Ekonomi Malaysia dijangka berkembang pada kadar yang perlahan pada suku ketiga 2023 dengan indeks pelopor mencatatkan 110.1 mata pada Mac 2023

PUTRAJAYA, 25 MEI 2023 – Pada hari ini, Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia menerbitkan **PENUNJUK EKONOMI MALAYSIA: INDEKS PELOPOR, SERENTAK & SUSULAN BAGI FEBRUARI 2023**. Indeks Pelopor (IP) merupakan alat yang digunakan untuk menjangkakan kenaikan dan penurunan ekonomi dalam purata empat hingga enam bulan ke hadapan.

Menurut Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia, “Ekonomi Malaysia dijangka bertumbuh dengan kadar perlahan pada beberapa bulan ke hadapan berdasarkan Indeks Pelopor (IP) yang menyusut 1.2 peratus kepada 110.1 mata pada Mac 2023 (Mac 2022: 111.4 mata) (**Paparan I**). Prestasi IP terjejas disebabkan oleh penurunan yang ketara dalam Import Benar Semi Konduktor dan Indeks Perusahaan Bursa Malaysia. Perubahan bulanan IP juga mencatatkan penurunan sebanyak 1.1 peratus pada Mac 2023 berbanding 2.9 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya yang disebabkan oleh Jangkaan Nilai Jualan, Pembuatan (-0.6%) dan Import Benar Logam Asas Berharga & Logam Bukan Ferus Lain (-0.5%).

Melihat kepada arah aliran jangka panjang terlicin pada Mac 2023, IP mencatatkan 99.3 mata berbanding 99.2 mata pada Februari 2023 (**Paparan II**). Meskipun masih berada di bawah trend 100.0 mata, ekonomi dijangka berkembang secara sederhana dalam tempoh terdekat. Jangkaan itu mengambil kira cabaran global dan ketidaktentuan domestik.

Indeks Serentak (IS) yang mencerminkan keadaan ekonomi semasa, meningkat 3.4 peratus kepada 121.9 mata pada Mac 2023 (Mac 2022: 117.9 mata). Peningkatan ini disumbangkan oleh semua komponen kecuali Kapasiti Penggunaan, Pembuatan. Pada masa yang sama, perubahan bulanan IS juga mencatatkan peningkatan 0.2 peratus, disokong terutamanya oleh Indeks Kuantiti Perdagangan Runcit (0.3%).





Malaysia's economy is expected to grow at a slower pace in the third quarter of 2023 with the Leading Index recording 110.1 points in March 2023

PUTRAJAYA, MAY 25, 2023 - Today, the Department of Statistics Malaysia released the **MALAYSIAN ECONOMIC INDICATORS: LEADING, COINCIDENT & LAGGING INDEXES FOR FEBRUARY 2023**. The Leading Index (LI) is a predictive tool used to anticipate economic upturns and downturns in an average of four to six months ahead.

According to the Department of Statistics Malaysia, "Malaysia's economy is likely to grow at a slower rate in the next few months based on the Leading Index (LI) which decreased 1.2 per cent to 110.1 points in March 2023 (March 2022: 111.4 points) (**Exhibit I**). The performance of LI was weighed down by significant decreases in Real Imports of Semi Conductors and Bursa Malaysia Industrial Index. The monthly LI also weakened by 1.1 per cent in March 2023 compared to 2.9 per cent in the previous month attributed by Expected Sales Value, Manufacturing (-0.6%) and Real Imports of Other Basic Precious & Other Non-ferrous Metals (-0.5%).

Looking at the smoothed long-term trend in March 2023, the LI recorded 99.3 points as against 99.2 points in February 2023 (**Exhibit II**). Although it remained below the trend of 100.0 points, the economy is anticipated to grow modestly in the near term. The expectation is in view of the global headwinds and domestic uncertainties.

The Coincident Index (CI) which reflects the current economic condition, rose 3.4 per cent to 121.9 points in March 2023 (March 2022: 117.9 points). The increase was contributed by all components except Capacity Utilisation, Manufacturing. Concomitantly, the monthly (CI) also recorded an increase of 0.2 per cent, supported mainly by Volume Index of Retail Trade (0.3%).

Exhibit I: Leading Composite Index




Exhibit II: Leading Composite Index (Long Term Trend = 100) and Business Cycle
