Indeks nilai seunit eksport & import Malaysia mencatatkan pertumbuhan positif 1.4 peratus dan 0.6 peratus pada Oktober 2021

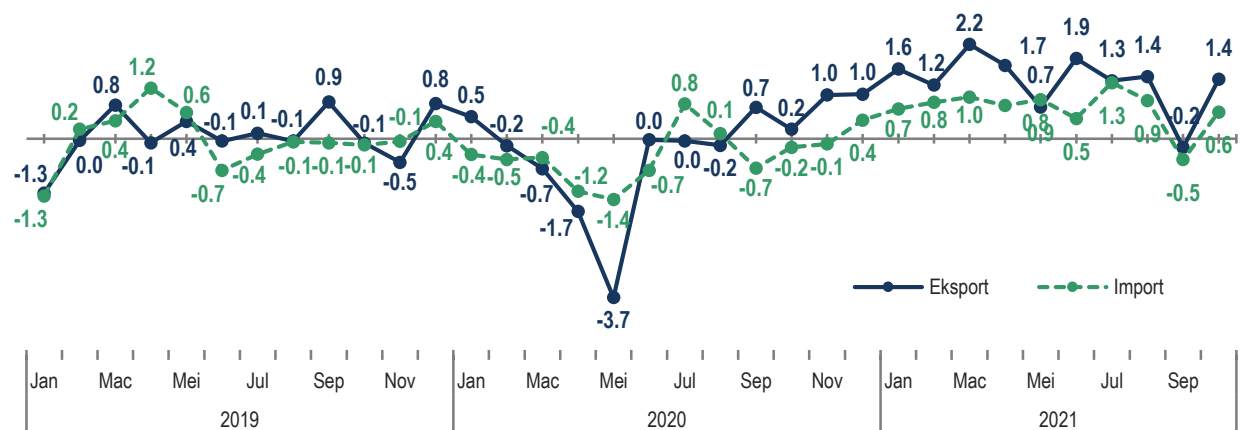
PUTRAJAYA, 3 DISEMBER 2021 – Indeks nilai seunit eksport dan import bulanan Malaysia masing-masing mencatatkan pertumbuhan positif 1.4 peratus dan 0.6 peratus pada Oktober 2021, sebagai mana dipaparkan oleh laporan **INDEKS PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI (2010=100), OKTOBER 2021** pada hari ini. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik indeks nilai seunit dan indeks volum mengikut seksyen bagi eksport dan import barangan.

Mengulas terhadap laporan tersebut, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia berkata, “Indeks nilai seunit eksport meningkat 1.4 peratus pada Oktober 2021 berbanding bulan sebelumnya, disumbangkan oleh kenaikan indeks minyak galian (+6.2%), minyak & lemak binatang & sayur-sayuran (+3.3%) dan bahan kimia (+0.9%). Sementara itu, indeks volum eksport meningkat 1.8 peratus pada bulan yang sama, disumbangkan oleh barang-barang keluaran kilang (+8.1%), bahan kimia (+7.1%) dan alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (+4.1%). Indeks volum eksport pelarasan bermusim menyusut 8.0 peratus daripada 165.9 mata kepada 152.6 mata. Berdasarkan perbandingan tahunan, kedua-dua indeks nilai seunit dan volum eksport masing-masing meningkat 16.4 peratus dan 7.8 peratus.”

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin turut berkata “Indeks nilai seunit import turut meningkat 0.6 peratus pada Oktober 2021 berbanding bulan sebelum, disumbangkan oleh kenaikan indeks minyak galian (+4.7%), barang-barang keluaran kilang (+0.04%) dan alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (+0.03%). Sementara itu, indeks volum import meningkat 3.6 peratus pada Oktober 2021 berbanding bulan sebelum, disumbangkan oleh kenaikan indeks minyak galian (+8.2%), alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (+4.6%) dan barang-barang keluaran kilang (+3.7%). Indeks volum import pelarasan bermusim pada Oktober 2021 menyusut 0.8 peratus daripada 160.9 mata kepada 159.6 mata. Berbanding tahun sebelum, kedua-dua indeks nilai seunit dan volum import masing-masing meningkat 7.5 peratus dan 19.2 peratus.”

Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) turut melaporkan terma perdagangan Malaysia mencatatkan pertumbuhan 0.8 peratus bulan ke bulan kepada 106.7 mata pada Oktober 2021. Prestasi terma perdagangan Malaysia kekal positif 8.3 peratus daripada 98.5 mata pada Oktober tahun lalu.

***Malaysia's export & import unit value indices recorded positive
growths of 1.4 per cent and 0.6 per cent in October 2021***

PUTRAJAYA, DECEMBER 3, 2021 – Malaysia's monthly export and import unit value indices posted positive growths of 1.4 per cent and 0.6 per cent respectively, in October 2021, as reported today in **EXTERNAL TRADE INDICES (2010=100), OCTOBER 2021**. This report presents the unit value and volume index by sections for both exports and imports of goods.

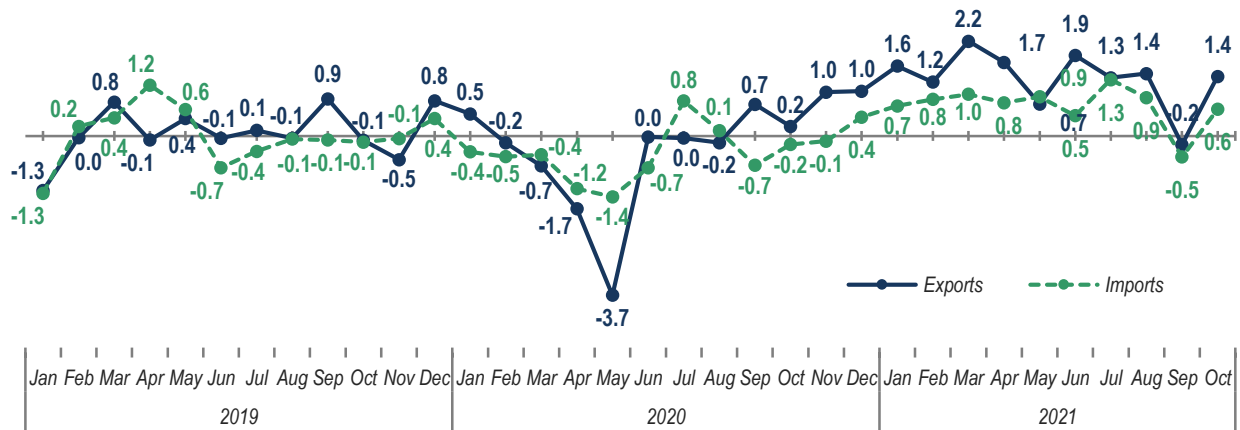
Commenting on the report, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia, said "The export unit value index increased 1.4 per cent in October 2021 as compared with the previous month, contributed by the increases in the index of mineral fuels (+6.2%), animal & vegetable oils & fats (+3.3%) and chemicals (+0.9%). Meanwhile, the export volume index rose 1.8 per cent in the same month, reflected by the increases in index of manufactured goods (+8.1%), chemicals (+7.1%) and machinery & transport equipment (+4.1%). The seasonally adjusted export volume index fell 8.0 per cent from 165.9 points to 152.6 points. On annual comparison, both export unit value and volume index grew 16.4 per cent and 7.8 per cent, respectively."

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin also commented, "The import unit value index also grew 0.6 per cent in October 2021 as compared with the previous month, attributed to the increases in the index of mineral fuels (+4.7%), manufactured goods (+0.04%) and machinery & transport equipment (+0.03%). On the other hand, the import volume index increased by 3.6 per cent in October 2021 as compared to the preceding month, contributed

by the increases in the index of mineral fuels (+8.2%), machinery & transport equipment (+4.6%) and manufactured goods (+3.7%). The seasonally adjusted import volume index in October 2021 dropped 0.8 per cent from 160.9 points to 159.6 points. On a year-on-year basis, both the import unit value and volume indices expanded 7.5 per cent and 19.2 per cent, respectively.”

Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) also reported that Malaysia’s terms of trade increased by 0.8 per cent month-on-month to 106.7 points in October 2021. Malaysia’s terms of trade performance remained positive at 8.3 per cent from 98.5 points in October of previous year.
