

Six states record higher trade in 2020 with Penang in front

PENANG led the list of six states in Malaysia that have seen an increase in total trade in 2020 despite the challenging economic climate as a result of Covid-19, the Department of Statistics Malaysia said today.

Chief Statistician Mohd Uzir Mahidin said Penang recorded the highest increase in trade with RM38.6 billion.
