PERANGKAAN PEMBUATAN BULANAN
NOVEMBER 2021**

Sektor Pembuatan mencatatkan nilai jualan tertinggi sebanyak RM142.4 bilion dengan pertumbuhan 18.8 peratus pada November 2021

PUTRAJAYA, 10 JANUARI 2022 – Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan Malaysia pada bulan November 2021 berjumlah **RM142.4 bilion**, bertumbuh sebanyak **18.8 peratus** berbanding bulan yang sama tahun 2020. Sementara itu, nilai jualan ini meningkat sebanyak **1.2 peratus** berbanding dengan bulan sebelumnya. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia menerbitkan **PERANGKAAN PEMBUATAN BULANAN, MALAYSIA, NOVEMBER 2021** hari ini.

Mengulas terhadap laporan tersebut, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia berkata, “Pertumbuhan nilai jualan pada bulan ini adalah dipacu oleh subsektor Produk Petroleum, Kimia, Getah & Plastik (**29.0%**) terutamanya dalam industri Pembuatan kok dan produk petroleum bertapis. Pengembangan ini juga didorong oleh subsektor Produk Makanan, Minuman & Tembakau (**20.7%**) yang disokong oleh industri Pembuatan produk makanan dan subsektor Produk Elektrik & Elektronik (**17.8%**) terutamanya dalam industri Pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik serta optikal.”

Nilai jualan bagi industri berorientasikan eksport yang menyumbang sebanyak **71.7 peratus** dari jumlah nilai jualan merekodkan peningkatan **22.2 peratus** manakala industri berorientasikan domestik mencatatkan kenaikan **11.0 peratus** pada November 2021 berbanding bulan yang sama tahun 2020. Pertumbuhan nilai jualan bagi industri berorientasikan eksport adalah selari dengan pertumbuhan dua digit yang dicatatkan bagi eksport perdagangan luar negeri serta faktor harga yang kekal memberangsangkan. Bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, industri berorientasikan eksport dan domestik masing-masing merekodkan pertumbuhan positif **0.2 peratus** dan **3.9 peratus**.


Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin juga berkata jumlah pekerja sektor Pembuatan pada bulan November 2021 adalah seramai **2,253,574 orang**, meningkat **2.6 peratus** berbanding 2,195,488 orang pada November 2020. Peningkatan ini disumbangkan oleh Produk Elektrik & Elektronik (**5.0%**), Produk Kayu, Perabot, Keluaran Kertas & Percetakan (**3.7%**) dan Produk Makanan, Minuman & Tembakau (**2.3%**)

Laporan tersebut juga menyatakan jumlah gaji & upah yang dibayar adalah berjumlah **RM7,535.5 juta**, meningkat **4.8 peratus** atau **RM345.2 juta** pada November 2021 berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Di samping itu, nilai jualan per pekerja meningkat **15.7 peratus** kepada **RM63,189** berbanding bulan yang sama tahun 2020 (November 2020: RM54,599). Sementara itu, purata gaji & upah setiap pekerja adalah sebanyak **RM3,344** pada bulan November 2021.


Bagi tempoh Januari hingga November 2021, nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan bertambah **15.4 peratus** kepada **RM1,410.8 bilion** berbanding tempoh yang sama tahun 2020. Bilangan pekerja dan gaji & upah masing-masing mencatatkan pertumbuhan sebanyak **2.6 peratus** (**2.25 juta orang**) dan **2.8 peratus** (**RM81.7 bilion**). Nilai jualan per pekerja bagi sebelas bulan pertama tahun 2021 turut bertumbuh **12.5 peratus** kepada **RM626,036**.

Malaysia's Manufacturing recorded the highest sales value amounted to RM142.4 billion with growth of 18.8 per cent in November 2021

PUTRAJAYA, 10 JANUARY 2022 - Malaysia's Manufacturing sales in November 2021 stood at **RM142.4 billion**, grew **18.8 per cent** as compared to the same month in 2020. Meanwhile, the sales value increased by **1.2 per cent** as against the previous month. The Department of Statistics Malaysia published the **MONTHLY MANUFACTURING STATISTICS, MALAYSIA, NOVEMBER 2021** today.

Commenting on the report, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia, said “The growth in sales value for this month was driven by the Petroleum, Chemical, Rubber & Plastic Products subsector (**29.0%**) especially in the Manufacture of coke & refined petroleum products industries. The expansion was also attributed by the Food, Beverages & Tobacco subsector (**20.7%**) supported by the Manufacture of food products industries as well as the Electrical & Electronics Products subsector (**17.8%**) mainly in the Manufacture of computer, optical & electronics products.”

*Sales value for export-oriented industries which accounted for **71.7 per cent** of total sales value recorded an increase of **22.2 per cent** while domestic-oriented industries posted an increment of **11.0 per cent** in November 2021 as compared to the same month in 2020. The growth of sales value for export-oriented industries was in line with the double-digit growth registered in the external trade exports and the price factors that remain favourable. On month-on-month comparison, export and domestic-oriented industries recorded positive growth of **0.2 per cent** and **3.9 per cent** respectively.*


*Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin added that the total employees engaged in the Manufacturing sector in November 2021 was **2,253,574 persons**, an increase of **2.6 per cent** as compared to 2,195,488 persons in November 2020. The increase was contributed by the Electrical & Electronic Products (**5.0%**), Wood, Furniture, Paper Products & Printing (**3.7%**) and Food, Beverages & Tobacco Products (**2.3%**).*

*The report also stated that salaries & wages paid amounted to **RM7,535.5 million**, increased by **4.8 per cent** or **RM345.2 million** in November 2021 as against the same month of the preceding year. Besides that, the sales value per employee increased by **15.7 per cent** to record **RM63,189** as compared with the same month in 2020 (November 2020: RM54,599). Meanwhile, the average salaries & wages per employee was **RM3,344** in November 2021.*


*For the period of January to November 2021, the sales value of the Manufacturing sector increased by **15.4 per cent** to **RM1,410.8 billion** as compared to the same period in 2020. The number of employees and salaries & wages recorded a growth of **2.6 per cent** (**2.25 million persons**) and **2.8 per cent** (**RM81.7 billion**) respectively. Sales value per employee for the first eleven months of 2021 also grew **12.5 per cent** to record **RM626,036**.*
