Indeks nilai seunit eksport & import Malaysia terus mencatatkan pertumbuhan positif 1.4 peratus dan 0.9 peratus pada Ogos 2021

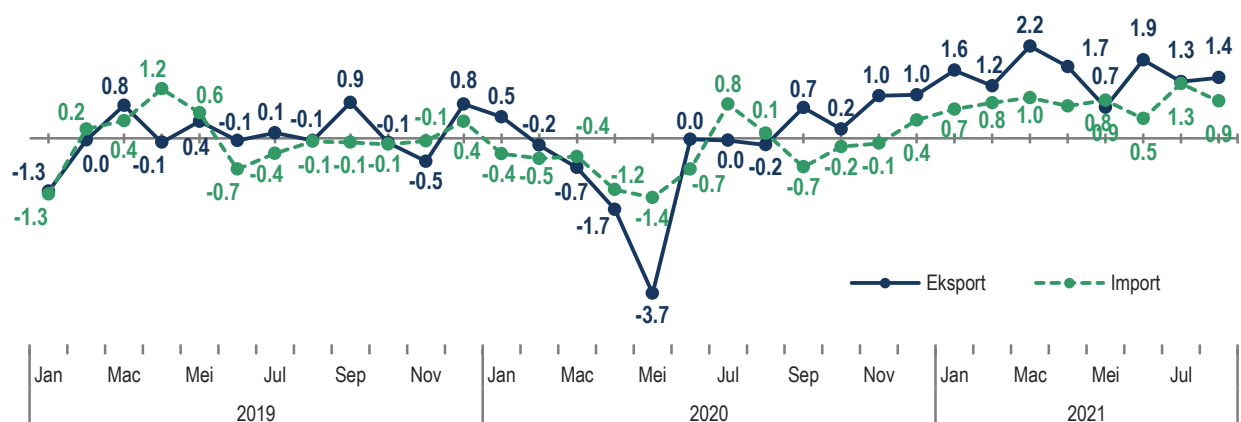
PUTRAJAYA, 4 OKTOBER 2021 – Indeks nilai seunit eksport dan import bulanan Malaysia kekal mencatatkan pertumbuhan positif pada Ogos 2021, masing-masing pada 1.4 peratus dan 0.9 peratus, sebagai mana dipaparkan oleh laporan **INDEKS PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI (2010=100), OGOS 2021** pada hari ini. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik indeks nilai seunit dan indeks volum mengikut seksyen bagi eksport dan import barangan.

Mengulas terhadap laporan tersebut, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia berkata, “Indeks nilai seunit eksport bertumbuh 1.4 peratus pada Ogos 2021 berbanding bulan sebelumnya, disumbangkan oleh kenaikan indeks minyak galian (+5.3%), minyak & lemak binatang & sayur-sayuran (+1.4%) dan alat jentera kelengkapan pengangkutan (+0.6%). Sementara itu, indeks volum eksport merekodkan penurunan 3.2 peratus pada bulan yang sama, disumbangkan oleh kejatuhan indeks minyak galian (-21.1%), minyak & lemak binatang & sayur-sayuran (-17.4%) dan jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (-0.9%). Indeks volum eksport pelarasan bermusim meningkat 5.1 peratus daripada 137.0 mata kepada 143.9 mata. Berbanding tahun sebelumnya, kedua-dua indeks nilai seunit dan volum eksport masing-masing meningkat 16.2 peratus dan 1.9 peratus.”

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin turut berkata “Indeks nilai seunit import turut menunjukkan pertumbuhan positif 0.9 peratus pada Ogos 2021 berbanding bulan sebelum. Peningkatan ini disumbangkan oleh pertumbuhan indeks minyak galian (+7.2%), minyak lemak binatang & sayur-sayuran (+1.5%) dan barang-barang keluaran kilang (+0.3%). Sebaliknya, indeks volum import menyusut 12.0 peratus pada Ogos 2021 berbanding bulan sebelum, disumbangkan oleh kejatuhan indeks minyak galian (-35.7%), jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (-6.2%) dan barang-barang keluaran kilang (-3.3%). Indeks volum import pelarasan bermusim pada Ogos 2021 mencatatkan penurunan 11.0 peratus daripada 154.1 mata kepada 137.2 mata. Berbanding tahun sebelum, kedua-dua indeks nilai seunit dan volum import masing-masing meningkat 6.4 peratus dan 5.7 peratus.”

Jabatan Perdagangan Malaysia (DOSM) turut melaporkan terma perdagangan Malaysia mencatatkan pertumbuhan 0.6 peratus bulan ke bulan kepada 105.6 mata pada Ogos 2021. Berasaskan tahun ke tahun, prestasi terma perdagangan Malaysia kekal positif 9.2 peratus daripada 96.7 mata pada Ogos tahun lalu.

Malaysia's export & import unit value indices continued to record positive growths at 1.4 per cent and 0.9 per cent in August 2021

PUTRAJAYA, OCTOBER 4, 2021 – Malaysia's monthly export and import unit value indices continued to record positive growths, at 1.4 per cent and 0.9 per cent respectively, in August 2021, as reported today in **EXTERNAL TRADE INDICES (2010=100), AUGUST 2021**. This report presents the unit value and volume index by sections for both exports and imports of goods.

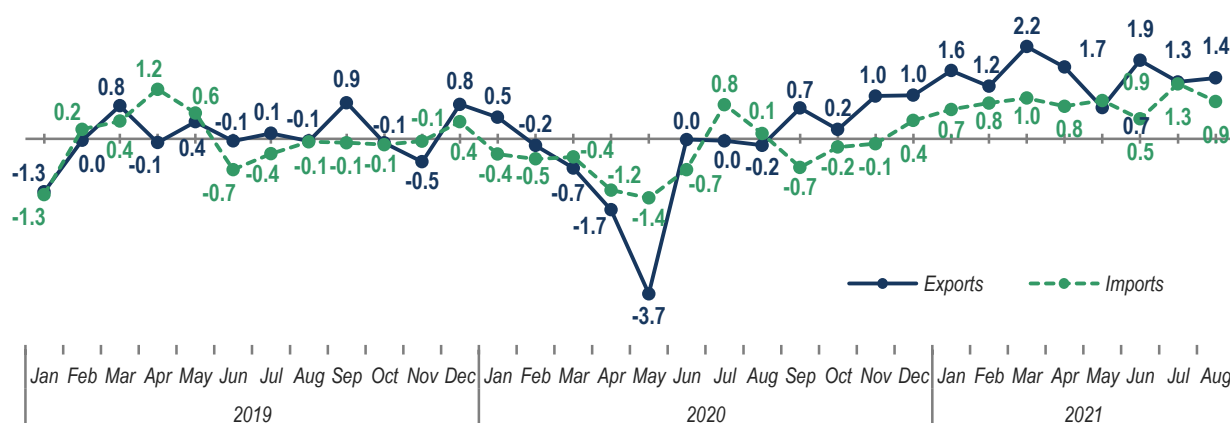
Commenting on the report, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia, said "The export unit value index rose 1.4 per cent in August 2021 as compared with the previous month, contributed by the increases in the index of mineral fuels (+5.3%), animal & vegetable oils & fats (+1.4%) and machinery & transport equipment (+0.6%). On the other hand, the export volume index recorded a decline of 3.2 per cent in the same month, reflected by the decreases in the index of mineral fuels (-21.1%), animal & vegetable oils & fats (-17.4%) and machinery & transport equipment (-0.9%). The seasonally adjusted export volume index grew 5.1 per cent from 137.0 points to 143.9 points. When compared to the previous year, the export unit value and volume index grew 16.2 per cent and 1.9 per cent, respectively."

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin also commented, "The import unit value index grew 0.9 per cent in August 2021 as compared with the previous month. The increment was driven by the growths in the index of mineral fuels (+7.2%), animal & vegetable oils & fats (+1.5%) and manufactured goods (+0.3%). In contrast, the import volume index declined

12.0 per cent in the same month as compared to the preceding month, attributed to the deterioration in the index of mineral fuels (-35.7%), machinery & transport equipment (-6.2%) and manufactured goods (-3.3%). The seasonally adjusted import volume index in August 2021 posted a decrease of 11.0 per cent from 154.1 points to 137.2 points. On a year-on-year basis, both the import unit value and volume indices expanded 6.4 per cent and 5.7 per cent, respectively.”

Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) also reported that Malaysia’s terms of trade increased by 0.6 per cent m-o-m to 105.6 points in August 2021. On a year-on year basis, Malaysia’s terms of trade performance remained positive at 9.2 per cent from 96.7 points in August of previous year.
