

Malaysia elected as vice-chair of the 12th OIC-Stat-Com

LUMPUR: Malaysia, through the Department of Statistics (DOSM), has been elected as the vice-chair of the 12th Organisation of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) Statistical Commission (OIC-Stat-Com), an intergovernmental forum of paramount significance in the global statistical community.

In a statement today, DOSM said the achievement was a testament to Malaysia's dedication to
