BAGI STATISTIK EKSPORT IMPORT MENGIKUT NEGERI JULAI 2023

EKSPORT BAGI ENAM NEGERI MENCATATKAN PENINGKATAN PADA BULAN JULAI 2023

PUTRAJAYA, 28 Ogos 2023 – Malaysia mencatatkan jumlah perdagangan bernilai RM216.4 bilion pada Julai 2023 dengan nilai eksport RM116.8 bilion dan import bernilai RM99.7 bilion seperti yang dilaporkan hari ini dalam **STATISTIK EKSPORT IMPORT MENGIKUT NEGERI JULAI 2023**.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata prestasi eksport Malaysia pada Julai 2023 bernilai RM116.8 bilion, menurun sebanyak RM17.6 billion (-13.1%) berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Penurunan eksport dipengaruhi oleh eksport yang lebih rendah di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Johor (-RM8.2 bilion), Sarawak (-RM3.4 bilion), Selangor (-RM3.4 bilion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM3.3 bilion), Terengganu (-RM1.1 bilion), Sabah (-RM860.5 juta), Melaka (-RM446.1 juta), Negeri Sembilan (-RM238.6 juta) dan Perak (-RM27.4 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai eksport meningkat di Pulau Pinang sebanyak RM2.1 bilion, Kedah (+RM1.2 bilion), W.P. Labuan (+RM462.3 juta), Kelantan (+RM167.4 juta), Perlis (+RM6.4 juta) dan Pahang (+RM6.2 juta).

Pulau Pinang kekal sebagai pengeksport utama dengan sumbangan 33.9 peratus, diikuti oleh Johor (19.6%), Selangor (17.8%), Sarawak (7.0%) dan Kedah (4.4%).

Beralih kepada prestasi import mengikut negeri, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin memaklumkan import pada bulan Julai 2023 juga menurun RM18.8 bilion (-15.9%) berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Penurunan import disebabkan oleh import yang lebih rendah di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Pulau Pinang (-RM5.8 bilion), Johor (-RM4.9 bilion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM2.5 bilion), Selangor (-RM2.0 bilion), Kedah (-RM1.2 bilion), Sarawak (-RM811.8 juta), Perak (-RM644.6 juta), Pahang (-RM427.5 juta), Negeri Sembilan (-RM405.6 bilion), Terengganu (-RM68.6 juta) dan Sabah (-RM49.3 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai import meningkat di Melaka sebanyak RM226.2 juta, W.P. Labuan (+RM136.7 juta), Kelantan (+RM20.2 juta) dan Perlis (+RM1.7 juta).


Selangor terus mendominasi import Malaysia dengan 27.8 peratus, diikuti oleh Johor (22.9%), Pulau Pinang (19.6%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (7.2%) dan Sarawak (5.0%).

FOR EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE JULY 2023

EXPORTS OF SIX STATES REGISTERED AN INCREASE IN JULY 2023

PUTRAJAYA, 28 August 2023 – Malaysia's total trade for July 2023 amounted to RM216.4 billion with exports and imports recorded RM116.8 billion and RM99.7 billion, respectively as reported today in **EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE JULY 2023**.

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said exports was valued at RM116.8 billion in July 2023, decreased RM17.6 billion (-13.1%) as compared to the same month of the previous year. The decrease in exports was attributed to the lower exports in most states such as Johor (-RM8.2 billion), Sarawak (-RM3.4 billion), Selangor (-RM3.4 billion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM3.3 billion), Terengganu (-RM1.1 billion), Sabah (-RM860.5 million), Melaka (-RM446.1 million), Negeri Sembilan (-RM238.6 million) and Perak (-RM27.4 million). However, exports increased in Pulau Pinang by RM2.1 billion, Kedah (+RM1.2 billion), W.P. Labuan (+RM462.3 million), Kelantan (+RM167.4 million), Perlis (+RM6.4 million) and Pahang (+RM6.2 million).

Pulau Pinang remained as the top exporter with 33.9 per cent share, followed by Johor (19.6%), Selangor (17.8%), Sarawak (7.0%) and Kedah (4.4%).

Looking at the performance of imports by state, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said imports also decreased RM18.8 billion (-15.9%) in July 2023 as compared to the same month in 2022. The decrease in imports was contributed by the lower imports in most states such as Pulau Pinang (-RM5.8 billion), Johor (-RM4.9 billion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM2.5 billion), Selangor (-RM2.0 billion), Kedah (-RM1.2 billion), Sarawak

(-RM811.8 million), Perak (-RM644.6 million), Pahang (-RM427.5 million), Negeri Sembilan (-RM405.6 million), Terengganu (-RM68.6 million) and Sabah (-RM49.3 million). However, imports increased in Melaka by RM226.2 million, W.P. Labuan (+RM136.7 million), Kelantan (+RM20.2 million) and Perlis (+RM1.7 million).

Selangor continued to dominate Malaysia's imports with a share of 27.8 per cent, followed by Johor (22.9%), Pulau Pinang (19.6%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (7.2%) and Sarawak (5.0%).

Chart 1: Time Series Data on Exports and Imports in Johor, Pulau Pinang and Selangor, July 2022 – July 2023 (RM Billion)




Exhibit 1: Infographic on Export Import Statistics by State, July 2023
