INDIKATOR SOSIOEKONOMI NEGERI, NEGERI SEMBILAN SUKU TAHUN PERTAMA 2026

Negeri Sembilan mencatatkan prestasi sosioekonomi yang kukuh pada suku pertama tahun 2026, disokong oleh pasaran buruh yang stabil dan sentimen perniagaan yang positif

PUTRAJAYA, 21 MEI 2026 – Negeri Sembilan menunjukkan prestasi sosioekonomi yang kukuh pada Suku Tahun Pertama 2026 (ST1 2026) dengan pasaran buruh kekal stabil dan sentimen perniagaan yang positif. Prestasi ini dipaparkan dalam penerbitan **Indikator Sosioekonomi Negeri Sembilan, Suku Tahun Pertama 2026** yang diterbitkan pada hari ini oleh Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM). Penerbitan ini merupakan penjenamaan semula daripada Poket Stats Negeri yang telah diperkasakan melalui penambahan indikator utama terpilih, yang mengetengahkan statistik ekonomi dan sosial di peringkat negeri. Antara indikator ekonomi utama ialah pengeluaran dalam subsektor Pertanian terpilih, inflasi, perdagangan luar dan pasaran buruh, sementara indikator sosial utama merangkumi populasi serta pendapatan dan perbelanjaan isi rumah. Penerbitan ini bertujuan menyediakan kefahaman serta berperanan sebagai rujukan kepada pengguna umum.

Ekonomi Malaysia bertumbuh 5.4 peratus pada suku tahun pertama 2026 (ST1 2026: 437.7 bilion) berbanding 6.2 peratus pada suku tahun sebelumnya (ST4 2025: 457.9 bilion). Menurut Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "Ekonomi Malaysia terus berkembang pada suku tahun pertama 2026, mencerminkan daya tahan asas ekonomi serta keadaan pertumbuhan yang stabil dalam persekitaran global yang mencabar."

Indeks Harga Pengguna (IHP) meningkat 2.2 peratus pada Mac 2026 berbanding 2.0 peratus pada Februari 2026. Ini menggambarkan kenaikan inflasi secara keseluruhan selaras dengan peningkatan indeks harga di peringkat nasional susulan ketidakpastian pergerakan harga komoditi global.

Dari sudut perdagangan luar negeri, nilai eksport pada ST1 2026 menurun 14.7 peratus kepada RM4.8 bilion (ST1 2025: RM5.6 bilion). Sebaliknya, nilai import meningkat 8.2 peratus kepada RM9.8 bilion (ST1 2025: RM9.1 bilion) dalam tempoh yang sama. Prestasi ini mencerminkan aktiviti perdagangan yang masih aktif meskipun eksport mencatatkan penyusutan.

Merujuk kepada pasaran buruh, Negeri Sembilan mengekalkan tahap penglibatan tenaga kerja yang stabil, disokong oleh aktiviti ekonomi yang berterusan. Bilangan tenaga buruh mencatatkan 578.1 ribu orang (ST4 2025: 579.8 ribu orang), sementara kadar penyertaan tenaga buruh (KPTB) berada pada 67.1 peratus (ST4 2025: 67.1%). Selari dengan senario tersebut, bilangan penduduk bekerja mencatatkan 564.1 ribu orang (ST4 2025: 565.1 ribu orang), manakala kadar pengangguran kekal rendah pada paras 2.4 peratus (ST4 2025: 2.5%).

Prospek ke hadapan, imbalan bersih jangkaan perniagaan kekal positif dengan mencatatkan +13.4 peratus pada Januari sehingga Jun 2026, meningkat berbanding +8.9 peratus pada suku sebelumnya, mencerminkan prospek perniagaan yang semakin menggalakkan dalam tempoh terdekat. Jangkaan masa hadapan yang positif menggambarkan keyakinan berterusan dalam kalangan peniaga terhadap perkembangan aktiviti ekonomi. Sentimen ini selaras dengan prestasi sektor Pembuatan yang kekal stabil dengan kapasiti penggunaan industri 85.4 peratus pada ST1 2026, sekali gus mencerminkan tahap operasi yang mampan dan berdaya tahan dalam kalangan pengusaha industri di negeri ini.

Melihat kepada trend demografi, penduduk mencatatkan 1.250 juta orang pada ST1 2026 berbanding 1.248 juta orang pada ST4 2025. Kelahiran hidup mencatatkan 3,405 orang manakala kematian direkodkan sebanyak 2,064 orang dalam tempoh yang sama.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia menyatakan bahawa penerbitan ini merupakan inisiatif dalam penyampaian statistik di peringkat negeri, dengan menyediakan gambaran prestasi sosioekonomi dalam frekuensi yang lebih kerap dan melengkapi Keluaran Dalam Negeri Kasar (KDNK) Negeri yang merupakan penanda aras ekonomi tahunan.

Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) sedang melaksanakan Banci Ekonomi 2026 (BE2026), bertemakan “Data Nadi Ekonomi Rakyat”. Pelaksanaan Banci Ekonomi kali keenam ini berlangsung dari 5 Januari hingga 31 Oktober 2026. BE2026 bertujuan untuk mengumpul data yang menyeluruh dan berstruktur daripada semua pertubuhan perniagaan berdaftar dan tidak berdaftar di Malaysia, bagi menilai prestasi, struktur serta ciri-ciri ekonomi negara secara komprehensif dan berasaskan bukti.

Malaysia buat julung kalinya telah menduduki tangga pertama (1) di peringkat global dalam laporan dwi-tahunan Open Data Inventory (ODIN) 2024/25 yang dikeluarkan oleh Open Data Watch (ODW), mengatasi 197 negara lain. Pencapaian ini merupakan lonjakan ketara daripada kedudukan ke-67 dalam penilaian ODIN 2022/23.

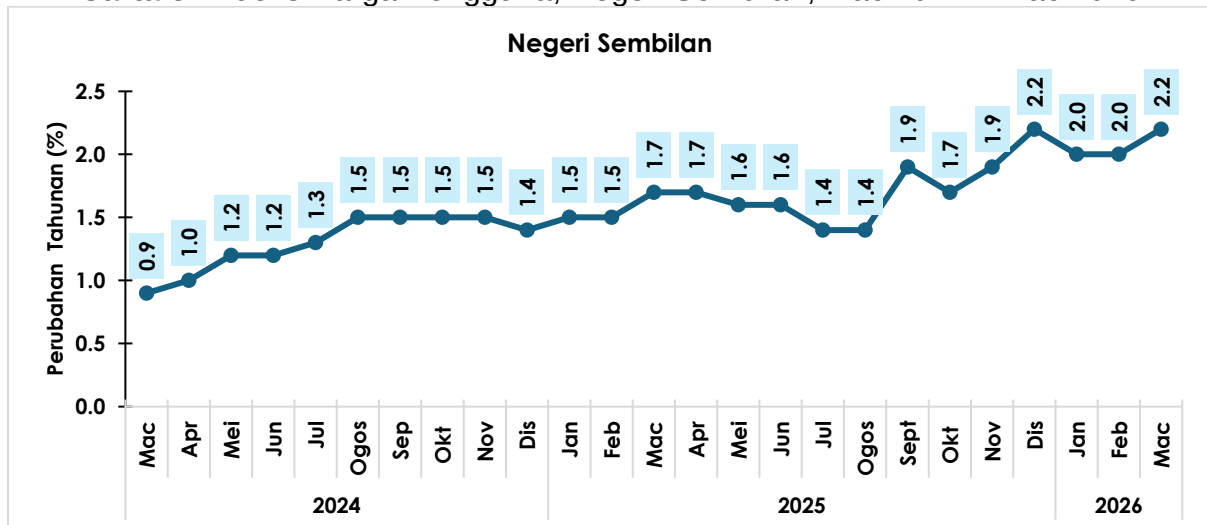

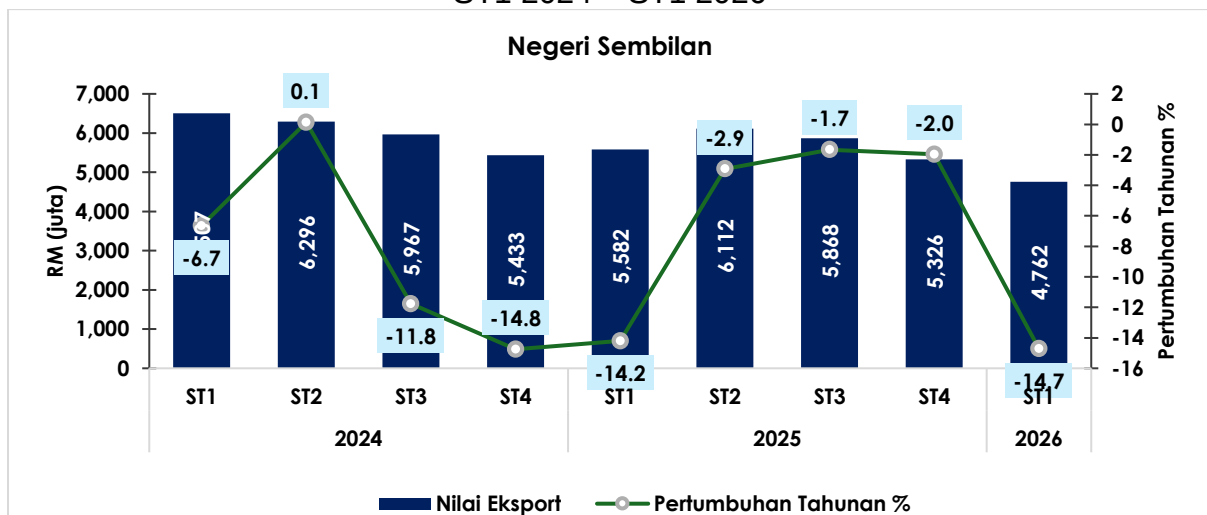
Carta 4: Keluaran Dalam Negeri Kasar (KDNK) mengikut Sektor, Negeri Sembilan, 2021– 2024



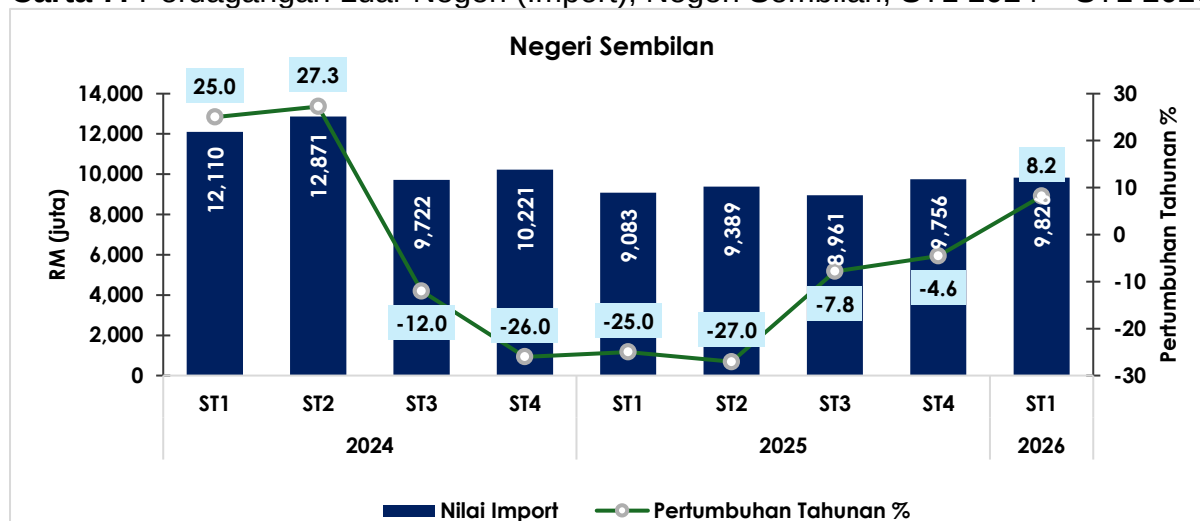
Carta 5: Indeks Harga Pengguna, Negeri Sembilan, Mac 2024 – Mac 2026



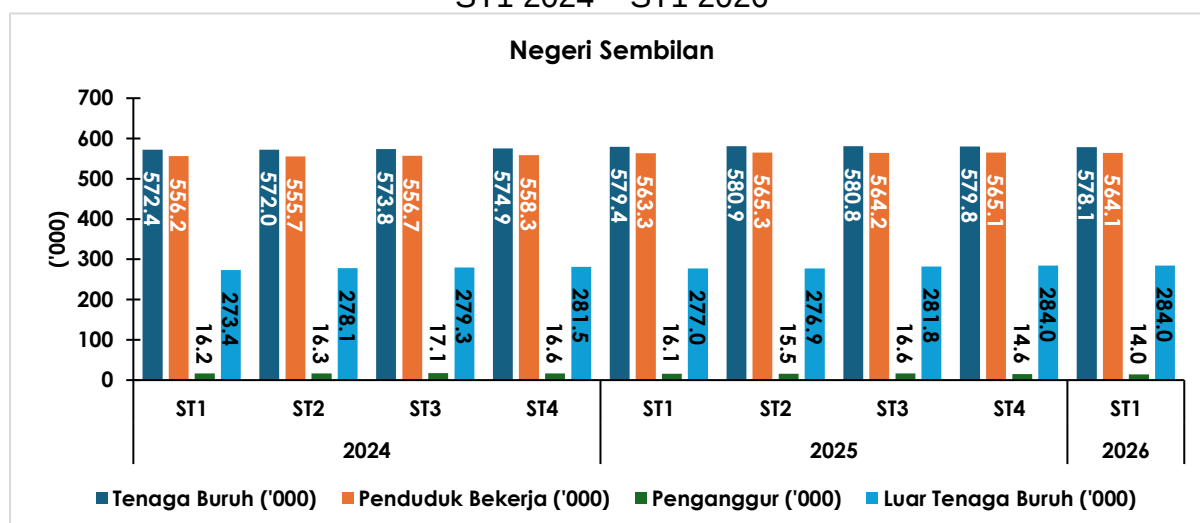
Carta 6: Perdagangan Luar Negeri (Eksport), Negeri Sembilan, ST1 2024 – ST1 2026



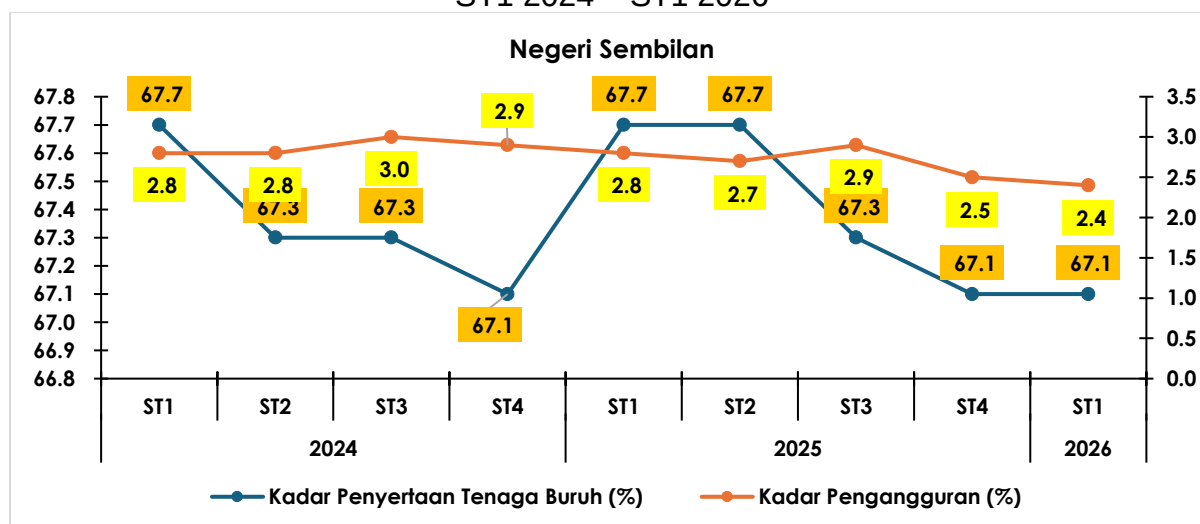
Carta 7: Perdagangan Luar Negeri (Import), Negeri Sembilan, ST1 2024 – ST1 2026



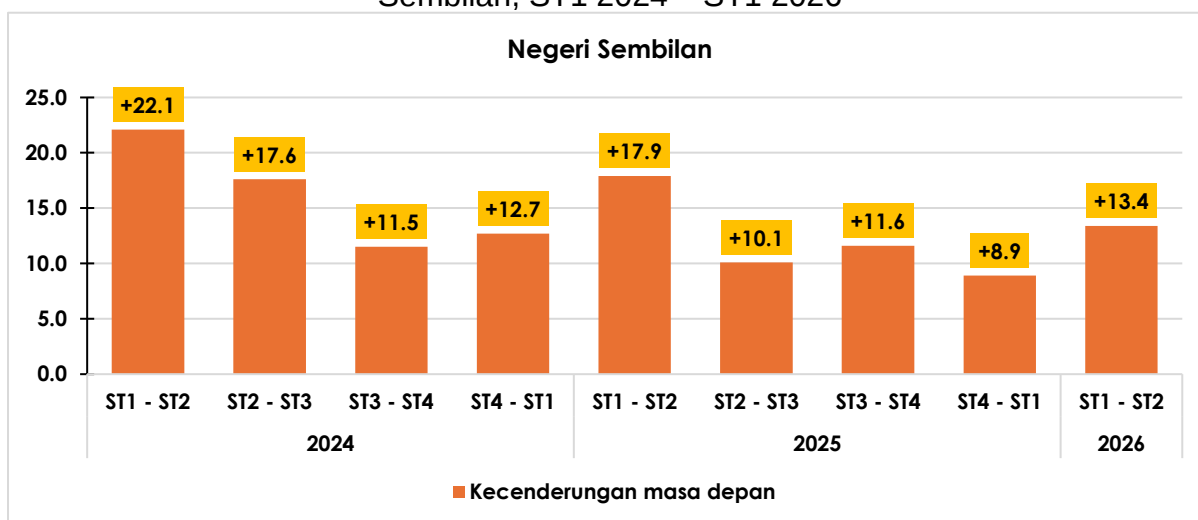
Carta 8: Statistik Utama Tenaga Buruh, Negeri Sembilan, ST1 2024 – ST1 2026



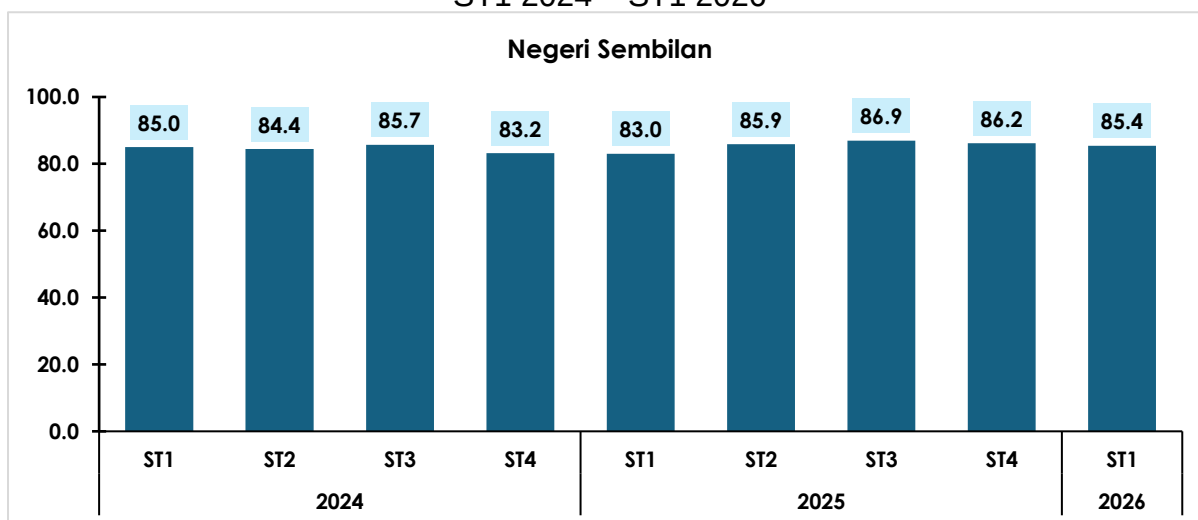
Carta 9: Kadar Penyertaan Tenaga Buruh dan Pengangguran, Negeri Sembilan, ST1 2024 – ST1 2026



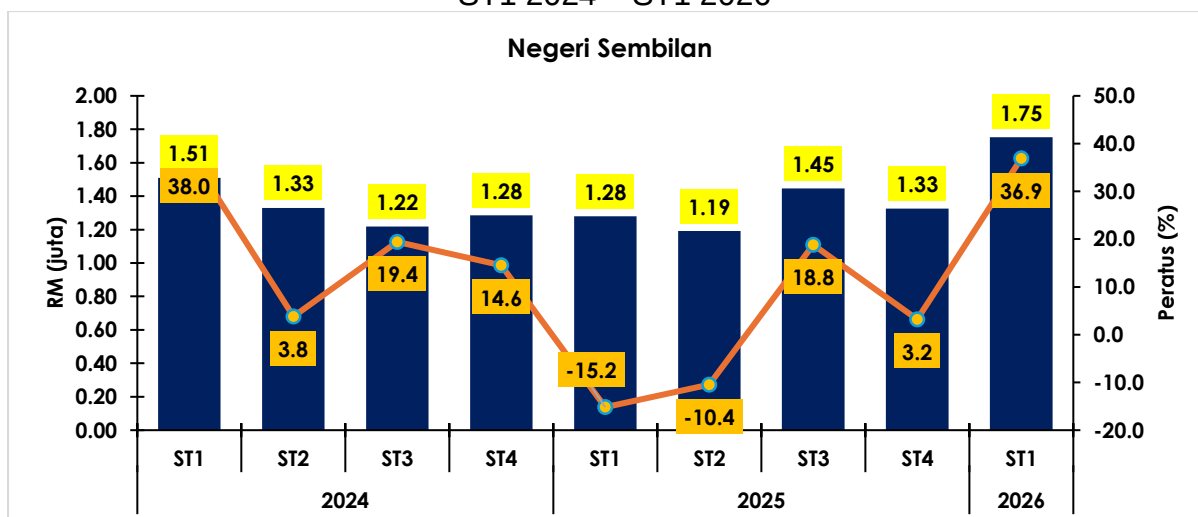

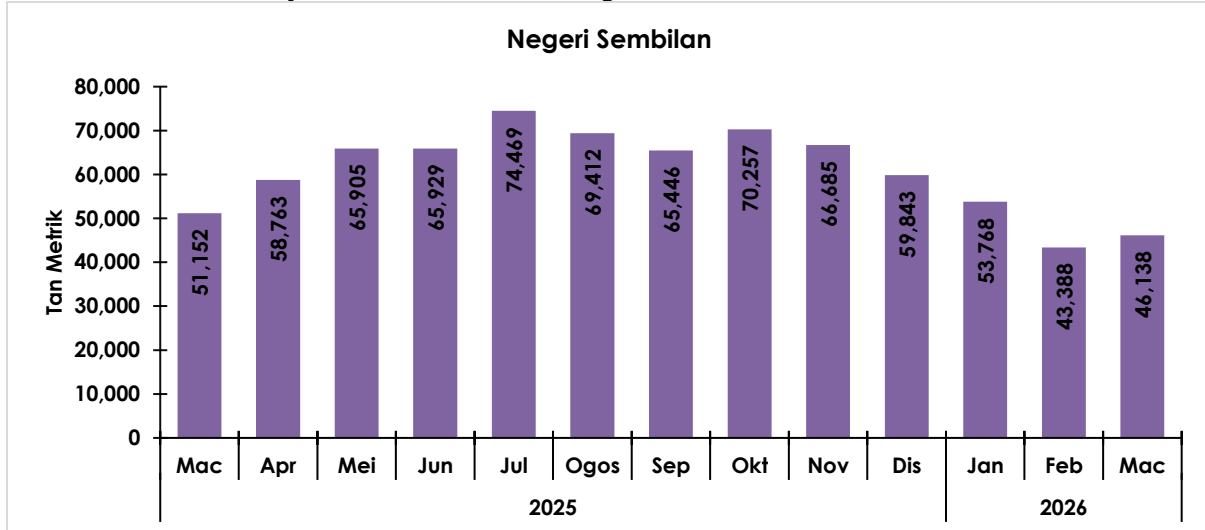
Carta 11: Kapasiti Penggunaan Industri Pembuatan, Negeri Sembilan, ST1 2024 – ST1 2026



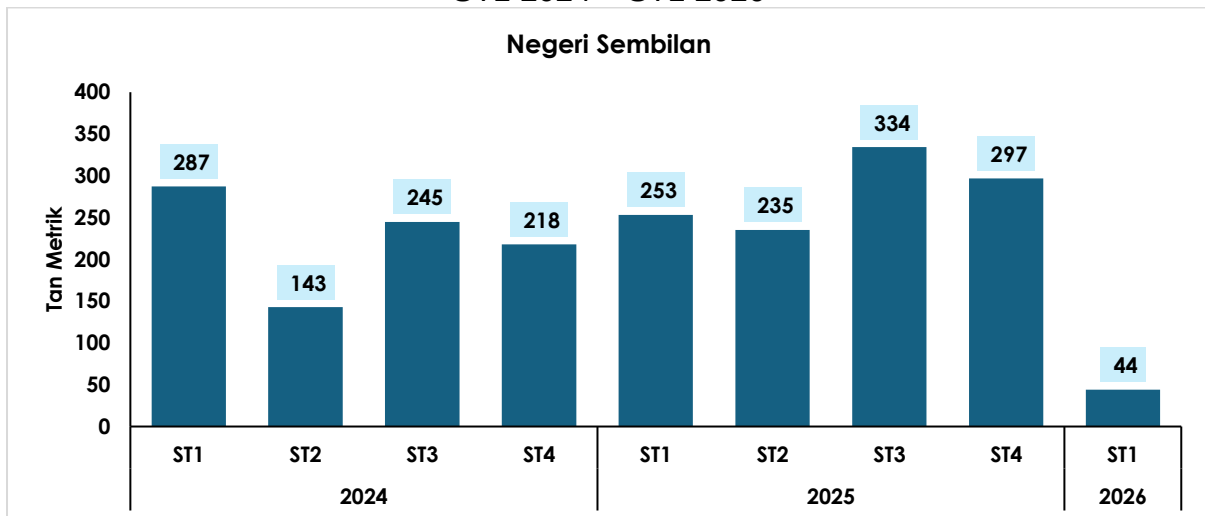
Carta 12: Nilai Kerja Pembinaan bagi Sektor Pembinaan, Negeri Sembilan, ST1 2024 – ST1 2026



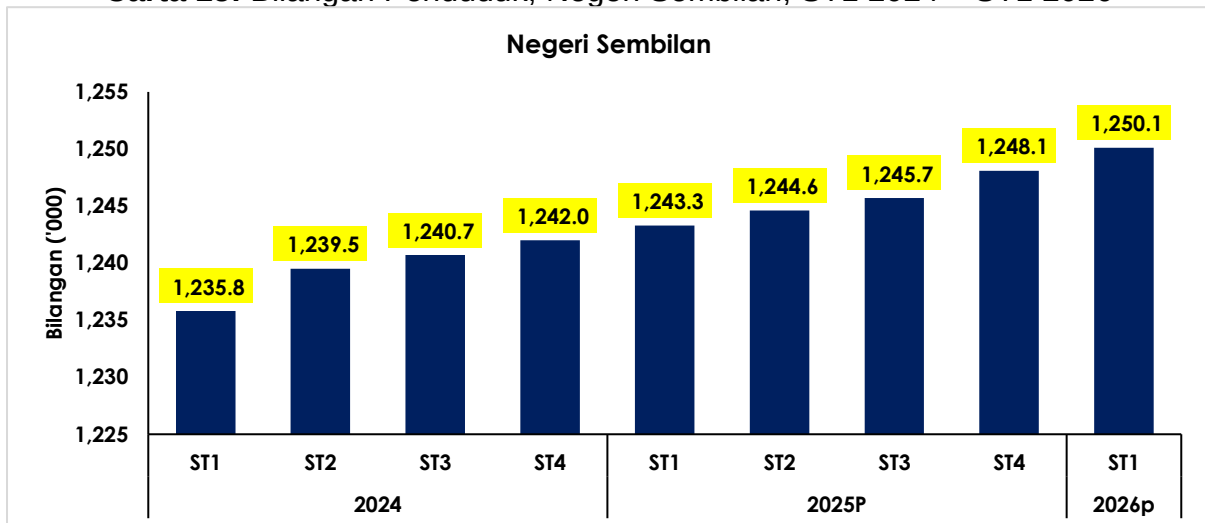
Carta 13: Minyak Sawit Mentah, Negeri Sembilan, Mac 2025 – Mac 2026



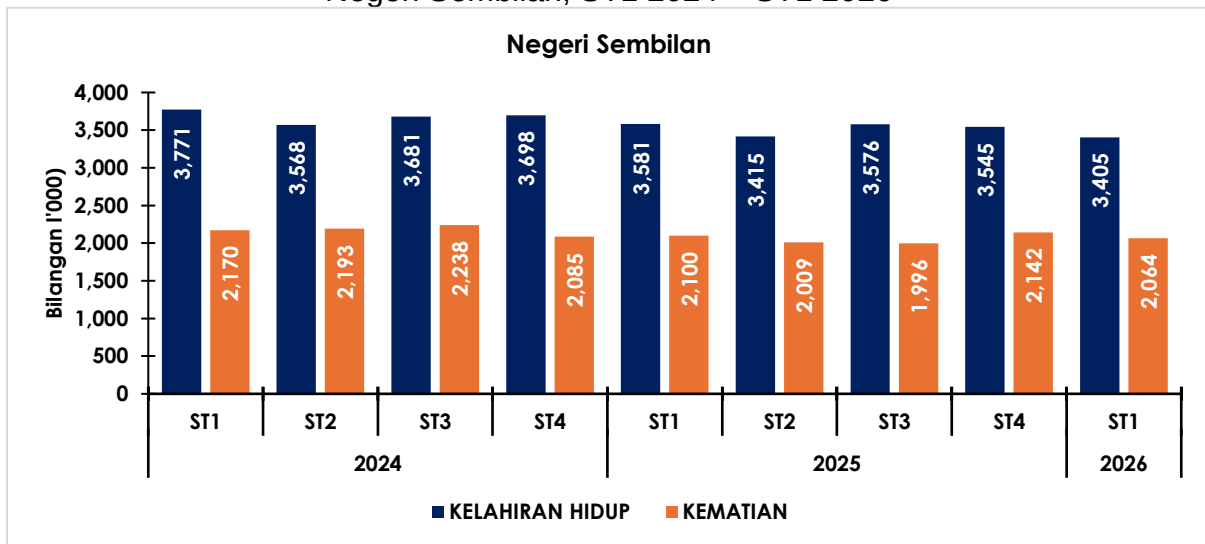
Carta 14: Pengeluaran Getah Asli, Negeri Sembilan, ST1 2024 – ST1 2026



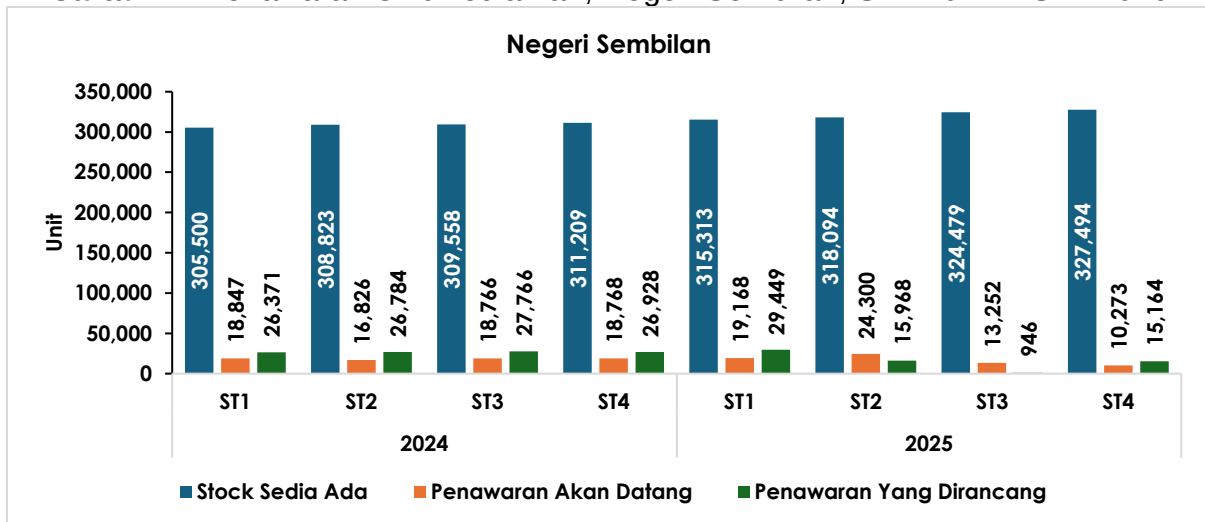
Carta 15: Bilangan Penduduk, Negeri Sembilan, ST1 2024 – ST1 2026

STATE SOCIOECONOMIC INDICATORS, NEGERI SEMBILAN FIRST QUARTER, 2026

Negeri Sembilan recorded steady socioeconomic performance in the first quarter of 2026, supported by a stable labour market and positive business sentiment.

PUTRAJAYA, 21 MAY 2026 – Negeri Sembilan recorded steady socioeconomic performance in the First Quarter of 2026 (Q1 2026), with a stable labour market and positive business sentiment. These developments are highlighted in the publication **State Socioeconomic Indicators, Negeri Sembilan First Quarter, 2026** released today by the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM). The publication is a rebranding of Pocket Stats State, enhanced with selected key indicators highlighting economic and social statistics at the state level. Among the key economic indicators are production in selected Agriculture sub-sectors, inflation, external trade and the labour market, while key social indicators include population, as well as household income and expenditure. This publication aims to provide better understanding while serving as a reference for general users.

Malaysia's economy expanded by 5.4 per cent in the first quarter of 2026 (Q1 2026: RM437.7 billion) compared to 6.2 per cent in the previous quarter (Q4 2025: RM457.9 billion). According to the Chief Statistician of Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "Malaysia's economy continued to expand in the first quarter of 2026, reflecting the resilience of economic fundamentals and stable growth conditions amid a challenging global environment."

The Consumer Price Index (CPI) rose by 2.2 per cent in March 2026 compared to 2.0 per cent in February 2026. This reflected the overall rising inflation in line with the increase in the national price index following uncertainties in global commodity price movements.

From the external trade perspective, exports in Q1 2026 declined by 14.7 per cent to RM4.8 billion (Q1 2025: RM5.6 billion). In contrast, imports increased by 8.2 per cent to RM9.8 billion (Q1 2025: RM9.1 billion) during the same period. This performance reflected continued trade activity despite a contraction in exports.

Referring to the labour market, Negeri Sembilan maintained a stable level of labour force participation, supported by continued economic activities a. The labour force recorded 578.1 thousand persons (Q4 2025: 579.8 thousand persons), while the labour force participation rate (LFPR) stood at 67.1 per cent (Q4 2025: 67.1%). In line with this trend, the number of employed persons recorded 564.1 thousand persons (Q4 2025: 565.1 thousand persons), while the unemployment rate remained low at 2.4 per cent (Q4 2025: 2.5%).

Looking ahead, the net balance of business expectations remained positive at +13.4 per cent for the period of January to June 2026, improving from +8.9 per cent in the previous quarter, reflecting more favourable business prospects in the near term. Positive future expectations indicated sustained confidence among businesses in economic activities. This sentiment was consistent with the stable performance of the Manufacturing sector, with industrial capacity utilisation at 85.4 per cent in Q1 2026, reflecting resilient operational conditions among industrial players in the state.

In terms of demographic trends, the population increased to 1.250 million persons in Q1 2026 compared to 1.248 million persons in Q4 2025. Live births recorded 3,405 persons, while deaths were recorded at 2,064 persons during the same period.

The Chief Statistician of Malaysia mentioned that this publication serves as an initiative for communicating state-level statistics, providing a more frequent insights on socioeconomic performance and complementing the annual economic yardstick of Gross Domestic Product (GDP) by State.

The Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) is conducting the **Economic Census 2026 (BE2026)**, with themed “**Data Nadi Ekonomi Rakyat**”. The sixth Economic Census, will be carried out from **5th January to 31st October 2026**. BE2026 aims to collect comprehensive and structured data from all registered and unregistered business establishments in Malaysia to assess the nation’s economic performance, structure and characteristics in an evidence-based manner.

Malaysia has, for the first time, successfully secured the **top position** globally in the biennial **Open Data Inventory (ODIN) 2024/25** report released by Open Data Watch (ODW), surpassing 197 other countries. This achievement marks a significant leap from its 67th position in the ODIN 2022/23 assessment.

Chart 2: Gross Domestic Product (GDP), Malaysia, Q1 2023 – Q1 2026

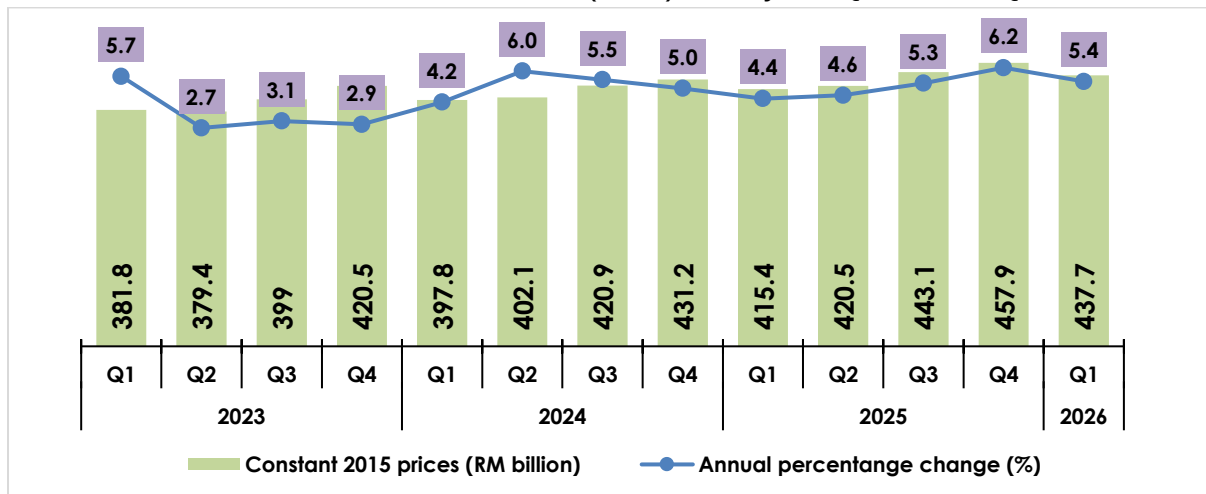


Chart 3: Gross Domestic Product (GDP), Negeri Sembilan, 2021–2024

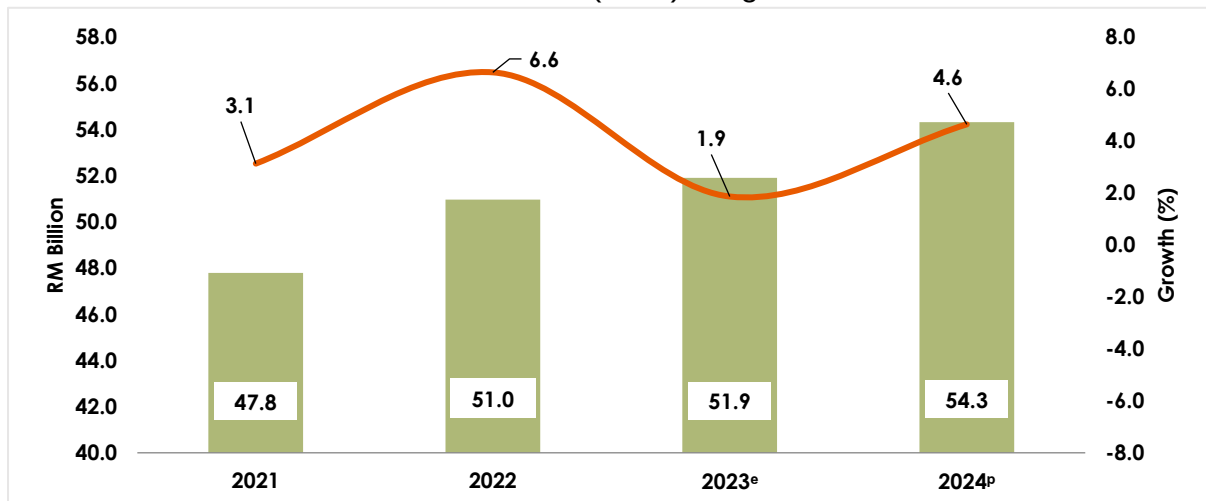


Chart 4 : Gross Domestic Product (GDP) by Sector, Negeri Sembilan, 2021– 2024

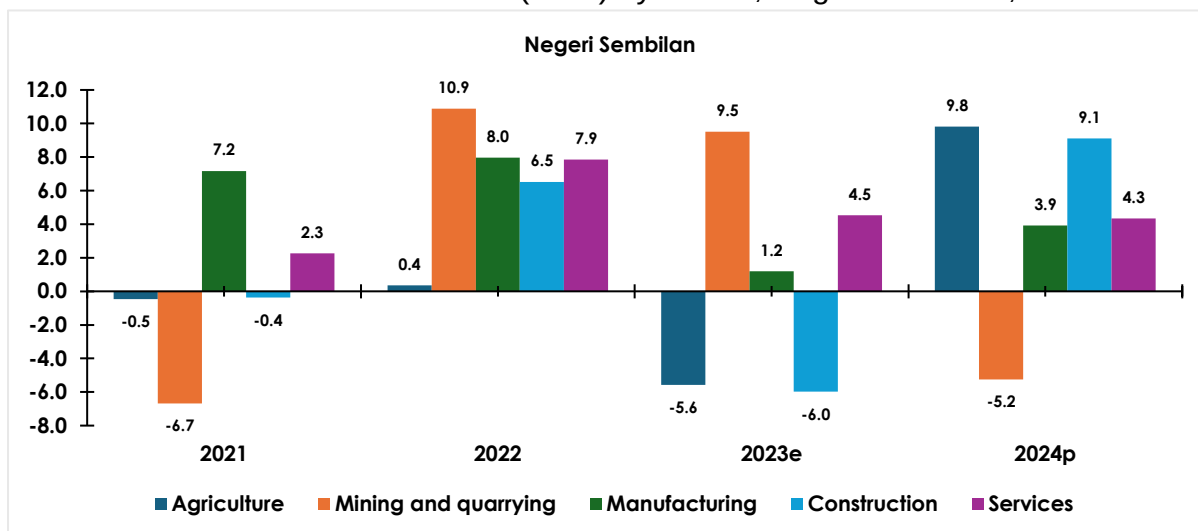


Chart 5: Consumer Price Index, Negeri Sembilan, March 2024 – March 2026

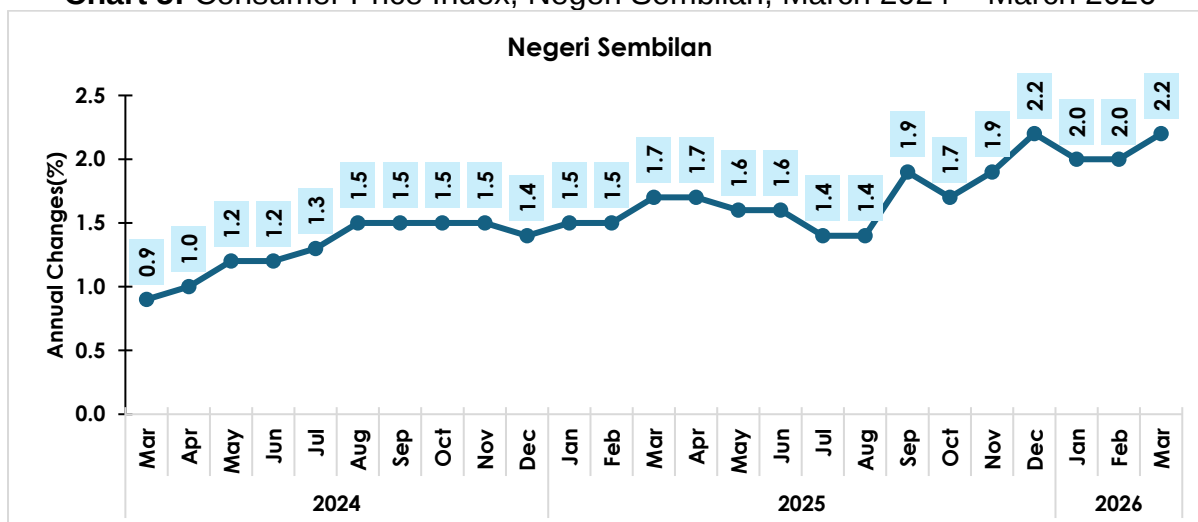


Chart 6: External Trade (Exports), Negeri Sembilan, Q1 2024 – Q1 2026

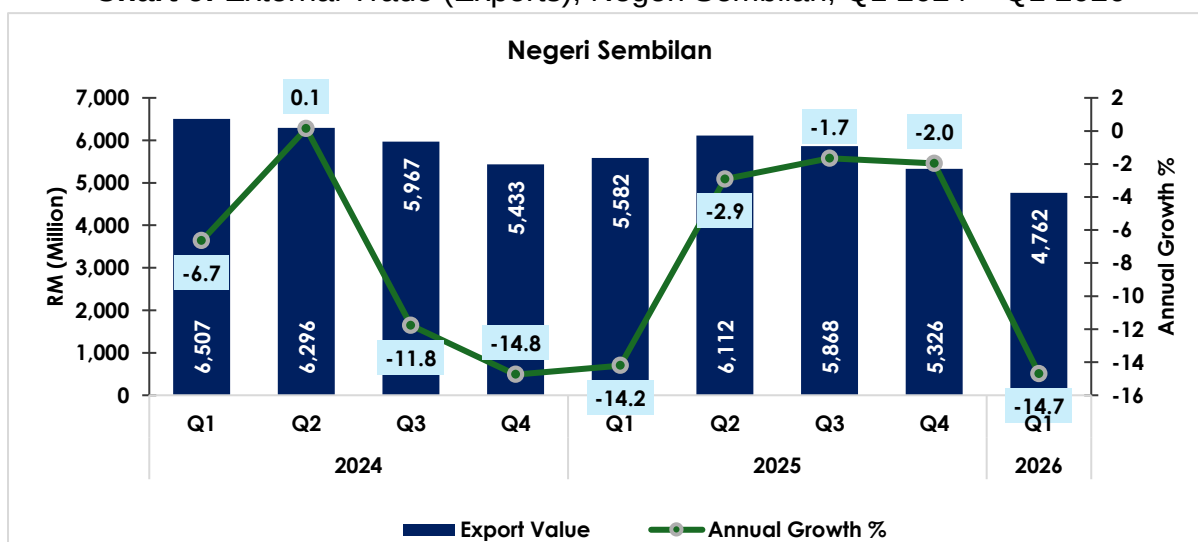


Chart 7: External Trade (Imports), Negeri Sembilan, Q1 2024 – Q1 2026

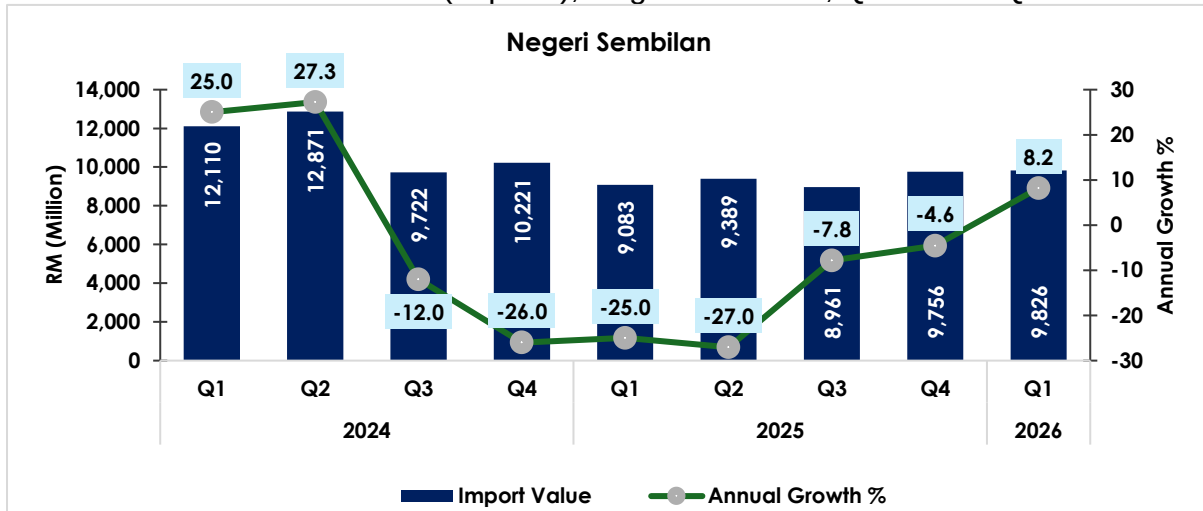


Chart 8: Principal Statistics of Labour Force, Negeri Sembilan, Q1 2024 – Q1 2026

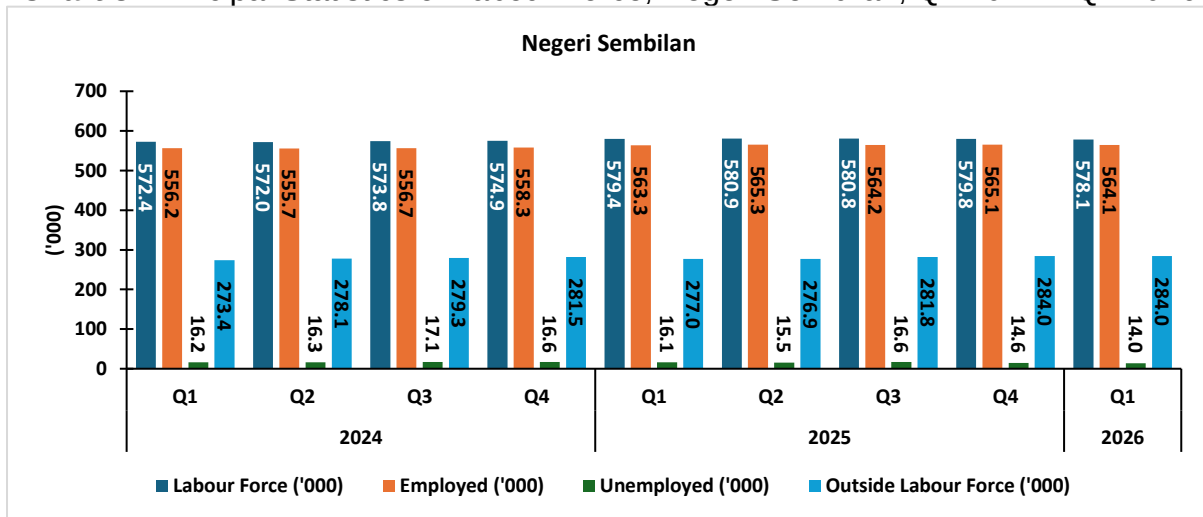


Chart 9: Labour Force Participation Rate and Unemployment Rate, Negeri Sembilan, Q1 2024 – Q1 2026

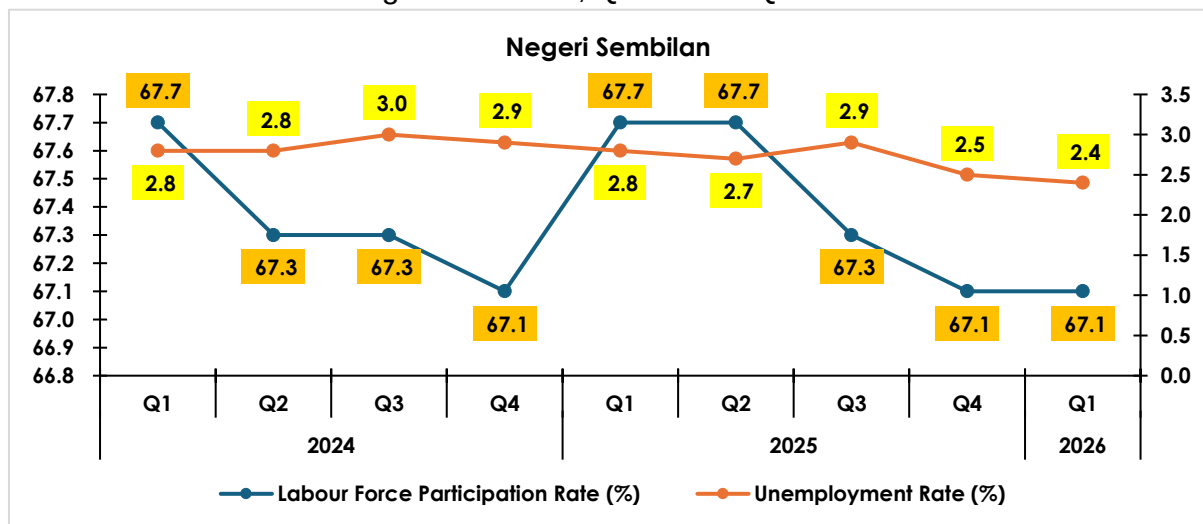


Chart 10: Net Balance of Business Performance for Upcoming Months, Negeri Sembilan, Q1 2024 – Q1 2026

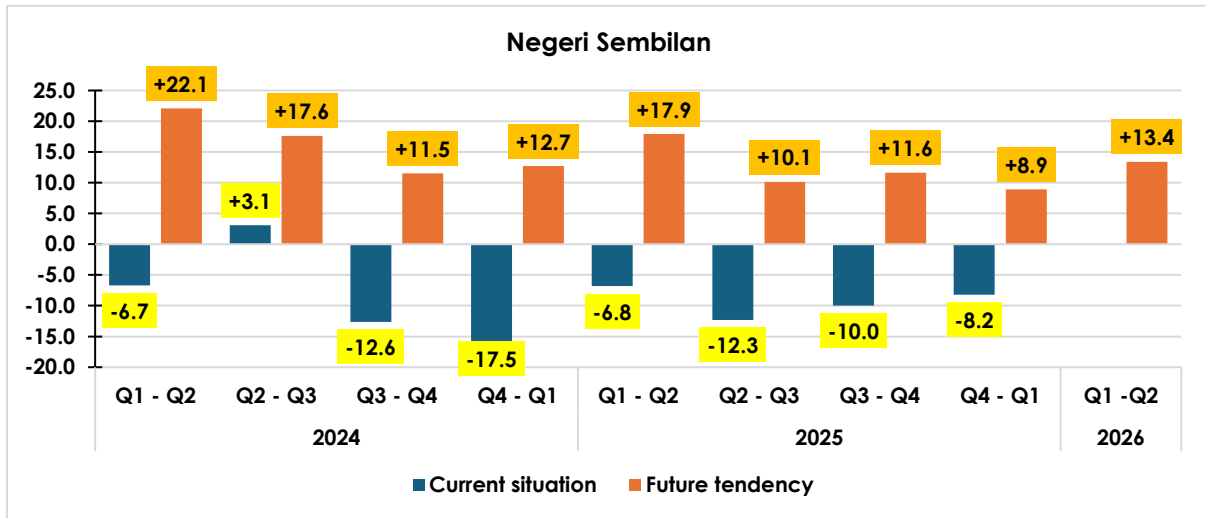


Chart 11: Manufacturing Industry Capacity Utilisation, Negeri Sembilan, Q1 2024 – Q1 2026

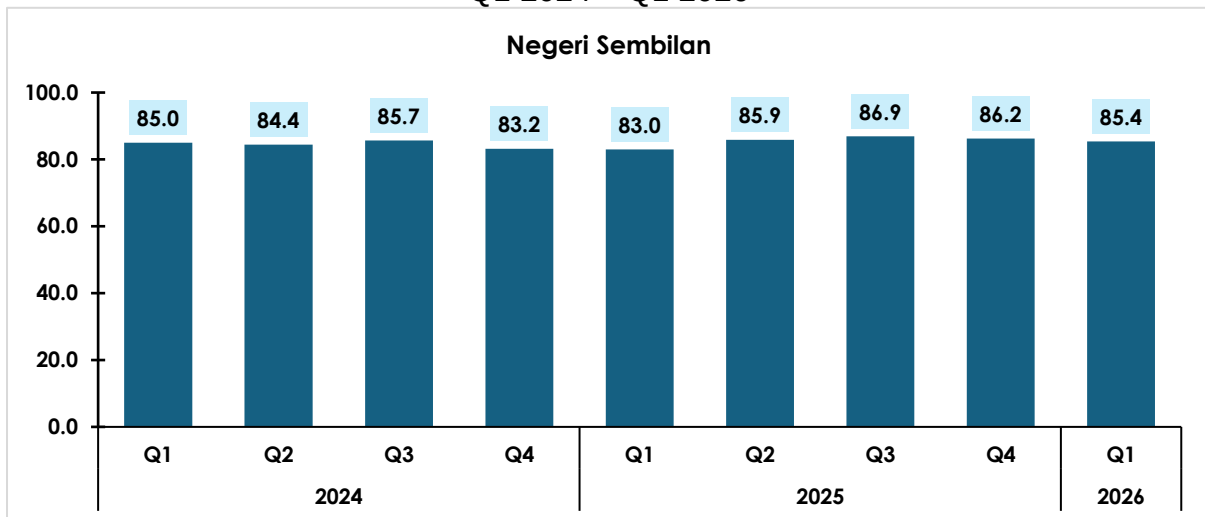


Chart 12: Value of Work Done Construction Sector, Negeri Sembilan, Q1 2024 – Q1 2026

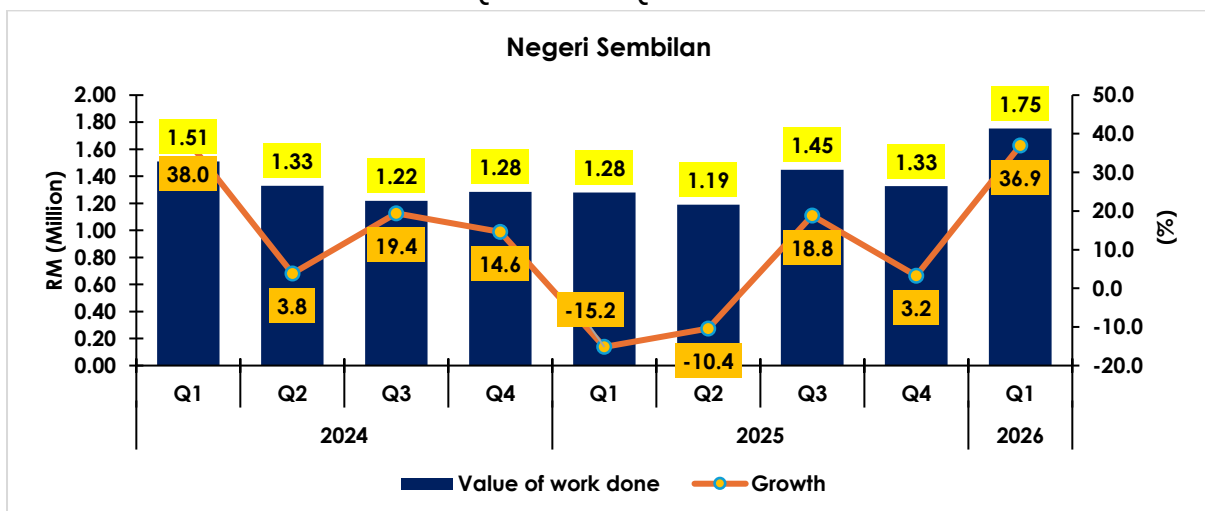


Chart 13: Crude Oil Palm, Negeri Sembilan, Mar 2025 – Mar 2026

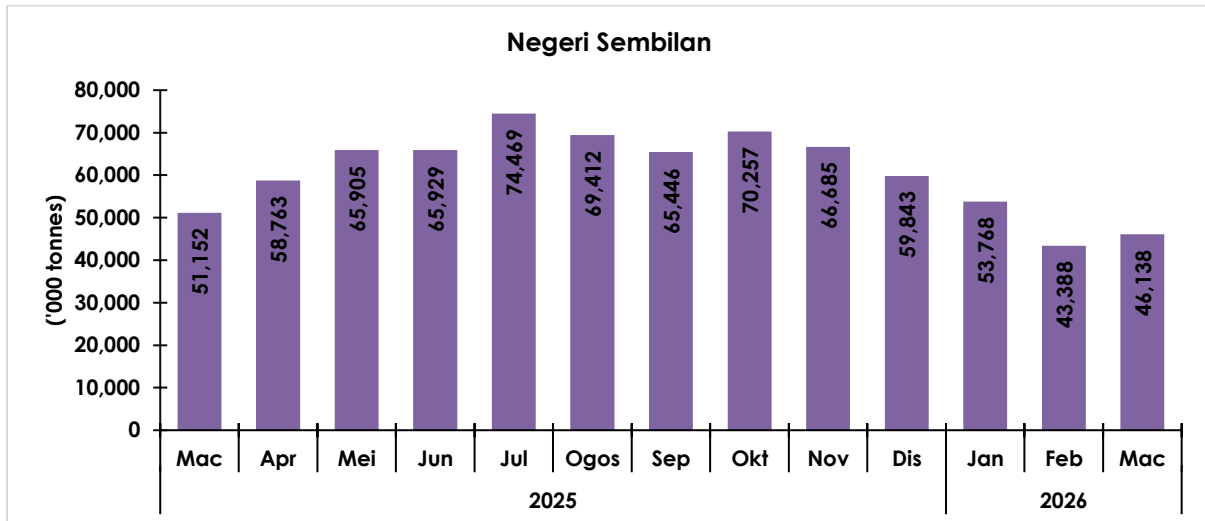


Chart 14: Production of Natural Rubber, Negeri Sembilan, Q1 2024 – Q1 2026

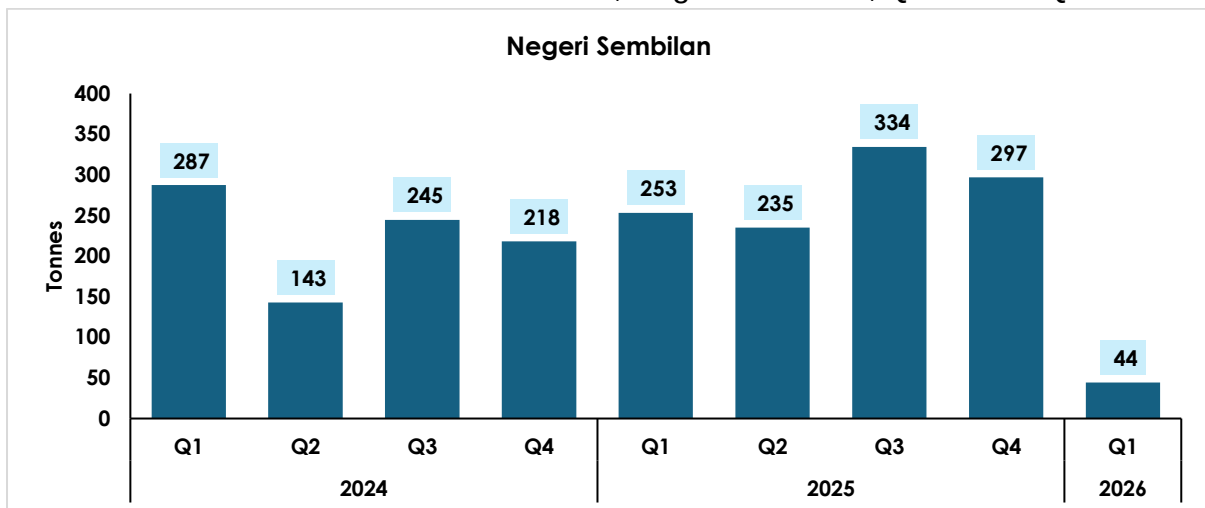


Chart 15: Total Population, Negeri Sembilan, Q1 2024 – Q1 2026

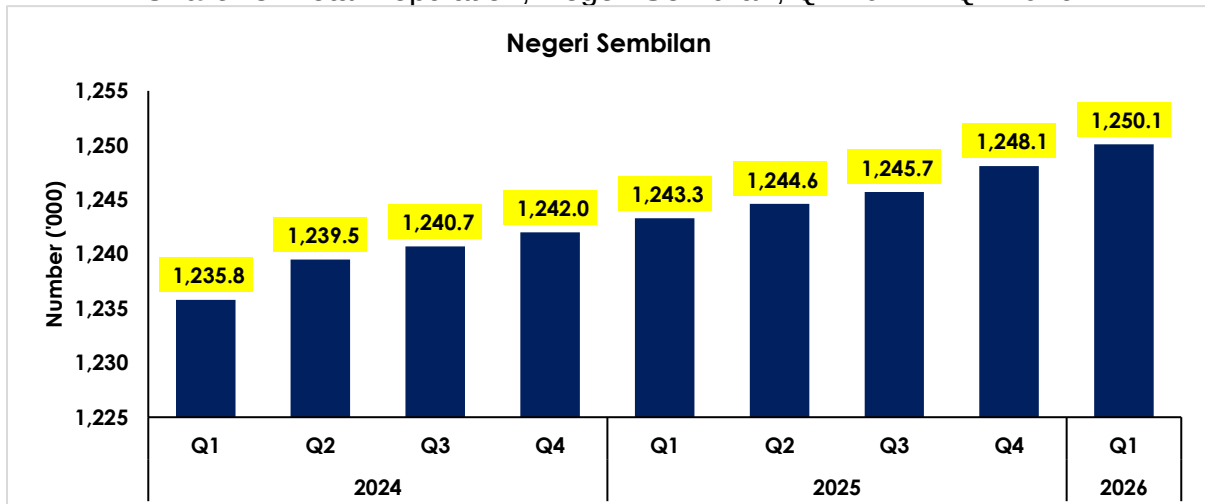


Chart 16: Vital Statistics on Live Births and Deaths, Negeri Sembilan, Q1 2024 – Q1 2026

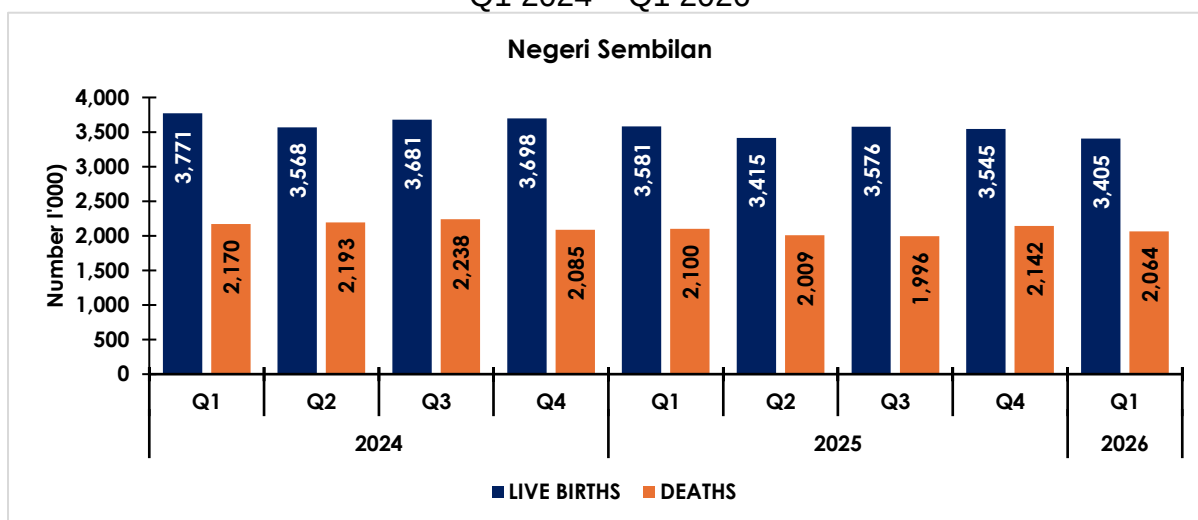


Chart 17: Supply of Residential Units, Negeri Sembilan, Q1 2024 – Q1 2026
