

## Proposal to model Sabah, Sarawak as mainland Malaysia will probably be raised in Dewan Rakyat on Wednesday (Dec 1)

KUALA LUMPUR: The query on whether or not the federal government intends to model Sabah and Sarawak as mainland Malaysia, being the 2 states having a complete land measurement of 198,354 sq km, or 60 per cent of Malaysia's land, is predicted to be answered through the query and reply session within the Dewan Rakyat on Wednesday (Dec 1).

In keeping with the Order Paper, the matter will probably be raised by way of a query by Datuk Seri Madius Tangau (Upko-Tuaran) to the Prime Minister contemplating that the Federation of Malaya, or Peninsular Malaysia solely totalled 132,265 sq km, or solely 40 per cent of Malaysia's measurement.

There will even be a query from Ahmad Fadhli Shaari (PAS-Pasir Mas) to the Surroundings and Water Minister on the most recent progress of the flood mitigation challenge alongside Sungai Golok, involving the worldwide border between Malaysia and Thailand.

The main focus can be anticipated to be on a query by Datuk Seri Rohani Abdul Karim (GPS-Batang Lupar) whether or not the information collected by the **Division of Statistics** displays the true scenario of the assorted dimensions of poverty that exist within the nation.

After the query and reply session, the home will proceed with the talk session on the Provide Invoice 2022 on the Committee stage for the Transport Ministry; Science, Know-how and Innovation Ministry; and the Rural Improvement Ministry.

Yesterday, the Committee stage debate session concerned the Entrepreneur Improvement and Cooperatives Ministry with the Dewan Rakyat approving an allocation of RM195,036,300 of the Provide Invoice 2022 and RM835,666,800 in working expenditure to the Human Assets Ministry by way of a voice vote.

The present Dewan Rakyat will sit till Dec 16. – Bernama
