Kedua-dua indeks nilai seunit eksport dan import meningkat masing-masing dengan peningkatan 2.1 peratus dan 1.3 peratus

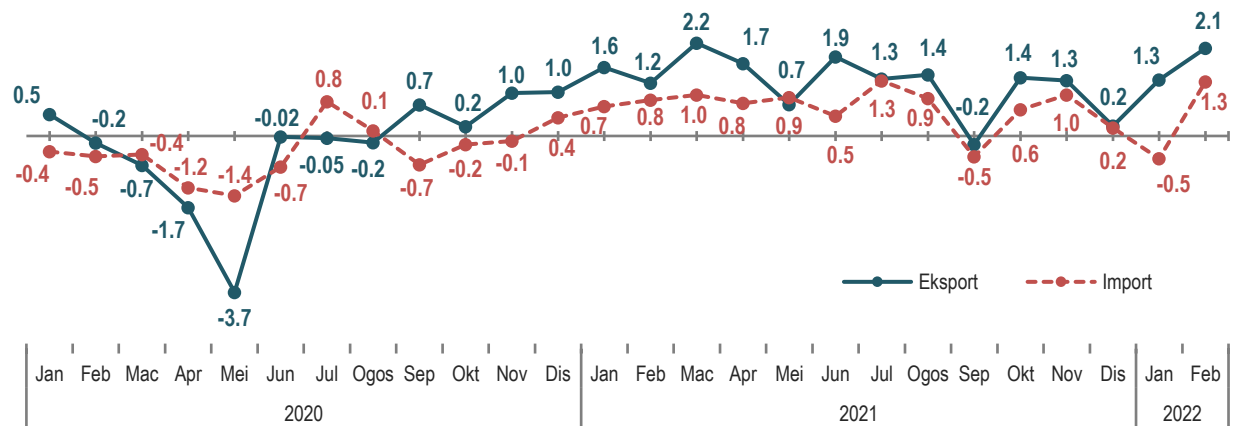
PUTRAJAYA, 4 APRIL 2022 – Pertumbuhan indeks nilai seunit eksport dan import Malaysia masing-masing meningkat 2.1 peratus dan 1.3 peratus, sebagai mana dipaparkan oleh laporan **INDEKS PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI (2010=100), FEBRUARI 2022** pada hari ini. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik indeks nilai seunit dan indeks volum mengikut seksyen bagi eksport dan import barangan.

Menurut Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "Indeks nilai seunit eksport meningkat 2.1 peratus pada Februari 2022 berbanding bulan sebelumnya, disumbangkan oleh kenaikan indeks minyak galian (+8.0), minyak & lemak binatang & sayur-sayuran (+2.2%), dan alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (+0.7%). Sementara itu, indeks volum eksport menyusut 9.8 peratus pada bulan yang sama, disumbangkan oleh kejatuhan indeks barang-barang keluaran kilang (-14.9%), alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (-12.2%) dan pelbagai barang keluaran kilang (-10.9%). Indeks volum eksport pelarasan bermusim bertumbuh 2.8 peratus daripada 155.6 mata kepada 160.0 mata. Berdasarkan perbandingan tahunan, kedua-dua indeks nilai seunit dan volum eksport masing-masing berkembang 16.4 peratus dan 0.3 peratus."

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata “Indeks nilai seunit import pula meningkat 1.3 peratus pada Februari 2022 berbanding bulan sebelum, disumbangkan oleh indeks minyak galian (+9.0%), minyak & lemak binatang & sayur-sayuran (+1.2%) dan bahan kimia (+0.2%). Manakala, indeks volum import menyusut 12.0 peratus pada Februari 2022 berbanding bulan sebelum, disumbangkan oleh kejatuhan barang-barang keluaran kilang (-16.3%), alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (-13.1%) dan bahan kimia (-10.4%). Indeks volum import pelarasan bermusim pada Februari 2022 meningkat 0.4 peratus daripada 169.7 mata kepada 170.3 mata. Perbandingan tahun ke tahun menunjukkan kedua-dua indeks nilai seunit dan volum import masing-masing berkembang 7.5 peratus dan 10.1 peratus.”

Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) turut melaporkan terma perdagangan Malaysia meningkat 0.8 peratus bulan ke bulan kepada 109.9 mata pada Februari 2022. Perbandingan tahun ke tahun prestasi terma perdagangan Malaysia menunjukkan pertumbuhan positif 8.3 peratus daripada 101.5 mata pada Februari tahun lalu.

Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia sedang menjalankan Survei Pendapatan, Perbelanjaan Isi Rumah dan Kemudahan Asas (HIES/BA) 2022 bermula dari 1 Januari 2022 sehingga 31 Disember 2022. Both export and import unit value index grew 2.1 per cent and 1.3 per cent, respectively

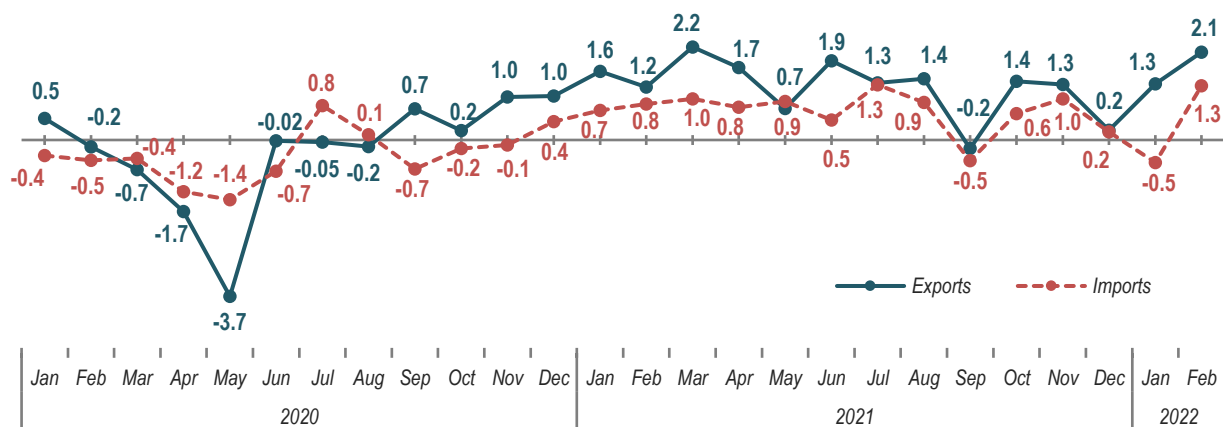
PUTRAJAYA, APRIL 4, 2022 – Malaysia's export and import unit value index grew 2.1 per cent and 1.3 per cent respectively, as reported today in **EXTERNAL TRADE INDICES (2010=100), FEBRUARY 2022**. This publication presents the unit value and volume index by sections for both exports and imports of goods.

According to the Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "The export unit value index grew 2.1 per cent in February 2022 as compared with the previous month, supported by the increases in the index of mineral fuels (+8.0%), animal and vegetable and oil fats (+2.2%) and machinery & transport equipment (+0.7%). Meanwhile, the export volume index fell 9.8 per cent in the same month, reflected by the deterioration in the index of manufactured goods (-14.9%), machinery & transport equipment (-12.2%) and miscellaneous manufactured articles (-10.9%). The seasonally adjusted export volume index grew 2.8 per cent from 155.6 points to 160.0 points. On annual comparison, both export unit value and volume index continued to expand 16.4 per cent and 0.3 per cent, respectively."

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin commented, "The import unit value index grew 1.3 per cent in February 2022 as compared with the previous month, contributed by the improvement in index of mineral fuels (+9.0%), animal & vegetable oils & fats (+1.2%) and chemicals (+0.2%). However, the import volume index fell by 12.0 per cent in February 2022 as compared to the previous month, attributed to the deterioration in the index of manufactured goods (-16.3%), machinery & transport equipment (-13.1%) and chemicals (-10.4%). The seasonally adjusted import volume index in February 2022 increased by 0.4 per cent from 169.7 points to 170.3 points. On a year-on-year basis, both the import unit value and volume indices expanded 7.5 per cent and 10.1 per cent, respectively."

Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) also reported that Malaysia's terms of trade increased by 0.8 per cent month-on-month to 109.9 points in February 2022. On a y-o-y basis, Malaysia's terms of trade performance showed positive growth of 8.3 per cent from 101.5 points in February of previous year.
