PERANGKAAN PEMBUATAN BULANAN, MALAYSIA, MAC 2023

**Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan berkembang 8.0 peratus,
berjumlah RM156.2 bilion pada Mac 2023**

PUTRAJAYA, 9 Mei 2023 - Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan berkembang 8.0 peratus, berjumlah sebanyak RM156.2 bilion pada Mac 2023. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) melaporkan dalam keluaran **Perangkaan Pembuatan Bulanan, Malaysia, Mac 2023** pada hari ini.

Mengulas laporan tersebut, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, berkata, "Pengembangan 8.0 peratus bagi nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan disokong terutamanya oleh pertumbuhan dua digit dalam subsektor Kelengkapan pengangkutan & pembuatan lain (14.6%) dan Peralatan elektrik & elektronik (12.7%). Berbanding dengan bulan sebelumnya, nilai jualan kembali mencatatkan pertumbuhan positif sebanyak 7.6 peratus selepas mencatatkan penurunan berterusan sejak Disember 2022."

Nilai jualan industri berorientasikan eksport yang menyumbang lebih dua pertiga atau 71.7 peratus daripada jumlah jualan, meningkat 7.3 peratus pada Mac 2023 selepas mencatatkan pertumbuhan 9.9 peratus pada Februari 2023. Kenaikan tersebut disebabkan terutamanya oleh pertumbuhan kukuh yang dicatatkan dalam Pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik dan optikal (14.1%) dan Pembuatan kok dan produk petroleum bertapis (12.7%). Selari dengan itu juga, industri berorientasikan domestik mencatatkan pertumbuhan stabil sebanyak 9.9 peratus (Februari 2023: 11.3%) disokong oleh Pembuatan kenderaan bermotor, treler dan semi treler (18.6%) dan Pembuatan produk prosesan makanan (9.9%). Berbanding Februari 2023, kedua-dua industri berorientasikan eksport dan domestik masing-masing meningkat kepada 8.6 peratus dan 5.1 peratus.

Mengulas mengenai bilangan pekerja, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia berkata, "Seramai 2.35 juta orang pekerja yang terlibat dalam sektor Pembuatan pada Mac 2023 yang meningkat sebanyak 2.8 peratus berbanding 2.29 juta orang yang direkodkan tahun lalu. Kenaikan ini didorong terutamanya oleh subsektor Produk makanan, minuman & tembakau (5.3%); Peralatan elektrik & elektronik (4.2%); dan Produk kayu, perabot, keluaran kertas & percetakan (2.3%). Bilangan pekerja yang

terlibat dalam ketiga-tiga subsektor ini merangkumi lebih separuh daripada jumlah keseluruhan dalam sektor Pembuatan. Berbanding bulan sebelumnya, bilangan pekerja meningkat sedikit sebanyak 0.1 peratus.”

Selaras dengan peningkatan bilangan pekerja, gaji & upah yang dibayar dalam sektor Pembuatan meningkat sebanyak 4.2 peratus tahun ke tahun yang berjumlah RM8.17 bilion pada Mac 2023. Berbanding dengan bulan sebelumnya, gaji & upah meningkat secara marginal sebanyak 0.1 peratus daripada RM8.16 bilion. Tambahan lagi, purata gaji & upah bulanan bagi setiap pekerja mencatatkan peningkatan sebanyak 1.3 peratus berbanding setahun lalu dengan nilai RM3,475 manakala nilai jualan bagi setiap pekerja meningkat 5.1 peratus kepada RM66,430.

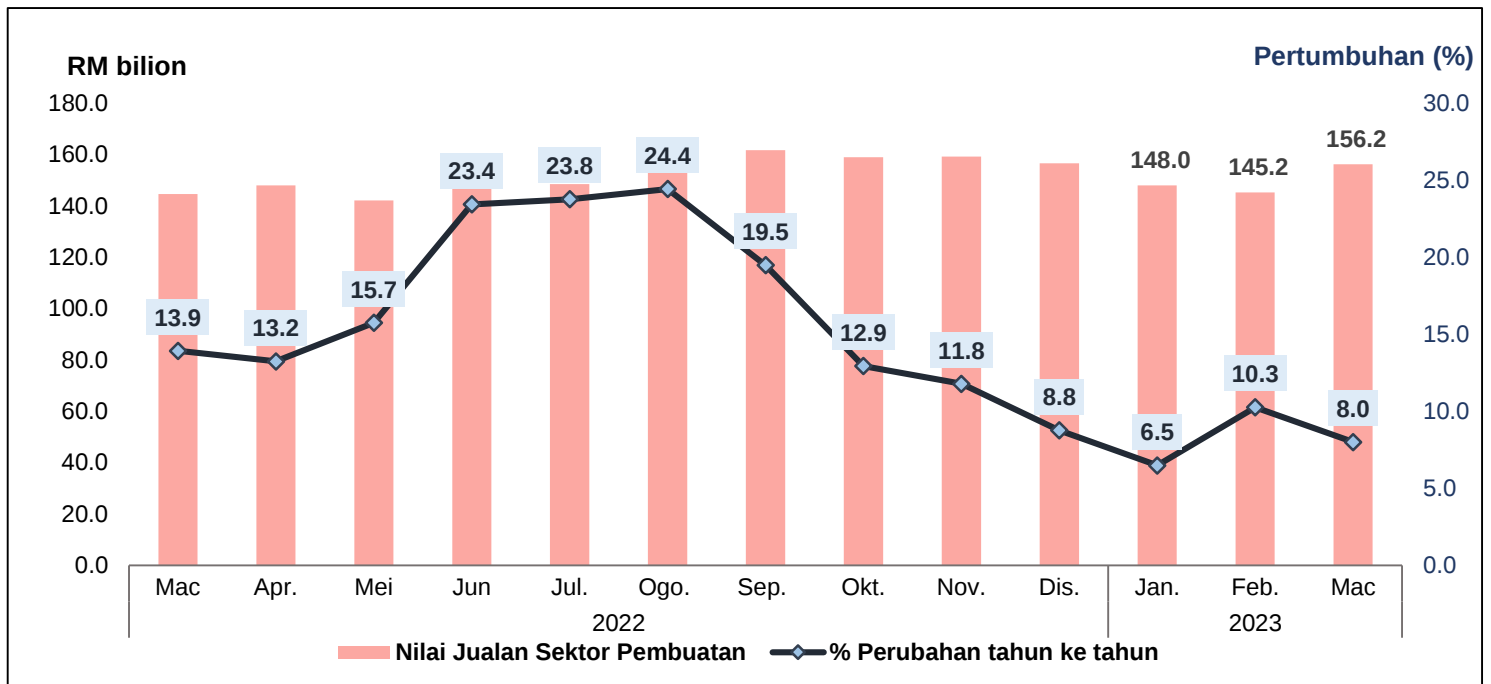
Merumuskan prestasi untuk suku tahun pertama 2023, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata, “Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan meningkat sebanyak 8.2 peratus kepada RM449.4 bilion berbanding suku yang sama tahun 2022. Pertumbuhan tersebut disumbangkan oleh subsektor Produk peralatan elektrik & elektronik (10.6%); Produk petroleum, kimia, getah & plastik (7.7%); dan Produk makanan, minuman & tembakau (6.0%). Bilangan pekerja bertambah 2.8 peratus untuk merekodkan seramai 2.35 juta orang dengan gaji & upah tumbuh 4.3 peratus kepada RM24.5 bilion. Selain itu, nilai jualan setiap pekerja mencatatkan pertumbuhan sebanyak 5.3 peratus, berjumlah RM191,141.”

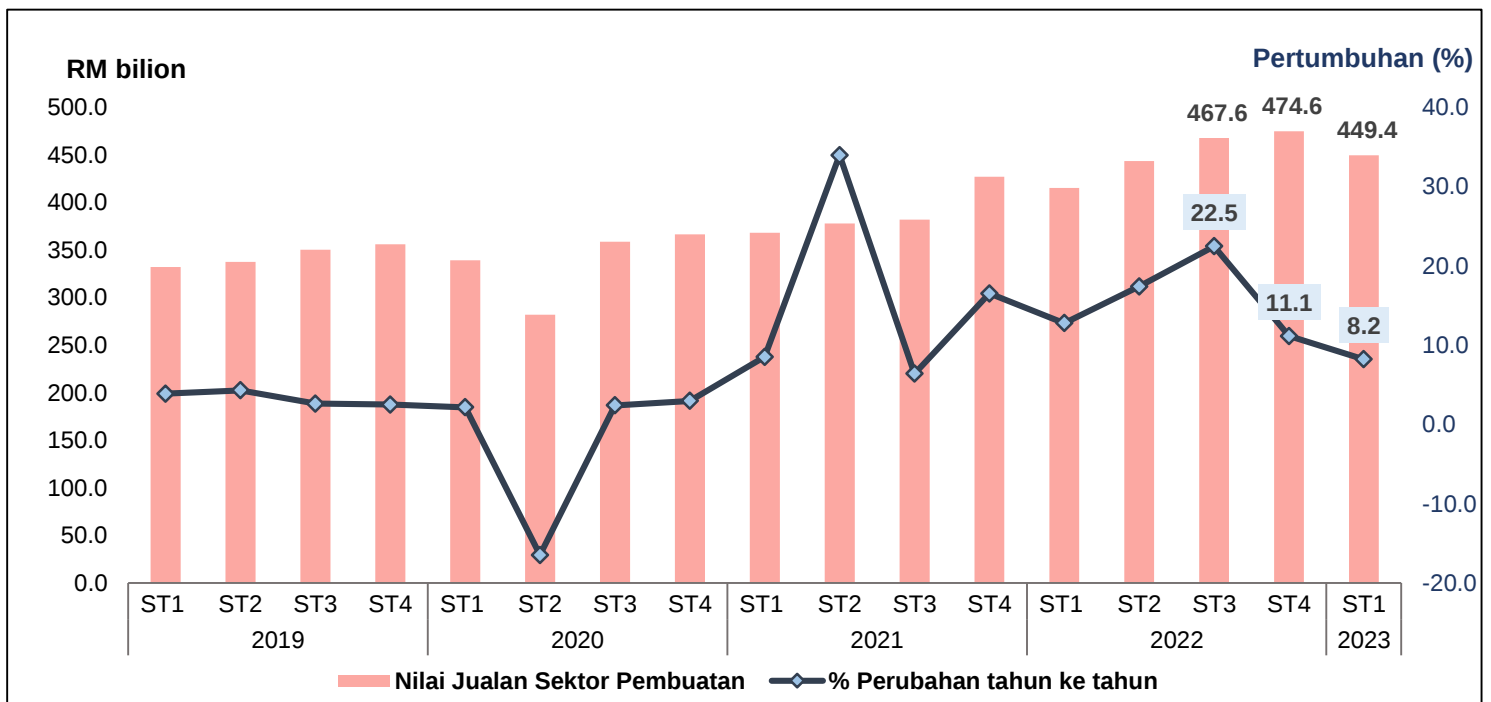

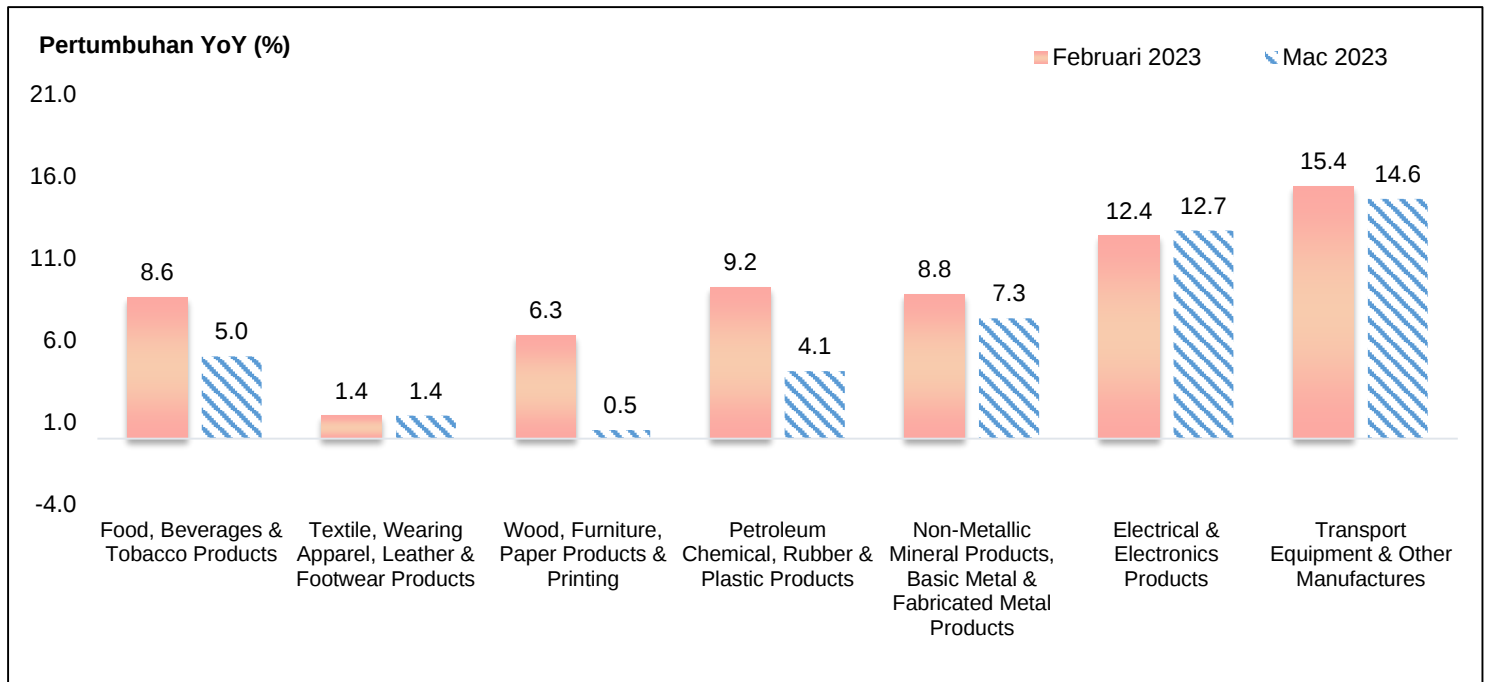
**Carta 1: Nilai Jualan Sektor Pembuatan,
Mac 2022 - Mac 2023**



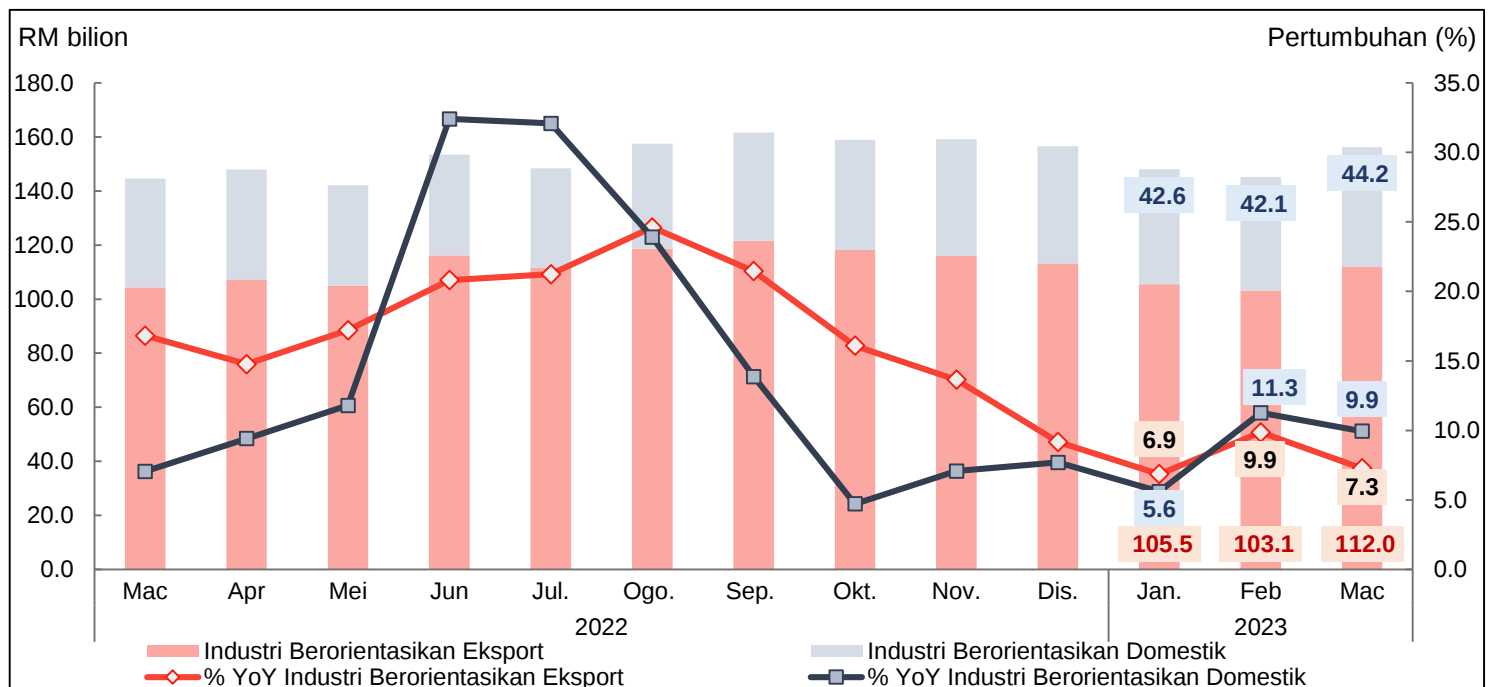
**Carta 2: Nilai Jualan Sektor Pembuatan,
ST1 2019 – ST1 2023**



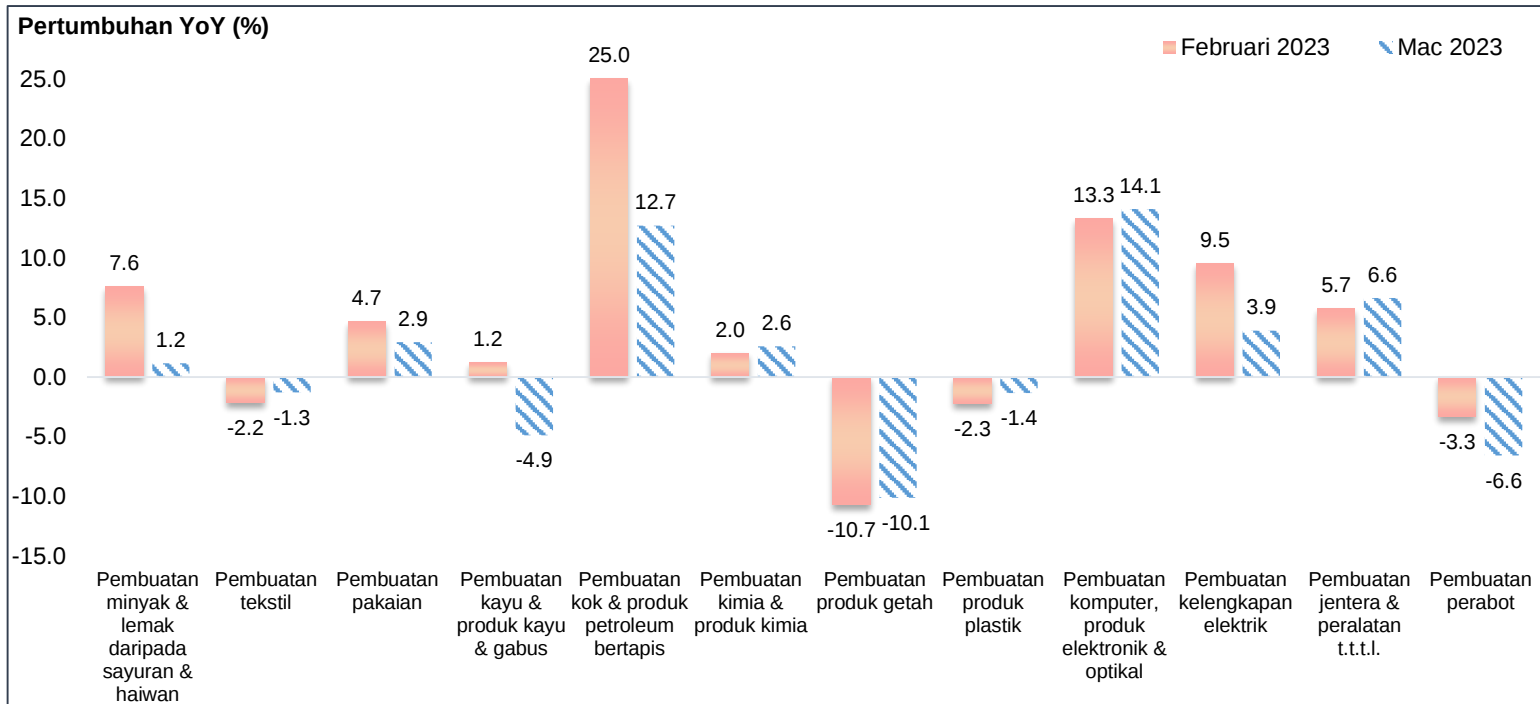
Carta 3: Pertumbuhan Subsektor Pembuatan pada Mac 2023 berbanding Februari 2023



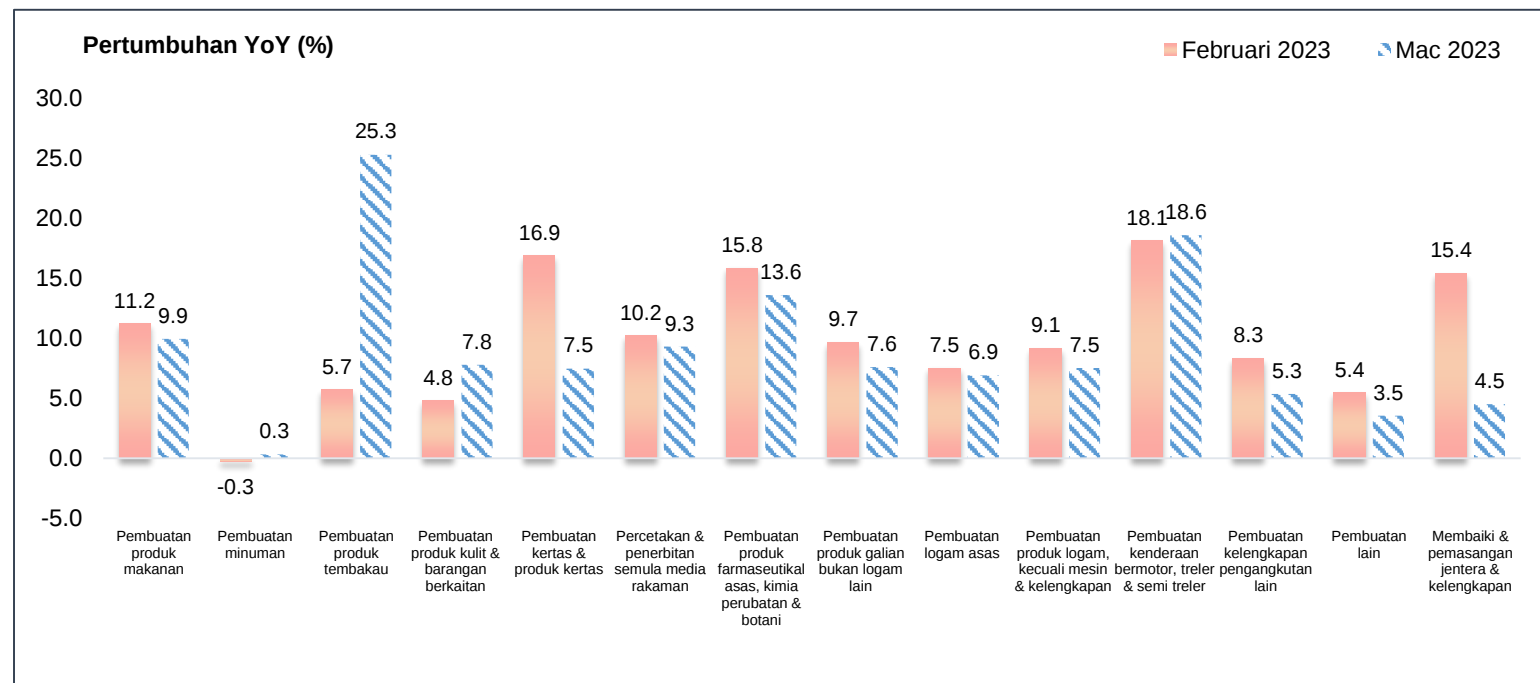

The sales value of the Manufacturing sector expanded by 8.0 per cent, amounting to RM156.2 billion in March 2023

PUTRAJAYA, 9 May 2023 – The sales value of the Manufacturing sector expanded by 8.0 per cent, amounting to RM156.2 billion in March 2023. The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) reported today on the release of **Monthly Manufacturing Statistics, Malaysia, March 2023**.

Commenting on the report, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia, said, “The expansion of 8.0 per cent in the sales value of Manufacturing sector was mainly supported by the double-digit growth in Transport equipment & other manufactures (14.6%) and Electrical & electronics products (12.7%) sub-sectors. In comparison with the preceding month, the sales value returned to record positive growth of 7.6 per cent after registering a continuous decline since December 2022.”

The sales value of export-oriented industries which contributed more than two-thirds or 71.7 per cent of total sales, rose 7.3 per cent in March 2023 after registering 9.9 per cent growth in February 2023. The increment was mainly attributable to the strong growth registered in Manufacture of computer, electronics and optical products (14.1%) and Manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (12.7%). Similarly, the domestic-oriented industries posted steady growth of 9.9 per cent (February 2023: 11.3%) underpinned by the Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (18.6%) and Manufacture of food processing products (9.9%). As compared to February 2023, both export and domestic-oriented industries improved to 8.6 per cent and 5.1 per cent respectively.

Commenting on the number of employees, the Chief Statistician Malaysia said, “There were 2.35 million persons engaged in the Manufacturing sector in March 2023 which increased by 2.8 per cent as against 2.29 million persons registered a year ago. The increase was mainly supported by the Food, beverages & tobacco products (5.3%); Electrical & electronic products (4.2%); and Wood, furniture, paper products & printing (2.3%) sub-sectors. The number of persons engaged in these three sub-sectors

encompasses more than half of the total in the Manufacturing sector. As compared to the preceding month, the number of employees grew slightly by 0.1 per cent.”

In line with the increase in the number of employees, the salaries & wages paid in the Manufacturing sector went up by 4.2 per cent year-on-year which amounted to RM8.17 billion in March 2023. In comparison with the previous month, the salaries & wages increased marginally by 0.1 per cent from RM8.16 billion. In addition, the average monthly salaries & wages per employee posted an increase of 1.3 per cent as compared to a year ago with a value of RM3,475 while the sales value per employee rose by 5.1 per cent to record RM66,430.

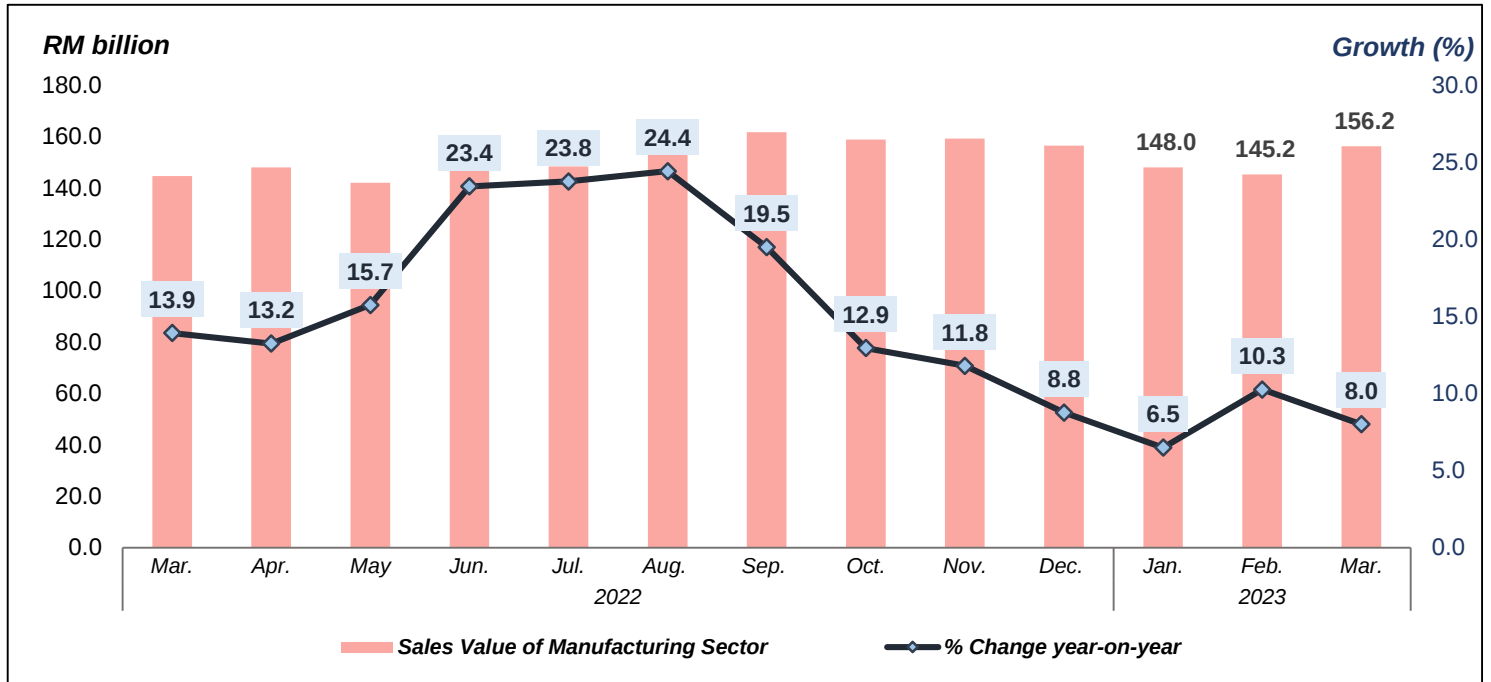
Summarising the performance for the first quarter of 2023, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, “The sales value of the Manufacturing sector rose by 8.2 per cent to register RM449.4 billion as against the same quarter in 2022. The growth was contributed by Electrical & electronics products (10.6%); Petroleum, chemical, rubber & plastics products (7.7%); and Food, beverages & tobacco products (6.0%) sub-sectors. The number of employees added by 2.8 per cent to record a total of 2.35 million persons with salaries & wages grew by 4.3 per cent to RM24.5 billion. Furthermore, sales value per employee registered a growth of 5.3 per cent, amounting to RM191,141.”

Q1 2019 – Q1 2023**

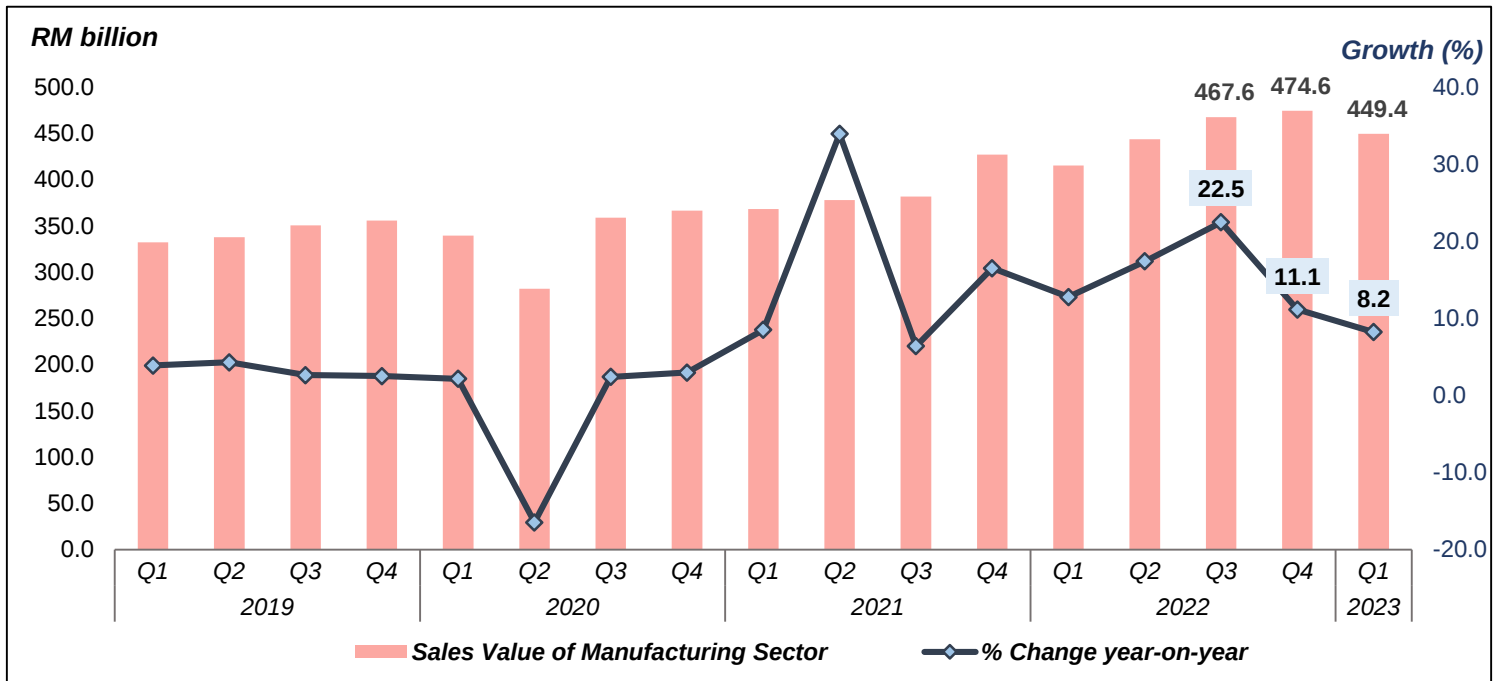


Chart 3: The Growth of Manufacturing Sub-sector in March 2023 as against February 2023

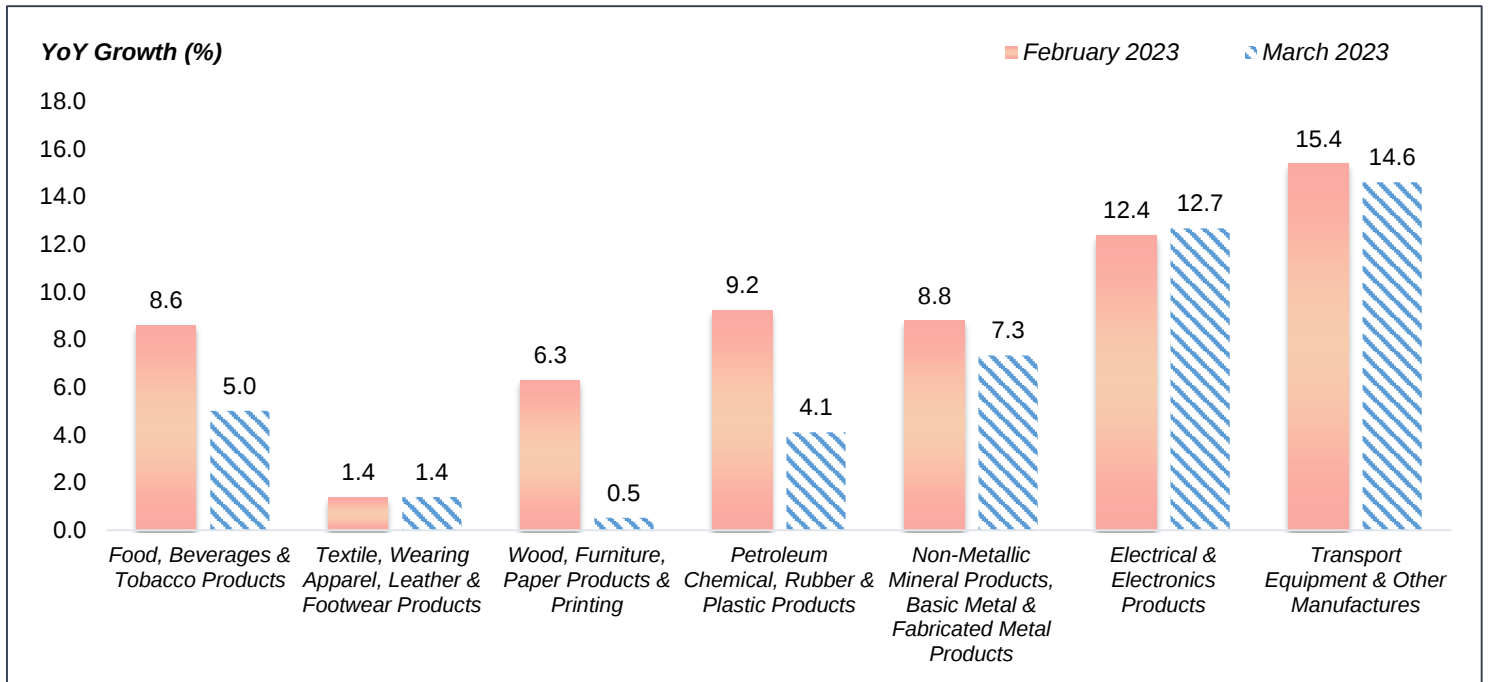
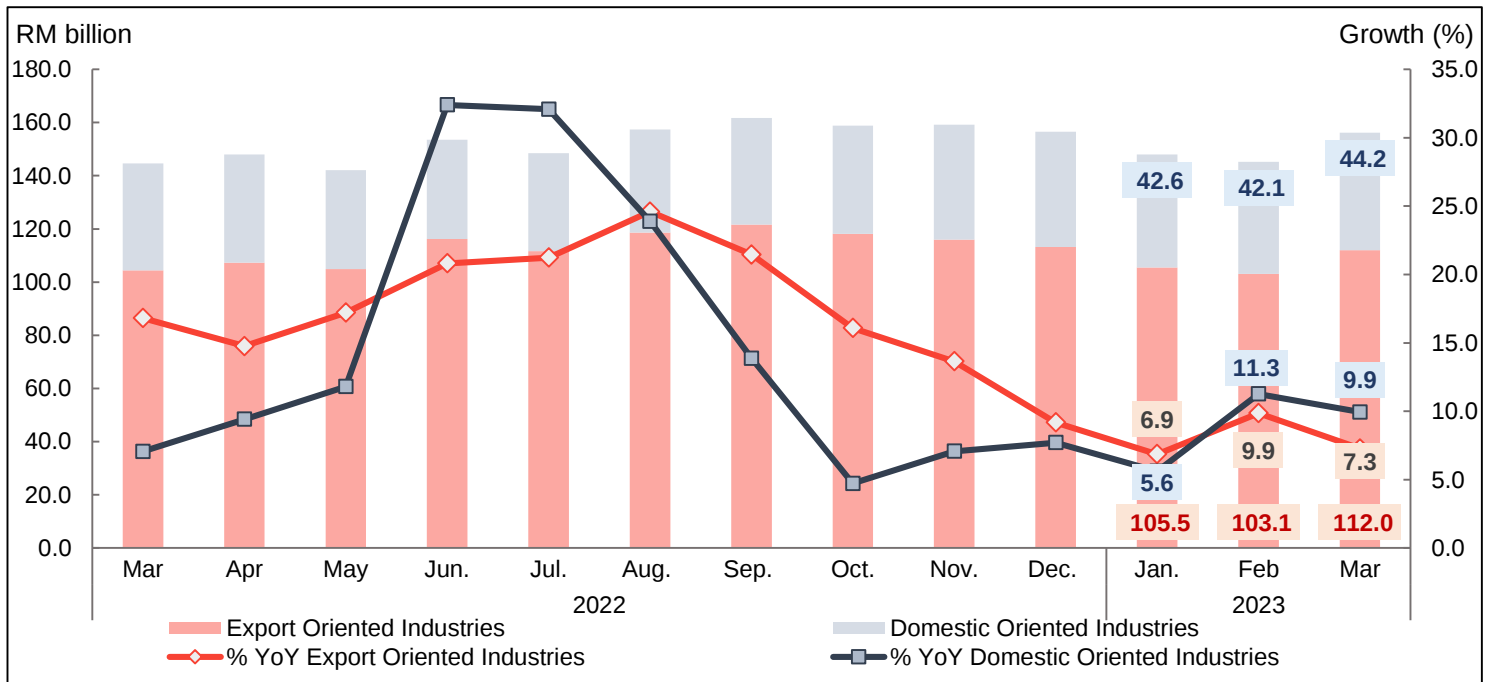
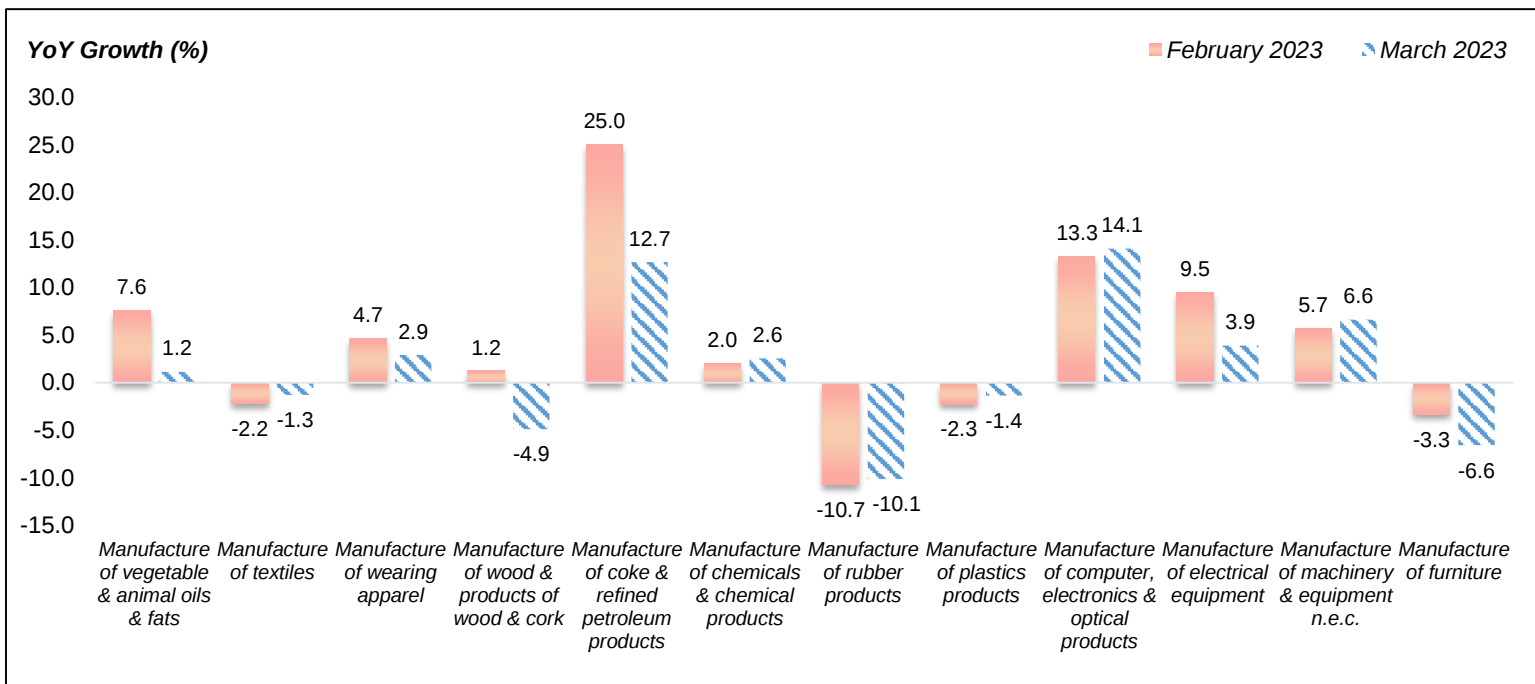


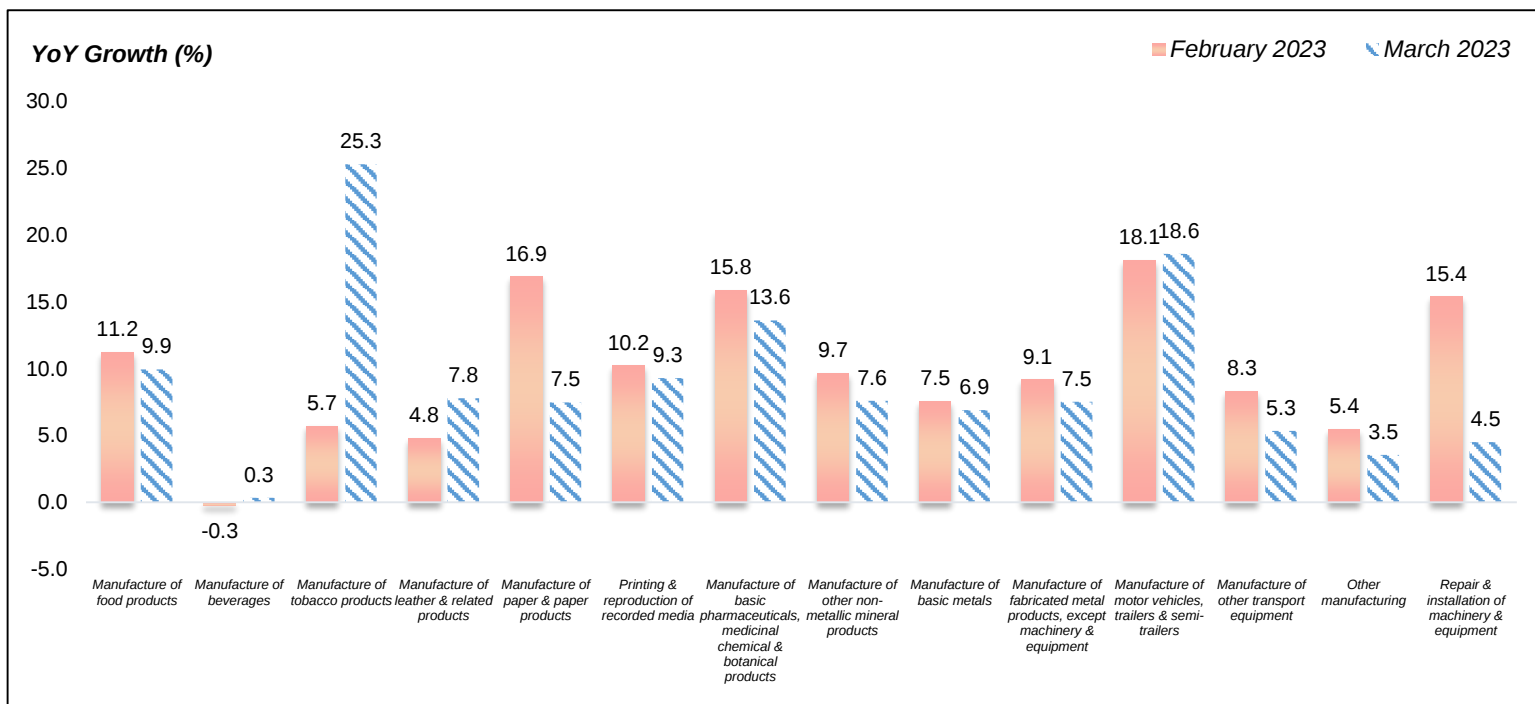
Chart 4: Sales Value of the Export and Domestic-oriented Industries for Manufacturing Sector, March 2022 – March 2023
