BAGI STATISTIK EKSPORT IMPORT MENGIKUT NEGERI
JUN 2026**

Pulau Pinang mendominasi eksport negara dengan sumbangan 48.9 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan eksport Malaysia pada Jun 2026

PUTRAJAYA, 28 JULAI 2026 – Malaysia mencatatkan jumlah perdagangan bernilai RM340.9 bilion pada Jun 2026 dengan eksport dan import masing-masing bernilai RM177.9 bilion dan RM163.0 bilion seperti yang dilaporkan hari ini dalam **STATISTIK EKSPORT IMPORT MENGIKUT NEGERI JUN 2026**.

Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) menyatakan bahawa eksport Malaysia pada Jun 2026 mencapai RM177.9 bilion, meningkat RM55.6 bilion (+45.4%) berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Peningkatan eksport ini disumbangkan oleh eksport lebih tinggi di Pulau Pinang (+RM39.0 bilion), Johor (+RM8.7 bilion), Sarawak (+RM4.3 bilion), Selangor (+RM4.0 bilion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM880.4 juta), Perak (+RM567.5 juta), Kedah (+RM178.7 juta), W.P. Labuan (+RM153.8 juta) dan Negeri Sembilan (+RM99.9 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, eksport menurun di Perlis (-RM22.1 juta), Kelantan (-RM63.3 juta), Terengganu (-RM93.7 juta), Pahang (-RM104.6 juta), Melaka (-RM508.7 juta) dan Sabah (-RM547.5 juta).

Pulau Pinang kekal sebagai pengeksport utama dengan sumbangan sebanyak 48.9 peratus, diikuti oleh Johor (17.6%), Selangor (13.8%), Sarawak (6.0%) dan W.P. Kuala Lumpur (3.2%).

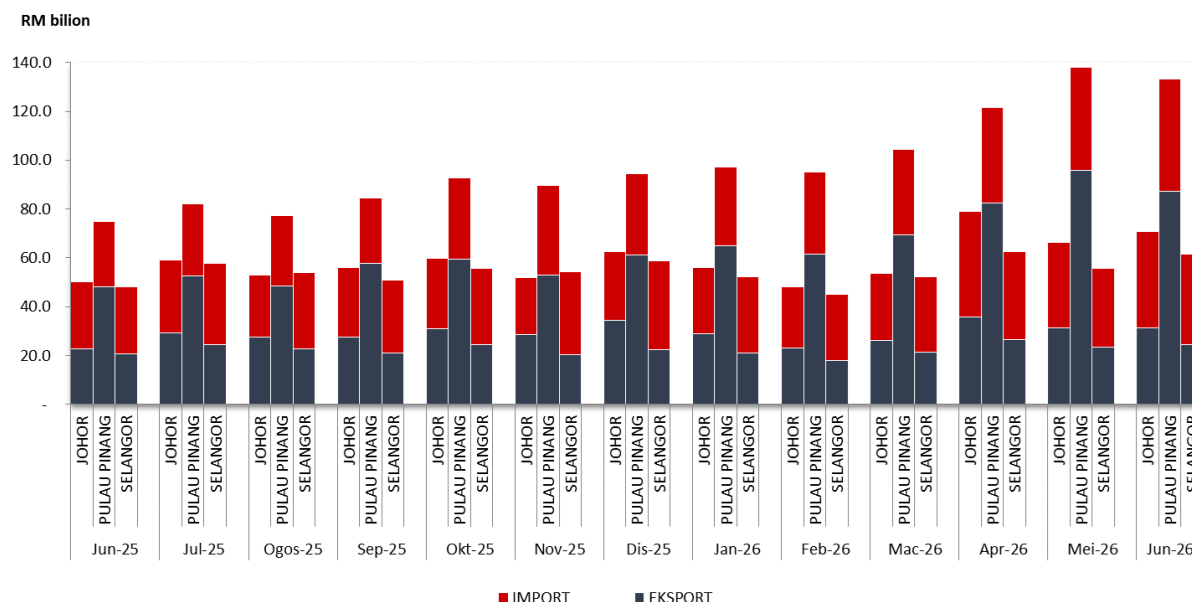
DOSM menyatakan import pada bulan Jun 2026 meningkat RM49.7 bilion (+43.9%) berbanding bulan yang sama tahun 2025. Peningkatan import ini disumbangkan oleh import lebih tinggi di kebanyakan negeri seperti Pulau Pinang (+RM19.5 bilion), Johor (+RM11.9 bilion), Selangor (+RM9.2 bilion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM8.3 bilion), Kedah (+RM1.5 bilion), Negeri Sembilan (+RM748.7 juta), Perak (+RM398.6 juta), Pahang (+RM266.6 juta) dan Sabah (+RM4.8 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, import menurun di Kelantan (-RM12.4 juta), W.P. Labuan (-RM17.3 juta), Perlis (-RM31.6 juta), Sarawak (-RM32.6 juta), Terengganu (-RM50.0 juta) dan Melaka (-RM559.7 juta).

Pulau Pinang mendominasi import Malaysia dengan pegangan 28.4 peratus, diikuti oleh Johor (24.2%), Selangor (22.6%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (10.9%) dan Kedah (4.6%).

Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) sedang melaksanakan **Banci Ekonomi 2026 (BE2026)** dengan tema “**Data Nadi Ekonomi Rakyat**”. Pelaksanaan Banci Ekonomi kali keenam ini berlangsung dari **5 Januari hingga 31 Oktober 2026**. BE2026 bertujuan untuk mengumpul data yang menyeluruh dan berstruktur daripada semua pertubuhan perniagaan berdaftar dan tidak berdaftar di Malaysia, bagi menilai prestasi, struktur serta ciri-ciri ekonomi negara secara komprehensif dan berasaskan bukti.

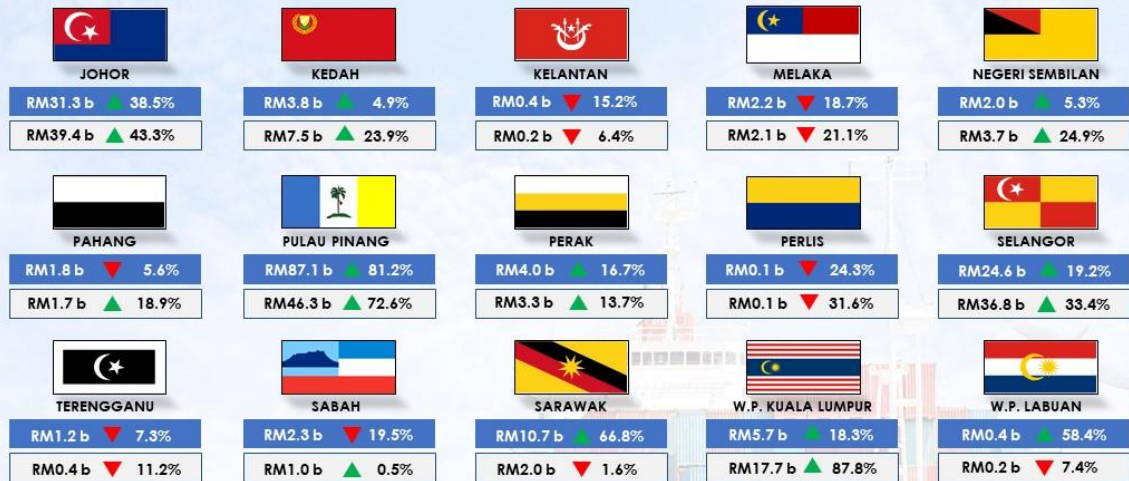

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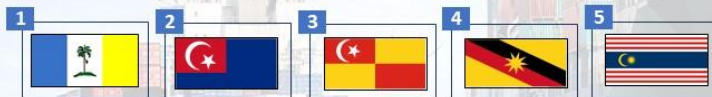

FOR EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE JUNE 2026**

**Pulau Pinang dominated the nation's exports, accounting for
48.9 per cent of Malaysia's total exports in June 2026**

PUTRAJAYA, 28 JULY 2026 – Malaysia's total trade for June 2026 amounted to RM340.9 billion with exports and imports recording RM177.9 billion and RM163.0 billion respectively, as reported today in **EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE JUNE 2026**.

The Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) unveiled that Malaysia's exports in June 2026 reached RM177.9 billion an increased of RM55.6 billion (+45.4%) as compared to the same month of the previous year. The increase in exports was attributed to the higher exports in Pulau Pinang (+RM39.0 billion), Johor (+RM8.7 billion), Sarawak (+RM4.3 billion), Selangor (+RM4.0 billion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM880.4 million), Perak (+RM567.5 million), Kedah (+RM178.7 million), W.P. Labuan (+RM153.8 million) and Negeri Sembilan (+RM99.9 million). However, exports decreased in Perlis (-RM22.1 million), Kelantan (-RM63.3 million), Terengganu (-RM93.7 million), Pahang (-RM104.6 million), Melaka (-RM508.7 million) and Sabah (-RM547.5 million).

Pulau Pinang remained as the top exporter with a contribution of 48.9 per cent, followed by Johor (17.6%), Selangor (13.8%), Sarawak (6.0%) and W.P. Kuala Lumpur (3.2%).

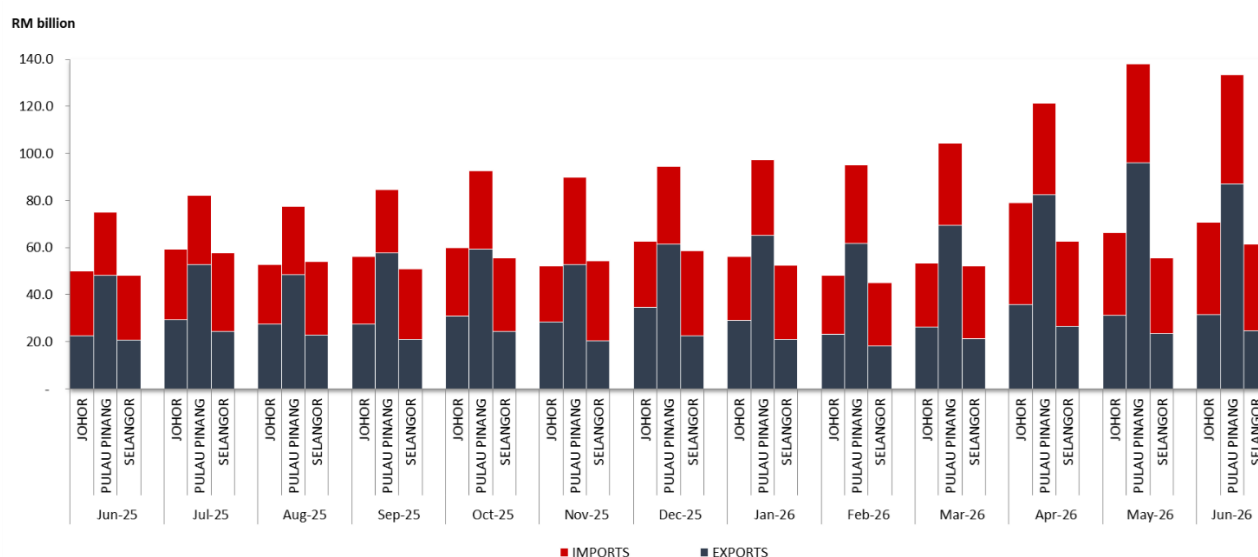
DOSM stated that imports in June 2026 increased RM49.7 billion (+43.9%) as compared to the same month in year 2025. The increase in imports was attributed by the higher imports in most states such as Pulau Pinang (+RM19.5 billion), Johor (+RM11.9 billion), Selangor (+RM9.2 billion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM8.3 billion), Kedah (+RM1.5 billion), Negeri Sembilan (+RM748.7 million), Perak (+RM398.6 million), Pahang (+RM266.6 million) and Sabah (+RM4.8 million). However, imports decreased in Kelantan (-RM12.4 million), W.P. Labuan (-RM17.3 million), Perlis (-RM31.6 million), Sarawak (-RM32.6 million), Terengganu (-RM50.0 million) and Melaka (-RM559.7 million).

Pulau Pinang dominates Malaysia's imports with a share of 28.4 per cent, followed by Johor (24.2%), Selangor (22.6%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (10.9%) and Kedah (4.6%).

The Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) is conducting the **Economic Census 2026 (BE2026)**, with themed “*Data Nadi Ekonomi Rakyat*”. The sixth Economic Census, will be carried out from **5th January to 31st October 2026**. BE2026 aims to collect comprehensive and structured data from all registered and unregistered business establishments in Malaysia to assess the nation's economic performance, structure and characteristics in an evidence-based manner.

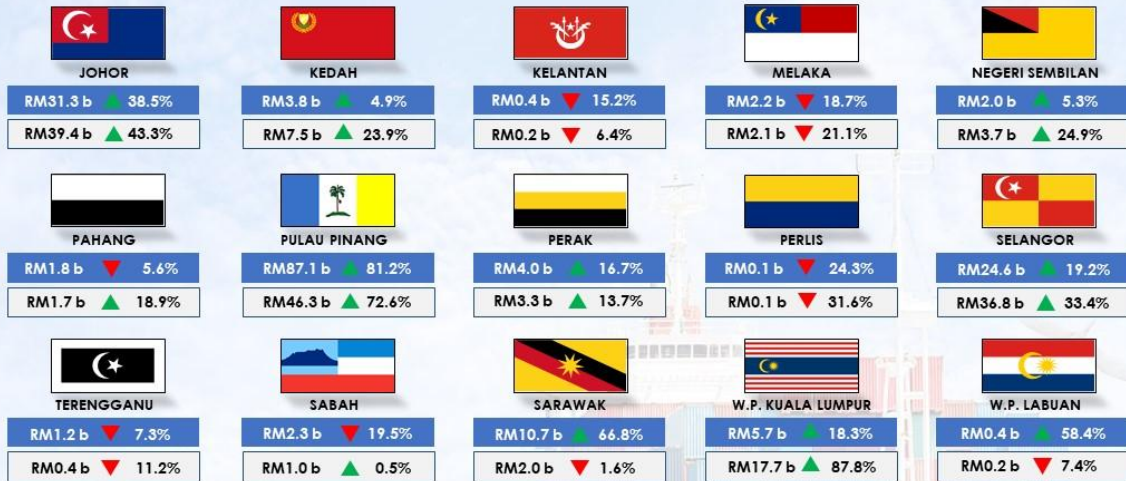
Chart 1: Exports and Imports in Johor, Pulau Pinang and Selangor, June 2025 – June 2026 (RM Billion)
