INDEKS HARGA PENGELUAR (IHPR) PENGELUARAN TEMPATAN, MALAYSIA
OGOS 2021**

IHPR Pengeluaran Tempatan meningkat 11.3 peratus pada Ogos 2021

PUTRAJAYA, 30 September 2021 – Indeks Harga Pengeluar (IHPR) pengeluaran tempatan yang mengukur kos barangan di pintu kilang meningkat **11.3 peratus** tahun ke tahun pada Ogos 2021 berbanding **negatif 2.8 peratus** yang direkodkan pada bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya, Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia melaporkan hari ini di dalam laporan bulannya yang baru diterbitkan iaitu **INDEKS HARGA PENGELUAR (IHPR) PENGELUARAN TEMPATAN, OGOS 2021**.

Dalam satu kenyataan pada hari ini, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia berkata, "IHPR pengeluaran tempatan mencatatkan kenaikan tujuh bulan berturut-turut. Peningkatan pada Ogos 2021 ini dipacu terutamanya oleh indeks Perlombongan yang meningkat **51.8 peratus** (Ogos 2020: -33.7%), diikuti indeks Pertanian, perhutanan & perikanan dan Pembuatan masing-masing dengan pertumbuhan tahun ke tahun **27.6 peratus** dan **7.1 peratus**. Indeks utiliti turut mencatatkan peningkatan **0.4 peratus** bagi indeks Bekalan elektrik & gas, manakala, indeks Bekalan air turun **0.4 peratus**."

Beliau turut berkata, "Disebabkan oleh kesan asas pada tahun lalu, beberapa komoditi utama dilihat mencatatkan peningkatan luar biasa tahun ini. Sebagai contoh, indeks bagi Minyak Mentah dan Gas Asli & Gas Asli Cecair (LNG) masing-masing menunjukkan kenaikan sejak Mac dan Mei 2021. Sementara itu, Litar Bersepadu meningkat buat kali pertama setelah mencatatkan pertumbuhan negatif berterusan selama dua belas bulan berturut-turut."

Melihat kepada perbandingan bulan ke bulan, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin menambah, "IHPR pengeluaran tempatan meningkat **0.6 peratus** pada Ogos 2021, pertumbuhan yang sama direkodkan pada Julai 2021. Indeks Pertanian, perhutanan & perikanan naik **2.8 peratus** berbanding **2.2 peratus** dicatatkan pada bulan sebelumnya. Kenaikan 0.6 mata peratus ini adalah dipengaruhi terutamanya oleh harga yang lebih tinggi bagi Ayam (**5.2%**) dan Buah Tandan Segar (**3.6%**). Walau bagaimanapun, indeks Perlombongan mencatatkan penurunan **negatif 0.8 peratus** (Julai 2021: 3.9%) disebabkan oleh penurunan harga bagi Minyak Mentah (**-2.9%**) walaupun kenaikan harga berterusan bagi komoditi Gas Asli (**10.1%**). Sementara itu, indeks Pembuatan mencatatkan peningkatan **0.4 peratus** disumbangkan oleh kenaikan harga bagi komoditi petroleum bertapis (**2.0%**), komoditi berasaskan minyak dan lemak sayuran dan haiwan (**0.5%**) dan produk berkaitan komponen dan papan elektronik (**0.4%**). Indeks Bekalan elektrik & gas turut meningkat **0.1 peratus** manakala indeks Bekalan air turun **negatif 0.2 peratus**."

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin menjelaskan, "Pada Ogos 2021, IHPR pengeluaran tempatan mengikut peringkat pemprosesan menunjukkan indeks Bahan mentah untuk diproseskan selanjutnya meningkat **30.9 peratus** berbanding **negatif 8.7 peratus** yang dicatatkan pada bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Peningkatan ini disumbangkan oleh indeks bagi Bahan bukan makanan dan Bahan makanan & makanan untuk binatang yang masing-masing meningkat **37.5 peratus** dan **4.4 peratus**. Pada masa yang sama, indeks Bahan perantaraan, bekalan & komponen turut naik **11.2 peratus** (Ogos 2020: -2.0%) dipacu terutamanya oleh indeks bagi Bahan api yang diproses dan pelincir (**20.0%**) dan Bahan & komponen untuk pembuatan (**12.7%**). Namun begitu, indeks Barang siap mencatatkan penurunan **1.3 peratus**.

Trend yang sama dapat dilihat dalam perbandingan bulan ke bulan di mana indeks bagi Bahan mentah untuk diproseskan selanjutnya dan Bahan perantaraan, bekalan & komponen masing-masing meningkat **0.6 peratus** dan **1.0 peratus**. Sementara itu, indeks Barang siap turun **0.2 peratus**."

PRODUCER PRICE INDEX (PPI) LOCAL PRODUCTION, MALAYSIA
AUGUST 2021**

PPI Local Production edged up 11.3 per cent in August 2021

PUTRAJAYA, 30th September 2021 – The Producer Price Index (PPI) local production which measures the costs of goods at the factory gate edged up **11.3 per cent** year-on-year in August 2021 as compared to **negative 2.8 per cent** recorded in the same month of the preceding year, the Department of Statistics Malaysia reported today in its newly published monthly report, the **PRODUCER PRICE INDEX (PPI) LOCAL PRODUCTION, AUGUST 2021**.

In a statement today, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, the Chief Statistician Malaysia, said, "The PPI local production recorded an increase for the straight seven months. The increase in August 2021 was attributed mainly by the Mining index that surged **51.8 per cent** (August 2020: -33.7%), followed by the indexes of Agriculture, forestry & fishing and Manufacturing with year-on-year growth of **27.6 per cent** and **7.1 per cent** respectively. The utility index also registered an increase of **0.4 per cent** for Electricity & gas supply index, while, Water supply index recorded a drop of **0.4 per cent**."

He also said, "Due to the base effect last year, some primary commodities were seen to have registered unusual increases this year. As for example, the index for Crude Oil and Natural Gas & Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) showed an increase since March and May 2021 respectively. On the other hand, Integrated Circuits increased for the first time after continuously recorded negative growth for the straight twelve months."

*In terms of a month-on-month comparison, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin added, "The PPI local production rose **0.6 per cent** in August 2021, the same growth recorded in July 2021. The index of Agriculture, forestry & fishing moved up **2.8 per cent** as opposed to **2.2 per cent** recorded in the previous month. The increase of 0.6 percentage points was due to higher prices of Chicken (**5.2%**) and Fresh Fruit Bunches (**3.6%**). Nevertheless, the Mining index registered a decline of **negative 0.8 per cent** (July 2021: 3.9%) attributed by the fall in Crude Oil prices (**-2.9%**) despite continuous rise in Natural Gas commodity prices (**10.1%**). On the other hand, the Manufacturing index recorded an increase of **0.4 per cent** contributed by an increase in the prices of refined petroleum commodity (**2.0%**), commodity based on vegetable and animal oils and fats (**0.5%**) and products related to electronic components and boards (**0.4%**). Index of Electricity & gas supply also increased **0.1 per cent** while Water supply index decreased by **negative 0.2 per cent**."*

*Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin further explained that, "In August 2021, the PPI local production by stage of processing showed that the index of Crude materials for further processing increased **30.9 per cent** as opposed to **negative 8.7 per cent** recorded in the same month of the previous year. The increase was contributed by indexes of Non-food materials and Foodstuffs & feedstuffs which moved up **37.5 per cent** and **4.4 per cent**. Similarly, the index of Intermediate materials, supplies & components also increased **11.2 per cent** (August 2020: -2.0%) supported mainly by Processed fuel & lubricants (**20.0%**) and Materials & components for manufacturing (**12.7%**) indexes. However, the index of Finished goods registered a decrease of **1.3 per cent**."*

*The same trend can be seen in terms of month-on-month comparison where the indexes of Crude materials for further processing and Intermediate materials, supplies & components increased **0.6 per cent** and **1.0 per cent** respectively. Meanwhile, the index of Finished goods decreased **0.2 per cent**."*
