Jumlah perdagangan Sabah tahun 2021 meningkat 9.8 peratus kepada rekod tertinggi RM87.2 bilion

PUTRAJAYA, 28 JULAI 2022 – Laporan **STATISTIK PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI Sabah BAGI TAHUN RUJUKAN 2021** yang dikeluarkan hari ini memaparkan statistik perdagangan Sabah dengan rakan dagangan dari segi nilai barang mengikut klasifikasi komoditi terperinci. Laporan ini menunjukkan jumlah perdagangan Sabah mencatatkan paras tertinggi pada tahun 2021 didorong oleh peningkatan harga dan permintaan komoditi, terutamanya bagi komoditi berkaitan dengan petroleum dan minyak sawit.


Mengulas terhadap laporan tersebut, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata "Sabah berdagang dengan 134 buah negara pada tahun 2021 dengan jumlah dagangan RM87.2 bilion, meningkat 9.8 peratus berbanding tahun sebelumnya. Peningkatan ini dipacu oleh eksport yang meningkat 34.7 peratus kepada RM55.7 bilion. Manakala, import mencatatkan RM31.6 bilion, menguncup 17.1 peratus dengan lebihan dagangan berjumlah RM24.1 bilion, meningkat 642.2 peratus yang merupakan rekod pertumbuhan tertinggi dalam tempoh sepuluh tahun sebelum".

Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia juga melaporkan peningkatan nilai eksport barang adalah dipacu oleh minyak kelapa sawit yang meningkat RM4.4 bilion (+34.4%) kepada RM17.3 bilion. Ini dikuti petroleum mentah (+RM3.8 bilion, +24.6%), minyak isirung sawit (+RM1.1 bilion, +63.7%) dan metanol (+RM1.0 bilion, +67.0%). Sementara itu, import yang lebih rendah pada RM31.6 bilion adalah disebabkan oleh penurunan sebanyak 50.2 peratus bagi jentera dan kelengkapan pengangkutan.


Laporan tersebut juga menyatakan Semenanjung Malaysia merupakan rakan dagang utama yang menyumbang 39.8 peratus kepada jumlah perdagangan, diikuti oleh China (12.3%), Australia (5.0%), Kesatuan Eropah (4.9%) dan India (4.6%). Lima rakan dagang ini bukan sahaja merangkumi 66.5 peratus daripada jumlah perdagangan pada 2021, malahan juga merupakan lima destinasi eksport utama yang menyumbangkan RM34.9 bilion atau 62.8 peratus daripada jumlah eksport.


Carta 1: Peratus Perubahan Tahun ke Tahun Statistik Perdagangan Luar Negeri Sabah,

Total trade of Sabah in 2021 increased 9.8 per cent to a record high

RM87.2 billion

PUTRAJAYA, JULY 28, 2022 – Sabah External Trade Statistics Report for the reference year 2021 released today provide the Sabah's trade performance vis-a-vis trading partners in terms of value for merchandise goods by detail classification of commodity. The report shows that Sabah's total trade recorded the highest level in 2021 driven by increased commodity prices and demand, especially for commodity related to petroleum and palm oil.

Commenting on the report, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia, said “Sabah trades with 134 countries in 2021 with a total trade of RM87.2 billion, an increase of 9.8 per cent, as compared to 2020. The increase was driven by exports, which grew 34.7 per cent to RM55.7 billion. Meanwhile, imports valued at RM31.6 billion, contracted 17.1 per cent with a trade surplus amounting to RM24.1 billion, up 642.2 per cent, which is the highest growth record in the past ten years”.

The Department of Statistics Malaysia also reported that the increase in exports of goods was propelled by palm oil, which increased by RM4.4 billion or 34.4 per cent to RM17.3 billion. This was followed by crude petroleum (+RM3.8 billion, +24.6%), palm kernel oil (+RM1.1 billion, +63.7%) and methanol (+RM1.0 billion, 67.0%). Meanwhile, the lower

imports, valued at RM31.6 billion were mainly due to the 50.2 per cent decline in machinery and transport equipment.

The report also stated that Peninsular Malaysia was the major trading partners and contributed 39.8 per cent of total trade, followed by China (12.3%), Australia (5.0%), the European Union (4.9%) and India (4.6%). These five trading partners not only accounted for 66.5 per cent of trade in 2021 but were also top five export destinations, which contributing RM34.9 billion or 62.8 per cent of total exports.

2010 – 2021*




Chart 3: Year-on-Year of Total Trade for Sabah, 2010 – 2021





Chart 3: Top Five Trading Partners
