INDEX OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION, MALAYSIA
OCTOBER 2021

Malaysia's Industrial Production Index (IPI) continued to strengthen to 5.5 per cent driven by the Manufacturing index growth of 8.0 per cent in October 2021

PUTRAJAYA, 10 DECEMBER 2021 – The Department of Statistics Malaysia, today released **INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION INDEX (IPI), MALAYSIA, OCTOBER 2021**. This publication presents statistics on IPI which consists of three main sectors; Mining, Manufacturing and Electricity.

Commenting on the report, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia, said "The Industrial Production Index (IPI) rose to **5.5 per cent** with the Manufacturing index driving the growth when registered an increase of **8.0 per cent** in October 2021. Simultaneously, the Electricity index rose **4.1 percent**. Meanwhile, Mining index recorded a downturn of **3.5 per cent**. On month-on-month basis, the IPI increased by **4.8 per cent** driven by Manufacturing and Electricity sectors."

The Manufacturing sector output based on year-on-year comparison increased by **8.0 per cent** in October 2021 after recording a positive growth of 4.0 per cent in September 2021. The main subsectors contributed to the growth in Manufacturing sector in October 2021 were Electrical & Electronics Products (**13.6%**), Food, Beverages & Tobacco (**9.3%**) and Petroleum, Chemical, Rubber & Plastic Products (**6.3%**).

*Simultaneously, export-oriented and domestic-oriented industries recorded a growth of **8.6 per cent** and **6.6 per cent** respectively. The increase in export-oriented industries was mainly supported by the manufacture of computer, electronics & optical products and manufacture of coke & refined petroleum products. The performance of the Manufacturing sector was also in line with the encouraging growth of exports. Meanwhile, the growth for the domestic-oriented industry was attributed by the manufacture of food products and the manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery & equipment. The expansion of domestic-oriented industries was also driven by the increase in the domestic economy and social activities after the inter-state movement being allowed on 11th October 2021 and most states have moved into phase four of the National Recovery Plan (NRP).*

*The Manufacturing sector for month-on-month basis also increased **4.0 per cent** as compared to September 2021 where the increment was reflected by higher capacity utilization compared to last month especially in the Transport Equipment & Other Manufactures, Electrical & Electronic Products and Textiles, Wearing Apparel, Leather Products & Footwear subsectors.*

*The Mining sector output shrank **3.5 per cent** in October 2021 as compared to the same period of the previous year. The deterioration was contributed by the fall of **10.2 per cent** in Crude Oil & Condensate index. Meanwhile, Natural Gas index augmented by **2.0 per cent**. The Mining index registered an increase of **7.1 percent** as compared to the previous month. The Electricity sector output rose **4.1 per cent** in October 2021 as compared to the same month last year. On the other hand, in terms of month-on-month comparison, the Electricity index grew **7.7 per cent**.*

*The IPI in the period of January to October 2021 recorded an expansion of **7.3 per cent** as compared to the same period of the previous year. The increment was influenced by the rise in all components; Manufacturing index (**9.4%**), Mining index (**1.8%**) and Electricity index (**1.9%**) .*

CHART 1 : PERFORMANCE OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION INDEX OCTOBER 2021

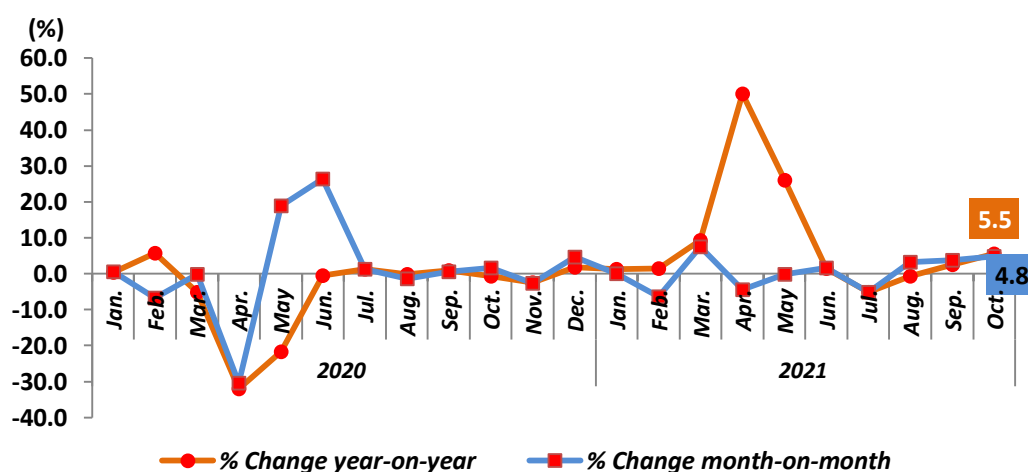
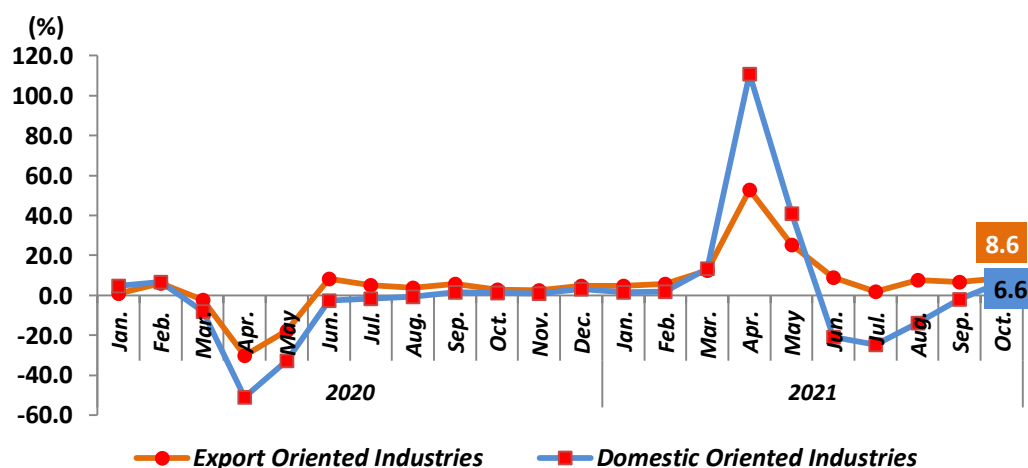

Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian (IPP) Malaysia terus mengukuh kepada 5.5 peratus dengan indeks Pembuatan memacu pertumbuhan 8.0 peratus pada Oktober 2021

PUTRAJAYA, 10 D I S E M B E R 2 0 2 1 – Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia menerbitkan **INDEKS PENGELUARAN PERINDUSTRIAN (IPP), MALAYSIA, OKTOBER 2021** pada hari ini. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik IPP yang terdiri daripada tiga sektor utama; Perlombongan, Pembuatan dan Elektrik.

Mengulas terhadap laporan tersebut, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia berkata, "Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian (IPP) meningkat kepada **5.5 peratus** dengan indeks Pembuatan memacu pertumbuhan apabila mencatatkan kenaikan **8.0 peratus** pada bulan Oktober 2021. Pada masa yang sama, indeks Elektrik meningkat **4.1 peratus**. Sementara itu, indeks Perlombongan merekodkan penyusutan **3.5 peratus**. Dari segi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, IPP meningkat **4.8 peratus** didorong oleh sektor Pembuatan dan Elektrik."

Output sektor Pembuatan berdasarkan perbandingan tahun ke tahun meningkat **8.0 peratus** pada bulan Oktober 2021 selepas mencatatkan pertumbuhan 4.0 peratus pada bulan September 2021. Subsektor utama yang menyumbang kepada pertumbuhan sektor Pembuatan pada Oktober 2021 adalah Produk Peralatan Elektrik & Elektronik (**13.6%**), Makanan, Minuman & Tembakau (**9.3%**) dan Produk Petroleum, Kimia, Getah & Plastik (**6.3%**).

Pada masa yang sama, industri berorientasikan eksport dan domestik masing-masing mencatatkan pertumbuhan sebanyak **8.6 peratus** dan **6.6 peratus**. Peningkatan bagi industri berorientasikan eksport disumbangkan terutamanya oleh pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik & optikal dan pembuatan kok & produk petroleum bertapis. Prestasi sektor Pembuatan ini juga selari dengan pertumbuhan eksport yang memberangsangkan. Sementara itu, pertumbuhan bagi industri berasaskan domestik dipengaruhi oleh pembuatan produk makanan dan pembuatan produk logam yang direka, kecuali mesin & kelengkapan. Pengembangan industri berorientasikan domestik turut didorong oleh kerancakan ekonomi domestik dan aktiviti sosial berikutan kebenaran rentas negeri pada 11 Oktober 2021 dan kebanyakan negeri telah beralih ke fasa empat Pelan Pemulihan Negara (PPN).

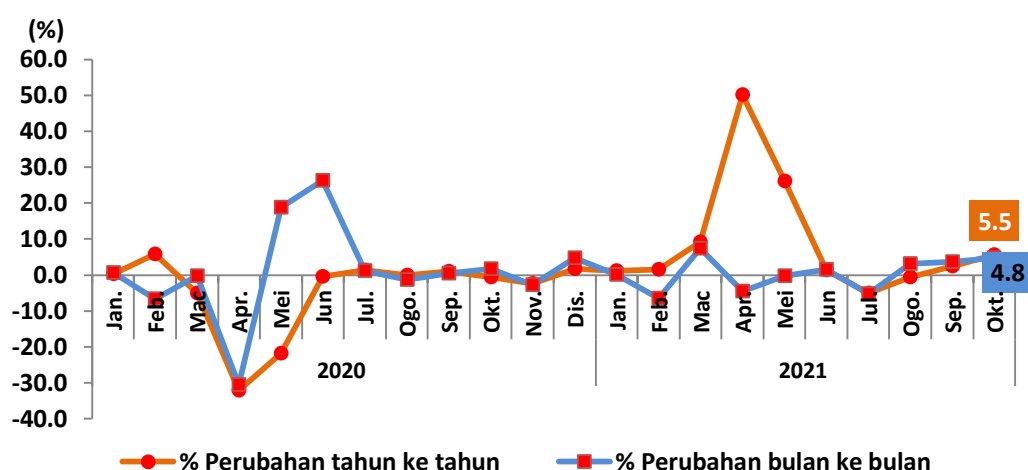
Sektor Pembuatan bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan turut meningkat **4.0 peratus** berbanding September 2021 di mana kenaikan ini turut digambarkan oleh kapasiti penggunaan kilang yang lebih tinggi berbanding bulan lalu terutamanya dalam subsektor Kelengkapan Pengangkutan & Pembuatan Lain, Produk Peralatan Elektrik & Elektronik dan Produk Tekstil, Pakaian, Kulit & Kasut.

Output sektor Perlombongan menguncup **3.5 peratus** pada bulan Oktober 2021 berbanding tempoh yang sama pada tahun sebelumnya. Penyusutan tersebut disebabkan oleh kejatuhan **10.2 peratus** dalam indeks Minyak Mentah & Kondensat. Sementara itu indeks Gas Asli tumbuh **2.0 peratus**. Indeks Perlombongan merekodkan peningkatan **7.1 peratus** berbanding bulan yang lalu. Output sektor Elektrik berkembang **4.1 peratus** pada bulan Oktober 2021 berbanding bulan yang sama tahun lalu. Sementara itu, dari segi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, indeks Elektrik turut berkembang **7.7 peratus**.

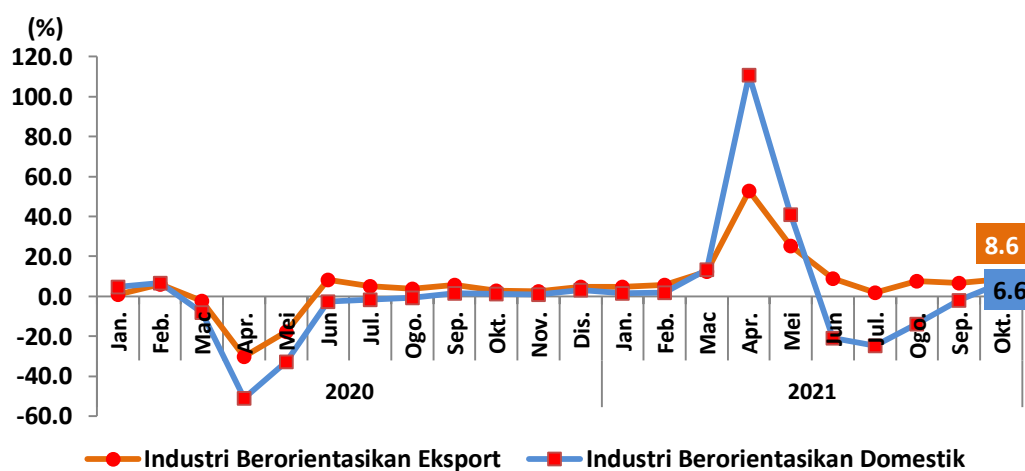
IPP bagi tempoh Januari hingga Oktober 2021 merekodkan pengembangan **7.3 peratus** berbanding dengan tempoh yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Peningkatan tersebut dipengaruhi oleh kenaikan dalam kesemua komponen; indeks Pembuatan (**9.4%**), indeks Elektrik (**1.9%**) dan indeks Perlombongan (**1.8%**).
