More specifically, the meeting has discussed different ways and types that citizens can be engaged in producing data and making an impact on policies; discussed the possibility of a conceptual framework on ways of citizens being engaged in data production and use and in filing SDG data gap; reviews challenges of integrating these data into official statistics and policy processes and discussed how the international community could support the engagement with citizens in various ways through sharing of and documenting experiences and providing guidance.














Annual meeting of the Special Programme for the Economies of Central Asia (SPECA) Working Group on Gender and SDGs


