KENYATAAN MEDIA PERANGKAAN PEMBUATAN BULANAN SEPTEMBER 2021

Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan merekodkan RM135.3 bilion, tumbuh sebanyak 11.6 peratus pada September 2021

PUTRAJAYA, 9 NOVEMBER 2021 – Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan Malaysia pada bulan September 2021 berjumlah **RM135.3 bilion**, bertumbuh sebanyak **11.6 peratus** berbanding bulan yang sama tahun 2020. Sementara itu, nilai jualan ini meningkat sebanyak **6.9 peratus** berbanding dengan bulan sebelumnya. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia menerbitkan **PERANGKAAN PEMBUATAN BULANAN, MALAYSIA, SEPTEMBER 2021** hari ini.

Mengulas terhadap laporan tersebut, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia berkata, “Pertumbuhan nilai jualan pada bulan ini adalah dipacu oleh subsektor Produk Petroleum, Kimia, Getah & Plastik **(29.2%)** terutamanya dalam industri Pembuatan kok dan produk petroleum bertapis. Pengembangan ini juga didorong oleh subsektor Produk Makanan, Minuman dan Tembakau **(12.0%)** yang disokong oleh industri Pembuatan Produk Makanan serta subsektor Produk Elektrik & Elektronik **(10.8%)** terutamanya dalam industri Pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik dan optikal.”

Nilai jualan bagi industri berorientasikan eksport yang menyumbang sebanyak **74.0 peratus** dari jumlah nilai jualan merekodkan kenaikan **15.9 peratus (RM100.2 bilion)** manakala industri berorientasikan domestik mencatatkan kenaikan **1.1 peratus** pada September 2021 berbanding bulan yang sama tahun 2020. Pertumbuhan nilai jualan bagi industri berorientasikan eksport adalah selari dengan pertumbuhan dua digit yang dicatatkan bagi eksport perdagangan luar negeri serta faktor harga yang kekal memberangsangkan. Bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, industri berorientasikan eksport dan domestik masing-masing merekodkan pertumbuhan positif **5.2 peratus** dan **12.3 peratus**.

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin juga berkata jumlah pekerja sektor Pembuatan pada bulan September 2021 adalah seramai **2,231,406 orang**, meningkat **1.6 peratus** berbanding 2,195,300 orang pada September 2020. Peningkatan ini disumbang oleh Produk Elektrik & Elektronik (**4.5%**), Produk Petroleum, Kimia, Getah dan Plastik (**1.3%**) dan Produk Kayu, Perabot, Keluaran Kertas & Percetakan (**1.5%**).

Laporan tersebut juga menyatakan jumlah gaji & upah yang dibayar adalah berjumlah **RM7,478.8 juta**, meningkat **3.6 peratus** atau **RM261.8 juta** pada September 2021 berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Di samping itu, nilai jualan per pekerja meningkat **9.8 peratus** kepada **RM60,645** berbanding bulan yang sama tahun 2020 (September 2020: RM55,218). Sementara itu, purata gaji & upah setiap pekerja adalah sebanyak **RM3,352** pada bulan September 2021.


Pada suku tahun ketiga 2021, nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan meningkat **6.4 peratus** kepada **RM381.8 bilion** berbanding suku tahun yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Peningkatan ini didorong oleh kenaikan dalam Produk Petroleum, Kimia, Getah & Plastik (**34.2%**), Produk Makanan, Minuman & Tembakau (**8.8%**) dan Produk Peralatan Elektrik & Elektronik (**2.9%**). Bilangan pekerja dan gaji & upah masing-masing meningkat **1.6 peratus** dan **2.3 peratus** pada suku tahun ketiga 2021.

Bagi tempoh Januari hingga September 2021, nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan bertambah **15.1 peratus** kepada **RM1,127.8 bilion** berbanding tempoh yang sama tahun 2020. Bilangan pekerja dan gaji & upah masing-masing mencatatkan pertumbuhan sebanyak **1.6 peratus** dan **2.5 peratus** iaitu berjumlah **2.23 juta orang** dan **RM66.6 bilion**. Nilai jualan per pekerja bagi sembilan bulan pertama tahun 2021 turut bertumbuh **13.2 peratus** kepada **RM505,404**.



Malaysia's Manufacturing sales recorded RM135.3 billion, increased by 11.6 per cent in September 2021

PUTRAJAYA, 9 NOVEMBER 2021 - Malaysia's Manufacturing sales in September 2021 stood at **RM135.3 billion**, grew **11.6 per cent** as compared to the same month in 2020. Meanwhile, the sales value increased by **6.9 per cent** as against the previous month. The Department of Statistics Malaysia published the **MONTHLY MANUFACTURING STATISTICS, MALAYSIA, SEPTEMBER 2021** today.

Commenting on the report, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia, said "The growth in sales value for this month was driven by the Petroleum, Chemical, Rubber & Plastic Products subsector (**29.2%**) especially in the Manufacture of Coke & Refined Petroleum Products industries. The expansion was also attributed by the Food, Beverages & Tobacco subsector (**12.0%**) supported by the Manufacture of Food Products industries as well as the Electrical & Electronics Products subsector (**10.8%**) mainly in the Manufacture of computer, optical & electronics products."

*Sales value for export-oriented industries which accounted for **74.0 per cent** of total sales value recorded an increase of **15.9 per cent (RM100.2 billion)** while domestic-oriented industries posted an increment of **1.1 per cent** in September 2021 as compared to the same month in 2020. The growth of sales value for export-oriented industries was in line with the double-digit growth registered in the external trade exports and the price factors that remain favourable. On month-on-month comparison, export and domestic-oriented industries recorded positive growth of **5.2 per cent** and **12.3 per cent** respectively.*

*Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin added that the total employees engaged in the Manufacturing sector in September 2021 was **2,231,406 persons**, an increase of **1.6 per cent** as compared to 2,195,300 persons in September 2020. The increase was contributed by the Electrical & Electronic Products (4.5%), Petroleum, Chemical, Rubber & Plastic Products (1.3%) and Wood, Furniture, Paper Products & Printing (1.5%).*

*The report also stated that salaries & wages paid amounted to **RM7,478.8 million**, increased by **3.6 per cent** or **RM261.8 million** in September 2021 as against the same month of the preceding year. Besides that, the sales value per employee increased by **9.8 per cent** to record **RM60,645** as compared with the same month in 2020 (September 2020: RM55,218). Meanwhile, the average salaries & wages per employee was **RM3,352** in September 2021.*

*In the third quarter 2021, the sales value of the Manufacturing sector grew **6.4 per cent** to **RM381.8 billion** as compared to the same quarter of the previous year. The increase was driven by Petroleum, Chemical, Rubber & Plastics Products (34.2%), Food, Beverages & Tobacco Products (8.8%) and Electrical & Electronics Products (2.9%). The number of employees and salaries & wages rose **1.6 per cent** and **2.3 per cent** respectively in the third quarter 2021.*

*For the period of January to September 2021, the sales value of the Manufacturing sector increased by **15.1 per cent** to **RM1,127.8 billion** as compared to the same period in 2020. The number of employees and salaries & wages recorded a growth of **1.6 per cent** and **2.5 per cent** respectively, **2.23 million persons** and **RM66.6 billion**. Sales value per employee for the first nine months of 2021 also grew **13.2 per cent** to record **RM505,404**.*



