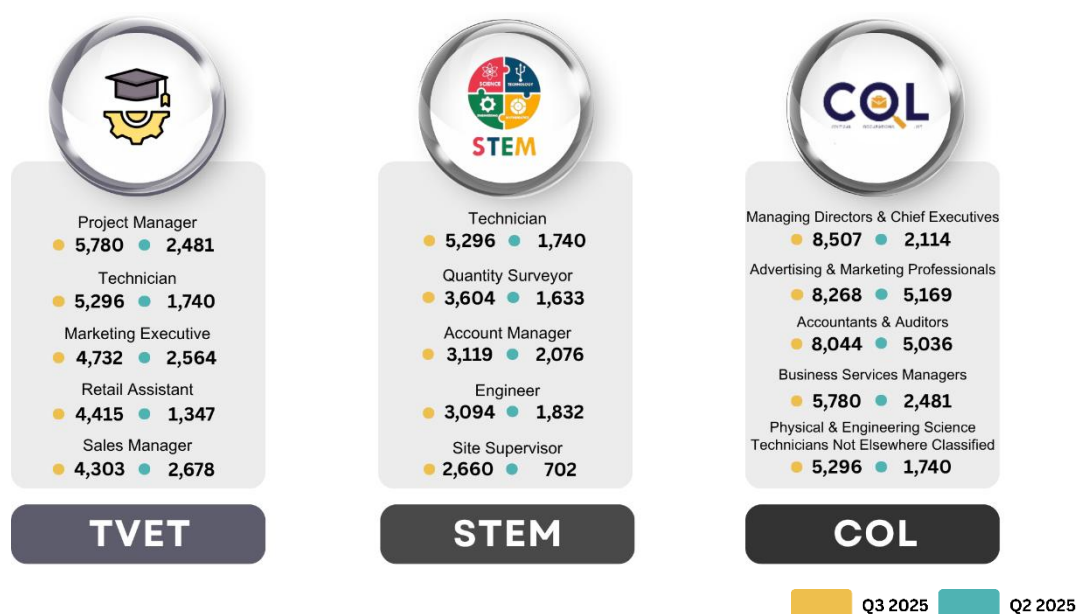


Exhibit 4: Highest Job Offerings Advertised Online for Occupation Groups in TVET, STEM and COL, Q3 2025 & Q2 2025
