PERANGKAAN PEMBUATAN BULANAN, MALAYSIA, OGOS 2023

Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan mencatatkan penurunan 3.3 peratus dengan merekodkan RM152.3 bilion pada Ogos 2023

PUTRAJAYA, 12 Oktober 2023 - Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan mencatatkan penurunan sebanyak 3.3 peratus tahun ke tahun dengan merekodkan RM152.3 bilion pada Ogos 2023. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) melaporkan dalam keluaran **Perangkaan Pembuatan Bulanan, Malaysia, Ogos 2023** pada hari ini.

Mengulas prestasi nilai jualan Pembuatan terkini, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata, "Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan terus merosot kepada 3.3 peratus pada Ogos 2023 selepas merekodkan negatif 3.0 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya. Penurunan tersebut dipengaruhi terutamanya oleh subsektor Petroleum, kimia, getah & plastik yang menurun 12.1 peratus, mencatatkan penurunan dua digit selama tiga bulan berturut-turut. Tambahan lagi, kemerosotan ini juga disumbangkan oleh penyusutan dalam subsektor Makanan, minuman & tembakau (-6.6%) dan Produk kayu, perabot, keluaran kertas & percetakan (-0.1%). Bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, nilai jualan pulih kepada 5.8 peratus berbanding negatif 2.4 peratus yang dicatatkan pada Julai 2023."

Nilai jualan industri berorientasikan eksport yang merangkumi 72.7 peratus daripada jumlah jualan, menurun 6.7 peratus pada Ogos 2023 (Julai 2023: -7.0%). Penguncupan ini disebabkan terutamanya oleh industri Pembuatan kok & produk petroleum bertapis (-19.7%); Pembuatan minyak & lemak daripada sayuran & haiwan (-15.1%); dan Pembuatan produk getah (-8.8%). Sebaliknya, kemerosotan dalam nilai jualan dikurangkan oleh industri berorientasikan domestik secara berterusan, dengan pertumbuhan 7.2 peratus pada Ogos 2023 (Julai 2023: 9.1%). Kestabilan momentum ini sebahagian besarnya disokong oleh peningkatan kukuh dalam nilai jualan industri Pembuatan kenderaan bermotor, treler & semi treler yang melonjak sebanyak 15.0 peratus, serta industri Pembuatan produk logam, kecuali mesin & kelengkapan pada 10.4 peratus. Tambahan lagi, industri Pembuatan produk galian bukan logam lain dan Pembuatan prosesan produk makanan meningkat masing-masing sebanyak 7.1 peratus dan 6.0 peratus. Perbandingan bulan ke bulan, industri berorientasikan eksport dan domestik masing-masing berkembang sebanyak 6.7 peratus dan 3.5 peratus.

Mengulas mengenai bilangan pekerja, Ketua Perangkawan menyatakan, “Sektor Pembuatan melibatkan seramai 2.36 juta orang pada Ogos 2023, mencatatkan peningkatan 2.0 peratus berbanding 2.31 juta orang yang direkodkan setahun lalu. Penambahan itu sebahagian besarnya disumbangkan dalam subsektor Makanan, minuman dan tembakau (6.2%); Produk kayu, perabot, keluaran kertas & percetakan (2.6%); dan Produk Mineral Bukan Logam, Logam Asas dan Produk Logam yang Direka (2.2%). Berbanding bulan sebelumnya, bilangan pekerja dalam sektor ini meningkat secara marginal sebanyak 0.6 peratus”.

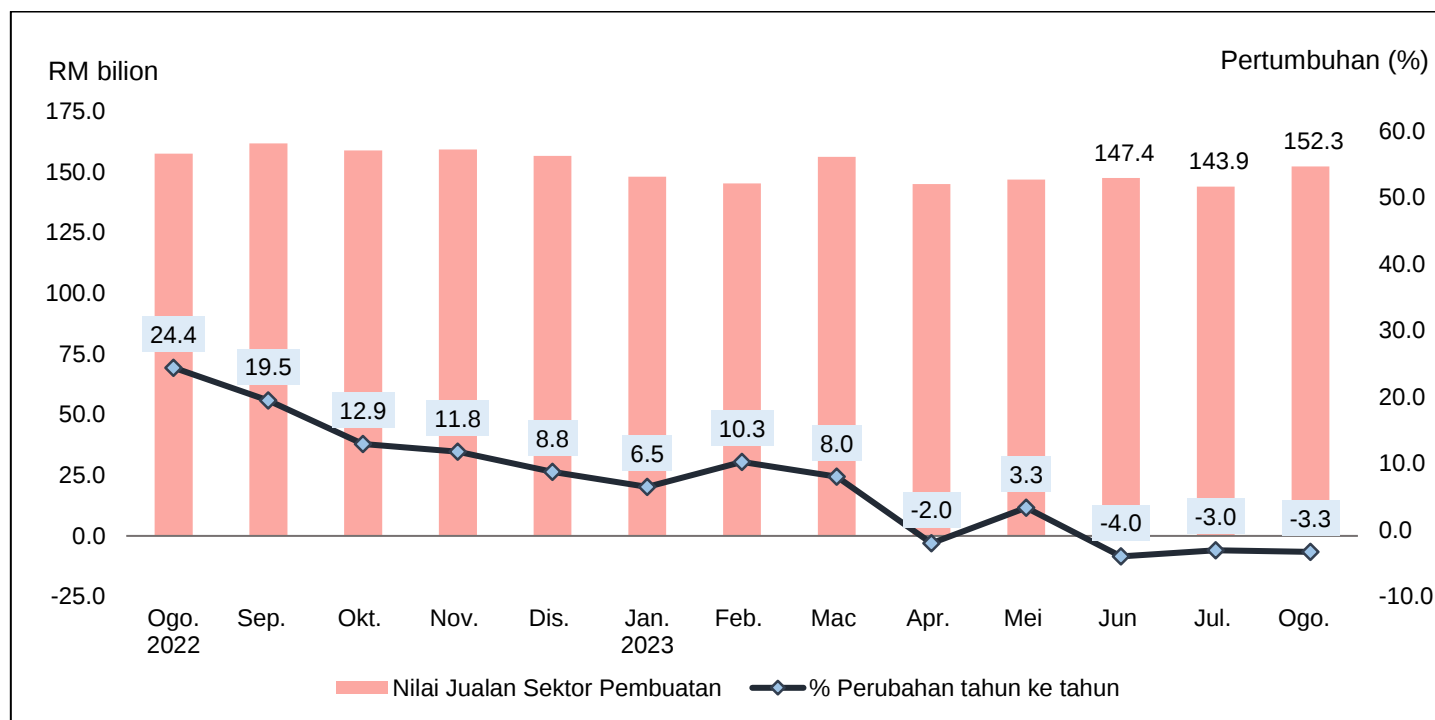
Selaras dengan itu, gaji & upah yang dibayar dalam sektor Pembuatan juga meningkat sebanyak 3.0 peratus tahun ke tahun, dengan sejumlah RM8.0 bilion pada Ogos 2023. Bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, gaji & upah meningkat 0.9 peratus daripada RM7.9 bilion yang direkodkan pada Julai 2023. Tambahan lagi, purata gaji & upah bulanan bagi setiap pekerja mencatatkan kenaikan sebanyak 1.0 peratus dengan nilai RM3,397 manakala nilai jualan bagi setiap pekerja jatuh sebanyak 5.2 peratus kepada RM64,660.

Merumuskan prestasi bagi lapan bulan pertama tahun 2023, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata, “Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan mencapai RM1,184.8 bilion, berkembang sebanyak 1.7 peratus berbanding tempoh yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Pada tempoh tersebut, bilangan pekerja meningkat sebanyak 2.0 peratus untuk merekodkan seramai 2.36 juta orang manakala gaji & upah meningkat 3.7 peratus, mencatatkan RM64.6 bilion. Sementara itu, nilai jualan per pekerja merosot sedikit sebanyak 0.2 peratus, dengan jumlah RM503,093.”

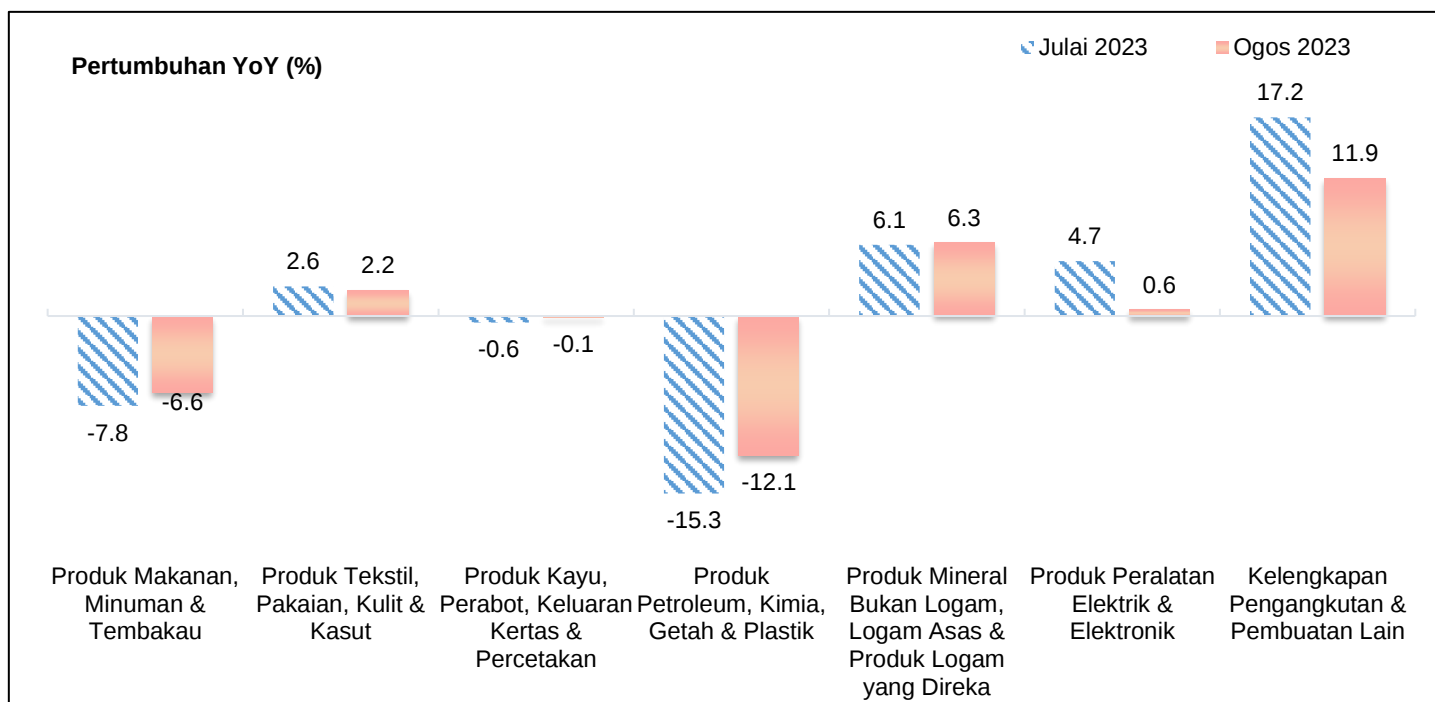

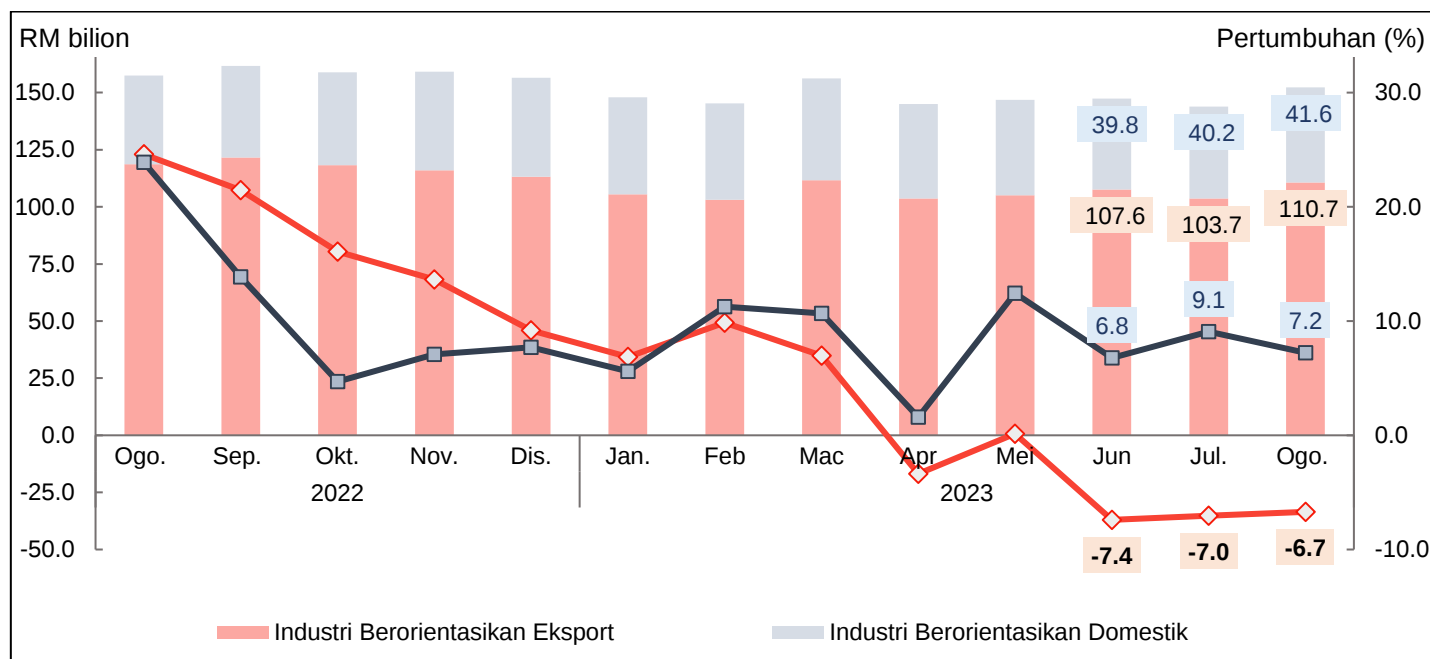
**Carta 1: Nilai Jualan Sektor Pembuatan, Malaysia
Ogos 2022 - Ogos 2023**



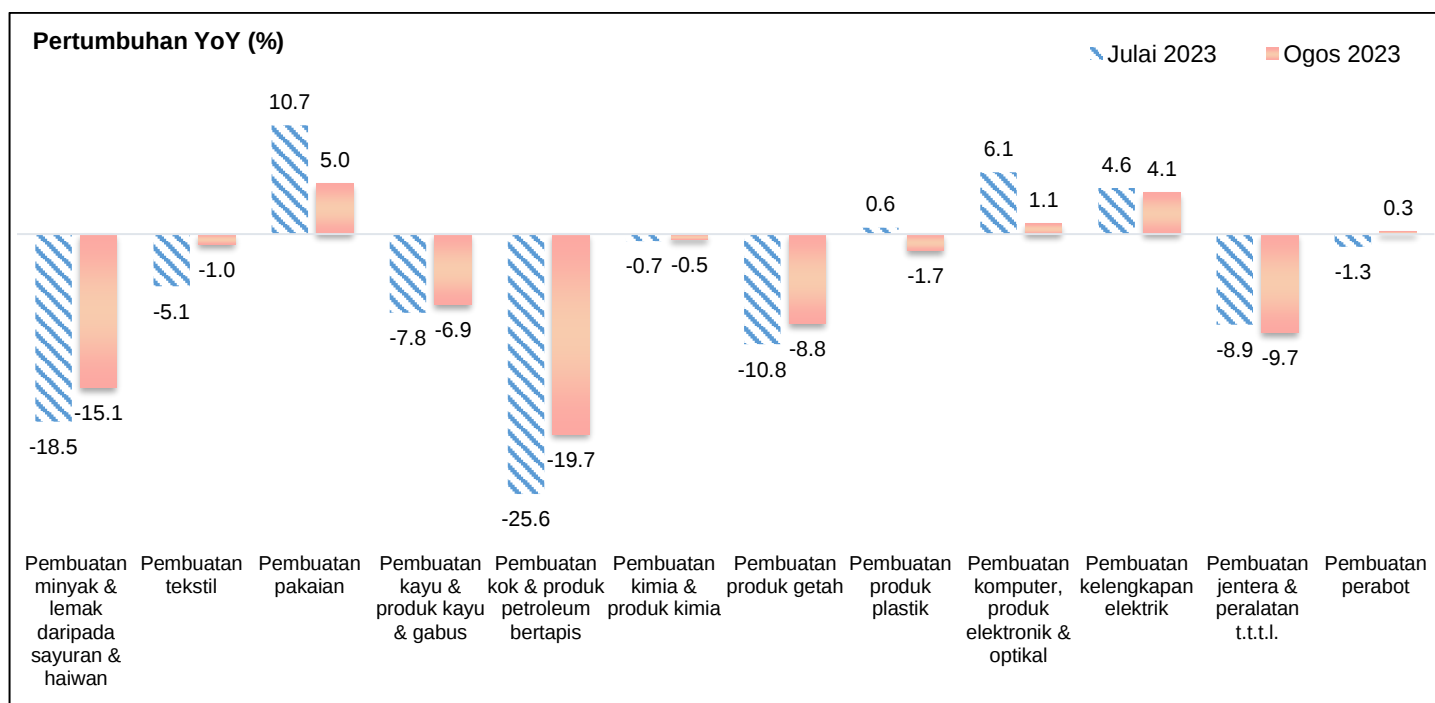
**Carta 2: Pertumbuhan Jualan Subsektor Pembuatan, Malaysia,
Julai dan Ogos 2023**



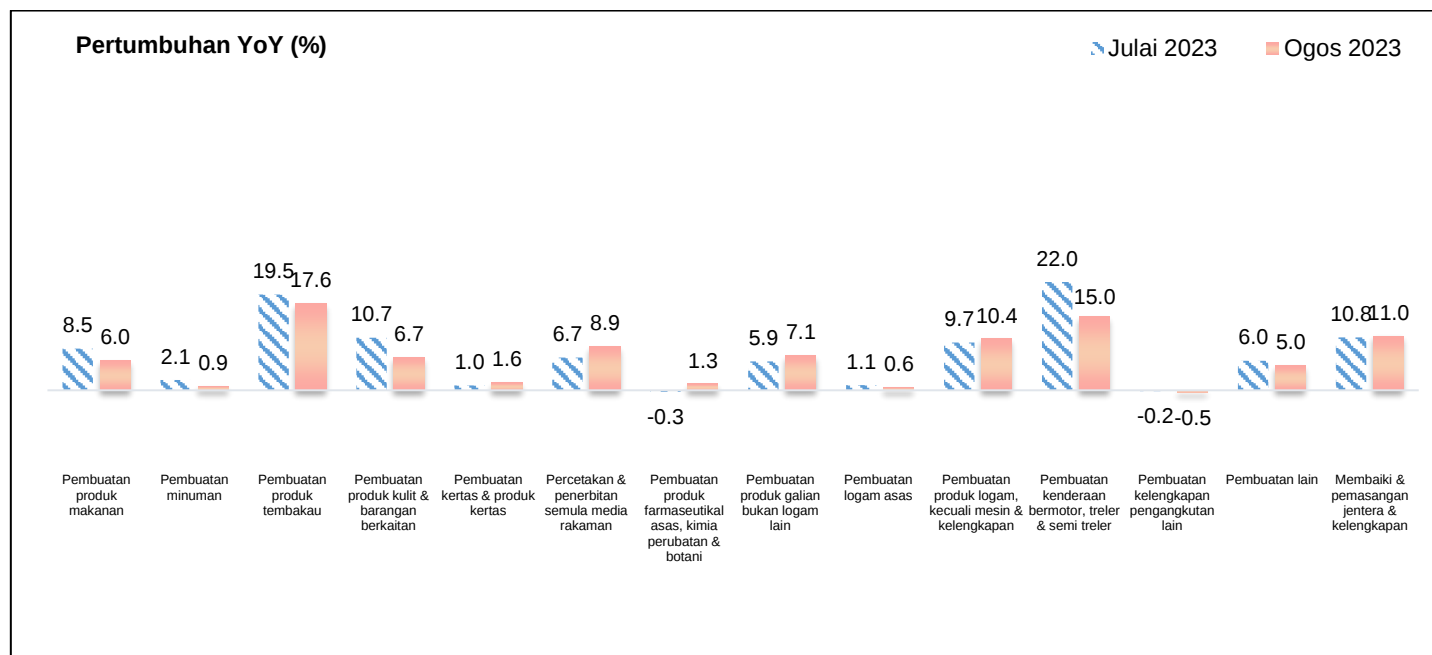

MONTHLY MANUFACTURING STATISTICS, MALAYSIA, AUGUST 2023

The sales value of the Manufacturing sector registering a decline of 3.3 per cent to record RM152.3 billion in August 2023

PUTRAJAYA, 12 October 2023 – The sales value of the Manufacturing sector registering a decline of 3.3 per cent year-on-year to record RM152.3 billion in August 2023. The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) reported today in the release of ***Monthly Manufacturing Statistics, Malaysia, August 2023***.

Commenting on the latest Manufacturing sales performance, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia, said, “The sales value of the Manufacturing sector declined further to 3.3 per cent in August 2023 after recording negative 3.0 per cent in the preceding month. The downturn was primarily influenced by the Petroleum chemical, rubber & plastic sub-sector, which decreased by 12.1 per cent, marking three consecutive months of double-digit declines. In addition, the deterioration was also attributable to the contraction of Food, beverages & tobacco (-6.6%); and Wood, furniture, paper products & printing (-0.1%) sub-sectors. On a month-on-month comparison, the sales value rebounded to 5.8 per cent as compared to the negative 2.4 per cent recorded in July 2023.”

The sales value of export-oriented industries which accounted for 72.7 per cent of total sales decreased by 6.7 per cent in August 2023 (July 2023: -7.0%). The decline was mainly due to the Manufacture of coke & refined petroleum products (-19.7%); Manufacture of vegetable & animal oils & fats (-15.1%); and Manufacture of rubber products (-8.8%). On the other hand, domestic-oriented industries continued to mitigate the decline in sales value, with a growth of 7.2 per cent in August 2023 (July 2023: 9.1%). The steady momentum was predominantly backed by the strong increase in sales value of the Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers & semi-trailers, which surged by 15.0 per cent, as well as Manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery & equipment at 10.4 per cent. In addition, Manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products and Manufacture of food processing products increased by 7.1 per cent and 6.0 per cent respectively. On month-on-month basis, export-oriented and domestic industries increased by 6.7 per cent and 3.5 per cent respectively.

Commenting on the number of employees, the Chief Statistician stated, “The Manufacturing sector engaged 2.36 million persons in August 2023, posted a 2.0 per cent increase as compared to the 2.31 million persons recorded a year ago. The addition was largely in the Food, beverages and tobacco (6.2%); Wood, furniture, paper products & printing (2.6%); and Non-metallic mineral products, basic metal & fabricated metal (2.2%) sub-sectors. As compared to the preceding month, the number of employees in this sector increased marginally by 0.6 per cent.”

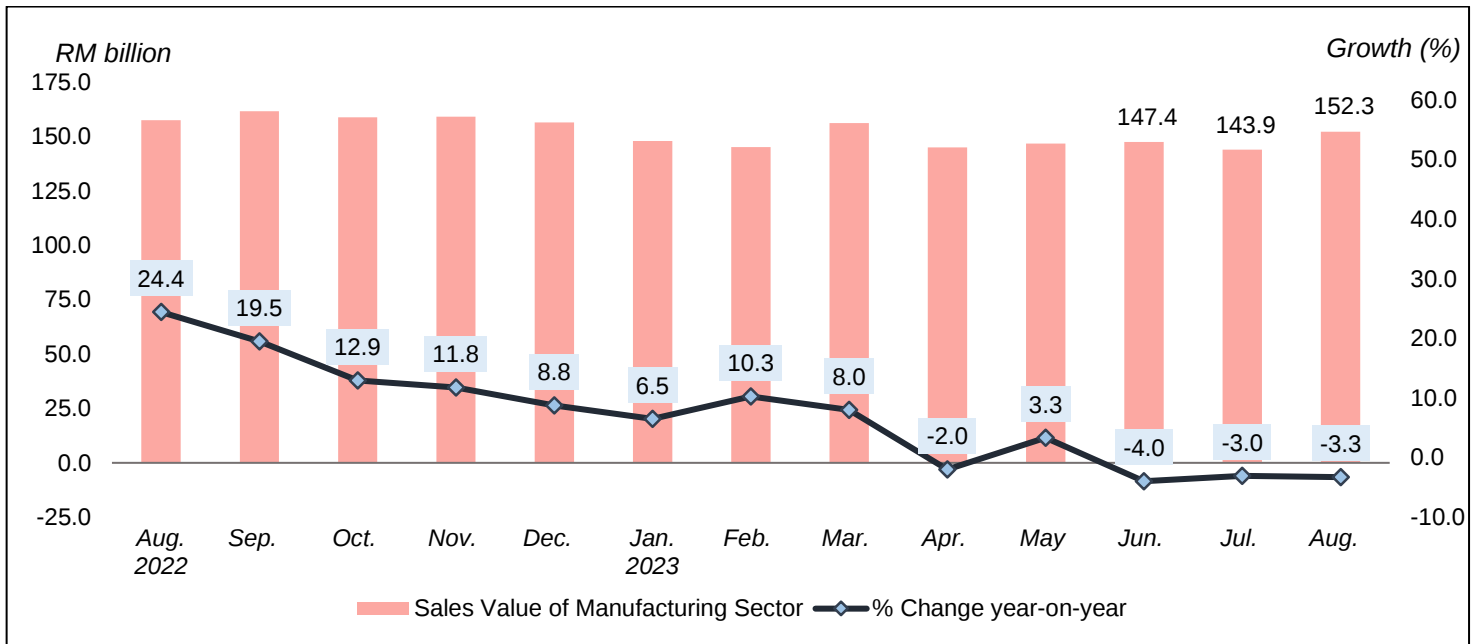
In line with the increase in employment, the salaries & wages paid in the Manufacturing sector grew by 3.0 per cent year-on-year, amounting to RM8.0 billion in August 2023. On a month-on-month comparison, the salaries & wages increased by 0.9 per cent from RM7.9 billion recorded in July 2023. In addition, the average salaries & wages per employee went up by 1.0 per cent with a value of RM3,397 while the sales value per employee dropped by 5.2 per cent to RM64,660.

Summarising the performance for the first eight months of 2023, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, “The sales value of the Manufacturing sector attained RM1,184.8 billion, rose by 1.7 per cent as compared to the same period in the preceding year. During this period, the number of employees increased by 2.0 per cent to record a total of 2.36 million persons while salaries & wages grew by 3.7 per cent, registering RM64.6 billion. Meanwhile, the sales value per employee declined slightly by 0.2 per cent, amounting to RM503,093.”

DOSM has launched OpenDOSM NextGen as a medium that provides a catalogue of data and visualisation to facilitate users in analysing various data. OpenDOSM NextGen is an open source data sharing platform and accessible through <https://open.dosm.gov.my> portal.

The Government of Malaysia has declared National Statistics Day (MyStats Day) on October 20 each year. MyStats Day theme is “Statistics is the Essence of Life”.

July and August 2023**

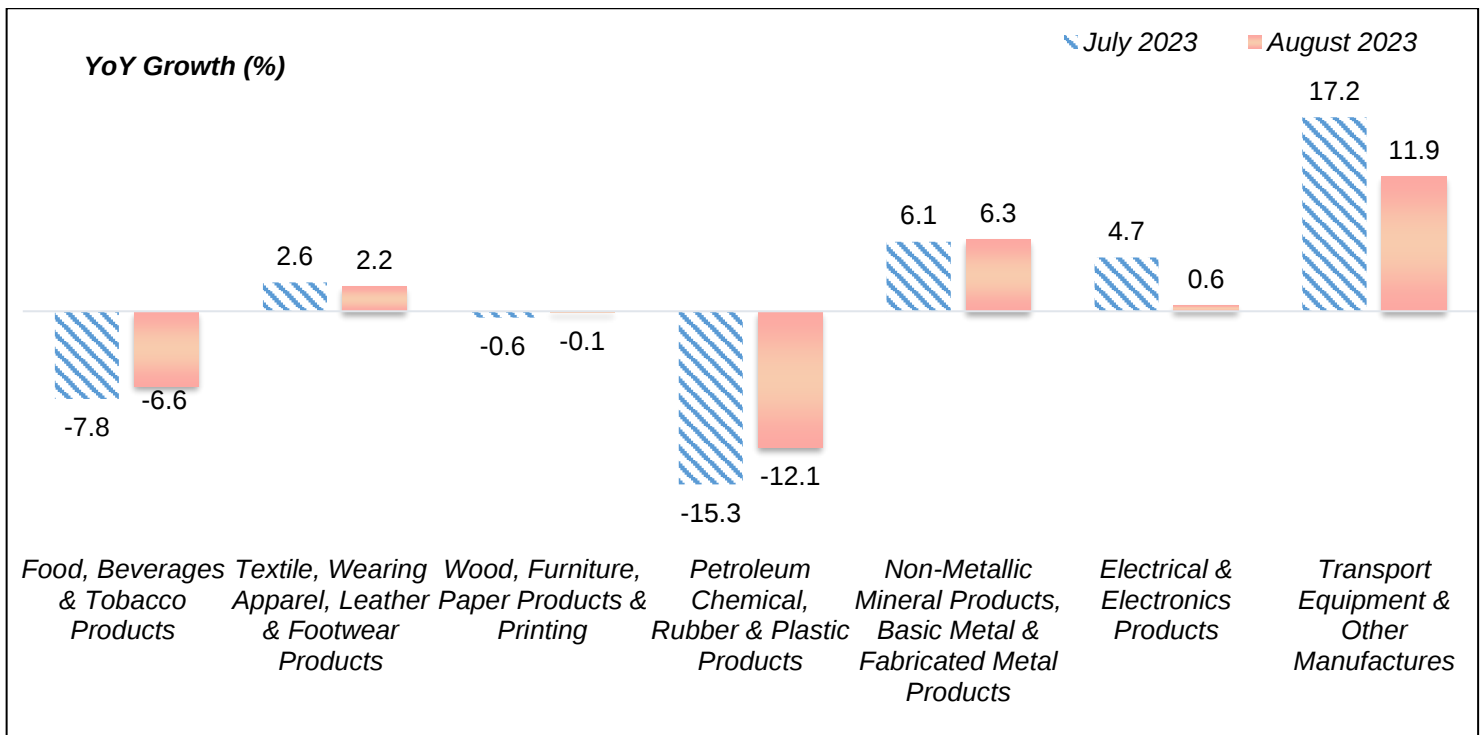


Chart 3: Sales Value of the Export and Domestic-oriented Industries for Manufacturing Sector, Malaysia, August 2022 – August 2023

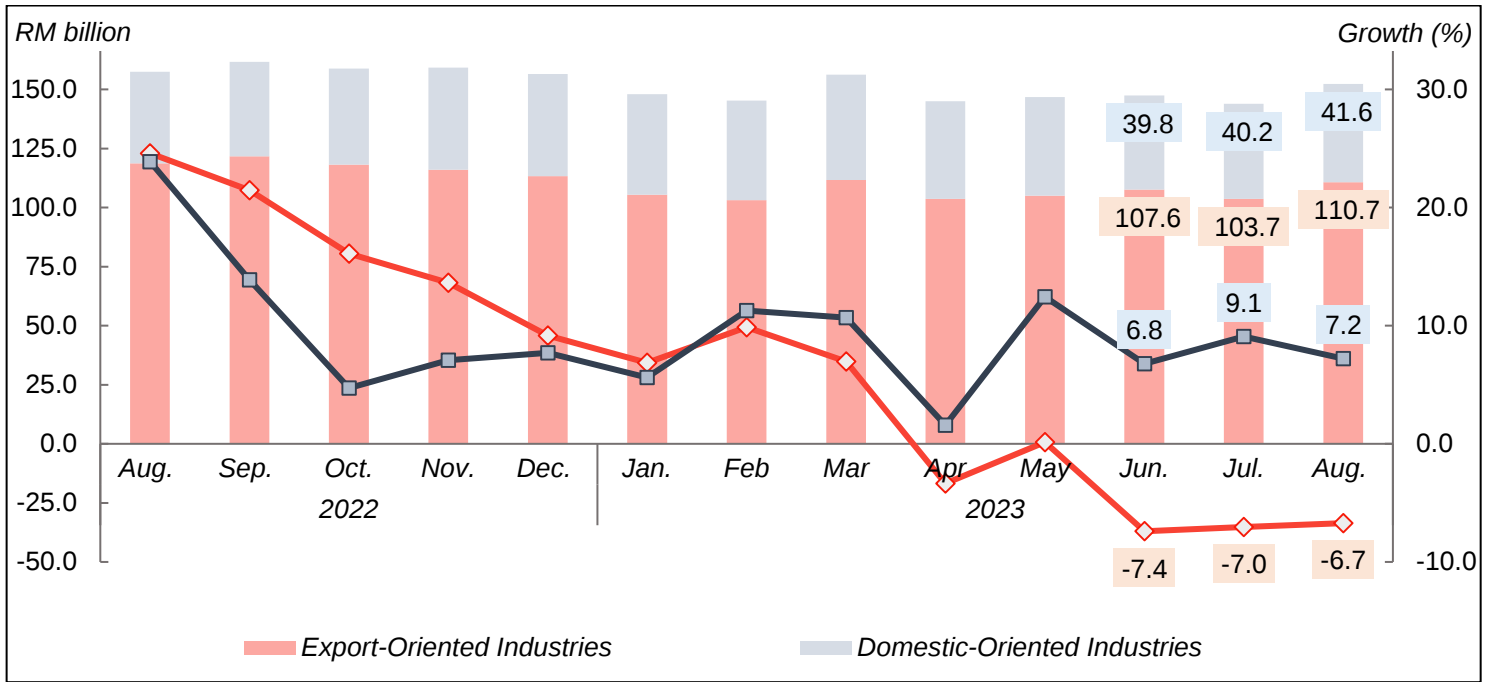


Chart 4: Manufacturing Export-Oriented by Group, Malaysia, July and August 2023

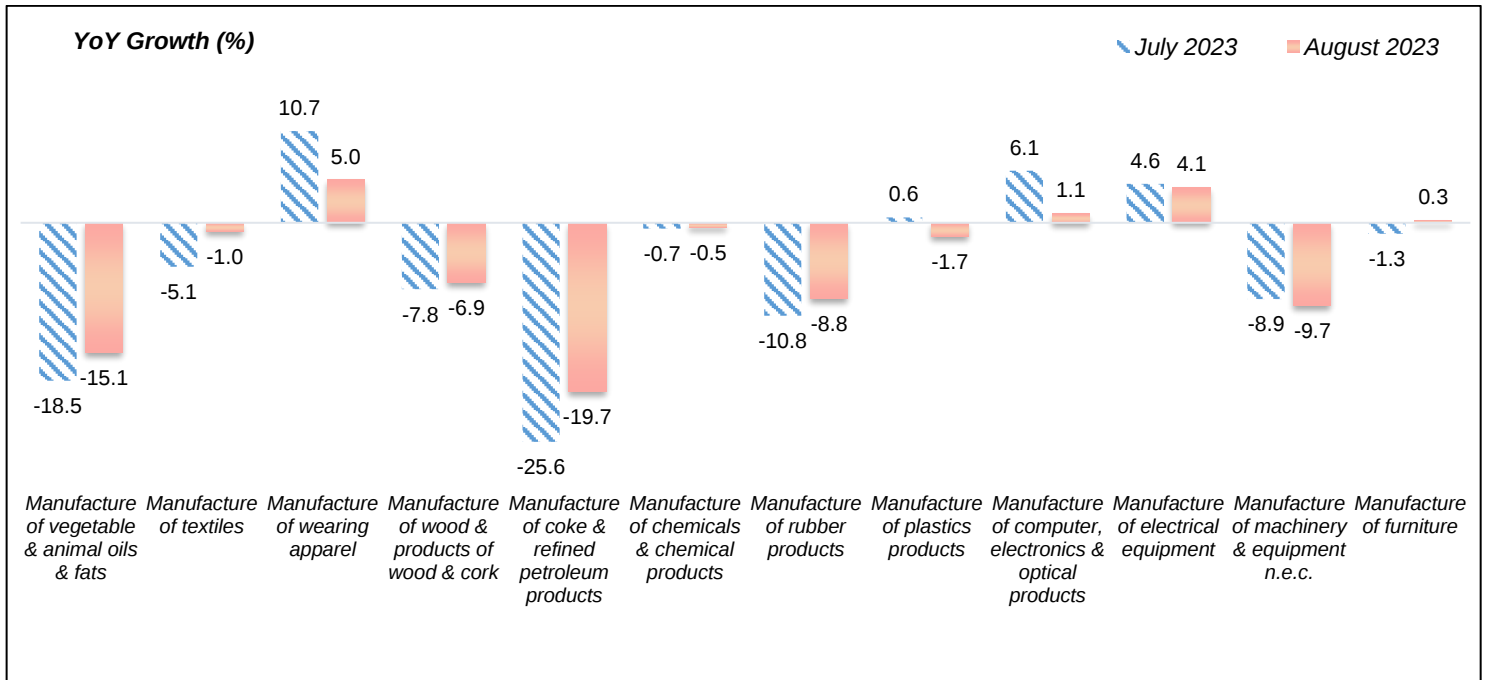
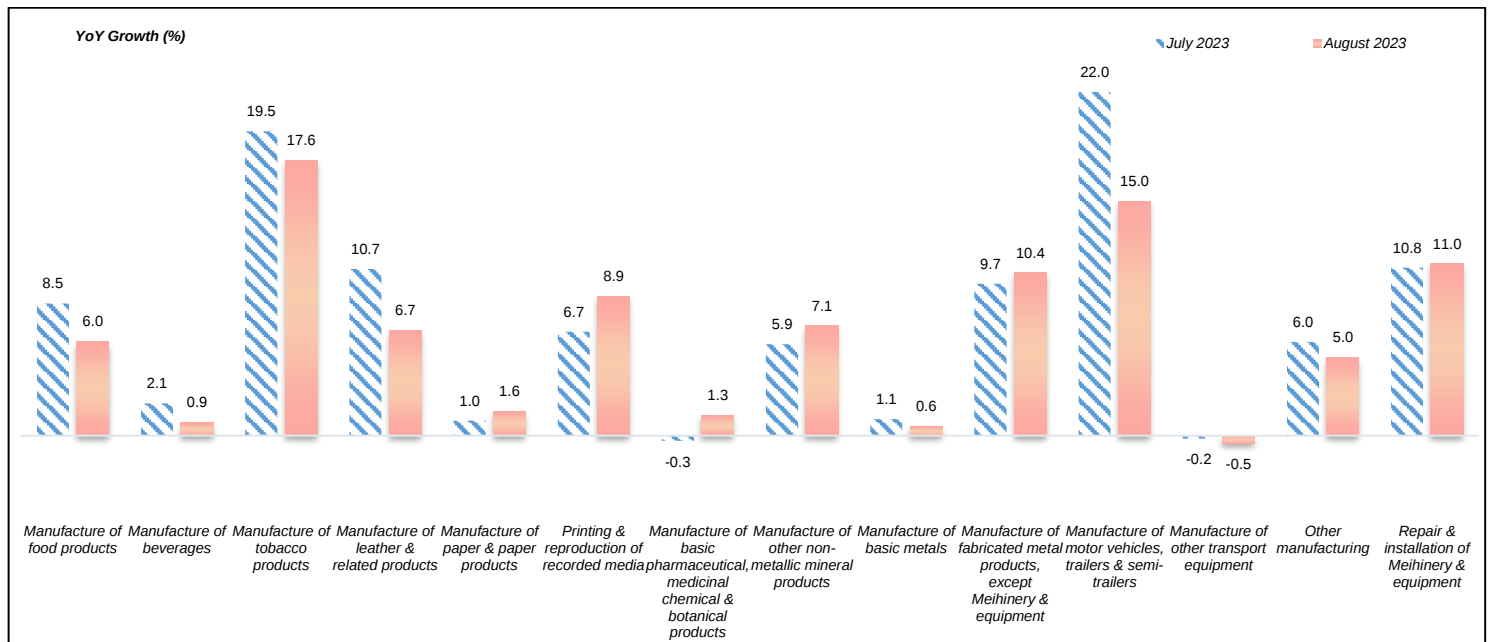


Chart 5: Manufacturing Domestic-Oriented by Group, Malaysia, July and August 2023
