PULAU PINANG MENCATATKAN EKSPORT TERTINGGI

BARANGAN ELEKTRIK DAN ELEKTRONIK SEBANYAK

RM32.7 BILION PADA JUN 2022

PUTRAJAYA, 28 Julai 2022 – Jumlah dagangan Malaysia pada bulan Jun 2022 bernilai RM270.4 bilion (+43.4% tahun ke tahun) dengan nilai eksport RM146.2 bilion (+38.8% tahun ke tahun) dan import bernilai RM124.2 bilion (+49.3% tahun ke tahun). Beralih kepada nilai eksport barangan elektrik dan elektronik ke Malaysia pada Jun 2022, Pulau Pinang mencatatkan eksport tertinggi bagi barangan elektrik dan elektronik bernilai RM32.7 bilion (62.5%), diikuti Selangor (RM6.6 bilion, 12.7%) dan Johor (RM5.8 bilion, 11.1%) seperti yang dilaporkan hari ini dalam **STATISTIK EKSPORT IMPORT MENGIKUT NEGERI JUN 2022**.

Dalam satu kenyataan pada hari ini, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia berkata, "Eksport pada bulan Jun 2022 meningkat sebanyak RM40.8 bilion (+38.8%) berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Eksport lebih tinggi direkodkan bagi kebanyakan negeri iaitu Pulau Pinang (+RM16.3 bilion), Johor (+RM13.0 bilion), Sarawak (+RM6.1 bilion), Selangor (+RM4.2 bilion), W.P. Labuan (+RM720.7 juta), Kedah (+RM617.9 juta), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM577.1 juta), Sabah (+RM408.9 juta), Negeri Sembilan (+RM92.8 juta), Kelantan (+RM32.5 juta) dan Perlis (+RM27.6 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, eksport menyusut di Terengganu (-RM983.0 juta), Pahang (-RM303.6 juta), Melaka (-RM226.0 juta) dan Perak (-RM47.7 juta)."

Beralih kepada prestasi import mengikut negeri, Ketua Perangkawan memaklumkan, "Import juga meningkat RM41.0 bilion (+49.3%) berbanding bulan yang sama tahun

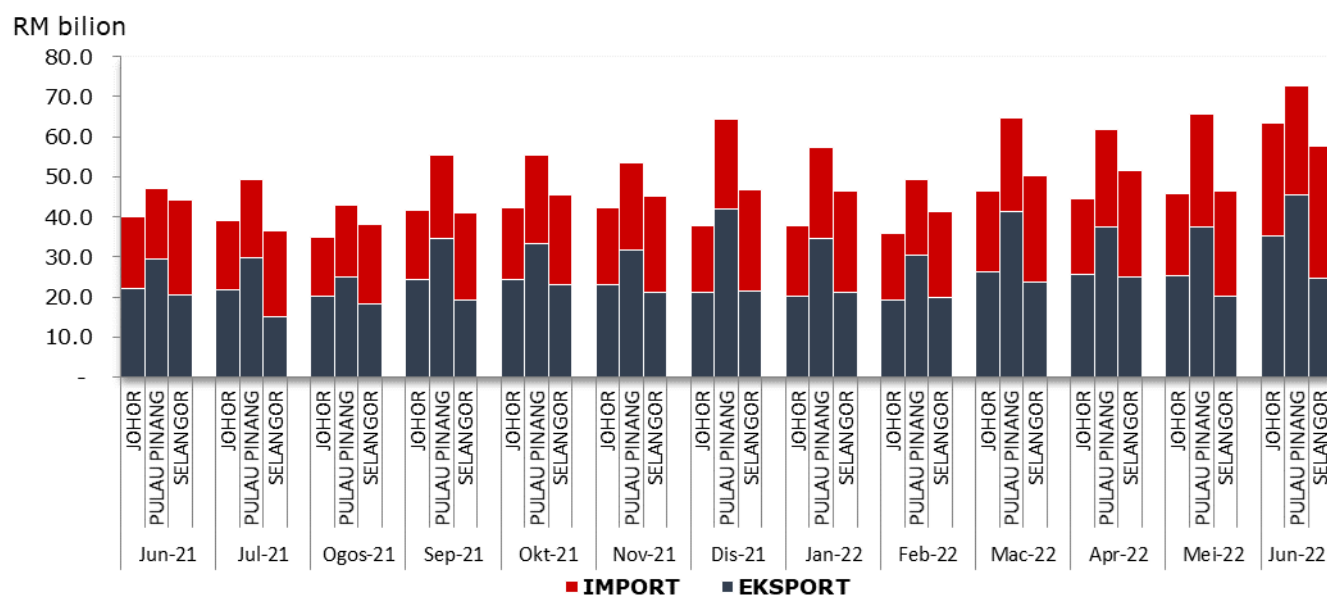
sebelumnya. Peningkatan import dicatatkan di Johor (+RM10.4 bilion), Pulau Pinang (+RM9.5 bilion), Selangor (+RM9.1 bilion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM5.5 bilion), Negeri Sembilan (+RM1.9 bilion), Sarawak (+RM1.2 bilion), Kedah (+RM1.1 bilion), Pahang (+RM718.3 juta), W.P. Labuan (+RM243.5 juta), Melaka (+RM228.6 juta), Perak (+RM221.9 juta), Sabah (+RM139.6 juta) dan Perlis (+RM32.7 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, import menurun di Terengganu (-RM197.9 juta) dan Kelantan (-RM137.5 juta).”

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin seterusnya memaklumkan “Antara lima negeri pengekspor utama, Pulau Pinang kekal sebagai pengekspor utama dengan sumbangan 31.2 peratus, diikuti oleh Johor (24.0%), Selangor (16.9%), Sarawak (8.5%) dan W.P. Kuala Lumpur (3.9%). Sementara itu, bagi import, Selangor menjadi penyumbang utama dengan 26.4 peratus, diikuti oleh Johor (22.7%), Pulau Pinang (21.9%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (9.4%) dan Kedah (4.9%).”

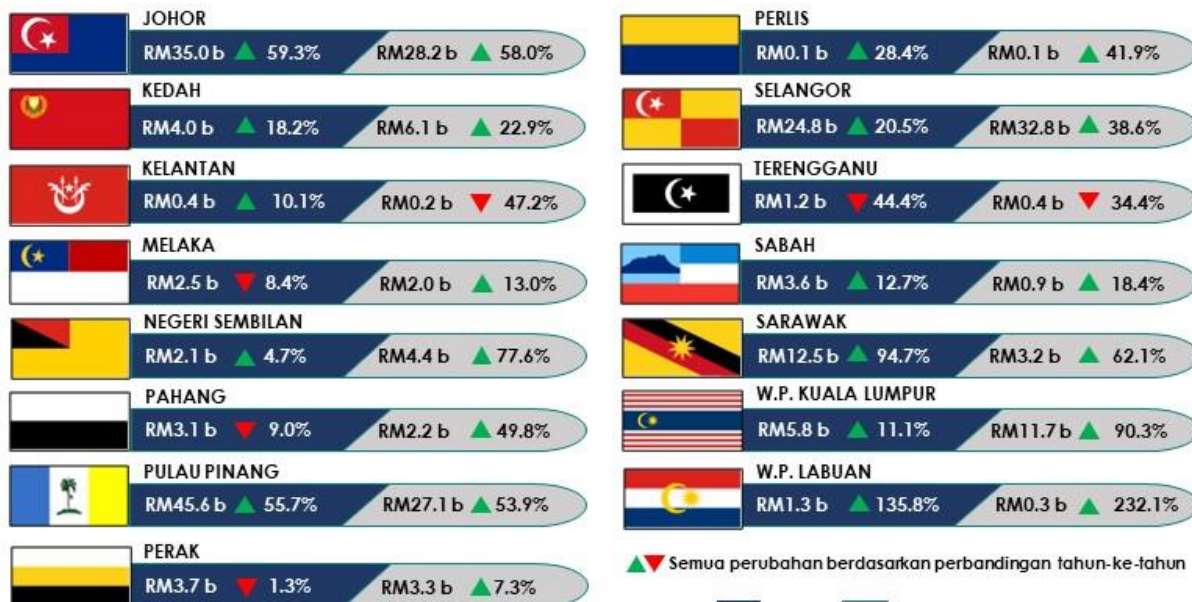
**Carta 1: Data Siri Masa Eksport dan Import bagi negeri Johor, Pulau Pinang dan Selangor,

**PULAU PINANG RECORDED THE HIGHEST
EXPORTS OF ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONIC PRODUCTS
WORTH RM32.7 BILLION IN JUNE 2022**

PUTRAJAYA, 28 July 2022 – Malaysia's total trade for June 2022 amounted to RM270.4 billion (+43.4% year-on-year), with exports of RM146.2 billion (+38.8% year-on-year) and imports worth RM124.2 billion (+49.3% year-on-year). Looking at the exports value of electrical and electronic products to Malaysia in June 2022, Pulau Pinang recorded the highest exports of electrical and electronic products worth RM32.7 billion (62.5%), followed by Selangor (RM6.6 billion, 12.7%) and Johor (RM5.8 billion, 11.1%) as reported today in **EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE JUNE 2022**.

In a statement today, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia said, "Exports in June 2022 increased RM40.8 billion (+38.8%) compared to the same month of the previous year. Higher exports were recorded in most states such as Pulau Pinang (+RM16.3 billion), Johor (+RM13.0 billion), Sarawak (+RM6.1 billion), Selangor (+RM4.2 billion), W.P. Labuan (+RM720.7 million), Kedah (+RM617.9 million), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM577.1 million), Sabah (+RM408.9 million), Negeri Sembilan (+RM92.8 million), Kelantan (+RM32.5 million) and Perlis (+RM27.6 million). However, exports decreased in Terengganu (-RM983.0 million), Pahang (-RM303.6 million), Melaka (-RM226.0 million) and Perak (-RM47.7 million)."

Looking at the performance of exports by state, the Chief Statistician informed, “Imports also increased RM41.0 billion (+49.3%) compared to the same month of the previous year. Higher imports were recorded from Johor (+RM10.4 billion), Pulau Pinang (+RM9.5 billion), Selangor (+RM9.1 billion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM5.5 billion), Negeri Sembilan (+RM1.9 billion), Sarawak (+RM1.2 billion), Kedah (+RM1.1 billion), Pahang (+RM718.3 million), W.P. Labuan (+RM243.5 million), Melaka (+RM228.6 million), Perak (+RM221.9 million), Sabah (+RM139.6 million) and Perlis (+RM32.7 million). However, imports decreased in Terengganu (-RM197.9 million) and Kelantan (-RM137.5 million).”

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin also informed, “Among the top five major exporting states, Pulau Pinang remained as the top exporter with a share of 31.2 per cent, followed by Johor (24.0%), Selangor (16.9%), Sarawak (8.5%) and W.P. Kuala Lumpur (3.9%). Meanwhile, as for imports, Selangor was the largest contributor with a share of 26.4 per cent, followed by Johor (22.7%), Pulau Pinang (21.9%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (9.4%) and Kedah (4.9%).”

Chart 1: Time Series Data on Exports and Imports in Johor, Pulau Pinang and Selangor, June 2021 – June 2022 (RM Billion)

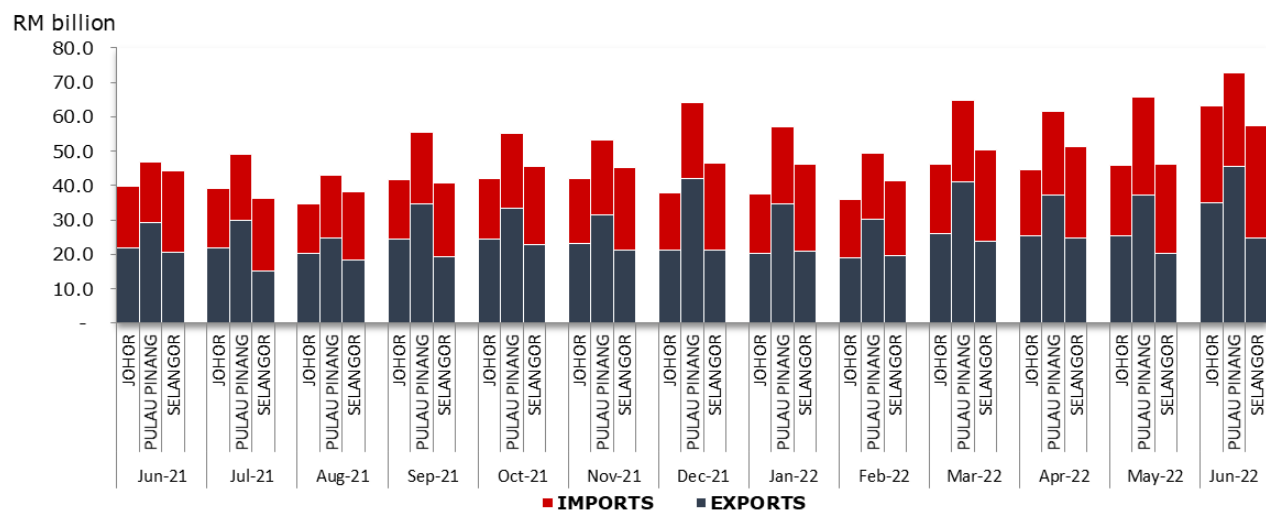
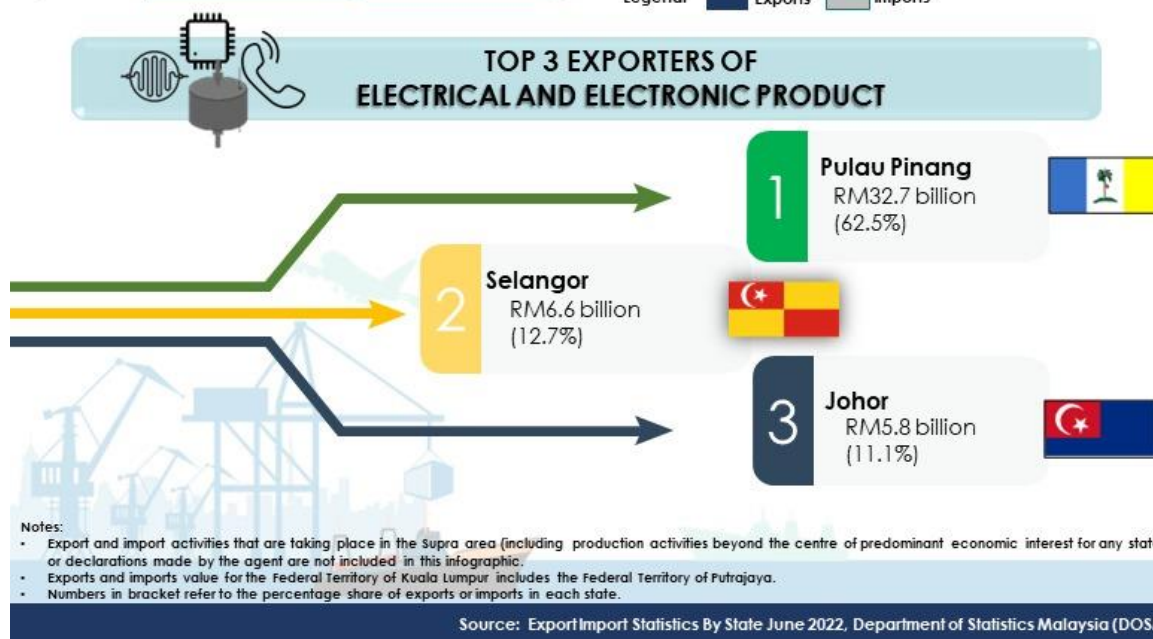
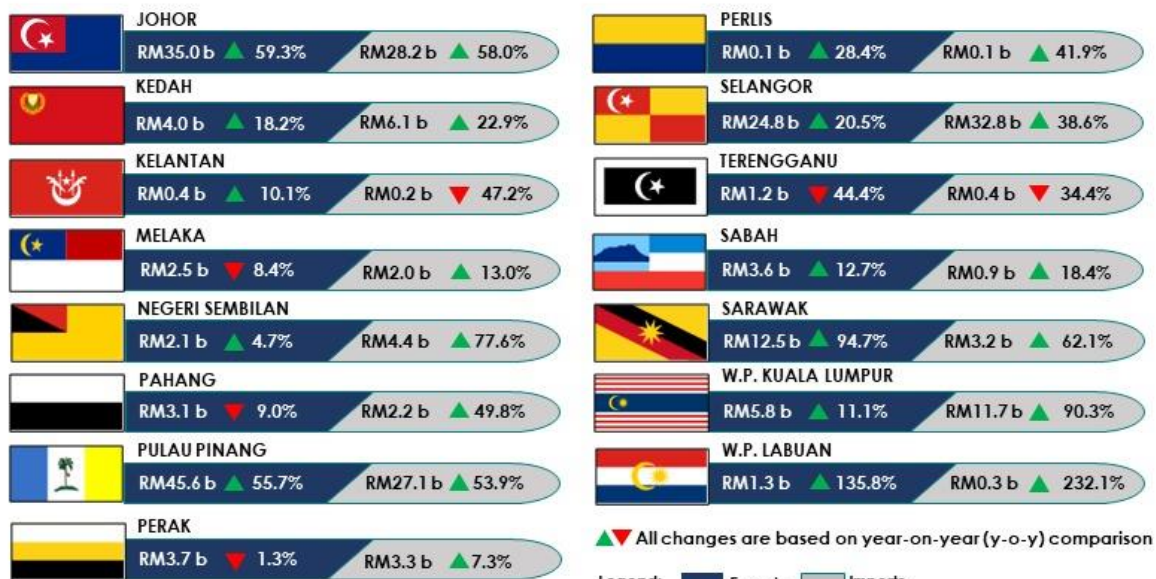


Exhibit 1: Infographic on Export Import Statistics by State June 2022
