For the first time this year DOSM has published five Reports of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) Indicators, Malaysia, 2021 consist of the Executive Summary and four reports based on five focus areas of SDG, namely People; Prosperity; Planet; Peace and Partnership. The availability of indicators in 2021 showed a significant increase to 71 per cent (175 indicators) as compared to 59 per cent (146 indicators) in the previous year.
