### **INDEKS HARGA PENGELOUAR (IHPR) PENGELOUARAN TEMPATAN MALAYSIA MAC 2021**

#### **IHPR untuk Pengeluaran Tempatan naik 6.7% pada Mac 2021**

**PUTRAJAYA, 28 April 2021** – Pada hari ini, Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia menerbitkan, Indeks Harga Pengeluar (IHPR) pengeluaran tempatan bagi bulan Mac 2021. IHPR pengeluaran tempatan terus meningkat dengan pertumbuhan 6.7 peratus pada Mac 2021, 4.0 mata lebih tinggi daripada 2.7 peratus yang dicatatkan pada bulan lalu.. Berdasarkan rekod IHPR, ini adalah kenaikan tertinggi sejak Ogos 2017.

Mengulas laporan tersebut, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, berkata, “Pertumbuhan ini didorong oleh kenaikan indeks Perlombongan yang melonjak 32.0 peratus berbanding negatif 11.0 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya. Indeks Pertanian, perhutanan & perikanan mencatatkan paras pertumbuhan baru yang tinggi 41.1 peratus kerana komoditi mencatatkan harga lebih tinggi pada bulan ini. Seterusnya, indeks Pembuatan juga mencatatkan kenaikan 2.2 peratus disebabkan oleh kenaikan harga komoditi petroleum dan pertanian. Sementara itu, indeks Bekalan elektrik dan gas & Bekalan air masing-masing mencatatkan penurunan 1.4 peratus dan 0.1 peratus.”

Jelas beliau lagi, “Bagi perbandingan bulanan, IHPR pengeluaran tempatan mencatatkan peningkatan 0.7 peratus pada Mac 2021, berkurangan daripada 1.5 peratus pada Februari 2021. Kesemua empat indeks meneruskan momentum pertumbuhannya; Pertanian, perhutanan & perikanan (2.3%), Perlombongan (1.0%), Bekalan elektrik & gas (0.8%) dan Pembuatan (0.6%). Sementara itu, indeks Bekalan air turun 0.2 peratus.”

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin turut menyatakan, “IHPR pengeluaran tempatan bagi suku pertama 2021 naik 3.0 peratus kepada 108.5 berbanding 105.3 pada suku yang

sama tahun sebelumnya. Pertumbuhan ini disebabkan kenaikan indeks Pertanian, perhutanan dan perikanan (32.6%), Pembuatan (1.6%) dan Bekalan air (0.4%). Sementara itu, indeks Perlombongan dan Bekalan elektrik & gas masing-masing mencatatkan penurunan 7.3 peratus dan 1.7 peratus. Bagi perbandingan suku tahunan, IHPR pengeluaran tempatan meningkat 5.1 peratus berbanding 2.0 peratus pada suku keempat 2020.

Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia turut melaporkan bagi IHPR pengeluaran tempatan tahun ke tahun mengikut peringkat pemprosesan, indeks Bahan mentah untuk diproseskan selanjutnya melonjak kepada 31.8 peratus daripada 10.0 peratus pada Februari 2021. Indeks Bahan perantaraan, bekalan & komponen turut meningkat 2.8 peratus. Namun begitu, indeks Barang siap mencatatkan negatif 0.2 peratus.

### **FOR MALAYSIA PRODUCER PRICE INDEX (PPI) LOCAL PRODUCTION MARCH 2021**

#### ***PPI for local production increased 6.7% in March 2021***

**PUTRAJAYA, 28<sup>th</sup> April 2021** – Department of Statistics, Malaysia has released the report on Producer Price Index (PPI) local production for March 2021. PPI local production continued to increase with a growth of 6.7 per cent in March 2021, 4.0 point higher than 2.7 per cent recorded last month. Based on PPI record, this is the highest increase since August 2017.

Commenting on the report, Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, highlighted, “The growth was driven by the increase in the Mining index which rebounded to 32.0 per cent as compared to negative 11.0 per cent in the previous month. The Agriculture, forestry & fishing index marked a new high growth of 41.1 per cent as commodities recorded higher prices this month. Subsequently, Manufacturing index also registered an increase of 2.2 per cent resulted from a higher price of petroleum and agriculture commodities. Meanwhile, Electricity & gas supply and Water supply indices recorded a decline of 1.4 per cent and 0.1 per cent respectively.”

He added that, “On a monthly basis, the PPI local production recorded an increase of 0.7 per cent in March 2021, down from 1.5 per cent in February 2021. All four indices continued its momentum of growth; Agriculture, forestry & fishing (2.3%), Mining (1.0%), Electricity & gas supply (0.8%) and Manufacturing (0.6%). Meanwhile, the Water supply index fell 0.2 per cent.”

*Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin also stated that, "The PPI local production for the first quarter of 2021 rose 3.0 per cent to 108.5 from 105.3 in the same quarter of the previous year. The growth was due to the higher indices of Agriculture, forestry & fishing (32.6%), Manufacturing (1.6%) and Water supply (0.4%). Meanwhile, the Mining and Electricity & gas supply indices both recorded a decline of 7.3 per cent and 1.7 per cent respectively. For quarterly comparison, the PPI local production increased by 5.1 per cent from 2.0 per cent in the fourth quarter of 2020."*

*The Department of Statistics Malaysia also reported that for stages of processing, the index of Crude materials for further processing surged to 31.8 per cent from 10.0 per cent in February 2021. The index of Intermediate materials, supplies & components also increased 2.8 per cent. However, the Finished goods recorded a negative 0.2 per cent.*
