**KENYATAAN MEDIA
INDEKS HARGA PENGELUAR (IHPR) PENGELUARAN TEMPATAN, MALAYSIA
JULAI 2021**

Indeks Harga Pengeluar kekal tinggi 11.7 peratus, disumbangkan terutamanya oleh harga komoditi utama iaitu Minyak Mentah (64.4%), Buah Tandan Segar (57.3%) dan Minyak Sawit Mentah (42.7%)

PUTRAJAYA, 26 Ogos 2021 – Pada hari ini, Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia menerbitkan, Indeks Harga Pengeluar (IHPR) pengeluaran tempatan bagi bulan Julai 2021. IHPR pengeluaran tempatan yang mengukur kos barangan di pintu kilang meningkat 11.7 peratus tahun ke tahun pada Julai 2021, berbanding 11.5 peratus yang dicatatkan pada Jun 2021.

Mengulas kepada laporan tersebut, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata, "Indeks Perlombongan meningkat 57.7 peratus disebabkan harga gas asli yang lebih tinggi serta kenaikan harga yang berterusan bagi komoditi minyak mentah. Indeks Pertanian, perhutanan dan perikanan mencatatkan pertumbuhan dua digit 31.5 peratus (Jun 2021: 29.8%) disumbangkan oleh kenaikan harga komoditi buah tandan segar dan komoditi lain. Di samping itu, kenaikan indeks Pembuatan dipengaruhi oleh kenaikan harga komoditi utama dan komoditi berkaitan pembinaan (7.1%). Dari segi indeks utiliti, Bekalan air dan Bekalan elektrik masing-masing meningkat 1.3 peratus dan 0.2 peratus".

Jelas beliau lagi, "Bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, IHPR pengeluaran tempatan merekodkan peningkatan marginal 0.6 peratus pada Julai 2021 berbanding 0.2 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya. Pertumbuhan positif ini disokong oleh indeks Perlombongan yang bertumbuh 3.9 peratus, diikuti indeks bagi Pertanian, perhutanan & perikanan dan

Pembuatan yang masing-masing meningkat 2.2 peratus dan 0.2 peratus. Namun begitu, Bekalan elektrik & gas dan Bekalan air mencatatkan penurunan 0.2 peratus”.

Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia turut melaporkan pada Julai 2021, peningkatan IHPR pengeluaran tempatan mengikut peringkat pemprosesan adalah terutamanya disumbangkan oleh indeks Bahan mentah untuk diproseskan selanjutnya yang meningkat 35.8 peratus berbanding 39.2 peratus yang dicatatkan pada Jun 2021. Pada masa yang sama, indeks Bahan perantaraan, bekalan & komponen turut meningkat 10.5 peratus. Namun begitu, indeks Barang siap mencatatkan penurunan 0.4 peratus. Trend yang sama juga dapat dilihat dalam perbandingan bulanan di mana indeks bagi Bahan mentah untuk diproseskan selanjutnya dan Bahan perantaraan, bekalan & komponen masing-masing meningkat 2.3 peratus dan 0.6 peratus. Sementara itu, indeks Barang siap turun 0.8 peratus.

PRODUCER PRICE INDEX (PPI) LOCAL PRODUCTION, MALAYSIA
JULY 2021**

The Producer Price Index remained high at 11.7 per cent, contributed mainly by prices of primary commodities which are Crude Oil (64.4%), Fresh Fruit Bunches (57.3%) and Crude Palm Oil (42.7%)

PUTRAJAYA, 26th August 2021 – Today, the Department of Statistics Malaysia has released the Producer Price Index (PPI) local production for July 2021. The PPI local production which measures the costs of goods at the factory gate, increased 11.7 per cent year-on-year in July 2021 from 11.5 per cent recorded in June 2021.

Commenting on the report, the Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, "The Mining index rose 57.7 per cent due to higher prices of natural gas and continuous increase in prices of crude oil commodity. The Agriculture, forestry and fishing index recorded double digit growth of 31.5 per cent (June 2021: 29.8%) attributed by the increase in prices of fresh fruit bunches and other commodities. In addition, the increase in Manufacturing index was contributed by higher prices of primary commodities and construction-related commodities (7.1%). In terms of utility indices, Water supply and Electricity & gas supply rose 1.3 per cent and 0.2 per cent respectively".

He further explained, "On month-on-month comparison, the PPI local production registered a marginal increase of 0.6 per cent in July 2021 as compared to 0.2 per cent in the previous month. This positive growth was due to the Mining index which grew by 3.9 per cent, followed by the indices of Agriculture, forestry & fishing and Manufacturing which increased by 2.2 per cent and 0.2 per cent respectively. However, the indices of Electricity & gas supply and Water supply declined by 0.2 per cent".

The Department of Statistics Malaysia also reported in July 2021, the increase of the PPI local production by stage of processing was mainly from the index of Crude materials for further processing which grew 35.8 per cent as opposed to 39.2 per cent recorded in June 2021. Similarly, the index of Intermediate materials, supplies & components also increased 10.5 per cent. However, the index of Finished goods registered a decrease of 0.4 per cent. The same trend can be seen in terms of monthly comparison where the index of Crude materials for further processing and Intermediate materials, supplies & components increased 2.3 per cent and 0.6 per cent respectively. Meanwhile, the index of Finished goods decreased 0.8 per cent.
