Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian Malaysia menyusut 3.3 peratus pada April 2023, dipengaruhi penurunan dalam kesemua sektor

PUTRAJAYA, 9 Jun 2023 – Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian Malaysia menyusut 3.3 peratus pada April 2023, dipengaruhi penurunan dalam kesemua sektor. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia melaporkan dalam keluaran **Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian (IPP), Malaysia, April 2023** pada hari ini. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik IPP yang terdiri daripada tiga sektor iaitu Perlombongan, Pembuatan dan Elektrik.

Menurut Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia, IPP menurun kepada negatif 3.3 peratus pada April 2023 berbanding positif 3.2 peratus yang dicatatkan pada bulan sebelumnya. Penurunan pada April 2023 adalah berikutan penguncupan dalam kesemua sektor, iaitu Perlombongan dengan negatif 4.9 peratus (Mac 2023: 0.8%); Pembuatan dengan negatif 3.0 peratus (Mac 2023: 4.1%); dan Elektrik dengan negatif 2.0 peratus (Mac 2023: 0.4%). Berbanding dengan bulan sebelumnya, IPP merosot 10.8 peratus selepas mencatatkan pertumbuhan 8.4 peratus pada Mac 2023.

Kemerosotan sektor Pembuatan sebanyak 3.0 peratus pada April 2023 merupakan penyusutan kali pertama sejak Julai 2021, dipengaruhi terutamanya oleh penurunan 3.5 peratus dalam industri berorientasikan eksport (Mac 2023: 3.6%). Di samping itu, penguncupan industri berorientasikan eksport pada April 2023 adalah yang pertama direkodkan dalam tempoh 34 bulan, berikutan penurunan dalam Pembuatan produk getah sebanyak 16.5 peratus dan Pembuatan komputer, elektronik & produk optik yang mencatatkan negatif 1.8 peratus. Pada masa yang sama, industri berorientasikan domestik merekodkan penurunan 2.1 peratus disebabkan terutamanya oleh Pembuatan kenderaan bermotor, trailer dan semi-trailer (-15.5%); Pembuatan minuman (-5.5%) dan; Pembuatan produk prosesan makanan (-4.9%). Bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, sektor Pembuatan menguncup 11.4 peratus selepas mencatatkan 7.8 peratus pada Mac 2023.

Pengeluaran dalam sektor Perlombongan menyusut 4.9 peratus pada April 2023, dipengaruhi oleh kemerosotan berterusan dalam indeks Gas Asli dengan 7.8 peratus dan kejatuhan marginal 0.9 peratus dalam indeks Minyak Mentah & Kondensat. Berbanding Mac 2023, indeks Perlombongan mencatatkan penurunan dua digit 10.7 peratus berbanding kenaikan 8.5 peratus yang direkodkan pada Mac 2023.

Begitu juga dengan pengeluaran Elektrik yang berkurang 2.0 peratus pada April 2023 selepas merekodkan sedikit peningkatan 0.4 peratus pada Mac 2023. Bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, indeks Elektrik turun 4.8 peratus berbanding pertumbuhan positif 15.1 peratus yang dicatatkan pada bulan sebelumnya.

Bagi empat bulan pertama 2023, IPP menyederhana kepada 1.3 peratus berbanding tempoh yang sama pada 2022. Pada tempoh tersebut, indeks Pembuatan dan Perlombongan masing-masing meningkat sebanyak 1.8 peratus dan 0.3 peratus, manakala indeks Elektrik jatuh 1.2 peratus.

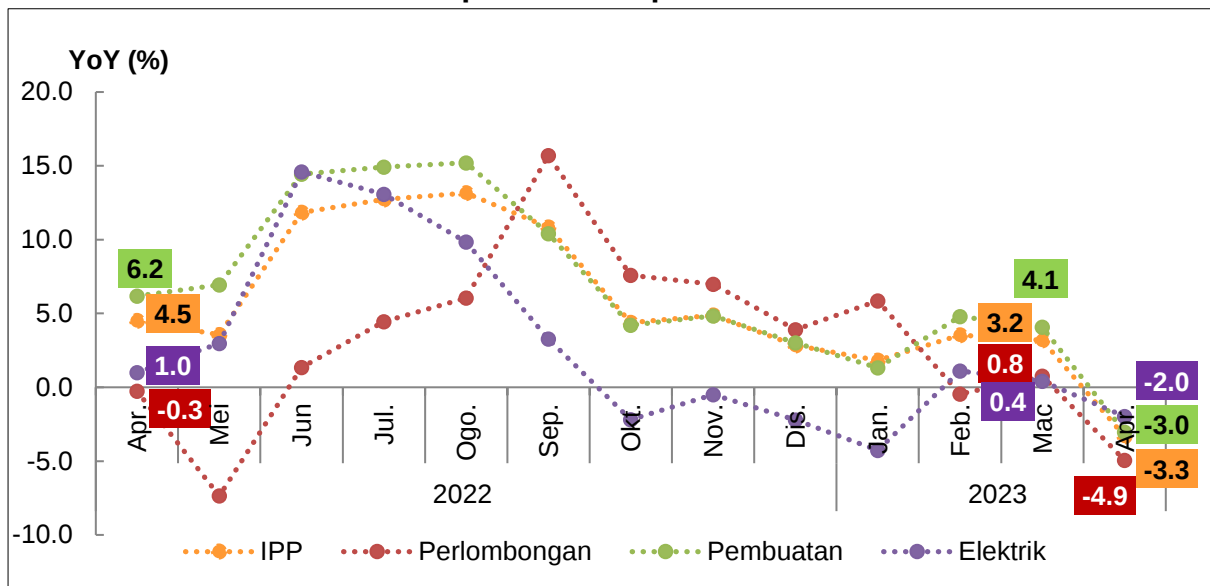

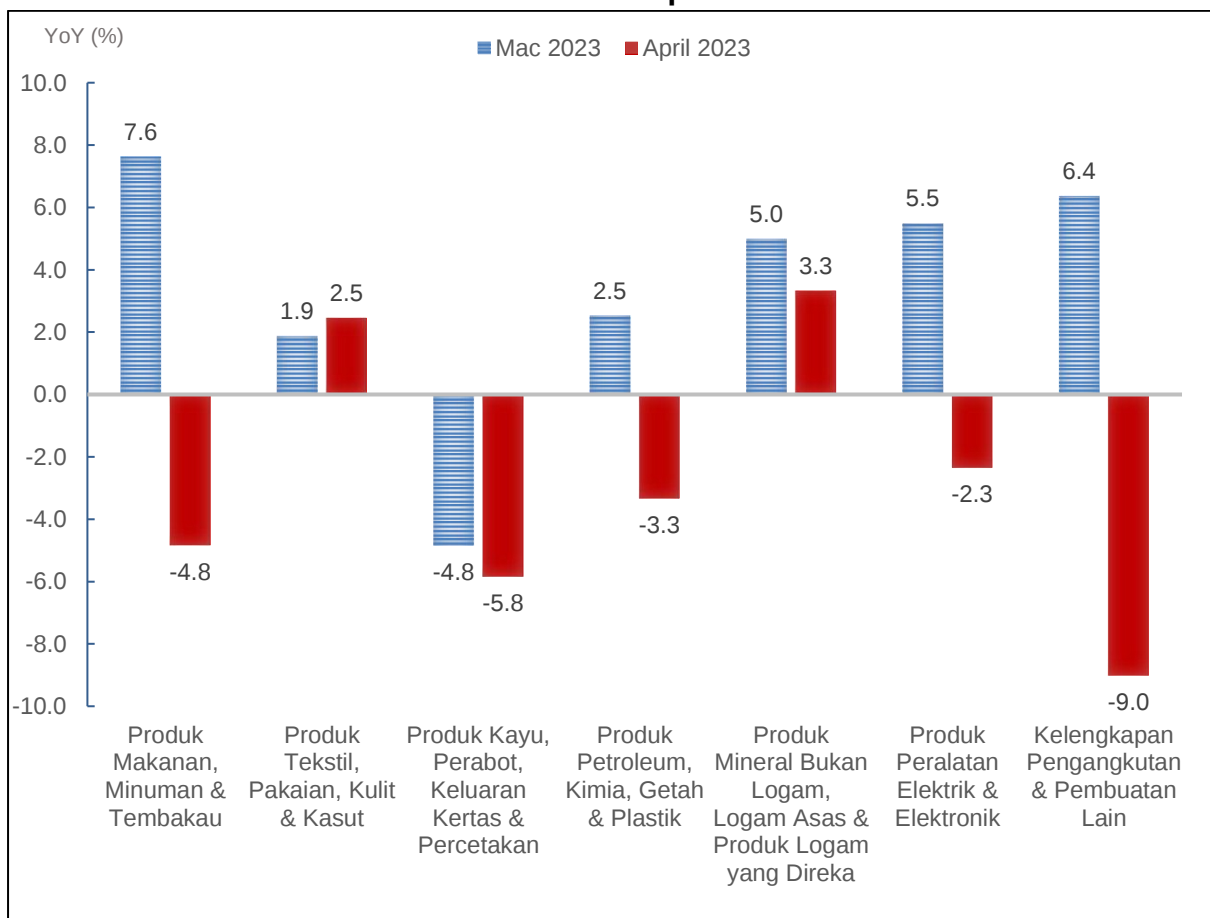

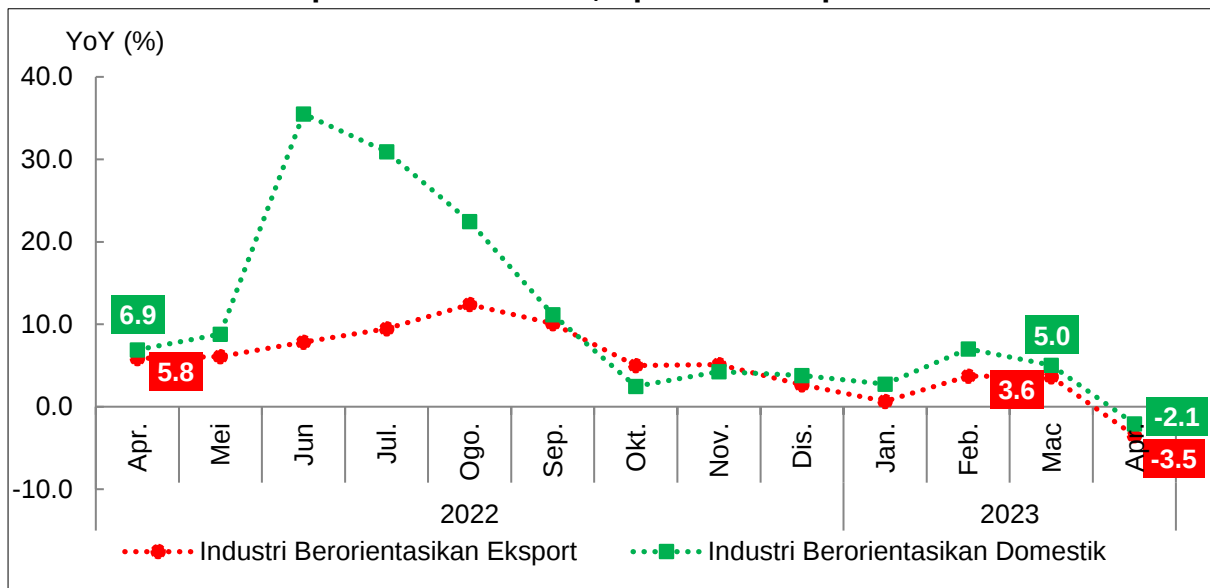
**Carta 1: Prestasi Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian,
April 2022 – April 2023**



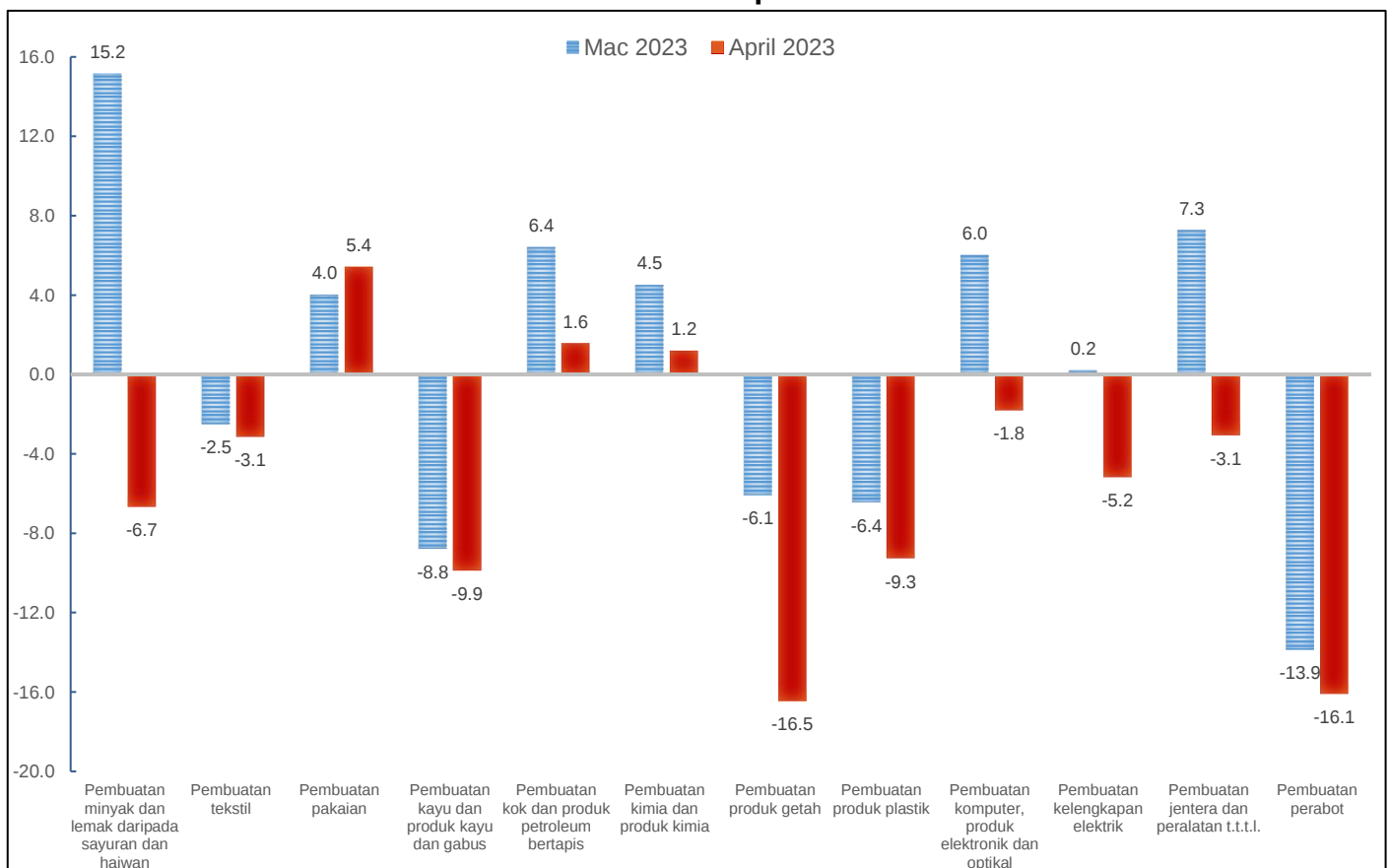
**Carta 2: Pertumbuhan Indeks Pembuatan Mengikut Subsektor,
Mac 2023 dan April 2023**



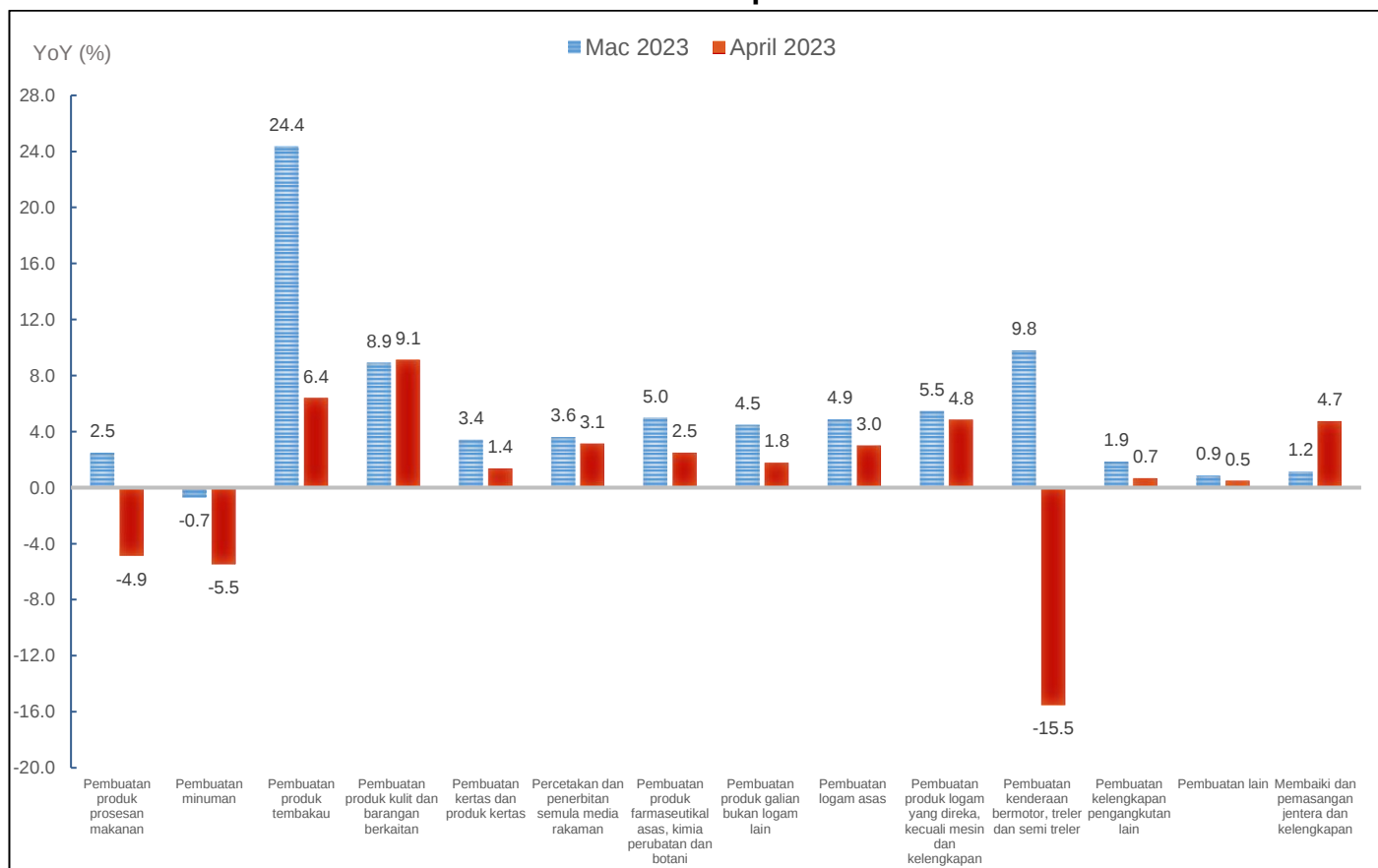
Carta 3: Prestasi Indeks Pembuatan Mengikut Industri Berorientasikan Eksport dan Domestik, April 2022 – April 2023

Malaysia's Industrial Production Index contracted by 3.3 per cent in April 2023, weighed down by all sectors

PUTRAJAYA, 9 June 2023 - Malaysia's Industrial Production Index contracted by 3.3 per cent in April 2023, weighed down by all sectors. The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) reported today on the release of the **Industrial Production Index (IPI), Malaysia, April 2023**. This publication presents IPI statistics, consisting of three sectors namely Mining, Manufacturing and Electricity.

According to the Department of Statistics Malaysia, the IPI turned downward to negative 3.3 per cent in April 2023 as against positive 3.2 per cent recorded in the preceding month. The decrease in April 2023 was attributed to contraction in all sectors, namely Mining with negative 4.9 per cent (March 2023: 0.8%); Manufacturing with negative 3.0 per cent (March 2023: 4.1%); and Electricity with negative 2.0 per cent (March 2023: 0.4%). In comparison with the preceding month, the IPI declined by 10.8 per cent after registering a growth of 8.4 per cent in March 2023.

The deterioration of the Manufacturing sector by 3.0 per cent in April 2023 was its first contraction since July 2021, mainly influenced by the decline of 3.5 per cent in export-oriented industries (March 2023: 3.6%). In addition, the contraction of export-oriented industries in April 2023 was the first recorded in 34 months, attributable to the decline in the Manufacture of rubber products by 16.5 per cent and the Manufacture of computers, electronics & optical products which posted a negative 1.8 per cent. In the meantime, the domestic-oriented industries recorded a fall of 2.1 per cent particularly attributed to the Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers & semi-trailers (-15.5%); Manufacture of beverages (-5.5%); and Manufacture of food processing products (-4.9%). A month-on-month comparison, the Manufacturing sector shrank by 11.4 per cent after registering 7.8 per cent in March 2023.

The production in the Mining sector slowed by 4.9 per cent in April 2023, weighed down by a continuous downturn in the Natural Gas index by 7.8 per cent and a marginal drop of 0.9 per cent in the Crude Oil & Condensate index. As compared to March 2023, the Mining index posted a double-digit decline of 10.7 per cent as compared to an increase of 8.5 per cent recorded in March 2023.

Similarly, the Electricity output dropped by 2.0 per cent in April 2023 after recording slight growth of 0.4 per cent in March 2023. In a month-on-month comparison, the Electricity index weakened by 4.8 per cent as against positive growth of 15.1 per cent recorded in the preceding month.

For the first four months of 2023, the IPI moderated to 1.3 per cent as compared to the same period of 2022. During the period, the Manufacturing and Mining indices increased by 1.8 per cent and 0.3 per cent respectively, while the Electricity index went down by 1.2 per cent.

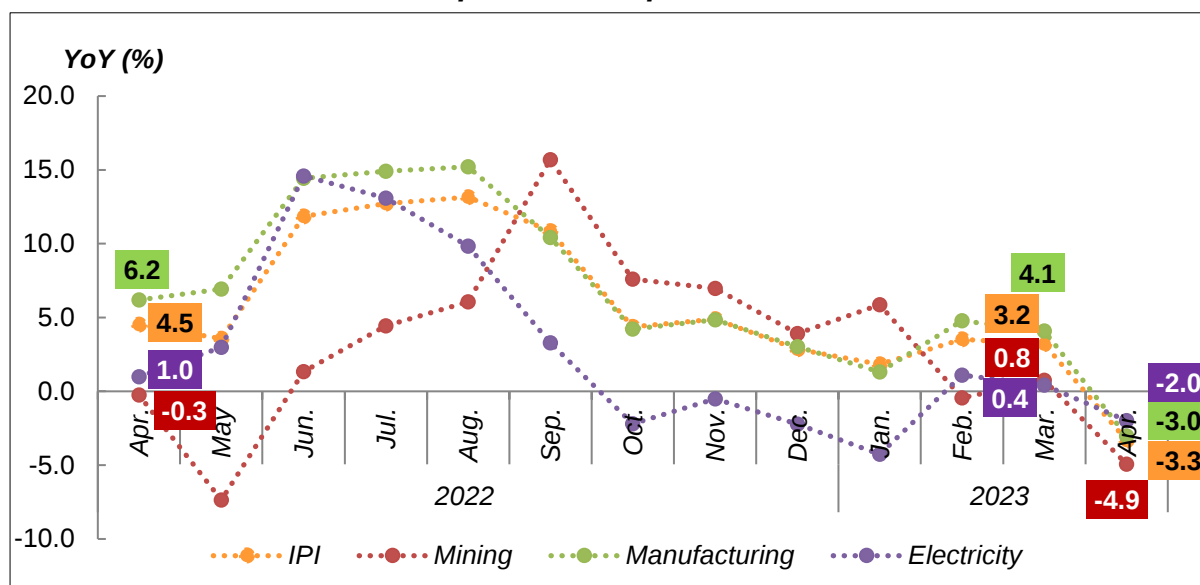

March 2023 and April 2023**

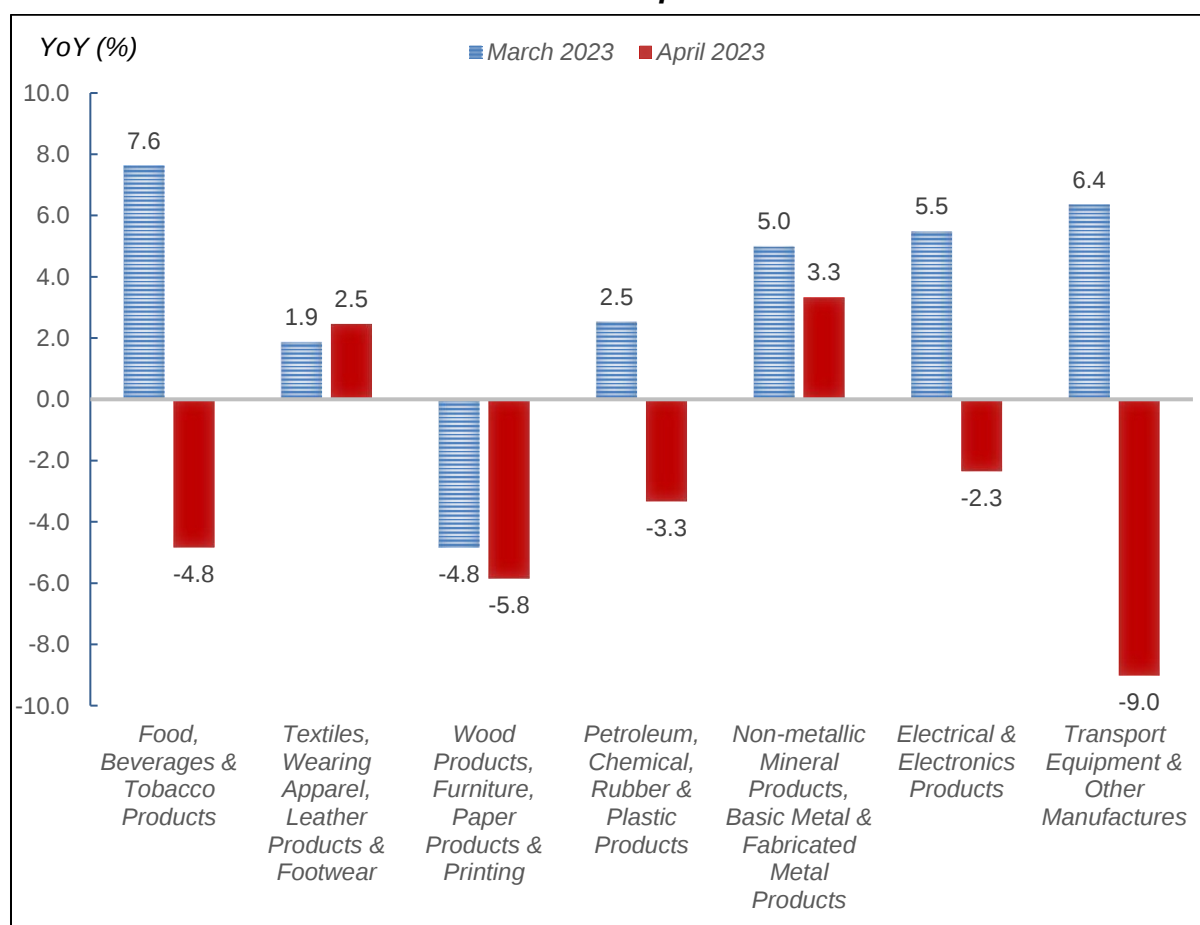


Chart 3: Performance of Manufacturing Index by Export and Domestic Oriented Industries, April 2022 – April 2023

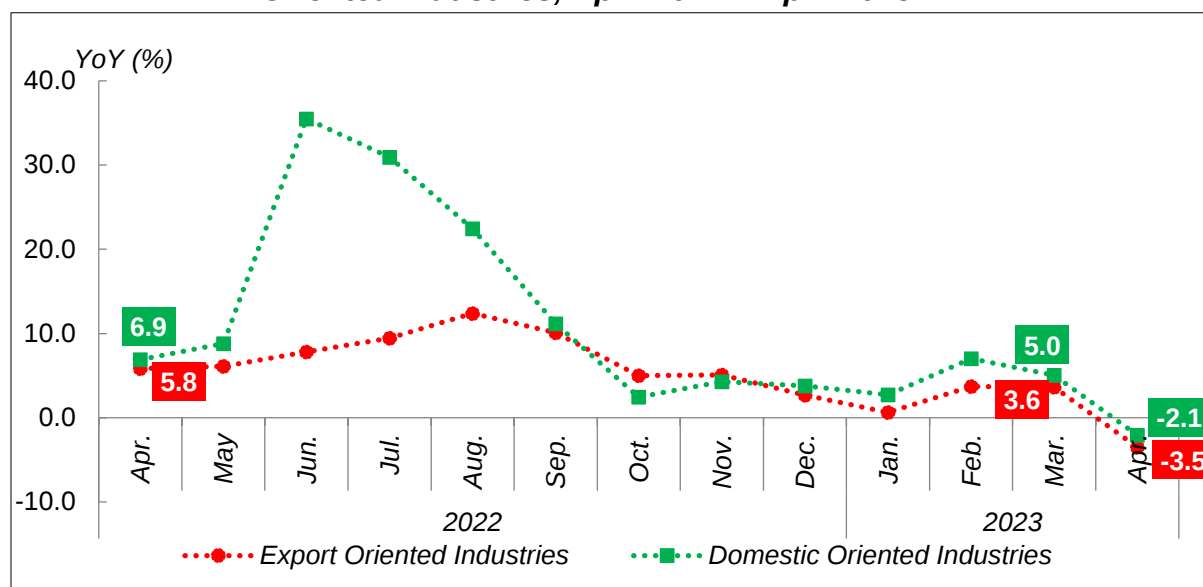
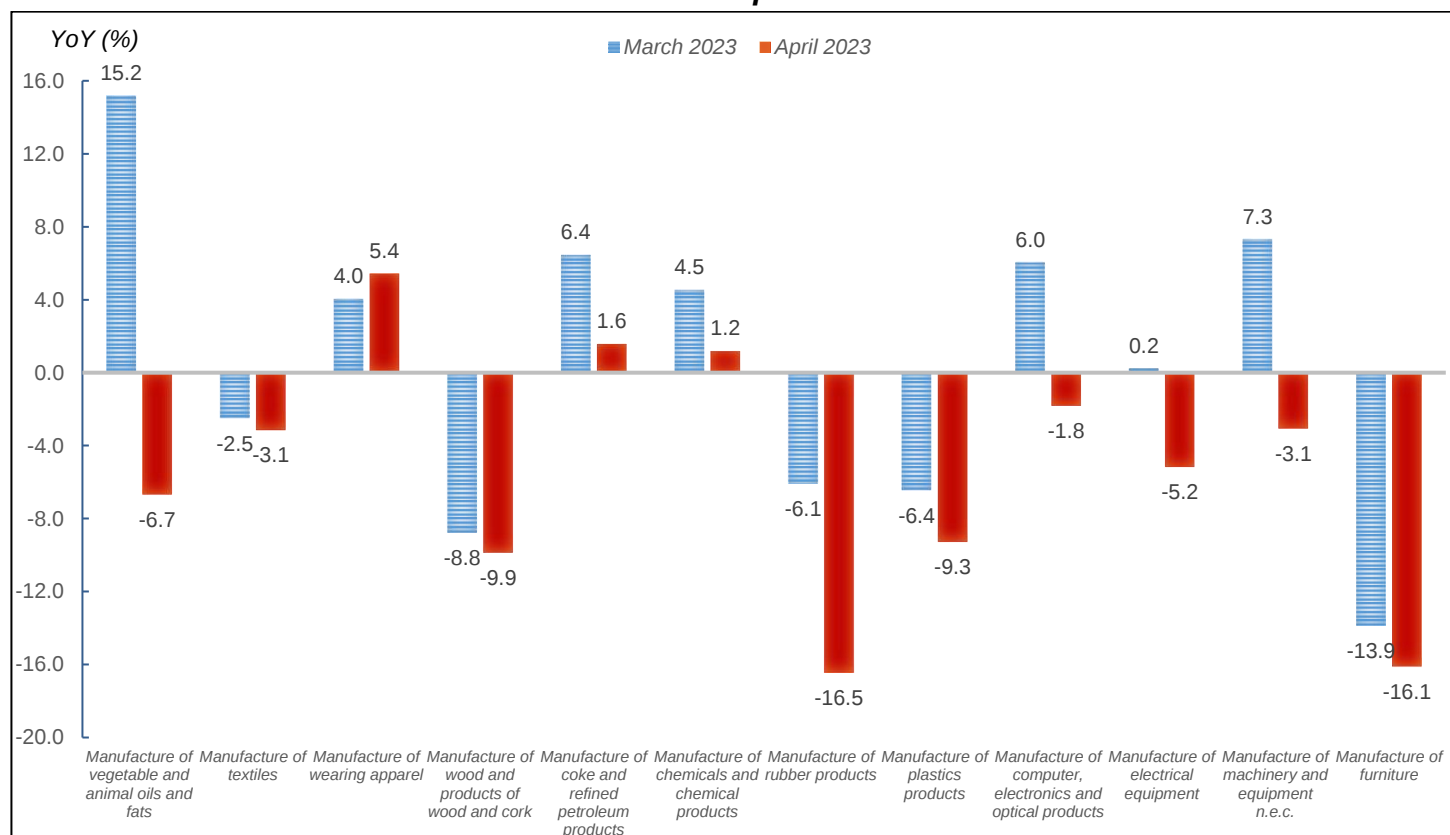
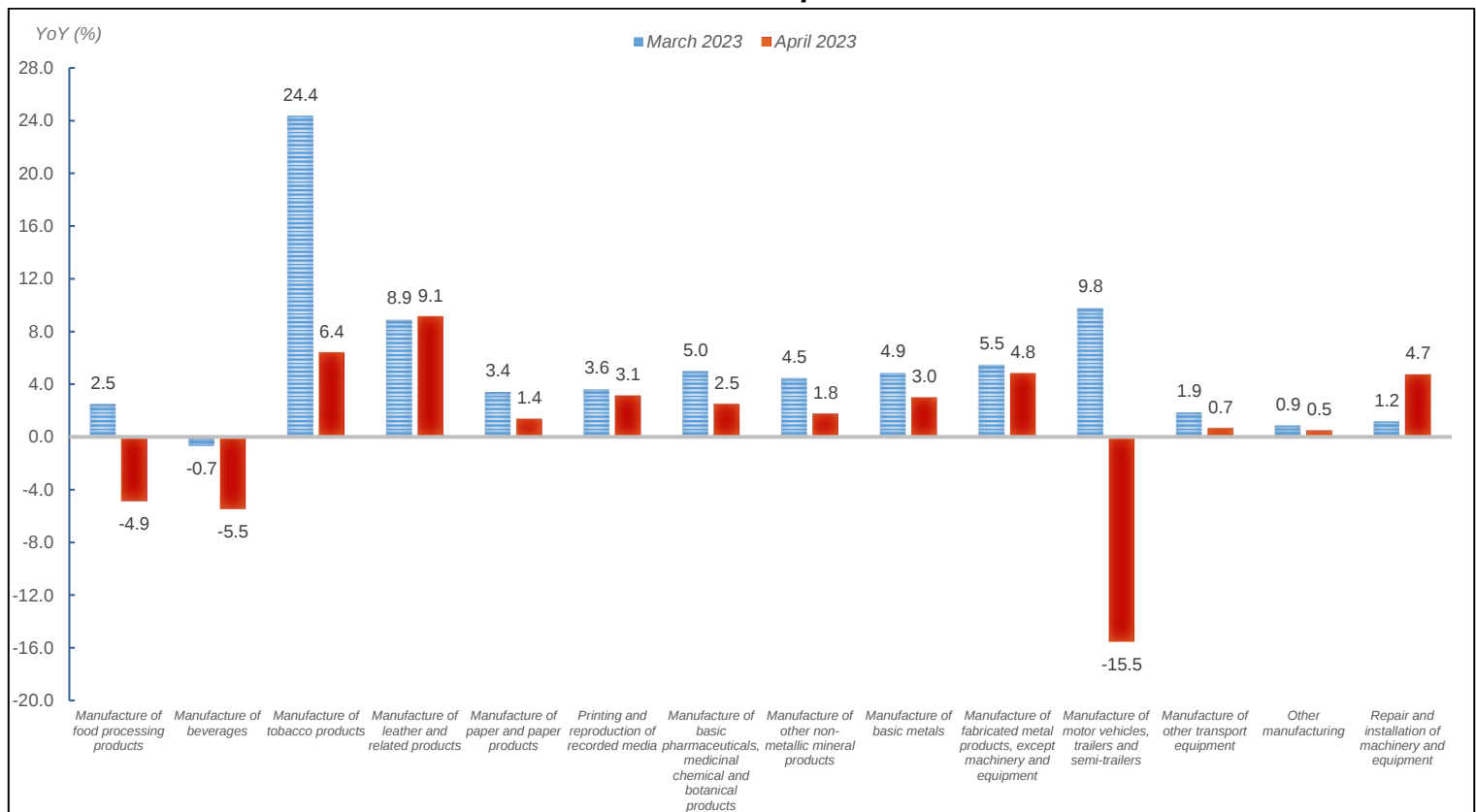


Chart 4: Manufacturing Export-Oriented by Group, March 2023 and April 2023
