INDEKS PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI, MALAYSIA APRIL 2026

Indeks Nilai Seunit Eksport meningkat 2.5 peratus pada April 2026, disumbangkan terutamanya oleh kenaikan indeks Minyak Galian.

PUTRAJAYA, 26 Mei 2026 – Indeks nilai seunit eksport Malaysia pada April 2026 mencatatkan peningkatan 2.5 peratus daripada 155.3 mata pada bulan sebelumnya kepada 159.2 mata. Indeks nilai seunit import juga meningkat 6.7 peratus daripada 124.8 mata kepada 133.1 mata. Sementara itu, terma perdagangan Malaysia menurun 3.9 peratus bulan ke bulan daripada 124.4 mata kepada 119.6 mata pada April 2026, sebagaimana dipaparkan oleh laporan **Indeks Perdagangan Luar Negeri (2010=100), April 2026** pada hari ini. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik indeks nilai seunit, indeks volum dan terma perdagangan meliputi 10 seksyen komoditi produk barangan selaras dengan Klasifikasi Standard Perdagangan Antarabangsa (SITC).

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin menjelaskan indeks nilai seunit eksport meningkat 2.5 peratus pada April 2026 disumbangkan oleh kenaikan dalam indeks minyak galian (+9.7%), minyak & lemak binatang & sayur-sayuran (+4.1%) dan alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (+0.4%). Indeks volum eksport turut meningkat 19.9 peratus selaras dengan peningkatan dalam indeks bahan kimia (+35.0%), minyak galian (+22.4%) dan alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (+21.0%). Indeks volum eksport pelarasan bermusim meningkat 20.4 peratus daripada 180.1 mata kepada 216.8 mata. Merujuk kepada perbandingan tahunan, kedua-dua indeks nilai seunit dan indeks volum eksport meningkat 5.9 peratus dan 29.3 peratus.

Indeks nilai seunit import juga meningkat 6.7 peratus pada April 2026, disumbangkan oleh peningkatan dalam indeks minyak galian (+52.8%), minyak & lemak binatang & sayur-sayuran (+2.6%) dan bahan kimia (+0.4%). Sementara itu, indeks volum import turut meningkat 16.1 peratus pada April 2026 berbanding bulan sebelum, disumbangkan oleh peningkatan dalam indeks minyak galian (+41.2%), barang-barang keluaran kilang (+23.0%) dan alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (+13.7%). Indeks volum import pelarasan bermusim meningkat 14.2

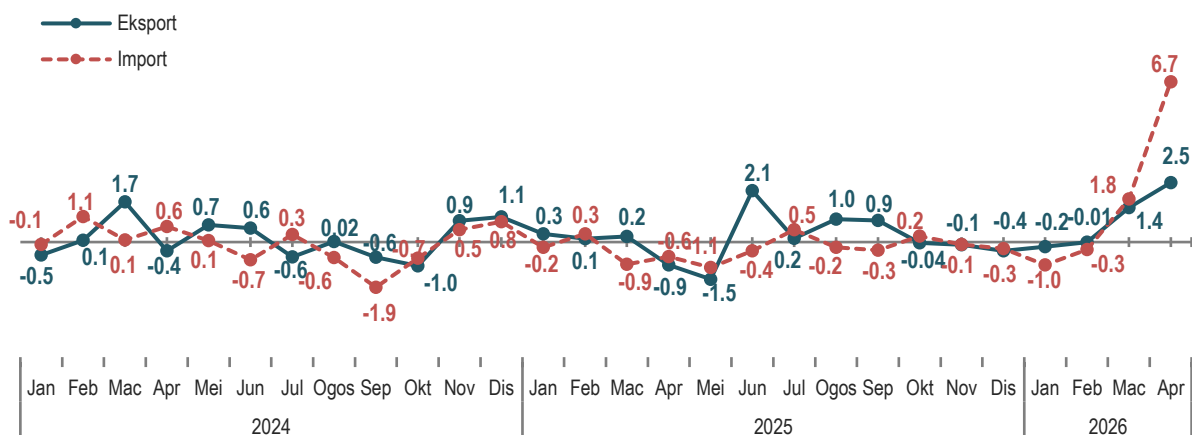
peratus daripada 162.6 mata kepada 185.7 mata. Perbandingan tahun ke tahun menunjukkan indeks nilai seunit import meningkat 5.5 peratus manakala indeks volum import turut meningkat 13.7 peratus.

Terma perdagangan Malaysia menurun 3.9 peratus bulan ke bulan kepada 119.6 mata pada April 2026, disebabkan oleh penurunan dalam indeks minyak galian (-28.2%). Manakala terma perdagangan Malaysia tahun ke tahun bertambah 0.3 peratus daripada 119.1 mata pada April tahun lalu.

Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) sedang melaksanakan Banci Ekonomi 2026 (BE2026), bertemakan “Data Nadi Ekonomi Rakyat”. Pelaksanaan Banci Ekonomi kali keenam ini berlangsung dari 5 Januari hingga 31 Oktober 2026. BE2026 bertujuan untuk mengumpul data yang menyeluruh dan berstruktur daripada semua pertubuhan perniagaan berdaftar dan tidak berdaftar di Malaysia, bagi menilai prestasi, struktur serta ciri-ciri ekonomi negara secara komprehensif dan berasaskan bukti.

Malaysia buat julung kalinya telah menduduki tangga pertama (1) di peringkat global dalam laporan dwi-tahunan Open Data Inventory (ODIN) 2024/25 yang dikeluarkan oleh Open Data Watch (ODW), mengatasi 197 negara lain. Pencapaian ini merupakan lonjakan ketara daripada kedudukan ke-67 dalam penilaian ODIN 2022/23.

**EXTERNAL TRADE INDICES, MALAYSIA
APRIL 2026**

The Export Unit Value Index increased by 2.5 per cent in April 2026, contributed mainly by an increase in the Mineral Fuels index.

PUTRAJAYA, May 26, 2026 – Malaysia's export unit value index in April 2026 increased by 2.5 per cent from 155.3 points in the previous month to 159.2 points. Import unit value index also increased by 6.7 per cent from 124.8 points to 133.1 points. In the meantime, Malaysia's terms of trade decreased 3.9 per cent month-on-month from 124.4 points to 119.6 points in April 2026 as reported in the **External Trade Indices (2010=100), April 2026** released today. This publication presents the unit value index, volume index and terms of trade for 10 commodity sections of merchandise products in accordance with the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC).

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin highlighted, the export unit value index increased by 2.5 per cent in April 2026, attributed to increases in the index of mineral fuels (+9.7%), animal & vegetable oils & fats (+4.1%) and machinery & transport equipment (+0.4%). The export volume index also rose by 19.9 per cent in line with increases in the indices of chemicals (+35.0%), mineral fuels (+22.4%) and machinery & transport equipment (+21.0%). Meanwhile seasonally adjusted export volume index increased by 20.4 per cent from 180.1 points to 216.8 points. Referring to the annual comparison, both the exports unit value index and the volume index expanded by 5.9 per cent and 29.3 per cent respectively.

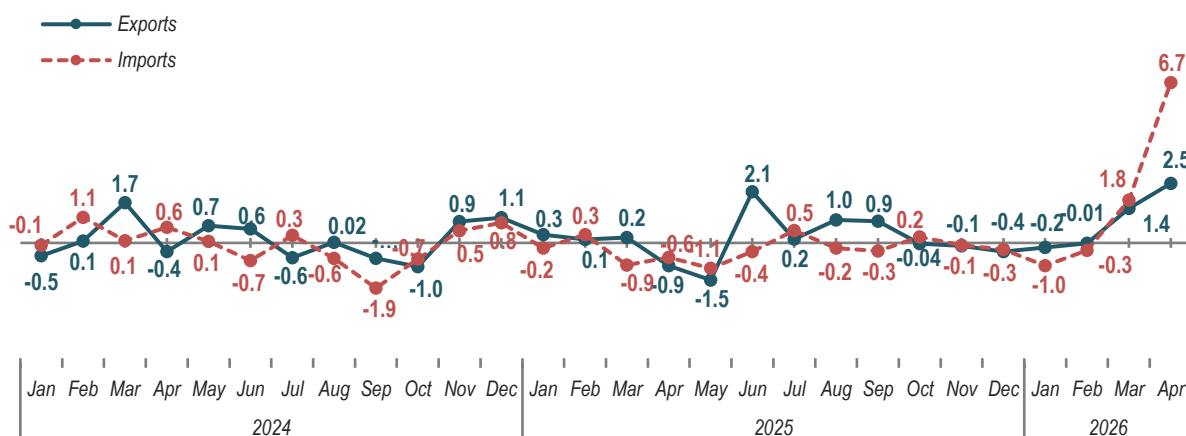
The import unit value index also increased by 6.7 per cent in April 2026, resulting from the increases in the indices of mineral fuels (+52.8%), animal & vegetable oils & fats (+2.6%) and chemicals (+0.4%). Meanwhile, the import volume index also increased by 16.1 per cent in April 2026 as compared to the previous month, driven by the increases in the indices of mineral of fuels (+41.2%), manufactured goods (+23.0%) and machinery & transport equipment (+13.7%). The seasonally adjusted import volume index increased by 14.2 per cent from 162.6 points to 185.7 points. A year-on-year comparison showed that the import unit value index increased by 5.5 per cent, while volume index edged up by 13.7 per cent.

Malaysia's terms of trade declined by 3.9 per cent month-on-month to 119.6 points in April 2026, due to a decrease in the index of mineral fuels (-28.2%). Meanwhile, Malaysia terms of trade increased by 0.3 per cent year-on-year from 119.1 points in April previous year.

The Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) is conducting the Economic Census 2026 (BE2026), themed "Data Nadi Ekonomi Rakyat". The sixth Economic Census, running from 5th January to 31st October 2026. BE2026 aims to collect comprehensive, structured data from all registered and unregistered business establishments in Malaysia to assess the nation's economic performance, structure and characteristics in an evidence-based manner.

Malaysia has, for the first time, successfully secured the top position globally in the biennial Open Data Inventory (ODIN) 2024/25 report released by Open Data Watch (ODW), surpassing 197 other countries. This achievement marks a significant leap from its 67th position in the ODIN 2022/23 assessment.
