

Selangor the unhappiest state due to 'economic issues'

KUALA LUMPUR: Low income and economic issues are why Selangor is ranked lowest in the Malaysian Happiness Index (MHI) 2021.

Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Rina Mohd Harun said this was based on a report by the **Statistics Department**, which recorded a happiness index of 5.74% in Selangor compared to the national index of 6.48%, reported Bernama.

"The highest index was recorded in Labuan at 9.29%, followed by Kuala Lumpur, Putrajaya, Terengganu and Selangor, ranked the lowest – "lowest" according to the components means income and economy.

"That is why today, we bring the Kasih@Smile programme to the community of Putra Perdana in Puchong for exposure to entrepreneurs in the target group of the Women, Family and Community Development Ministry.
