# E-CENSUS INTRODUCED FOR POPULATION, HOUSING CENSUS 2010

KUALA LUMPUR, May 24 (Bernama) -- In line with the country's flourishing information technology and communications development, the public will now be able to complete the Population and Housing Census 2010, through an online census questionnaire, e-Census.

Census commissioner Datuk Wan Ramlah Wan Abdul Raof said this could be done at [www.statistics.gov.my](http://www.statistics.gov.my) using a given ID and password.

She said the e-Census was one of two new data collection methods which would make things easier for busy urban residents.

"Another way is through the drop-off and pick up of Census Kits that respondents can fill up, before census enumerators pick," she told Bernama here today.

Wan Ramlah said the census, to be carried out from July 6 to Aug 22, would involve 36,000 enumerators, 3,000 supervisors and about 29 million Malaysians which is an 18.97 per cent increase as compared to the last census in 2000.

She said the census, the fifth to be carried out since it was established nationwide in 1963, would provide a set of statistics on households and its residents.

The information would assist in the planning, legislation and implementation of government policies, she said, adding that the people should give their full cooperation to enumerators.
