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**MEDIA STATEMENT
FOR EXTERNAL TRADE INDICES,
MALAYSIA, NOVEMBER 2021**

Malaysia's export & import unit value indices recorded positive growths of 1.3 per cent and 1.0 per cent, respectively in November 2021

***PUTRAJAYA, JANUARY 4, 2022** – Malaysia's monthly export and import unit value indices recorded positive growths of 1.3 per cent and 1.0 per cent respectively, in November 2021, as reported today in **EXTERNAL TRADE INDICES (2010=100), NOVEMBER 2021**. This report presents the unit value and volume index by sections for both exports and imports of goods.*

Malaysia's total trade recorded an upward trend, increased by 1.5 per cent in November 2021 compared to the previous month. Export value shrank by 1.9 per cent to RM112.2 billion in the same month, reflected by the deterioration in the exports of manufactured goods (-12.3%), inedible crude materials (-4.7%) and machinery & transport equipment (-4.3%). On the other hand, imports grew by 5.9 per cent month-on-month (m-o-m) in November 2021 amounted at RM93.3 billion. The increment was contributed by the increases in the imports of manufactured goods (+12.8%), chemicals (+12.6%) and machinery & transport equipment (+4.8%). Meanwhile, trade value declined by 28.1 per cent m-o-m, amounted to RM18.9 billion.

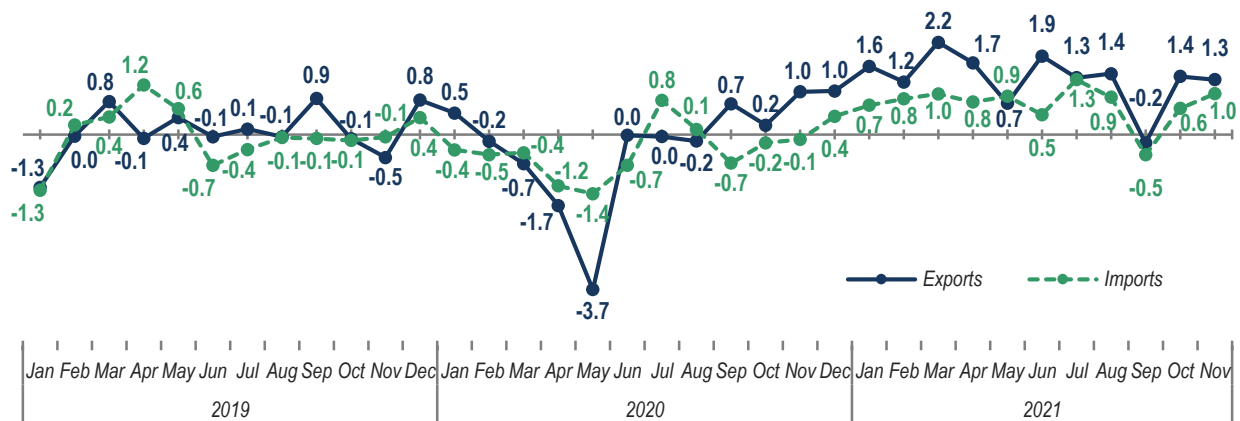
According to the Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "The export unit value index grew 1.3 per cent in November 2021 as compared with the previous month, contributed by the increases in the index of mineral fuels (+5.4%), animal & vegetable oils & fats (+1.1%) and machinery & transport equipment (+0.4%). Meanwhile, the export volume index fell 3.2 per cent in the same month, reflected by the deterioration in index of manufactured goods (-12.1%), machinery & transport equipment (-4.7%) and mineral fuels

(-3.5%). The seasonally adjusted export volume index rose 6.3 per cent from 152.6 points to 162.2 points. On annual comparison, both export unit value and volume index grew 16.8 per cent and 13.5 per cent, respectively.”

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin commented, “The import unit value index also grew 1.0 per cent in November 2021 as compared with the previous month, attributed to the increases in the index of animal & vegetable oils & fats (+10.3%), mineral fuels (+4.5%) and machinery & transport equipment (+0.4%). Likewise, the import volume index increased by 4.8 per cent in November 2021 as compared to the preceding month, contributed by the increases in the index of manufactured goods (+12.6%), chemicals (+12.4%) and machinery & transport equipment (+4.4%). The seasonally adjusted import volume index in November 2021 recorded an increase of 5.8 per cent from 159.5 points to 168.7 points. On a year-on-year basis, both the import unit value and volume indices expanded 8.7 per cent and 27.1 per cent, respectively.”

Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) also reported that Malaysia's terms of trade increased by 0.3 per cent m-o-m to 107.0 points in November 2021. Malaysia's terms of trade performance remained positive at 7.5 per cent from 99.6 points in November of previous year.

Indeks nilai seunit eksport & import Malaysia masing-masing merekodkan pertumbuhan positif 1.3 peratus dan 1.0 peratus pada November 2021

PUTRAJAYA, 4 JANUARI 2022 – Indeks nilai seunit eksport dan import bulanan Malaysia masing-masing mencatatkan pertumbuhan positif 1.3 peratus dan 1.0 peratus pada November 2021, sebagai mana dipaparkan oleh laporan **INDEKS PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI (2010=100), NOVEMBER 2021** pada hari ini. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik indeks nilai seunit dan indeks volum mengikut seksyen bagi eksport dan import barangan.

Jumlah perdagangan Malaysia merekodkan prestasi menaik, meningkat 1.5 peratus pada November 2021 berbanding bulan sebelumnya. Nilai eksport menyusut 1.9 peratus kepada RM112.2 bilion pada bulan yang sama, disumbangkan oleh kejatuhan eksport barang-barang keluaran kilang (-12.3%), bahan mentah tidak boleh dimakan (-4.7%) dan alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (-4.3%). Sementara itu, nilai import meningkat 5.9 peratus bulan ke bulan pada November 2021, dengan nilai RM93.3 bilion. Peningkatan ini disumbangkan oleh kenaikan import barang-barang keluaran kilang (+12.8%), bahan kimia (+12.6%) dan alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (+4.8%). Nilai perdagangan pula menyusut 28.1 peratus bulan ke bulan, dengan nilai RM18.9 bilion.

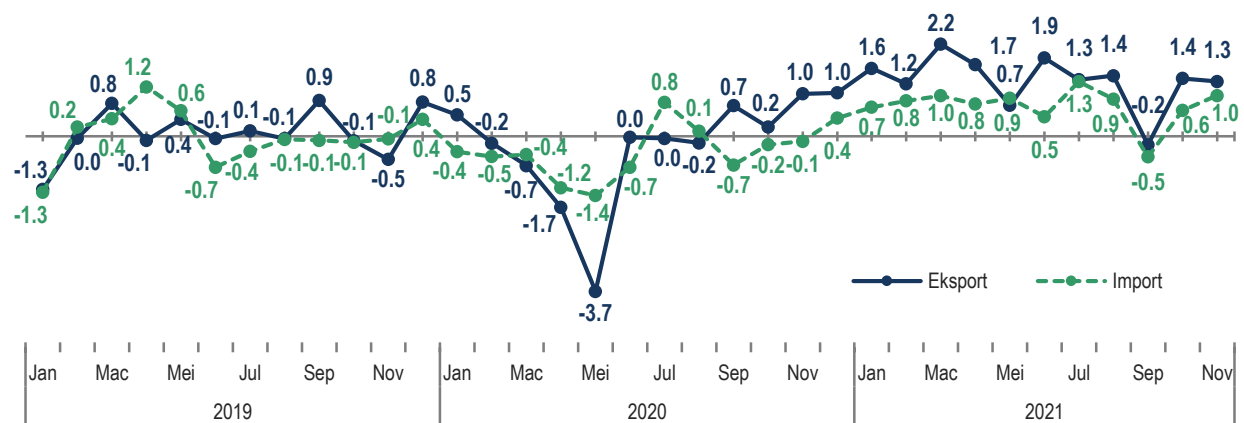
Menurut Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "Indeks nilai seunit eksport meningkat 1.3 peratus pada November 2021 berbanding bulan sebelumnya, disumbangkan oleh kenaikan indeks minyak galian (+5.4%), minyak & lemak

binatang & sayur-sayuran (+1.1%) dan alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (+0.4%). Sementara itu, indeks volum eksport menyusut 3.2 peratus pada bulan yang sama, disumbangkan oleh kejatuhan indeks barang-barang keluaran kilang (-12.1%), alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (-4.7%) dan minyak galian (-3.5%). Indeks volum eksport pelarasan bermusim bertumbuh 6.3 peratus daripada 152.6 mata kepada 162.2 mata. Berdasarkan perbandingan tahunan, kedua-dua indeks nilai seunit dan volum eksport masing-masing meningkat 16.8 peratus dan 13.5 peratus.”

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata “Indeks nilai seunit import turut meningkat 1.0 peratus pada November 2021 berbanding bulan sebelum, disumbangkan oleh kenaikan indeks minyak & lemak binatang & sayur-sayuran (+10.3%), minyak galian (+4.5%) dan alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (+0.4%). Indeks volum import turut meningkat 4.8 peratus pada November 2021 berbanding bulan sebelum, disumbangkan oleh kenaikan indeks barang-barang keluaran kilang (+12.6%), bahan kimia (+12.4%) dan alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (+4.4%). Indeks volum import pelarasan bermusim pada November 2021 berkembang 5.8 peratus daripada 159.5 mata kepada 168.7 mata. Perbandingan tahun ke tahun menunjukkan kedua-dua indeks nilai seunit dan volum import masing-masing meningkat 8.7 peratus dan 27.1 peratus.”

Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) turut melaporkan terma perdagangan Malaysia mencatatkan pertumbuhan 0.3 peratus bulan ke bulan kepada 107.0 mata pada November 2021. Prestasi terma perdagangan Malaysia kekal positif 7.5 peratus daripada 99.6 mata pada November tahun lalu.
