Pertumbuhan indeks nilai seunit eksport Malaysia menunjukkan trend positif pada Januari 2022, meningkat 1.3 peratus

PUTRAJAYA, 4 MAC 2022 – Pertumbuhan indeks nilai seunit eksport Malaysia menunjukkan trend positif bagi tempoh empat bulan berturut-turut pada Januari 2022 dengan peningkatan 1.3 peratus, sebagai mana dipaparkan oleh laporan **INDEKS PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI (2010=100), JANUARI 2022** pada hari ini. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik indeks nilai seunit dan indeks volum mengikut seksyen bagi eksport dan import barang.


Menurut Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, “Indeks nilai seunit eksport meningkat 1.3 peratus pada Januari 2022 berbanding bulan sebelumnya, disumbangkan oleh kenaikan indeks minyak & lemak binatang & sayur-sayuran (+3.3%), minyak galian (+2.1%) dan alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (+1.3%). Sementara itu, indeks volum eksport menyusut 11.8 peratus pada bulan yang sama, disumbangkan oleh kejatuhan indeks pelbagai barang keluaran kilang (-15.4%), alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (-11.4%) dan minyak galian (-7.8%). Indeks volum eksport pelarasan bermusim bertumbuh 0.5 peratus daripada 154.4 mata kepada 155.1 mata. Berdasarkan perbandingan tahunan, kedua-dua indeks nilai seunit dan volum eksport masing-masing meningkat 15.5 peratus dan 7.0 peratus.”

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata “Indeks nilai seunit import pula menyusut 0.5 peratus pada Januari 2022 berbanding bulan sebelumnya, disumbangkan oleh kejatuhan

indeks minyak galian (-4.6%), alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (-0.3%) dan bahan kimia (-0.2%). Indeks volum import turut menyusut 0.04 peratus pada Januari 2022 berbanding bulan sebelum, disumbangkan oleh kejatuhan pelbagai barang keluaran kilang (-4.2%), alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (-2.8%) dan bahan mentah tidak boleh dimakan (-0.3%). Indeks volum import pelarasan bermusim pada Januari 2022 meningkat 1.5 peratus daripada 166.8 mata kepada 169.3 mata. Perbandingan tahun ke tahun menunjukkan kedua-dua indeks nilai seunit dan volum import masing-masing berkembang 7.1 peratus dan 18.1 peratus.”

Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) turut melaporkan terma perdagangan Malaysia mencatatkan pertumbuhan 1.9 peratus bulan ke bulan kepada 109.1 mata pada Januari 2022. Perbandingan tahun ke tahun prestasi perdagangan Malaysia menunjukkan pertumbuhan positif sebanyak 7.9 peratus daripada 101.1 mata pada Januari tahun lalu.

Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia sedang menjalankan Survei Pendapatan, Perbelanjaan Isi Rumah dan Kemudahan Asas (HIES/BA) 2022 bermula dari 1 Januari 2022 sehingga 31 Disember 2022. Malaysia's growth of export unit value index showed positive trend in January 2022 with an increase of 1.3 per cent

PUTRAJAYA, MARCH 4, 2022 – Malaysia's export unit value index remained positive for four consecutive months since October 2021 with an increase of 1.3 per cent, as reported today in **EXTERNAL TRADE INDICES (2010=100), JANUARY 2022**. This publication presents the unit value and volume index by sections for both exports and imports of goods.

According to the Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, “The export unit value index grew 1.3 per cent in January 2022 as compared with the previous month, supported by the increases in the index of animal & vegetable oils & fats (+3.3%), mineral fuels (+2.1%) and machinery & transport equipment (+1.3%). On the other hand, the export volume index fell 11.8 per cent in the same month, reflected by the deterioration in the index of miscellaneous manufactured articles (-15.4%), machinery & transport equipment (-11.4%) and mineral fuels (-7.8%). The seasonally adjusted export volume index grew 0.5 per cent from 154.4 points to 155.1 points. On annual comparison, both export unit value and volume index grew 15.5 per cent and 7.0 per cent, respectively.”

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin commented, “The import unit value index dropped 0.5 per cent in January 2022 as compared with the previous month, attributed to the deterioration in the index of mineral fuels (-4.6%), machinery & transport equipment (-0.3%) and chemicals (-0.2%). Likewise, the import volume index fell by 0.04 per cent in January 2022 as compared to the preceding month, attributed to the deterioration in the index of

miscellaneous manufactured articles (-4.2%), machinery & transport equipment (-2.8%) and inedible crude materials (-0.3%). The seasonally adjusted import volume index in January 2022 increased by 1.5 per cent from 166.8 points to 169.3 points. On a year-on-year basis, both the import unit value and volume indices expanded 7.1 per cent and 18.1 per cent, respectively.”

Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) also reported that Malaysia’s terms of trade increased by 1.9 per cent month-on-month to 109.1 points in January 2022. On a y-o-y basis, Malaysia’s terms of trade performance showed positive growth of 7.9 per cent from 101.1 points in January of previous year.




Chart 1: Month-on-Month Percentage Change of Export & Import Unit Value Indices
