OF THE YEAR 2022



Malaysia was voted as a member of the Governing Council of the Statistical Institute for Asia and the Pacific (GC SIAP) for the term 2022 - 2024.

Governing Council (GC) of the United Nations the Statistical Institute for Asia and the Pacific (UN SIAP): In accordance with its Statute, the Institute has a GC consisting of a representative designated by the Government of Japan and eight representatives nominated by other members and associate members of ESCAP elected by the Commission.

The Commission, at its seventy-eight session on 24th May 2022, in Bangkok, elected the following countries as members of the Governing Council for the period from 2022 to 2024: Bangladesh; China; India; Japan(Host Country); **Malaysia**; Philippines; Republic of Korea; Thailand; and Viet Nam.

Malaysia was elected to the GC SIAP as a member for the term 2022–2024, following ten (10) years of membership as an observer. Asia and the Pacific region members voted overwhelmingly in favour of Malaysia.

DOSM through Malaysia sent two (2) teams for each track named as GEMy (Big Data Expert) and Analygent (Youth).

On 29th December 2022, winning teams have been announced and GEMy has been chosen out of 37 teams from all over the world as the **Key Contributor**. The winning teams will present their project at the UN World Data Forum 2023 (UNWDF2023) in Hangzhou, China, and receive certificates and rewards.






DOSM continued strengthening international engagement in 2022 by participating in 225 international programmes involving 1,330 officers. In addition, DOSM was invited as an instructor, panelist, and presenter to 30 expert group meetings, courses, workshops, and international conferences involving 47 officers. 

ASEAN COMMUNITY STATISTICAL SYSTEM COMMITTEE (ACSS)

WHAT IS THE ACSS?

- The ACSS is a partnership between and among the national statistical systems of the ASEAN Member States (AMSs), the ASEAN Community Councils, and the ASEAN Secretariat.
- The ACSS Committee is the highest policy-making and coordinating body on statistical matters in the ASEAN region. It was formally established in 2011 as a reconstitution of the ASEAN Heads of Statistical Offices Meeting (AHSOM).
- The ACSS Committee shall be responsible for strengthening regional statistical cooperation in support of the ASEAN Community, and provide professional guidance on the production, dissemination, and communication of ASEAN
- The ACSS Committee meets once a year or more, as necessary while Chairmanship is on a rotating basis, following the ASEAN chairmanship.

WHO ARE THE MAJOR PARTNERS?

- · The ACSS Committee is the highest regional policymaking and coordinating body on ASEAN statistics.
- The national statistical systems of all ASEAN Member States, with the national statistical office (NSO) as the country focal point on ASEAN statistics.
- The ASEAN Secretariat, through the ASEANstats, is the regional focal point of ASEAN statistics and the technical arm and secretariat of the ACSS Committee.
- The ASEAN Community Councils, through its ASEAN bodies, as the primary stakeholders.

TO WHOM SHALL THE COMMITTEE **REPORT?**

- To the ASEAN Economic Ministers (AEM) Meeting through the Senior Economic Official Meeting (SEOM);
- For the pillar-specific inputs and consultations, the Committee shall consult the ASEAN bodies under the pillars political-Security respective (ASEAN ASEAN Economic Community, and Community. ASEAN Socio-Cultural Community), and report its outcome to the AEM through SEOM.

Currently, there are seven (7) Working Groups (WGs) under ACSS Committee, namely:

- · ACSS Sub-Committee on Planning and Coordination (SCPC)
- WG on International Merchandise Trade Statistics
- WG on International Investment Statistics (WGIIS):
- WG on International Trade in Services (WGSITS);
- WG on Sustainable Development Goals Indicators (WGSDGIs):
- WG on System National Accounts (WGSNA);
- WG on Data Sharing, Analysis, Dissemination and Communication Statistics (WGDSA); and



ACSS-SCPC

The ACSS-SCPC was installed along with the ACSS Committee in November 2011, to address the strong need for coordination of statistical activities at the regional level in meeting the expanded coverage of statistics under the purview of the ACSS Committee. It assumes the role of the focal point and provides leadership support to the Committee Chair.

WGIMTS

The main objective of the ASEAN WCIMTS is to facilitate the development and harmonization of IMTS, enhance the timeliness and effectiveness of IMTS data sharing and dissemination, and to better respond to the information requirements in support of economic integration and development as envisaged in the ASEAN Economic Community Blueprint Community Blueprint.

WGIIS

The objective of the WGIIS is to promote the development, compilation, dissemination, and reporting of international investment statistics by ASEAN Member States for the design, development, implementation, and monitoring of ASEAN investment policies and programs. The ToR of the WGIIS was adopted at the Second of the ACSS Committee in September 2012

WGSITS

WGSITS is responsible for: 1) reflecting its permanent status within the decision-making framework of the ACSS Committee; 2) taking account the initiative on the harmonization of SITS; and 3) addressing the emerging needs for more detailed, more comparable, and more comprehensive SITS in various forms.

WGDSA

The WGDSA aims to improve the national and regional capacities in development and analysis, dissemination communication of statistics in support of regional policy and program implementation, monitoring/evaluation, and improved governance and accountability in ASEAN.

WGSDGI

The 5th Session of the ACSS Committee endorsed the TOR of WGSDGI and requested to start working on the implementation plan of the ASEAN SDG data compilation in AMS, including defining the SDG priority indicators, harmonization of the indicators, data collection templates and procedures, as well as data dissemination/communication, which is in line with ASEAN Community Vision 2025 and its Blueprints.

WGSNA

The WGSNA carries out its functions and activities under the purview of the ASEAN Community Statistical System (ACSS) Committee. The 5th Session of the ACSS Committee endorsed the TOR of WGSNA with the immediate mandate to start working on developing the ASEAN 2008 SNA roadmap/work plan in line with ACSS Strategic Plan 2016-2025.



The Twelfth Session of the ASEAN Community Statistical System Committee (ACSS12), hosted by the National Institute of Statistics Cambodia, was held virtually on 21 to 23 November 2022. The Session was chaired by Madam Hang Lina, with Dr. Imam Machdi as the Co-chairperson.

Aligned with the overall theme of Cambodia's ASEAN Chairmanship in 2022 "ASEAN A.C.T: Addressing Challenge Together", and as part of our continuous commitment to further enhance regional statistical cooperation and respond proactively to emerging statistical requirements, we adopted the following theme for 2022 ACSS work programme: "Speedy Recovery from the Impacts of COVID-19 Pandemic"
















UNITED NATIONS STATISTICAL COMMISSION (UN STATCOM)

The United Nations Statistical Commission (UN StatCom), established in 1947, is the highest body of the global statistical system bringing together the Chief Statisticians from member states from around the world. It is the highest decision-making body for international statistical activities, responsible for setting statistical standards and the development of concepts and methods, including their implementation at the national and international levels. The Statistical Commission oversees the work of the United Nations Statistics Division (UNSD), and it is a Functional Commission of the UN Economic and Social Council.

In 2022, Malaysia joined the 53 rd UN StatCom (#UN52SC) virtually led by YBhg Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia. A total of 38 agenda items with 55 supporting documents were discussed and finalised, resulting in crucial decisions for the development of the global statistical system. Malaysia's full engagement and contribution continued during the session, with the submission of 38 written national statements and the delivery of 10 virtual oral statements.





SESSION OF THE COMMITTEE ON STATISTICS OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COMMISSION FOR ASIA AND THE PACIFIC (UNESCAP)

The Committee on Statistics addresses the following issues:

- Ensure that by 2020 all countries in the region have the capability to provide a basic range of population, economic, social, and environmental statistics;
- Create a more adaptive and cost-effective information management environment for national statistical offices through stronger collaboration.

SESSION OF THE STATISTICAL INSTITUTE FOR ASIA AND THE PACIFIC (SIAP) GOVERNING COUNCIL

In accordance with its Statute, the Institute has a Governing Council consisting of a representative designated by the Government of Japan and eight representatives nominated by other members and associate members of ESCAP elected by the Commission. The Eighteenth session of the SIAP Governing Council was held from 12th to 13th December 2022 in Chiba, Japan, and Malaysia has been elected as the Chair of the session. The session was held together with the 8th Network for the Coordination of Statistical Training in Asia and the Pacific (the Network) on 13th December 2023 and the 17th Management Seminar for the Heads of National Statistical Offices (NSOs) in Asia and the Pacific on 14 to 15 December 2023 with the theme "Data Governance". Malaysia was represented by YBhg Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia, and Mr. Zuraidy Zainal Abidin, Director of Malaysia Statistical Training Institute.





SESSION OF THE OIC STATISTICAL COMMISSION (OIC-STATCOM)

OIC-Statistical Commission (OIC-StatCom) is an initiative by SESRIC. It was established in 2011 with the aim of enhancing the cooperation among the National Statistical Organisations (NSOs) of the member countries with a view to supporting their national statistical systems for the development of better national strategies and policies. The OIC Stat-Com is an important instrumental platform for cooperation among the NSOs of the member countries similar to the UN Statistical Commission (UNSC). In its capacity as the secretariat of the OIC-StatCom, SESRIC assumes the role of organizing the annual sessions of this Commission and following up on the activities of its working groups.

SESRIC, in its capacity as the Secretariat of the OIC Statistical Commission (OIC-StatCom), organised the eleventh Session of the OIC-StatCom in a hybrid format at its Headquarters in Ankara, Republic of Türkiye, on 18-19 October 2022 in collaboration with the Islamic Development Bank (IsDB) Group. The Session brought together 96 participants from the National Statistical Offices of 39 OIC countries and Malaysia represented by Ms. Norhayati Jantan, Senior Director of National Accounts Statistics Division. The Session has been also attended by representatives of 10 international and regional organisations.

The 53rd United Nations Statistical Commis 28th February – 4th March 2022 sion (UNSC)

Malaysia's key achievements in statistics have been documented in the UN commission's official report 2022

PUTRALAYA, MARCH 5, 2022 — The second virtual statistics commission, which took place from 28th February to 2nd March and on 4th March 2022, draw over 300 delegations from 100 nations and covered 25 areas of twick in Official Statistics. UNISC is externally influential in the formation of ractional statistics systems where statistical standards, guidelines, classifications, methodologies and concepts are developed, discussed and endorsed for implementation at the national and international level.

The Malaysian delegation was led by YBhg Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Utir Mahldin, Chief Statistician, the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM). A total of 38 agenda tems with 55 supporting documents were discussed and finalised, resulting in crucial decisions for the development of the global statistical system. Malaysia's full engagement and contribution cortinued during the session, with the submission of 38 written national statements and the delivery of 19 virtual oral statements.

Malaysia highlighted to the commission the importance of data stewardship, population and housing censuses, gender statistics, health statistics, environmental-economic accounting, national account, ICT statistics, agriculture and untal statistics, informal economy statistics and big data as well as scient. DOBM initiatives to improve the aforementoned statistics, in the margins of this statistical commission, Malaysia's initiatives to collect health data and provide advance estimates of GDP during the COVID-19 pandemic are also shared-with the world community.

Malaysia emphased the necessity of data stewardship in the National Statistical System. Thus, Malaysia has been invited to join the Working Group on Data Stewardship in order to contribute its expertise and experience for furthering he concept of data stewardship, continuing the stockclaking exercise, compiling best practises and providing recommendations and guidance on data stewardship and the role of statistical offices in the new data ecosystem.

Malaysia called for and encouraged the use of ICT and digitisation to moderniae the population and housing census, cling Malaysia's achievements and successes in implementing the Malaysia Population and Housing Census 2000 (MyCensus 2020) at a critical moment when many countries had postponed its






