Malaysia Economic Recovery Dashboard (MERD) Sebagai Sumber Rujukan Ekonomi Semasa Negara

PUTRAJAYA, 2 DISEMBER 2021 – Hari ini, Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) telah melancarkan ***Malaysia Economic Recovery Dashboard (MERD)*** yang disempurnakan oleh YB Dato' Sri Mustapa Mohamed, Menteri di Jabatan Perdana Menteri (Ekonomi). MERD merupakan platform yang memberi gambaran ringkas keadaan ekonomi semasa negara. *Dashboard* ini mengandungi sembilan indikator ekonomi utama, iaitu Keluaran Dalam Negeri Kasar (KDNK), Tenaga Buruh, Komoditi, Harga, Pembuatan, Perkhidmatan, Perdagangan Antarabangsa, Imbangian Pembayaran dan Indikator Lain, yang merangkumi 39 sub-indikator dalam bentuk siri masa bulanan, suku tahunan dan tahunan.

Menurut Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "***Malaysia Economic Recovery Dashboard (MERD)*** merupakan inisiatif terkini DOSM bagi membantu meningkatkan kefahaman orang ramai dan membantu usaha kerajaan dalam memulihkan ekonomi akibat pandemik COVID-19. Melalui MERD, orang ramai dapat mengenali indikator ekonomi utama dan hubungkait antara sub-indikator yang memberi gambaran perkembangan semasa dan pemulihan ekonomi negara. Adalah menjadi harapan DOSM agar orang ramai memanfaatkan dashboard yang disediakan ini."

Ketua Perangkawan juga menyatakan, "Pandemik COVID-19 telah menjelaskan ekonomi negara dengan ketara. Pertumbuhan KDNK menguncup sebanyak 5.6 peratus dan kadar pengangguran mencecah 4.5 peratus pada tahun lepas. Keadaan yang tidak menentu berikutan pandemik COVID-19 turut menjelaskan kedudukan ekonomi pada keseluruhan tahun ini. Prestasi ekonomi telah bertambah baik pada separuh tahun pertama ini dengan penguncupan yang lebih kecil sebanyak 1.1 peratus pada September 2021 berbanding penguncupan 4.7 peratus pada Ogos dan 7.6 peratus pada Julai 2021 hasil daripada pelaksanaan Pelan Jana Semula Ekonomi Negara (PENJANA) oleh kerajaan. MERD adalah relevan dalam senario semasa untuk memantau dan membantu kerajaan menggiatkan ekonomi dan meningkatkan kesejahteraan rakyat."

Tambahan kepada *Dashboard* ini, terdapat juga indikator daripada pelbagai sumber berkaitan COVID-19 seperti *Google Mobility Trends* dan *COVID-19 surveillance*

Dashboard yang tersedia untuk kegunaan umum bagi memantau perkembangan semasa senario pandemik di negara ini."

Malaysia Economic Recovery Dashboard (MERD) as a Reference on the Nation's Current Economic Situation

PUTRAJAYA, DECEMBER 2, 2021 – Today, the Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) launched the **Malaysia Economic Recovery Dashboard (MERD)** which was officiated by YB Dato' Sri Mustapa Mohamed, Minister in the Prime Minister's Department (Economy). MERD is a platform that serves as a quick overview of Malaysia's current economic situation. The dashboard contains nine key economic indicators, namely Gross Domestic Product (GDP), Labour Force, Commodities, Prices, Manufacturing, Services, International Trade, Balance of Payments and Other Indicators, that includes 39 sub-indicators in the form of monthly, quarterly and annual time series.

According to the Chief Statistician, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "The Malaysia Economic Recovery Dashboard (MERD) is the latest initiative by DOSM to increase public's awareness and understanding, besides assisting the government's efforts to revive the economy due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Through MERD, the public is able to know the key economic indicators and the relationship between sub-indicators that provide the current economic and recovery scenario. DOSM hope that the public will benefit and fully utilised the dashboard".

He also said that "The COVID-19 pandemic has significantly affected the country's economy. GDP growth contracted by 5.6 per cent, and the unemployment rate reached 4.5 per cent last year. The uncertainty following the COVID-19 pandemic also affected the economic position throughout the year. Economic performance has improved in the first half of this year with a smaller contraction of 1.1 per cent in September 2021 as compared to a contraction of 4.7 per cent in August and 7.6 per cent in July 2021 due to the implementation of the National Economic Recovery Plan by the government. MERD is relevant in the current scenario to monitor and assist the government in revitalizing the economy and rakyat's well-being."

In addition to the newly launched dashboard, there are also indicators related to COVID-19 from various sources such as Google Mobility Trends and COVID-19 surveillance Dashboard available for the public to monitor the current developments of the pandemic scenario in this country.
