Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian (IPP) Malaysia menyusut marginal 0.7 peratus pada Ogos 2021

PUTRAJAYA, 12 OKTOBER 2021 – Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia menerbitkan **INDEKS PENGELUARAN PERINDUSTRIAN (IPP), MALAYSIA, OGOS 2021** pada hari ini. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik IPP yang terdiri daripada tiga sektor utama; Perlombongan, Pembuatan dan Elektrik.

Mengulas terhadap laporan tersebut, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia berkata, “Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian (IPP) merosot marginal **0.7 peratus** pada bulan Ogos 2021 berbanding bulan yang sama pada tahun sebelumnya. Kejatuhan IPP ini disebabkan oleh penyusutan dalam indeks Perlombongan (**-4.2%**) dan indeks Elektrik (**-4.8%**). Sementara itu, indeks Pembuatan merekodkan peningkatan **0.6 peratus**. Dari segi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, IPP meningkat **3.2 peratus** didorong oleh sektor Pembuatan dan Elektrik yang turut dipengaruhi oleh pembukaan sektor ekonomi yang lebih luas seiring dengan peralihan fasa Pelan Pemulihan Negara (PPN).”

Output sektor Pembuatan berdasarkan perbandingan tahun ke tahun meningkat **0.6 peratus** pada bulan Ogos 2021 selepas mencatatkan kejatuhan 6.5 peratus pada bulan Julai 2021. Subsektor yang menyumbang kepada pertumbuhan sektor Pembuatan pada Ogos 2021 adalah Produk Petroleum, Kimia, Getah & Plastik (**15.2%**) dan Produk Peralatan Elektrik & Elektronik (**8.6%**).

Industri berorientasikan eksport tumbuh **7.6 peratus** manakala industri berorientasikan domestik menyusut sebanyak **13.8 peratus**. Peningkatan bagi industri berorientasikan eksport disumbangkan terutamanya oleh pembuatan kok & produk petroleum bertapis dan pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik & optikal. Prestasi sektor Pembuatan ini juga selari dengan pertumbuhan eksport yang memberangsangkan. Sementara itu, kemerosotan industri berasaskan domestik dipengaruhi oleh pembuatan kenderaan bermotor, treler & semi-treler dan pembuatan produk galian bukan logam lain.


Sektor Pembuatan bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan turut meningkat **5.3 peratus** berbanding Julai 2021 di mana kenaikan ini turut digambarkan oleh kapasiti penggunaan kilang yang lebih tinggi berbanding bulan lalu terutamanya dalam subsektor Produk Peralatan Elektrik & Elektronik, Makanan, Minuman & Tembakau dan Produk Petroleum, Kimia, Getah & Plastik.

Output sektor Perlombongan menguncup **4.2 peratus** pada bulan Ogos 2021 berbanding tempoh yang sama pada tahun sebelumnya. Penyusutan tersebut disebabkan oleh kejatuhan **11.0 peratus** dalam indeks Minyak Mentah & Kondensat. Sementara itu, indeks Gas Asli tumbuh **1.6 peratus**. Pada masa yang sama, indeks Perlombongan turut merosot **4.5 peratus** berbanding bulan sebelumnya. Output sektor Elektrik merosot **4.8 peratus** pada bulan Ogos 2021 berbanding bulan yang sama pada tahun lalu. Sebaliknya, dari segi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, indeks Elektrik berkembang **2.8 peratus**.

IPP bagi tempoh Januari hingga Ogos 2021 merekodkan pengembangan **8.2 peratus** berbanding dengan tempoh yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Peningkatan tersebut dipacu oleh kenaikan dalam kesemua komponen; indeks Pembuatan (**10.4%**), indeks Perlombongan (**3.0%**) dan indeks Elektrik (**1.7%**).

Banci Penduduk dan Perumahan Malaysia 2020 (Banci Malaysia 2020) masih dilaksanakan di seluruh Negara sehingga 31 Oktober 2021 secara bersempena dengan pematuhan Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) yang telah ditetapkan oleh Majlis Keselamatan Negara (MKN). Aktiviti Semakan Kualiti (QC) dan Penyiasatan Liputan Banci (PES) akan dilaksanakan pada November dan Disember 2021. Semua penduduk Malaysia diseru untuk memberikan kerjasama dalam menjayakan Banci Malaysia 2020 bagi memastikan tiada yang ketinggalan kerana "Data Anda Masa Depan Kita". Malaysia's Industrial Production Index (IPI) shrank marginally 0.7 per cent in August 2021

PUTRAJAYA, 12 OCTOBER 2021 – The Department of Statistics Malaysia, today released **INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION INDEX (IPI), MALAYSIA, AUGUST 2021**. This publication presents statistics on IPI which consists of three main sectors; Mining, Manufacturing and Electricity.

Commenting on the report, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia, said “The Industrial Production Index (IPI) decreased marginally **0.7 per cent** in August 2021 as compared to the same month of the previous year. The fall of IPI was influenced by the decline in Mining index (**-4.2%**) and Electricity index (**-4.8%**). Meanwhile, Manufacturing index recorded an expansion of **0.6 per cent**. On month-on-month basis, the IPI increased by **3.2 per cent** driven by Manufacturing and Electricity sectors which attributed by the opening of more economic sectors in line with the transition phase of the National Recovery Plan (NRP).”

The Manufacturing sector output based on year-on-year comparison increased by **0.6 per cent** in August 2021 after recording a downturn of 6.5 per cent in July 2021. The main subsectors that contributed to the growth in Manufacturing sector in August 2021 were Petroleum, Chemical, Rubber & Plastic Products (**15.2%**) and Electrical & Electronics Products (**8.6%**).

*Export-oriented industries grew **7.6 per cent** while domestic-oriented industries shrank by **13.8 per cent**. The increase in export-oriented industries was mainly supported by the manufacture of coke & refined petroleum products and manufacture of computer, electronics & optical products. The performance of the Manufacturing sector was also in line with the encouraging growth of exports. Meanwhile, the decline in the domestic-based industries was influenced by the manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers & semi-trailers and manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products.*


*The Manufacturing sector for month-on-month basis also increased **5.3 per cent** as compared to July 2021 where the increment was reflected by higher capacity utilization compared to last month especially in the Electrical & Electronic Products, Food, Beverages & Tobacco and Petroleum, Chemical, Rubber & Plastic Products sub-sectors.*

*The Mining sector output shrank **4.2 per cent** in August 2021 as compared to the same period last year. The growth was contributed by the fall of **11.0 per cent** in Crude Oil & Condensate index. Meanwhile, Natural Gas index augmented by **1.6 per cent**. Simultaneously, the Mining index also declined **4.5 per cent** as compared to the previous month. The Electricity sector output contracted **4.8 per cent** in August 2021 as compared to the same month of the previous year. On the other hand, in terms of month-on-month comparison, the Electricity index grew **2.8 per cent**.*

*The IPI in the period of January to August 2021 recorded an expansion of **8.2 per cent** as compared to the same period of the previous year. The increase was driven by the rise in all components; Manufacturing index (**10.4%**), Mining index (**3.0%**) and Electricity index (**1.7%**).*

The Malaysia Population and Housing Census 2020 (Malaysia Census 2020) is ongoing nationwide until 31st October 2021 through face-to-face method with the compliance of Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) implemented by Majlis Keselamatan Negara (MKN).
