FOR VOLUME INDEX OF WHOLESALE & RETAIL TRADE, MALAYSIA,
FIRST QUARTER 2023**

Wholesale & Retail Trade Volume Index up 9.5 per cent in first quarter 2023

PUTRAJAYA, MAY 10, 2023 – The volume index of Wholesale & Retail Trade Malaysia registered a growth of 9.5 per cent year-on-year in first quarter of 2023 as reported today in ***VOLUME INDEX OF WHOLESALE & RETAIL TRADE (2015=100), FIRST QUARTER 2023***. This report also presents statistics on volume index of Wholesale & Retail Trade by sub-sector.

Commenting on the report, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia in a statement today said, "The increase was attributed to Retail Trade sub-sector which rose 14.7 per cent, followed by Motor Vehicles and Wholesale Trade which increased 11.4 per cent and 3.5 per cent, respectively. For quarter-on-quarter comparison, volume index inched up 0.4 per cent, supported by Motor Vehicles which grew 3.2 per cent."

Moving on to performance across sub-sectors, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin added to note that, "Volume index of Retail Trade recorded a positive growth of 14.7 per cent, contributed by Retail Sale of Automotive Fuel in Specialised Stores

with 40.0 per cent. This was followed by Retail Sale of Other Goods in Specialised Stores 22.9 per cent and Retail Sale in Non-Specialised Stores 18.8 per cent. Meanwhile, volume index of Retail Trade went down -0.8 per cent as compared to the previous quarter.”

Commenting further on the performance of volume index of Motor Vehicles, he pointed out that the increase of 11.4 per cent in this sub-sector was attributed to Sales of Motor Vehicles and Sales of Motor Vehicles Parts & Accessories which grew 13.7 per cent and 12.4 per cent, respectively. The Chief Statistician added that, “Maintenance & Repair of Motor Vehicles also registered an increase with a growth of 12.3 per cent. For quarter-on-quarter performance, volume index of Motor Vehicles climbed 3.2 per cent as compared to the previous quarter.”

Dato’ Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin added to note that, “Volume index of Wholesale Trade sub-sector recorded a positive growth of 3.5 per cent in first quarter 2023 as compared to the same quarter in 2022. This positive growth was contributed by Wholesale of Agricultural Raw Materials & Live Animals of 11.4 per cent. This was followed by Wholesale of Household Goods 10.3 per cent and Wholesale of Food, Beverages & Tobacco 9.1 per cent. For quarter-on-quarter comparison, volume index of Wholesale Trade rose 1.1 per cent.”

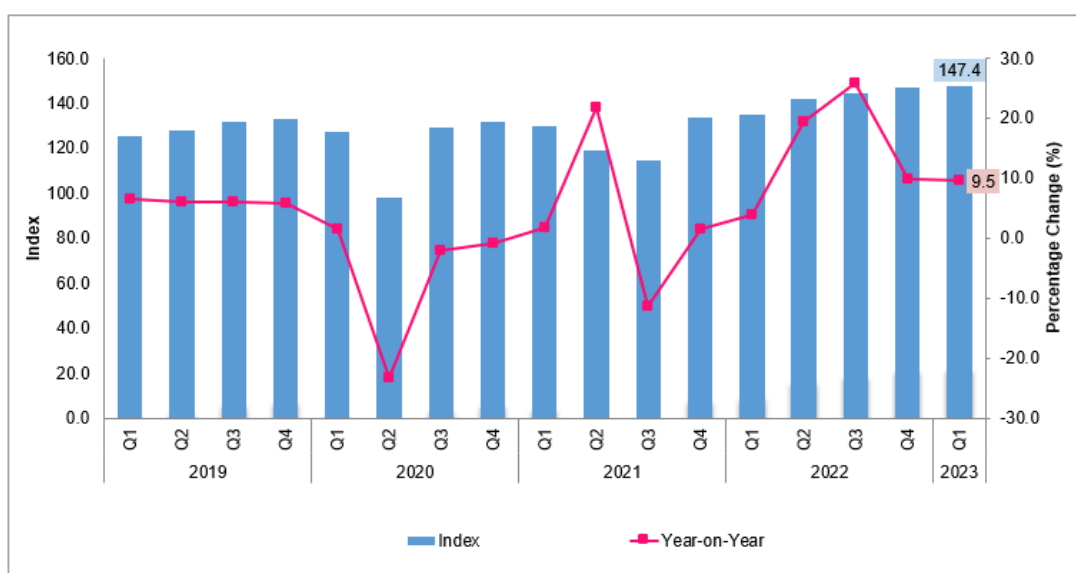
“As for seasonally adjusted volume index, Wholesale & Retail Trade increased 3.6 per cent as against the fourth quarter of 2022. Motor Vehicles and Wholesale Trade sub-sectors recorded positive growth of 7.2 per cent and 5.4 per cent, respectively,” he explained.

BAGI INDEKS VOLUM PERDAGANGAN BORONG & RUNCIT, MALAYSIA, SUKU TAHUN PERTAMA 2023

**Indeks Volum Perdagangan Borong & Runcit meningkat 9.5 peratus pada
suku tahun pertama 2023**

PUTRAJAYA, 10 MEI 2023 – Indeks volum Perdagangan Borong & Runcit Malaysia merekodkan pertumbuhan 9.5 peratus tahun ke tahun pada suku pertama 2023 seperti yang dilaporkan hari ini dalam **INDEKS VOLUM PERDAGANGAN BORONG & RUNCIT (2015=100), SUKU TAHUN PERTAMA 2023**. Laporan ini juga membentangkan statistik mengenai indeks volum Perdagangan Borong & Runcit mengikut subsektor.

Mengulas laporan tersebut, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia dalam satu kenyataan hari ini berkata, “Peningkatan itu disumbangkan oleh subsektor Perdagangan Runcit yang merekodkan peningkatan 14.7 peratus, diikuti oleh Kenderaan Bermotor dan Perdagangan Borong yang meningkat masing-masing 11.4 peratus dan 3.5 peratus. Bagi perbandingan suku tahun ke suku tahun, indeks volum menokok 0.4 peratus, disokong oleh Kenderaan Bermotor yang bertumbuh 3.2 peratus.”

Beralih kepada prestasi mengikut subsektor, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin memaklumkan, “Indeks volum subsektor Perdagangan Runcit merekodkan

pertumbuhan positif 14.7 peratus disumbangkan oleh Jualan Runcit Bahan Api Kenderaan dengan 40.0 peratus. Ini diikuti oleh Jualan Runcit di Kedai Khusus yang Menjual Barangan Lain 22.9 peratus dan Jualan Runcit di Kedai Bukan Pengkhususan 18.8 peratus. Sementara itu, indeks volum Perdagangan Runcit turun -0.8 peratus berbanding suku tahun lepas.”

Mengulas lanjut prestasi indeks volum Kenderaan Bermotor, beliau seterusnya memaklumkan peningkatan sebanyak 11.4 peratus bagi subsektor ini adalah disumbangkan oleh Jualan Kenderaan Bermotor dan Jualan Komponen & Aksesori Kenderaan Bermotor yang bertumbuh masing-masing 13.7 peratus dan 12.4 peratus. Ketua Perangkawan turut menerangkan, “Penyelenggaraan & Pembaikan Kenderaan Bermotor turut meningkat dengan pertumbuhan 12.3 peratus. Bagi prestasi suku tahunan, indeks volum Kenderaan Bermotor naik 3.2 peratus berbanding suku tahun sebelumnya.”

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin turut memaklumkan, “Indeks volum subsektor Perdagangan Borong merekodkan pertumbuhan positif 3.5 peratus pada suku tahun pertama 2023 berbanding tempoh yang sama pada 2022. Peningkatan ini disumbangkan oleh Jualan Borong Bahan Mentah Pertanian & Haiwan Hidup dengan 11.4 peratus. Ini diikuti oleh Jualan Borong Barangan Isi Rumah 10.3 peratus dan Jual Borong Makanan, Minuman & Tembakau 9.1 peratus. Bagi perbandingan suku tahunan, indeks volum Perdagangan Borong naik 1.1 peratus.”

“Bagi indeks volum pelarasan musim, Perdagangan Borong & Runcit meningkat 3.6 peratus berbanding suku tahun keempat 2022. Subsektor Kenderaan Bermotor dan Perdagangan Borong mencatatkan pertumbuhan positif masing-masing 7.2 peratus dan 5.4 peratus,” jelas beliau.
