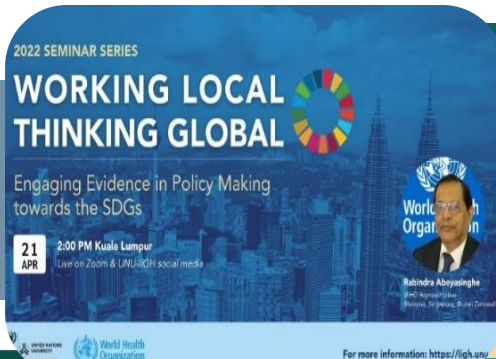

International Day of Sport for Development and Peace (IDSDP)

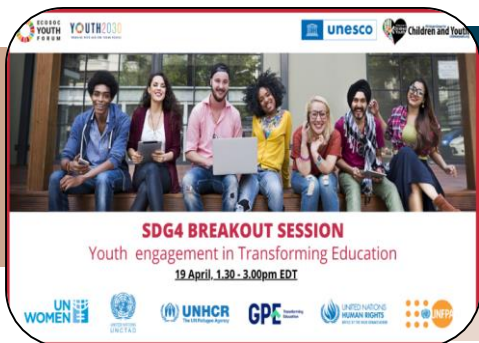

ECOSOC Youth Forum SDG4 Breakout Session: Youth Engagement in Transforming Education

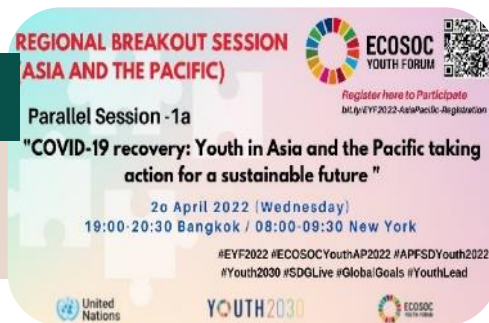
