PERANGKAAN PEMBUATAN BULANAN, MALAYSIA, APRIL 2023

Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan menurun 2.0 peratus untuk mencatatkan sebanyak RM145.0 bilion pada April 2023

PUTRAJAYA, 9 Jun 2023 - Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan menurun 2.0 peratus untuk mencatatkan sebanyak RM145.0 bilion pada April 2023. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) melaporkan dalam keluaran **Perangkaan Pembuatan Bulanan, Malaysia, April 2023** pada hari ini.

Menurut Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia, nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan menurun 2.0 peratus pada April 2023 setelah merekodkan pertumbuhan positif 8.0 peratus pada Mac 2023 iaitu yang terendah sejak Mei 2020. Penurunan ini dipengaruhi terutamanya oleh penyusutan dalam subsektor Makanan, minuman & tembakau (-12.7%); Kelengkapan pengangkutan & pembuatan lain (-4.9%); dan Petroleum, kimia, getah dan plastik (-3.1%). Berbanding dengan bulan sebelumnya, nilai jualan kembali menurun dengan negatif 7.2 peratus berbanding kenaikan 7.6 peratus yang direkodkan pada Mac 2023.

Nilai jualan industri berorientasikan eksport yang merangkumi 71.5 peratus daripada jumlah jualan merekodkan penurunan 3.4 peratus pada April 2023 selepas mencatatkan momentum positif sejak Mei 2020. Penguncupan ini dipengaruhi terutamanya oleh industri Pembuatan minyak & lemak daripada sayuran & haiwan (-23.2%); Pembuatan produk getah (-14.2%); dan Pembuatan produk plastik (-7.1%). Namun begitu, industri berorientasikan domestik mengekalkan trend positif dengan pertumbuhan 1.6 peratus pada April 2023, namun pada kadar yang lebih perlahan berbanding 10.7 peratus yang dicatatkan pada Mac 2023. Momentum positif dalam industri berorientasikan domestik disokong terutamanya oleh industri Pembuatan produk logam, kecuali mesin & kelengkapan (5.5%); Pembuatan produk galian bukan logam lain (4.6%); dan Pembuatan produk prosesan makanan (3.4%). Berbanding bulan sebelumnya, kedua-dua industri berorientasikan eksport dan domestik masing-masing berkurang 7.2 peratus.

Seramai 2.35 juta orang pekerja yang terlibat dalam sektor Pembuatan pada April 2023, meningkat sebanyak 2.5 peratus berbanding 2.29 juta orang yang direkodkan setahun yang lalu. Kenaikan ini didorong terutamanya oleh subsektor

Produk makanan, minuman & tembakau (5.6%); Peralatan elektrik & elektronik (4.2%); dan Produk kayu, perabot, keluaran kertas & percetakan (2.7%). Bilangan pekerja yang terlibat dalam ketiga-tiga subsektor ini menyumbang lebih separuh daripada jumlah keseluruhan pekerja dalam sektor Pembuatan. Berbanding bulan sebelumnya, bilangan pekerja dalam sektor ini berkurang sebanyak 0.1 peratus.

Selaras dengan peningkatan bilangan pekerja, gaji & upah yang dibayar dalam sektor Pembuatan meningkat sebanyak 3.9 peratus tahun ke tahun, yang berjumlah RM8.02 bilion pada April 2023. Bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, gaji & upah menurun 1.9 peratus daripada RM8.17 bilion yang direkodkan pada Mac 2023. Purata gaji & upah bulanan bagi setiap pekerja pada April 2023 adalah lebih tinggi sebanyak 1.4 peratus berbanding setahun lalu dengan nilai RM3,413 manakala nilai jualan bagi setiap pekerja menurun 4.4 peratus kepada RM61,716.

Prestasi keseluruhan bagi Januari hingga April 2023, nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan meningkat sebanyak 5.5 peratus, merekodkan sejumlah RM594.4 bilion berbanding tempoh yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Sementara itu, bilangan pekerja bertambah 2.5 peratus untuk merekodkan seramai 2.35 juta orang dengan gaji & upah meningkat 4.2 peratus kepada RM32.5 bilion. Selain itu, nilai jualan setiap pekerja mencatatkan pertumbuhan sebanyak 2.9 peratus, berjumlah RM253,029 bagi tempoh empat bulan pertama tahun 2023.

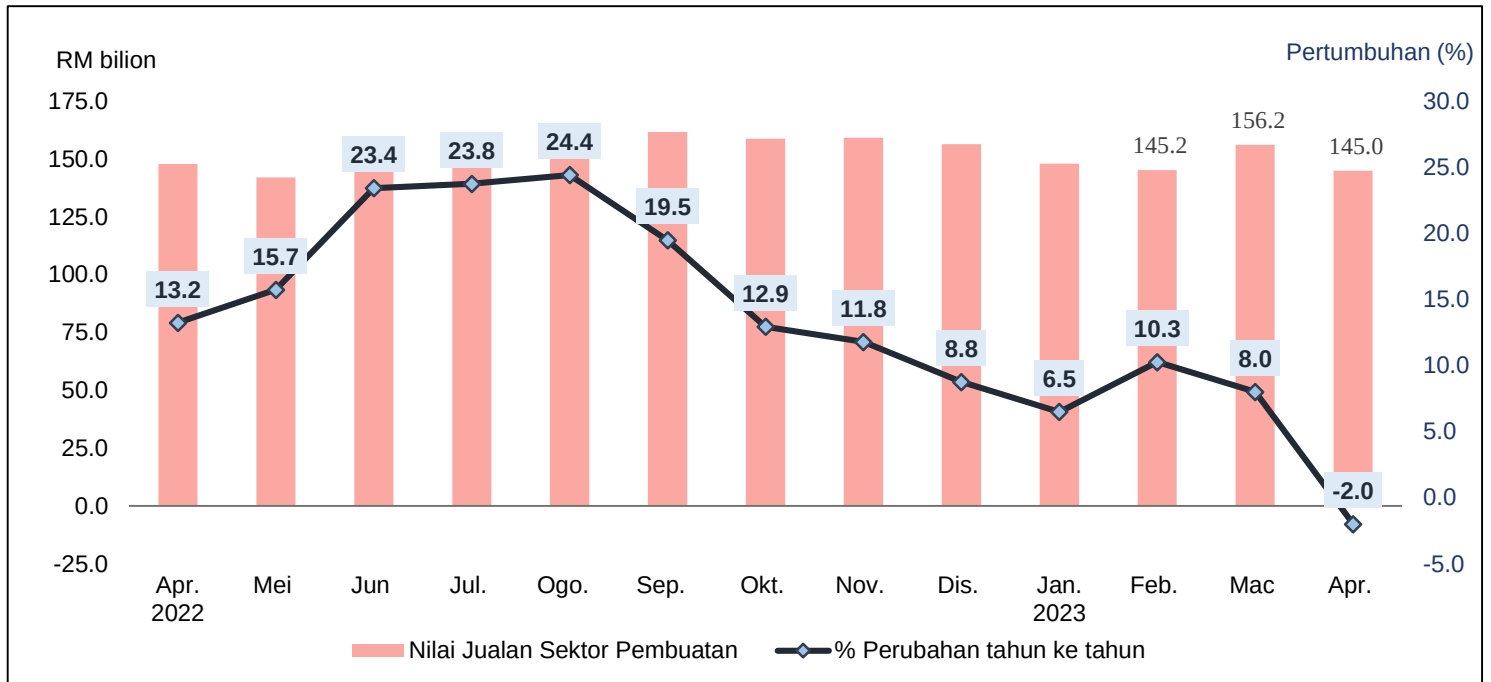

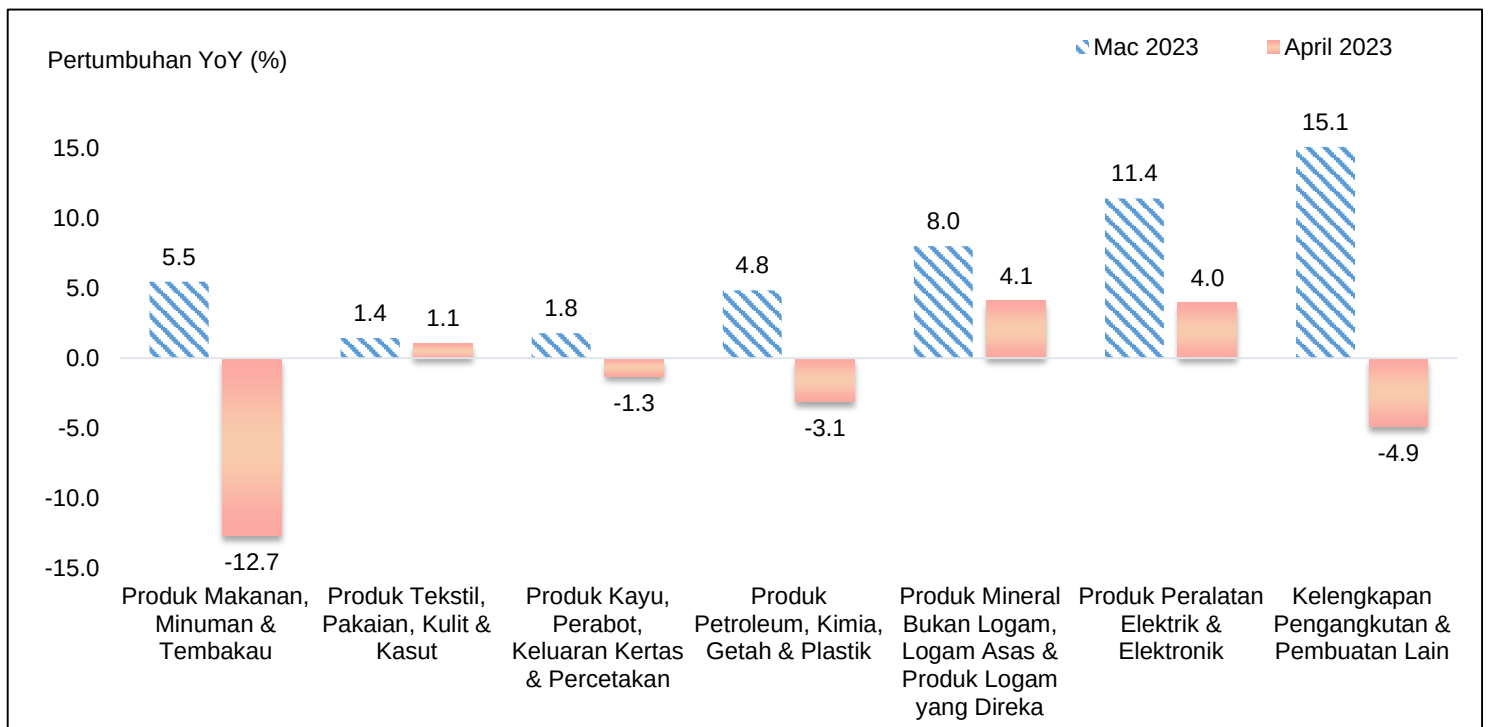

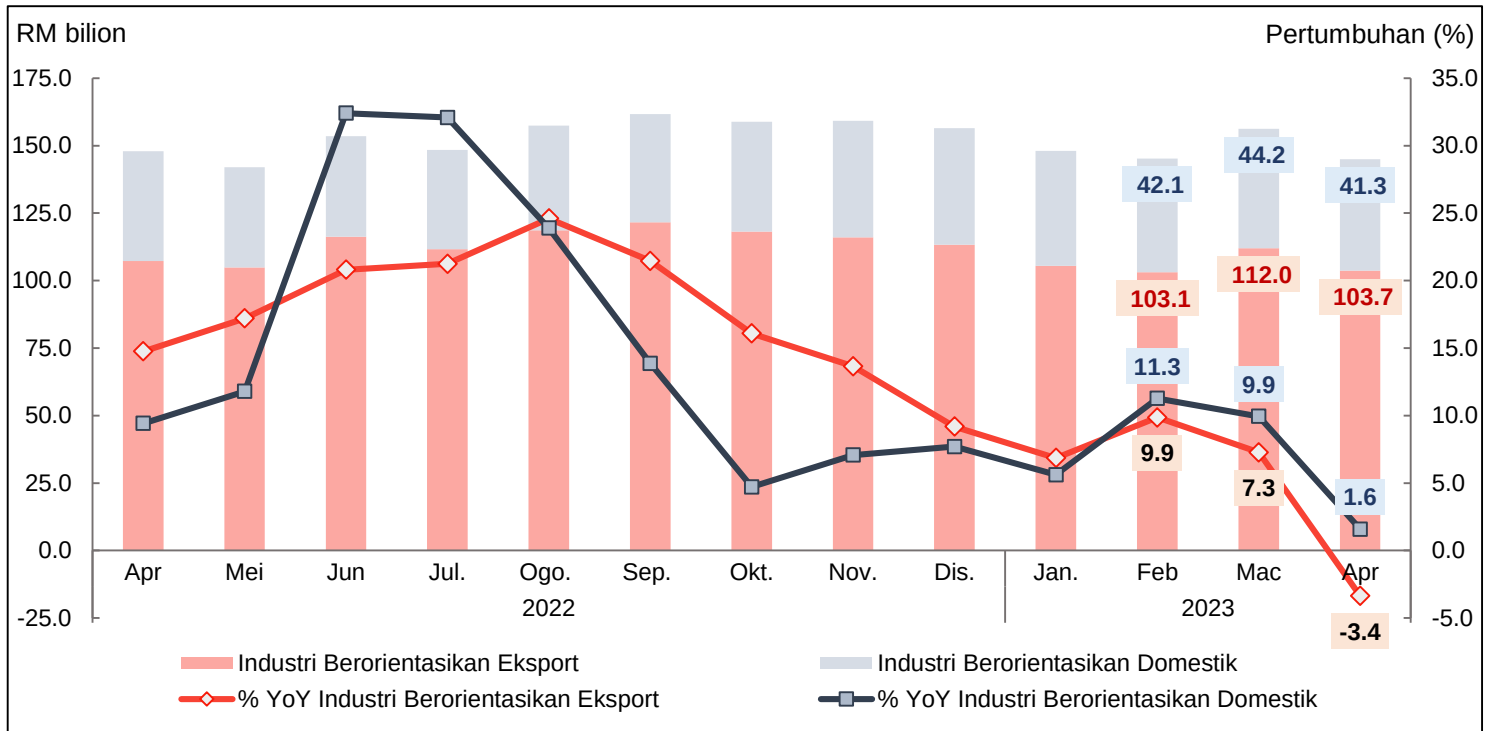
**Carta 1: Nilai Jualan Sektor Pembuatan,
April 2022 - April 2023**



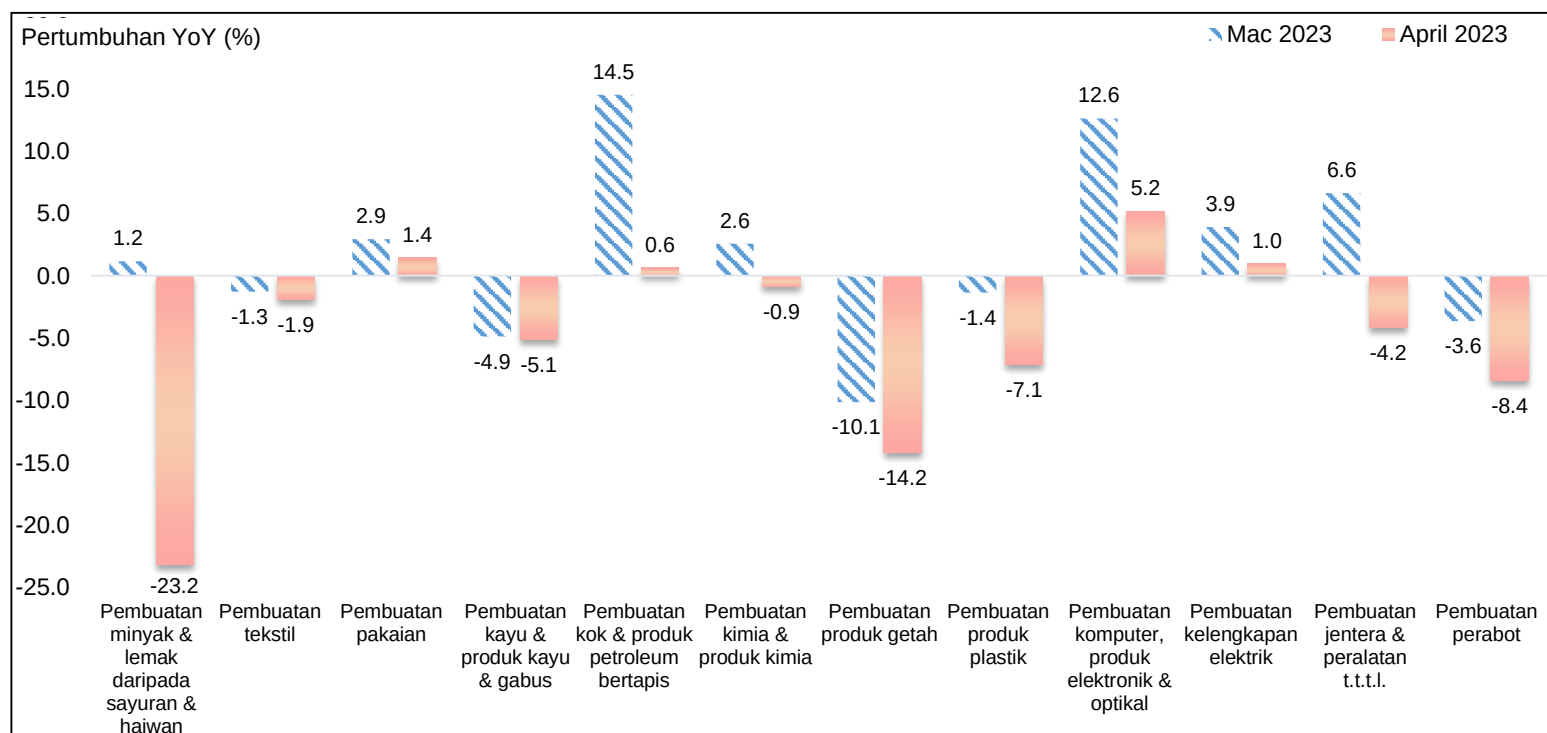
**Carta 2: Pertumbuhan Subsektor Pembuatan pada April 2023 berbanding
Mac 2023**



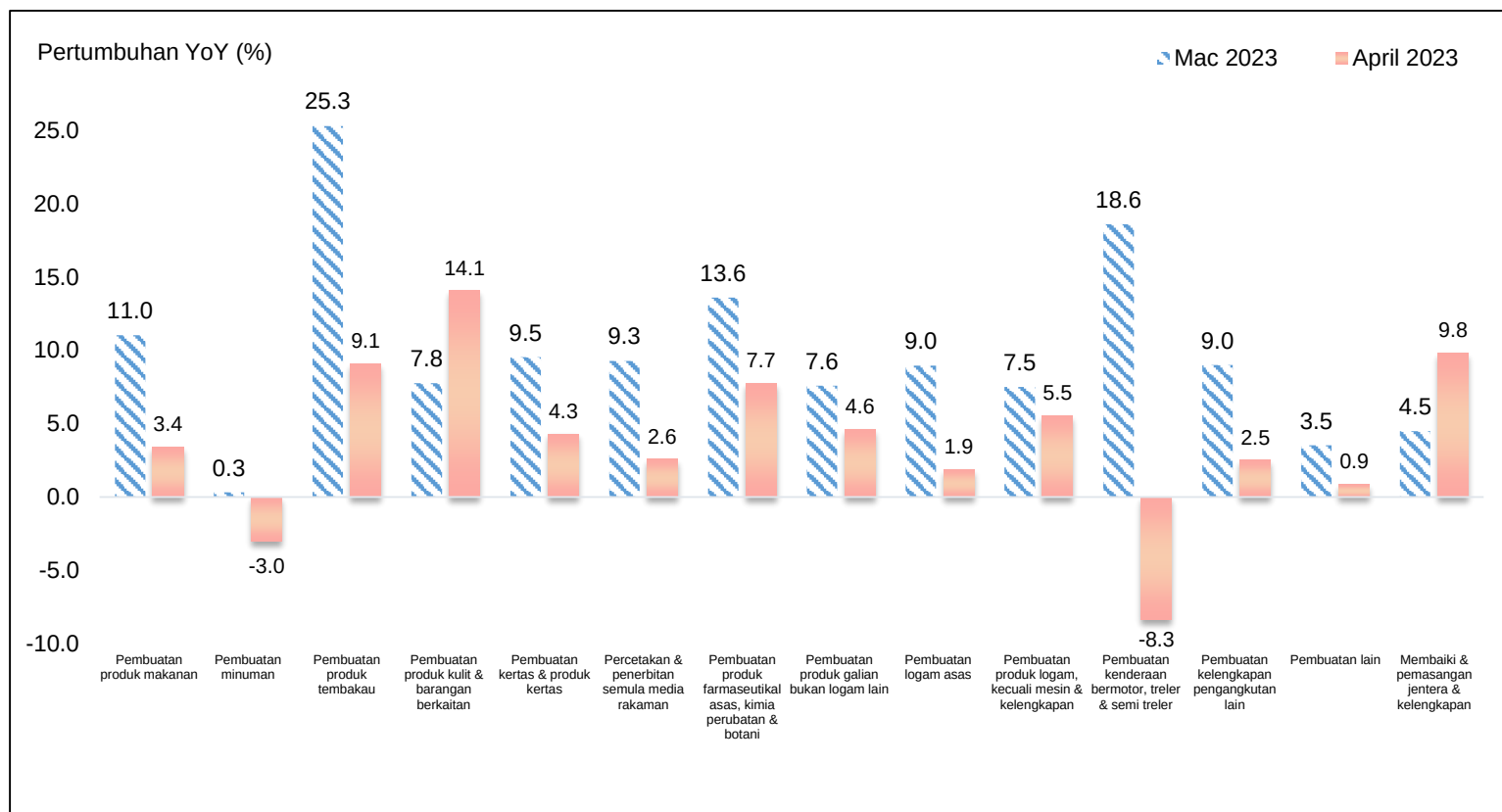
Carta 3: Nilai Jualan Industri Berorientasikan Eksport dan Domestik bagi Sektor Pembuatan, April 2022 - April 2023

MONTHLY MANUFACTURING STATISTICS, MALAYSIA, APRIL 2023

The sales value of the Manufacturing sector declined by 2.0 per cent to register RM145.0 billion in April 2023

PUTRAJAYA, 9 June 2023 – The sales value of the Manufacturing sector declined by 2.0 per cent to register RM145.0 billion in April 2023. The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) reported today on the release of **Monthly Manufacturing Statistics, Malaysia, April 2023**.

According to the Department of Statistics Malaysia, the sales value of the Manufacturing sector fell by 2.0 per cent in April 2023 after registering a positive growth of 8.0 per cent in March 2023, the lowest since May 2020. The decline was influenced mainly by the deterioration in Food, beverages & tobacco (-12.7%); Transport equipment & other manufactures (-4.9%); and Petroleum, chemical, rubber & plastics (-3.1%) sub-sectors. In comparison with the previous month, the sales value returned to a decline with negative 7.2 per cent as against an increase of 7.6 per cent registered in March 2023.

The sales value of export-oriented industries which accounted for 71.5 per cent of total sales recorded a decrease of 3.4 per cent in April 2023 after registering positive momentum since May 2020. The contraction was weighed down mainly by the Manufacture of vegetable & animal oils & fats (-23.2%); Manufacture of rubber products (-14.2%); and Manufacture of plastics products (-7.1%) industries. Nonetheless, the domestic-oriented industries maintained a positive trend with a growth of 1.6 per cent in April 2023, albeit at a slower pace as against 10.7 per cent registered in March 2023. The positive momentum in the domestic-oriented industries was primarily underpinned by the Manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery & equipment (5.5%); Manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products (4.6%); and Manufacture of food processing products (3.4%) industries. In comparison to the previous month, both export and domestic-oriented industries lessen by 7.2 per cent respectively.

There were 2.35 million persons engaged in the Manufacturing sector in April 2023, which increased by 2.5 per cent as against 2.29 million persons registered a year ago. The increase was supported mainly by the Food, beverages & tobacco products

(5.6%); Electrical & electronic products (4.2%); and Wood, furniture, paper products & printing (2.7%) sub-sectors. The number of persons engaged in these three sub-sectors encompasses more than half of the total employees in the Manufacturing sector. As compared to the preceding month, the number of employees in this sector edged down by 0.1 per cent.

In tandem with the addition in the number of employees, the salaries & wages paid in the Manufacturing sector went up by 3.9 per cent year-on-year, which amounted to RM8.02 billion in April 2023. In a month-on-month comparison, the salaries & wages declined by 1.9 per cent from RM8.17 billion which was recorded in March 2023. The average monthly salaries & wages per employee in April 2023 were higher by 1.4 per cent as compared to a year ago with a value of RM3,413 while the sales value per employee decreased by 4.4 per cent to record RM61,716.

Overall performance for January to April 2023, the sales value of the Manufacturing sector rose by 5.5 per cent, to register RM594.4 billion as against the same period of the preceding year. Meanwhile, the number of employees added by 2.5 per cent to record a total of 2.35 million persons with salaries & wages grew by 4.2 per cent to RM32.5 billion. Furthermore, sales value per employee registered a growth of 2.9 per cent, amounting to RM253,029 for the first four months of 2023.

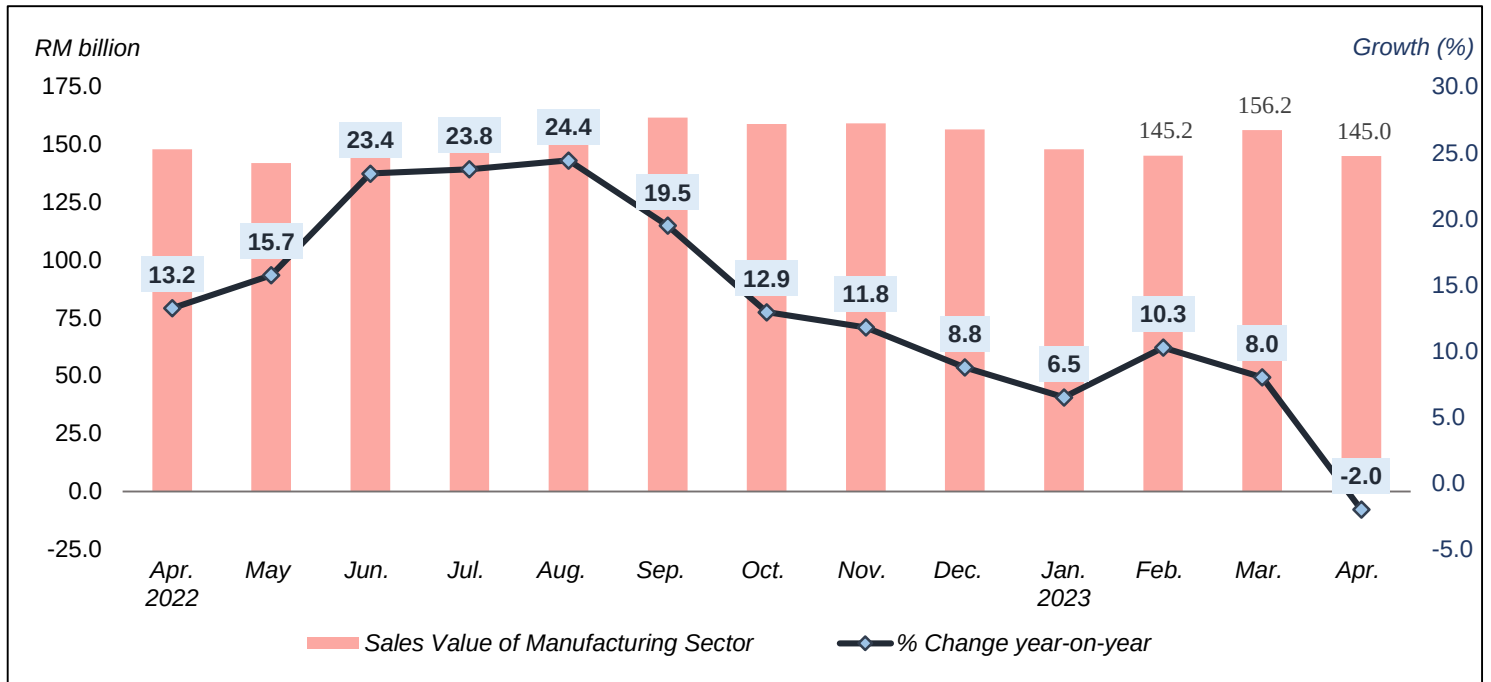

March 2023**

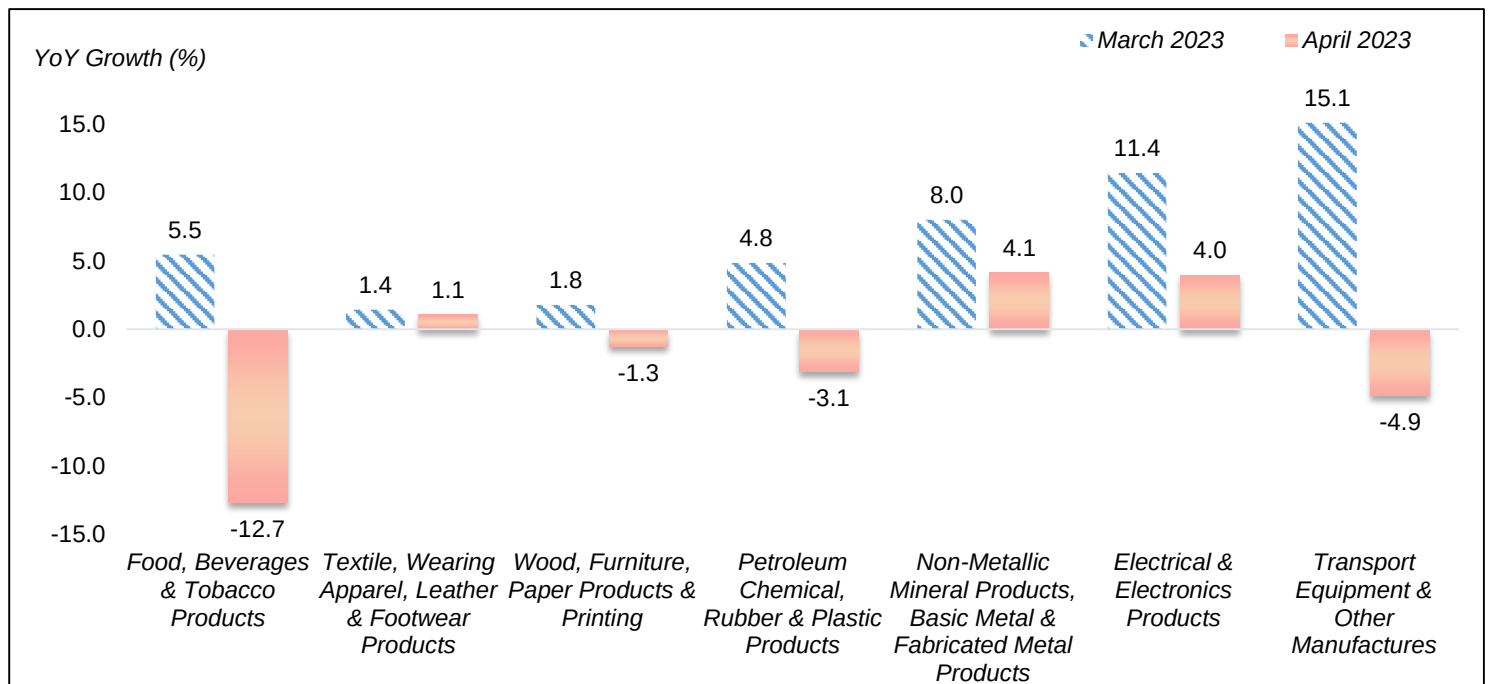


Chart 3: Sales Value of the Export and Domestic-oriented Industries for Manufacturing Sector, April 2022 – April 2023

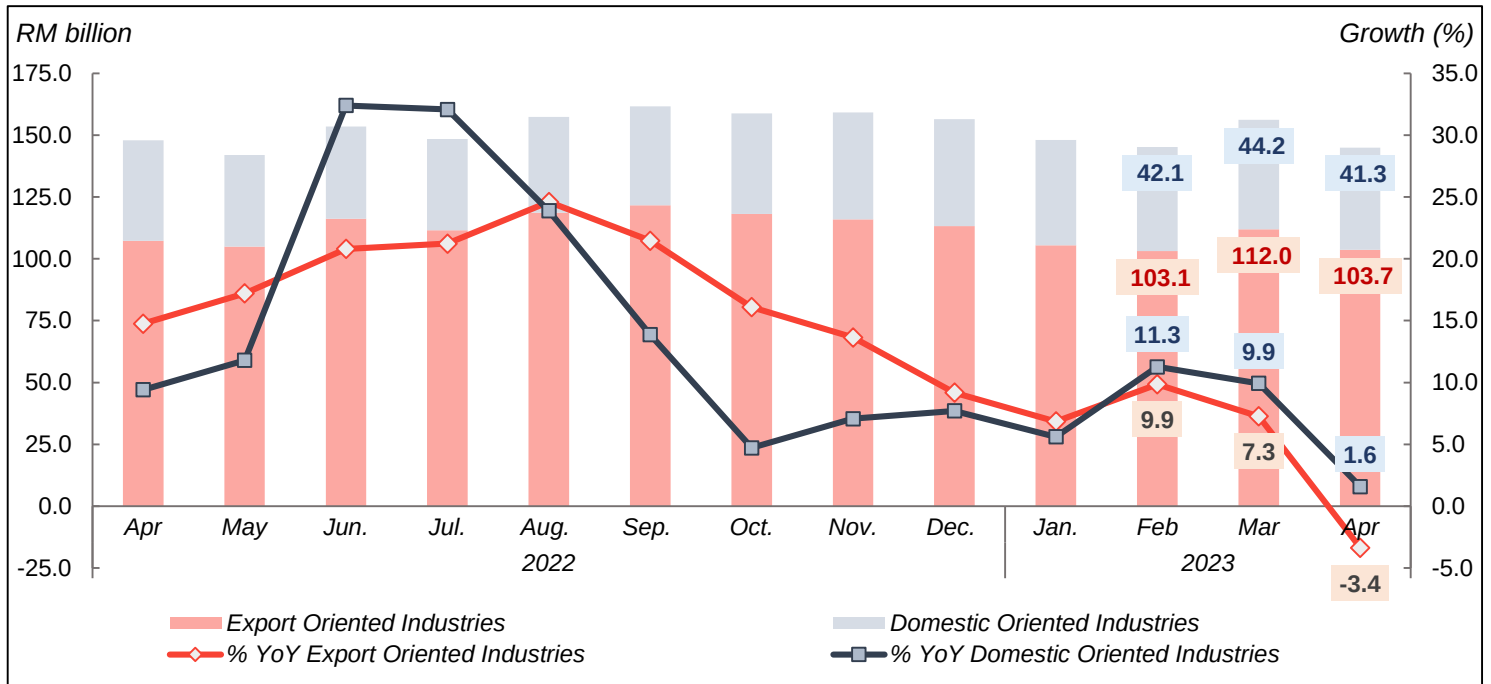
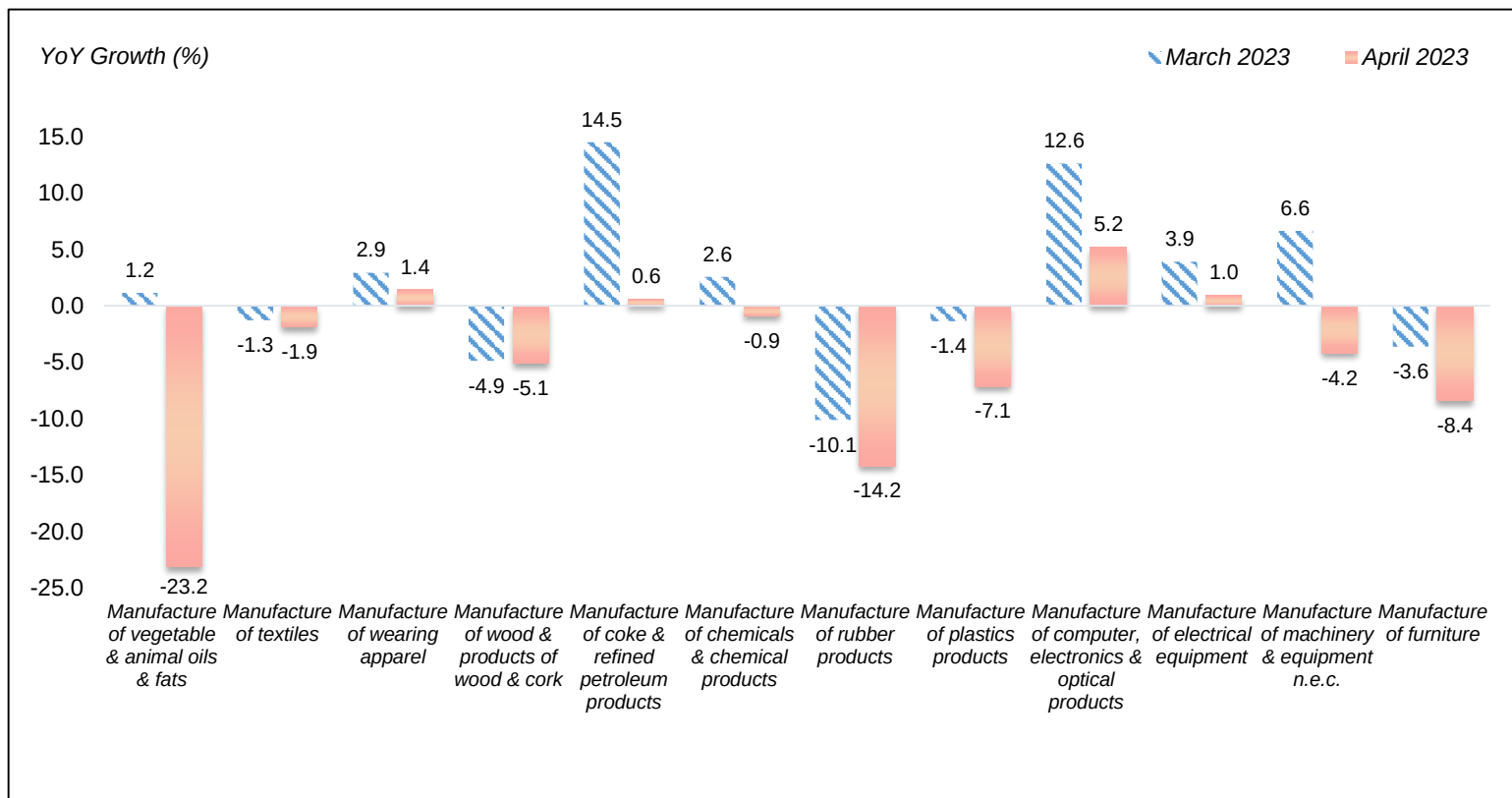
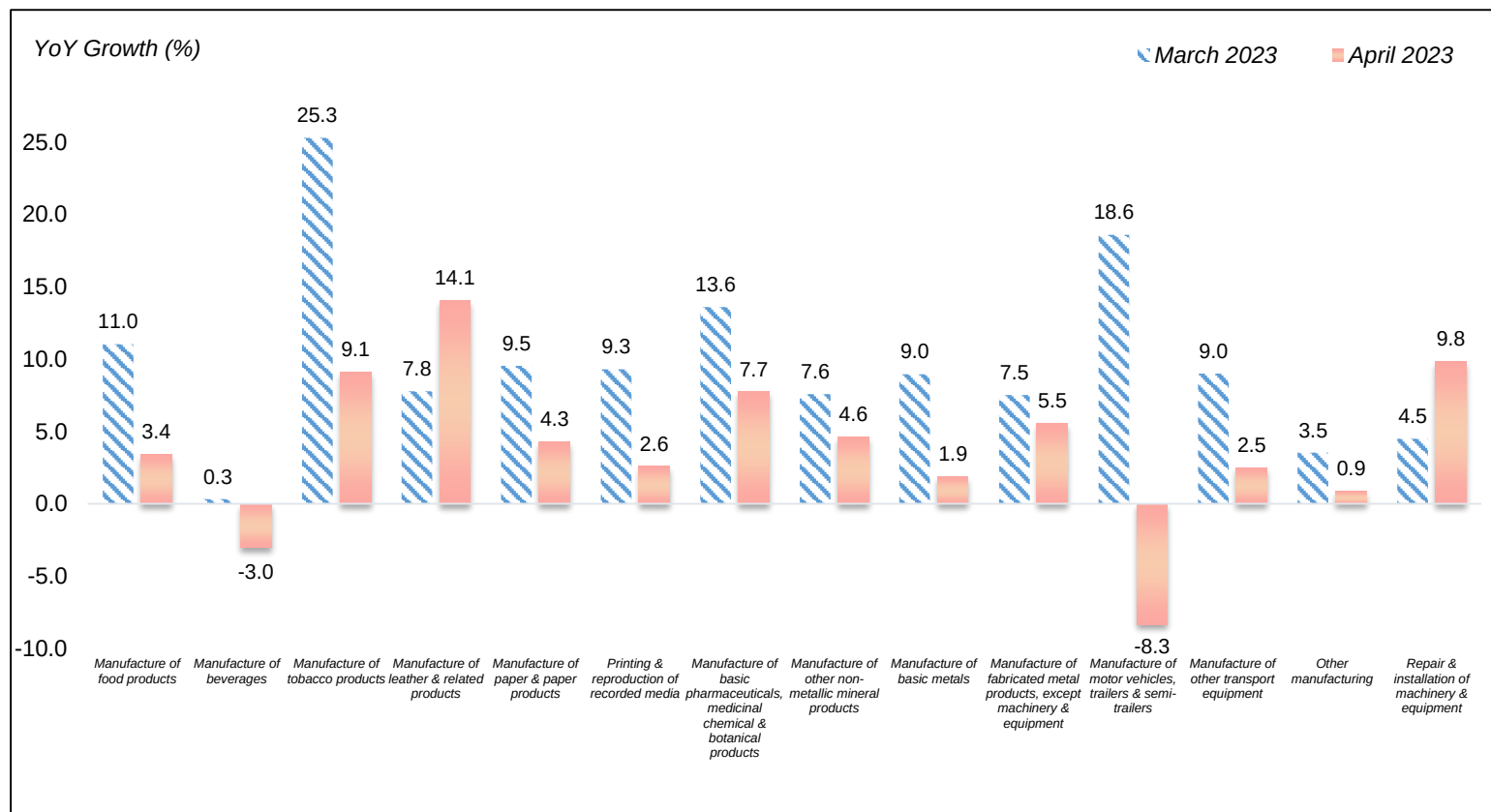


Chart 4: Manufacturing Export-Oriented by Group, March 2023 and April 2023
