ALAYSIA needs at least 45 per cont of its workforce to be highly skilled workers if the country is to compete with leading tech nations. Prime Minister Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yankob said according to data from the Statistics Department, only 29.6 per cent of the country's human capital were highly skilled workers.

"It is important for us to revitalise the technological and innovation ecosystem, not just through continuous supply oftalent, but to also reduce brain drain.

"To realise this, the government is committed to providing the best infrastructure to drive local innovation (Mranti) Park Master Plan.

Immail Sabri said the country needed a technology park as a meeting point for stakeholders, including in novators, researchers and Investors, to strengthen the sclence, technology and innovation of STD ecosystem, in addition to attracting foreign and demestic direct investments to drive the economy for the people's weitbelling.

The government, he added, had approved 99 research, development, commencialisation and innovation projects and programmes worth RM5.6 billion under the L2th Malaysal Plan,
