**PERANGKAAN PEMBUATAN BULANAN, MALAYSIA,
APRIL 2026**

**Jualan sektor Pembuatan merekodkan RM175.0 bilion,
tumbuh 9.1 peratus pada April 2026**

PUTRAJAYA, 12 JUN 2026 - Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) telah menerbitkan **Perangkaan Pembuatan Bulanan, Malaysia, April 2026**. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik nilai jualan, bilangan pekerja dan gaji & upah bagi sektor Pembuatan.

Mengulas prestasi jualan Pembuatan terkini, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia berkata, "Sektor Pembuatan mencatatkan nilai jualan RM175.0 bilion pada April 2026, tumbuh 9.1 peratus (Mac 2026: 5.3%). Peningkatan nilai jualan dalam sektor Pembuatan disumbangkan terutamanya oleh subsektor Peralatan elektrik & elektronik, meningkat 13.4 peratus pada April 2026 (Mac 2026: 13.3%). Selain itu, pertumbuhan ini turut disokong oleh subsektor Makanan, minuman & tembakau dan subsektor Produk Petroleum, kimia, getah dan plastik, yang masing-masing meningkat sebanyak 9.0 peratus (Mac 2026: 7.8%) dan 4.4 peratus (Mac 2026: -5.1%). Perbandingan bagi bulan ke bulan, nilai jualan meningkat 1.1 peratus, dari RM173.1 bilion yang direkodkan pada Mac 2026."

Pertumbuhan nilai jualan bagi industri berorientasikan eksport yang mewakili 70.6 peratus daripada jumlah jualan, berkembang 9.6 peratus pada April 2026 (Mac 2026: 6.5%). Prestasi ini ditunjangi oleh peningkatan dalam Pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik & optikal pada 15.0 peratus (Mac 2026: 15.2%). Selain itu, Pembuatan minyak dan lemak daripada sayuran dan haiwan juga mencatatkan kenaikan 11.0 peratus (Mac 2026: 10.2%), sementara Pembuatan kok dan produk petroleum bertapis tumbuh 5.3 peratus (Mac 2026: -2.8%). Walaubagaimana pun, nilai jualan industri berorientasikan eksport menyusut 0.5 peratus berbanding pada bulan sebelumnya.

Pada masa yang sama, industri berorientasikan domestik meningkat 7.8 peratus pada April 2026, selepas mencatatkan 2.5 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya. Prestasi ini disokong terutamanya oleh pertumbuhan dalam Pembuatan produk pemprosesan makanan sebanyak 5.8 peratus pada April 2026 (Mac 2026: 5.0%); serta dalam Pembuatan produk galian bukan logam lain (8.8%) dan Pembuatan logam asas

(6.4%). Di samping itu, industri berorientasikan domestik mengembang 5.1 peratus, berasaskan pertumbuhan bulan ke bulan.

Mengulas mengenai bilangan pekerja, Ketua Perangkawan menyatakan, “Sejumlah 2.4 juta orang pekerja direkodkan dalam sektor ini pada April 2026, bertambah sebanyak 1.2 peratus (Mac 2026: 1.1%). Pertambahan ini dipacu terutamanya oleh subsektor Makanan, minuman & tembakau (2.2%); diikuti dengan pertumbuhan subsektor Produk mineral bukan logam, logam asas & produk logam yang direka (1.7%) dan subsektor Peralatan elektrik & elektronik (1.5%). Sementara itu, bilangan pekerja dalam sektor ini melonjak 0.7 peratus bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan.

Seiring dengan itu, gaji & upah yang dibayar dalam sektor Pembuatan juga mencatatkan pengembangan 3.1 peratus (Mac 2026: 2.2%), berjumlah RM8.56 bilion pada April 2026. Berbanding jumlah yang direkodkan pada bulan sebelumnya, gaji & upah yang dibayar meningkat 0.1 peratus. Seterusnya, nilai jualan bagi setiap pekerja mencatatkan RM71,993 (7.7%), manakala purata gaji & upah bagi setiap pekerja adalah RM3,524, bertambah baik sebanyak 1.8 peratus tahun ke tahun.”

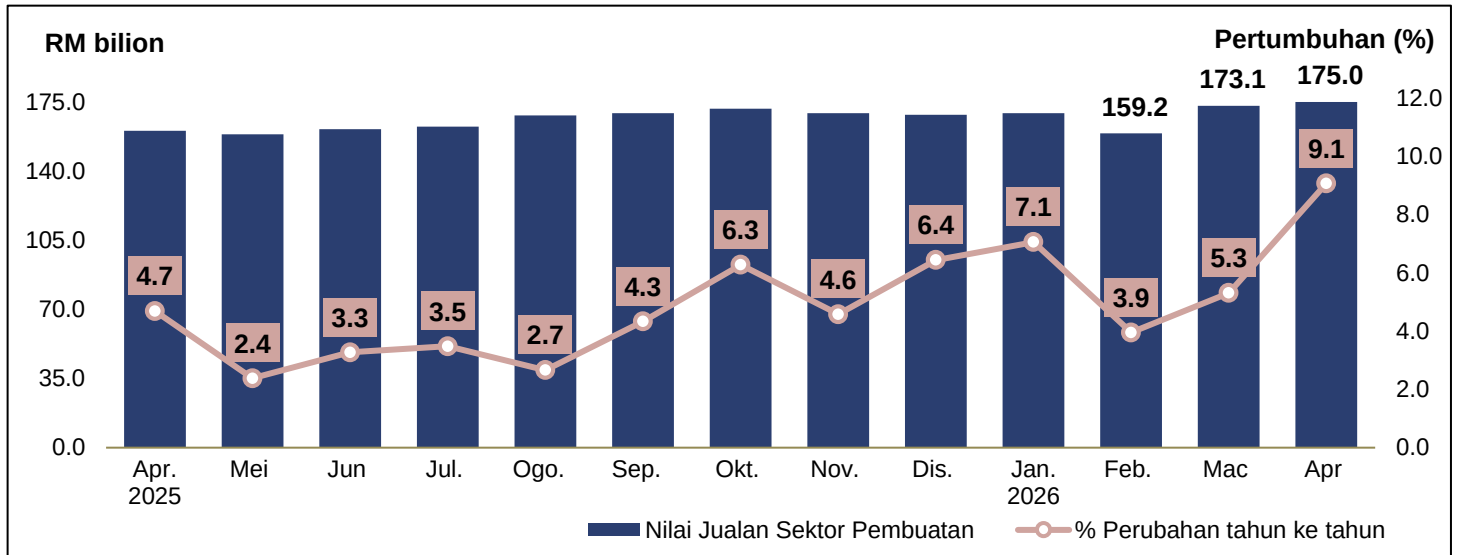
Merumuskan kenyataannya, Ketua Perangkawan berkata, “Bagi nilai jualan kumulatif empat bulan pertama tahun 2026, sektor Pembuatan merekodkan nilai jualan sebanyak RM676.5 bilion, tumbuh 6.4 peratus (Januari - April 2025: 4.2%). Bilangan pekerja kekal peningkatan sebanyak 1.2 peratus kepada 2.4 juta orang, sementara gaji & upah tumbuh 2.5 peratus kepada RM34.4 bilion. Selain itu, nilai jualan setiap pekerja berjumlah RM278,344, meningkat 5.1 peratus.”

Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) sedang melaksanakan **Banci Ekonomi 2026 (BE2026)** dengan tema “**Data Nadi Ekonomi Rakyat**”. Pelaksanaan Banci Ekonomi kali keenam ini berlangsung dari **5 Januari hingga 31 Oktober 2026**. BE2026 bertujuan untuk mengumpul data yang menyeluruh dan berstruktur daripada semua pertubuhan perniagaan berdaftar dan tidak berdaftar di Malaysia, bagi menilai prestasi, struktur serta ciri-ciri ekonomi negara secara komprehensif dan berasaskan bukti.

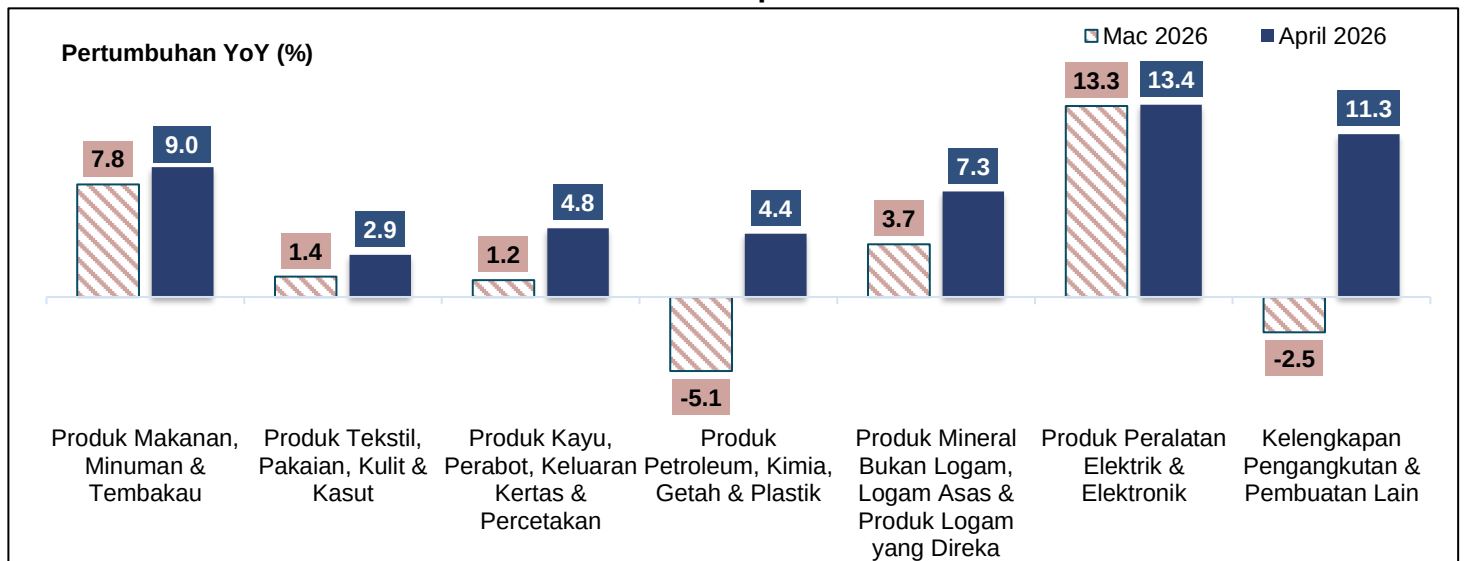
Malaysia buat julung kalinya telah menduduki **tangga pertama (1)** di peringkat global dalam laporan dwi-tahunan **Open Data Inventory (ODIN) 2024/25** yang dikeluarkan oleh *Open Data Watch* (ODW), mengatasi 197 negara lain. Pencapaian ini merupakan lonjakan ketara daripada kedudukan ke-67 dalam penilaian ODIN 2022/23.

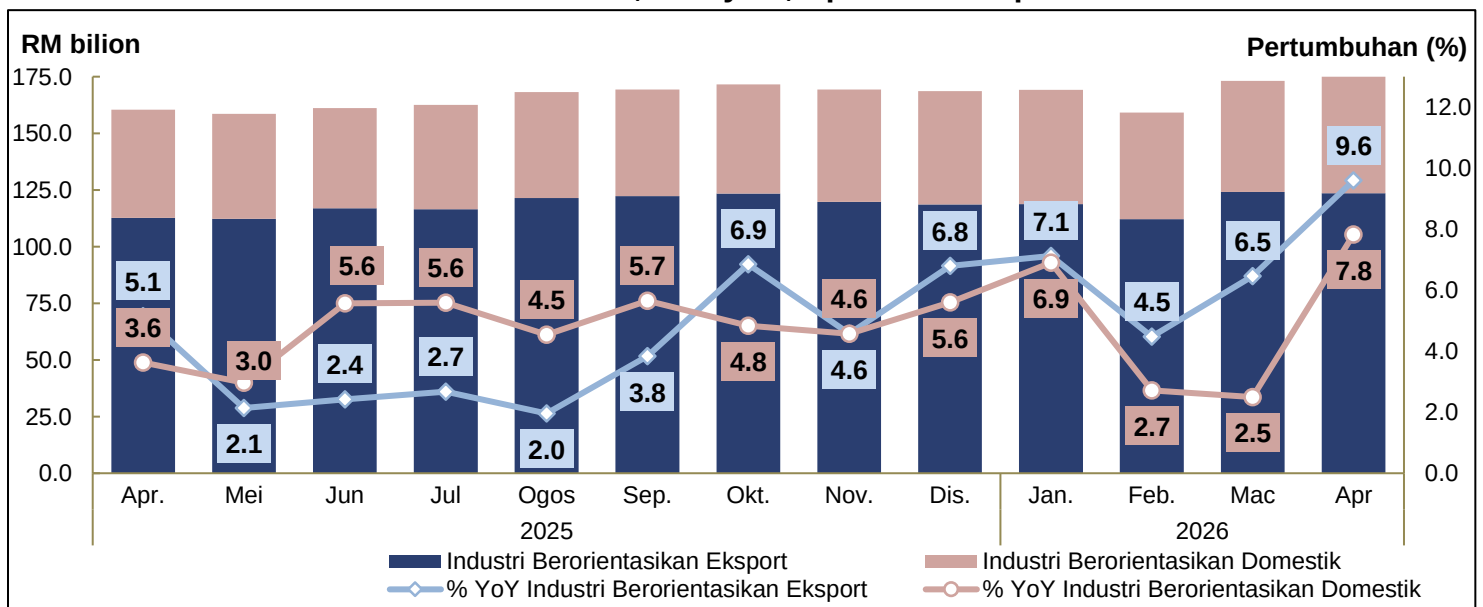
**Carta 1: Nilai Jualan Sektor Pembuatan, Malaysia
April 2025 - April 2026**



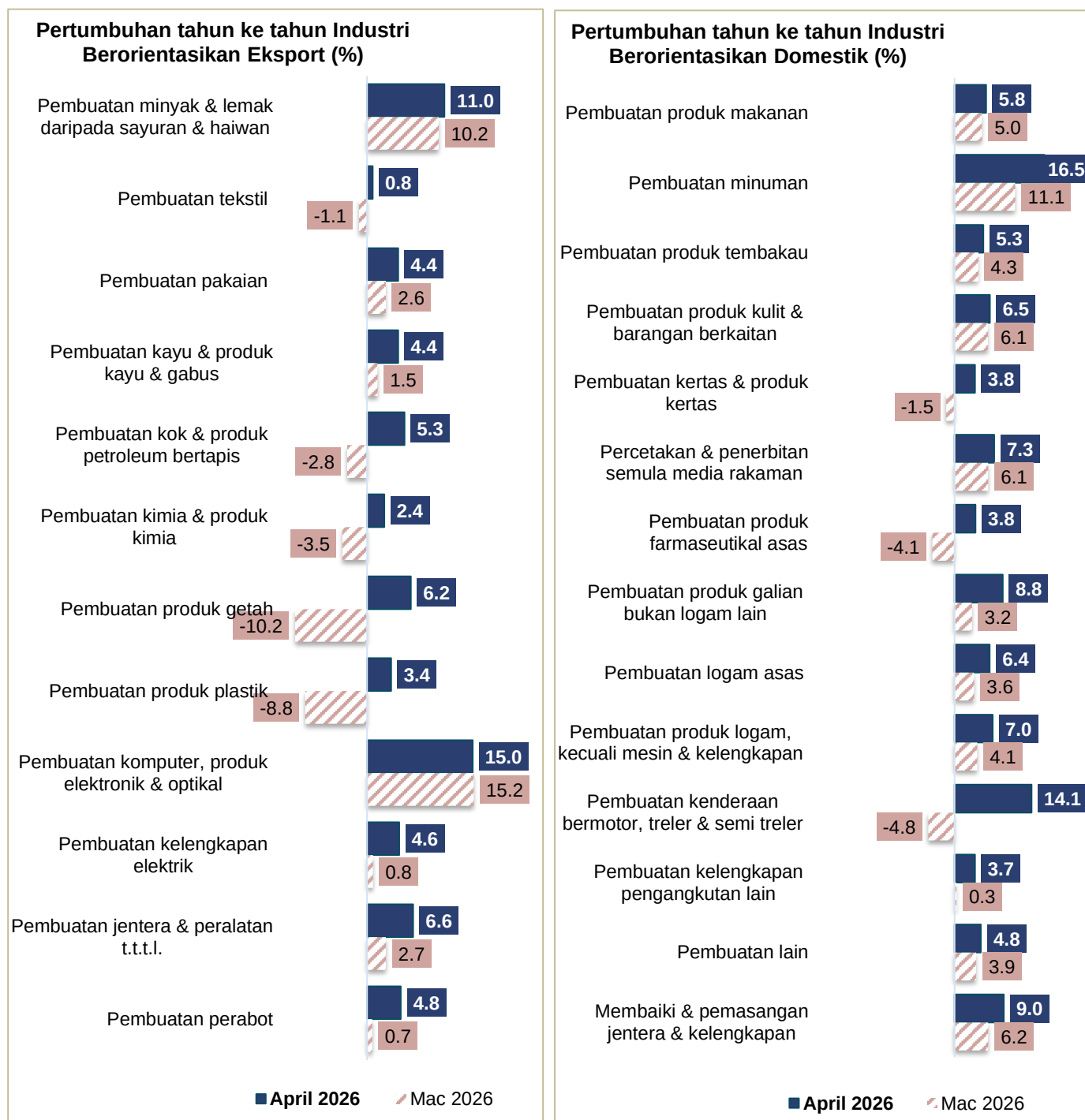
**Carta 2: Pertumbuhan Jualan Subsektor Pembuatan, Malaysia,

MONTHLY MANUFACTURING STATISTICS, MALAYSIA, APRIL 2026

Sales in the Manufacturing sector recorded RM175.0 billion, grew 9.1 per cent in April 2026

PUTRAJAYA, JUNE 12, 2026 – The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) released the **Monthly Manufacturing Statistics, Malaysia, April 2026**. This publication consists of statistics on sales value, number of employees and salaries & wages of Manufacturing sector.

Commenting on the latest Manufacturing sales performance, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia said, “The Manufacturing sector posted sales value of RM175.0 billion in April 2026, grew 9.1 per cent (March 2026: 5.3%). The growth in sales value within the Manufacturing sector was mainly contributed by the Electrical & electronics products sub-sector, rose 13.4 per cent in April 2026 (March 2026: 13.3%). Besides that, this was further supported by the Food, beverages & tobacco sub-sector and Petroleum, chemical, rubber & plastic products sub-sector, which increased by 9.0 per cent (March 2026: 7.8%) and 4.4 per cent (March 2026: -5.1%), respectively. In comparison by month-on-month, sales value increased by 1.1 per cent, from RM173.1 billion recorded in March 2026.”

Sales value growth in the export-oriented industries which accounting for 70.6 per cent of total sales, expanded by 9.6 per cent in April 2026 (March 2026: 6.5%). The performance was led by the increase in the Manufacture of computer, electronics & optical products at 15.0 per cent (March 2026: 15.2%). Moreover, the Manufacture of vegetable & animal oils and fats also registered an increment at 11.0 per cent (March 2026: 10.2%), while Manufacture of coke & refined petroleum products grew 5.3 per cent (March 2026: -2.8%). However, sales value of the export-oriented industries shrank 0.5 per cent, as compared to the preceding month.

In the meantime, the domestic-oriented industries increased 7.8 per cent in April 2026, after registered 2.5 per cent in the previous month. The performance was mainly supported by the growth in the Manufacture of food processing products by 5.8 per cent in April 2026 (March 2026: 5.0%); as well as in the Manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products (8.8%) and Manufacture of basic metals (6.4%). Furthermore, the domestic-oriented industries expanded 5.1 per cent, based on month-on-month growth.

Commenting on the number of employees, the Chief Statistician Malaysia stated, “A total of 2.4 million employees were recorded in this sector during April 2026, augmented by 1.2 per cent (March 2026: 1.1%). The augmentation was mainly driven by the Food, beverages & tobacco (2.2%); followed by the Non-metallic mineral products, basic metal & fabricated metal products sub-sector (1.7%) and Electrical & electronics products sub-sector (1.5%). Meanwhile, the number of employees in this sector rebounded to 0.7 per cent on month-on-month comparison.

Correspondingly, the salaries & wages paid in the Manufacturing sector also posted an expansion of 3.1 per cent (March 2026: 2.2%), amounted to RM8.56 billion in April 2026. As compared to the amount recorded in the prior month, the salaries & wages paid increased 0.1 per cent. Subsequently, the sales value per employee registered at RM71,993 (7.7%), while the average salaries & wages per employee was RM3,524, improved by 1.8 per cent year-on-year.”

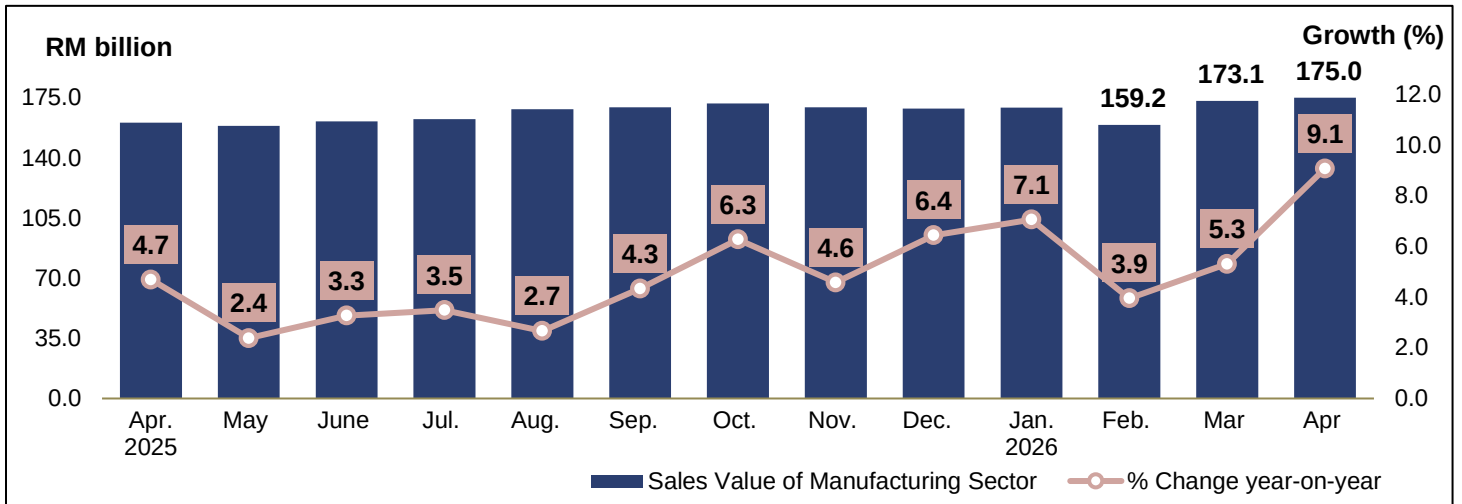
Concluding his statement, the Chief Statistician said, “For the cumulative sales of the first four months 2026, Manufacturing sector recorded sales value of RM676.5 billion, grew 6.4 per cent (Januari - April 2025: 4.2%). The number of employees upticked by 1.2 per cent to 2.4 million persons, while salaries & wages grew by 2.5 per cent to RM34.4 billion. Furthermore, the sales value per employee stood at RM278,344, increased 5.1 per cent.”

The Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) is conducting the **Economic Census 2026 (BE2026)**, with themed “**Data Nadi Ekonomi Rakyat**”. The sixth Economic Census, will be carried out from **5th January to 31st October 2026**. BE2026 aims to collect comprehensive and structured data from all registered and unregistered business establishments in Malaysia to assess the nation’s economic performance, structure and characteristics in an evidence-based manner.

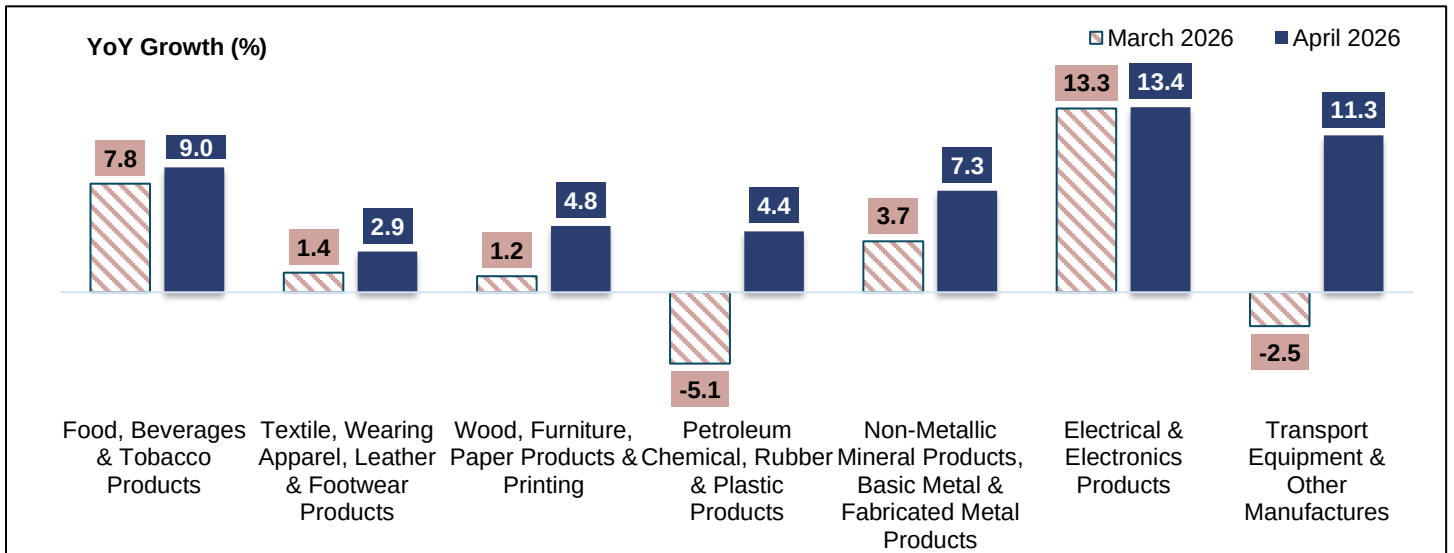
Malaysia has, for the first time, successfully secured the **top position** globally in the biennial **Open Data Inventory (ODIN) 2024/25** report released by Open Data Watch (ODW), surpassing 197 other countries. This achievement marks a significant leap from its 67th position in the ODIN 2022/23 assessment.

Manufacturing Sector, Malaysia, April 2025 – April 2026**

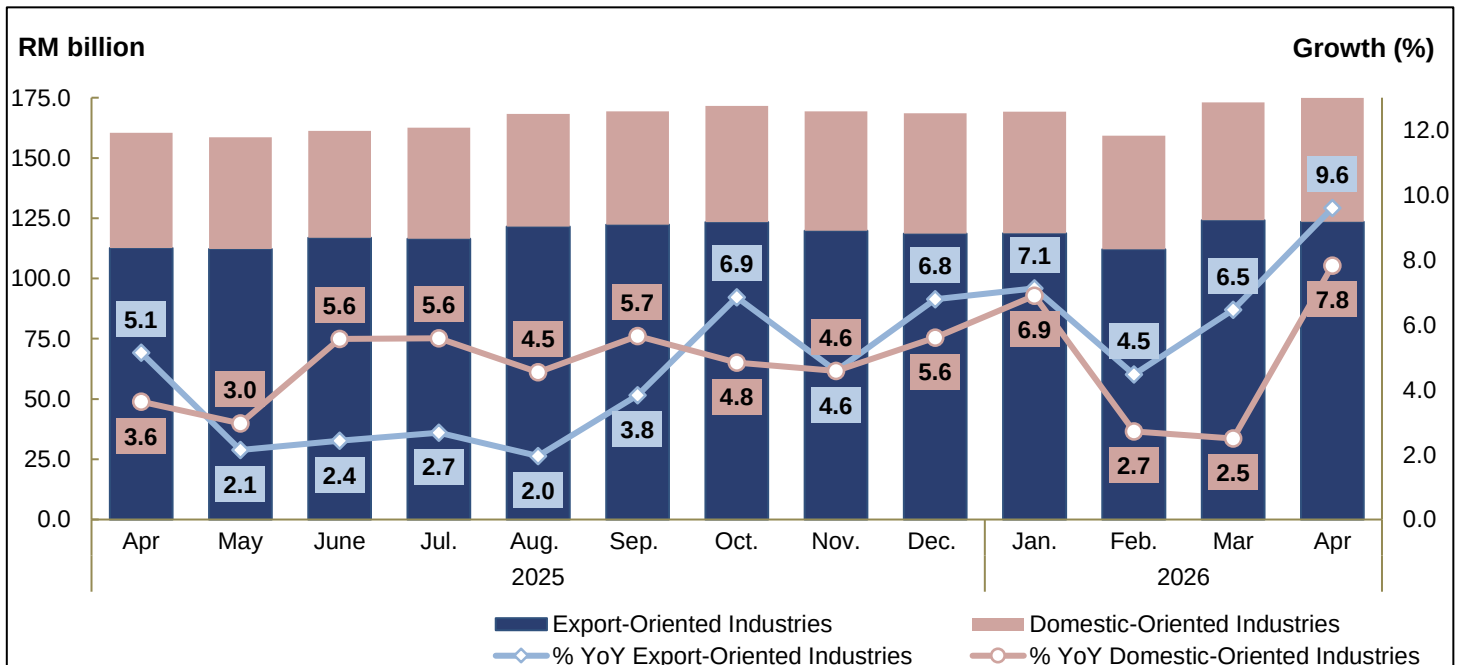


Chart 4: Sales Value of Manufacturing Export and Domestic-Oriented Groups, March and April 2026
