Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian (IPP) Malaysia merosot 5.2 peratus pada

Julai 2021, kejatuhan pertama semenjak November 2020

PUTRAJAYA, 10 SEPTEMBER 2021 – Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia menerbitkan **INDEKS PENGELUARAN PERINDUSTRIAN (IPP), MALAYSIA, JULAI 2021** pada hari ini. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik IPP yang terdiri daripada tiga sektor utama; Perlombongan, Pembuatan dan Elektrik.


Mengulas terhadap laporan tersebut, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia berkata, “Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian (IPP) merosot **5.2 peratus** pada bulan Julai 2021 berbanding bulan yang sama pada tahun sebelumnya. Kejatuhan IPP ini disumbangkan oleh penyusutan dalam indeks Pembuatan (**-6.5%**) dan indeks Elektrik (**-6.6%**). Sementara itu, indeks Perlombongan merekodkan kenaikan **0.6 peratus**.”

Output sektor Pembuatan berdasarkan perbandingan tahun ke tahun menurun **6.5 peratus** pada bulan Julai 2021 selepas mencatatkan kejatuhan 0.2 peratus pada bulan Jun 2021. Subsektor yang mempengaruhi kemerosotan dalam sektor Pembuatan pada Julai 2021 adalah Kelengkapan Pengangkutan & Pembuatan Lain (**-43.8%**), Produk Mineral Bukan Logam, Logam Asas & Produk Logam yang Direka (**-27.6%**) dan Produk Kayu, Perabot, Keluaran Kertas & Percetakan (**-23.7%**). Industri berorientasikan domestik menyusut **24.7 peratus** manakala industri berorientasikan eksport tumbuh sebanyak **1.9 peratus**.

Output sektor Perlombongan tumbuh **0.6 peratus** pada bulan Julai 2021 berbanding tempoh yang sama pada tahun sebelumnya. Pertumbuhan tersebut dipacu oleh peningkatan **4.1 peratus** dalam indeks Gas Asli. Sementara itu indeks Minyak Mentah & Kondensat berkurang **3.6 peratus**. Output sektor Elektrik merosot **6.6 peratus** pada bulan Julai 2021 berbanding bulan yang sama pada tahun sebelumnya.

***Malaysia's Industrial Production Index (IPI) deteriorated 5.2 per cent in July 2021,
the first decline since November 2020***

PUTRAJAYA, 10 SEPTEMBER 2021 – The Department of Statistics Malaysia, today released **INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION INDEX (IPI), MALAYSIA, JULY 2021**. This publication presents statistics on IPI which consists of three main sectors; Mining, Manufacturing and Electricity.


Commenting on the report, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia, said “The Industrial Production Index (IPI) declined **5.2 per cent** in July 2021 as compared to the same month of the previous year. The fall of IPI was influenced by the decrease in Manufacturing index (-6.5%) and Electricity index (-6.6%). Meanwhile, Mining index recorded an increase of **0.6 per cent**.”

The Manufacturing sector output based on year-on-year comparison decreased by **6.5 per cent** in July 2021 after recording a downturn of 0.2 per cent in June 2021. The main subsectors contributed to the downturn in Manufacturing sector in July 2021 were Transport Equipment & Other Manufactures (-43.8%), Non-metallic Mineral Products, Basic Metal & Fabricated Metal Products (-27.6%) and Wood Products, Furniture, Paper Products & Printing (-23.7%). Domestic-oriented industries shrank **24.7 per cent** while export-oriented industries grew by **1.9 per cent**.

The Mining sector output augmented **0.6 per cent** in July 2021 as compared to the same period of the previous year. The growth was driven by the increase of **4.1 per cent** in Natural Gas index. Meanwhile, Crude Oil & Condensate index dropped by **3.6 per cent**. The Electricity sector output contracted **6.6 per cent** in July 2021 as compared to the same month of the previous year.
