PERANGKAAN PEMBUATAN BULANAN, MALAYSIA, SEPTEMBER 2023

**Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan susut 1.9 peratus kepada RM158.7 bilion
pada September 2023**

PUTRAJAYA, 7 November 2023 - Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan susut 1.9 peratus tahun ke tahun kepada RM158.7 bilion pada September 2023, namun menunjukkan peningkatan 4.3 peratus berbanding Ogos 2023. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) melaporkan dalam keluaran **Perangkaan Pembuatan Bulanan, Malaysia, September 2023** pada hari ini.

Mengulas laporan tersebut, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata, "Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan menurun pada kadar yang lebih perlahan 1.9 peratus pada September 2023 berbanding kemerosotan 3.3 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya. Penurunan tersebut sebahagian besarnya dipengaruhi oleh penurunan berterusan sebanyak 12.3 peratus dalam subsektor Petroleum, kimia, getah & plastik. Tambahan lagi, subsektor Makanan, minuman & tembakau menguncup 1.7 peratus; dan Produk kayu, perabot, keluaran kertas & percetakan menyusut 0.7 peratus. Berbanding bulan sebelumnya, nilai jualan meningkat 4.3 peratus berbanding RM152.2 bilion yang direkodkan pada Ogos 2023 (5.7%)."

Nilai jualan industri berorientasikan eksport yang mewakili lebih dua pertiga daripada jumlah jualan, menurun 5.1 peratus pada September 2023 selepas menyusut 6.8 peratus pada Ogos 2023. Penguncupan ini disebabkan terutamanya oleh penurunan Pembuatan kok & produk petroleum bertapis (-21.6%); Pembuatan jentera & peralatan t.t.t.l. (-10.5%); dan Pembuatan minyak & lemak daripada sayuran & haiwan (-8.4%). Namun begitu, industri berorientasikan domestik kekal kukuh dan berkembang 8.1 peratus pada September 2023 (Ogos 2023: 7.2%). Pengembangan berterusan ini disokong terutamanya oleh peningkatan yang ketara dalam nilai jualan Pembuatan produk logam, kecuali mesin & kelengkapan yang meningkat sebanyak 10.5 peratus; dan Pembuatan kenderaan bermotor, treler & semi treler pada 10.4 peratus; dan juga Pembuatan produk makanan sebanyak 9.5 peratus. Perbandingan bulan ke bulan, kedua-dua industri berorientasikan eksport dan domestik masing-masing mencatatkan peningkatan sebanyak 4.4 peratus dan 4.1 peratus.

Mengulas mengenai bilangan pekerja, Ketua Perangkawan menyatakan, “Sektor Pembuatan melibatkan seramai 2.37 juta orang pada September 2023, meningkat 2.4 peratus berbanding 2.32 juta orang yang dicatatkan setahun lalu. Kenaikan itu didorong terutamanya oleh subsektor Makanan, minuman dan tembakau (7.4%); Produk mineral bukan logam, logam asas & produk logam yang direka (2.8%); dan Produk elektrik & elektronik (2.0%). Bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, bilangan pekerja dalam sektor Pembuatan meningkat sebanyak 0.8 peratus.”

Selaras dengan itu, gaji & upah yang dibayar dalam sektor Pembuatan juga mencatatkan peningkatan sebanyak 3.2 peratus tahun ke tahun, berjumlah RM8.1 bilion pada September 2023. Berbanding bulan Ogos 2023, gaji & upah yang dibayar meningkat 1.7 peratus berbanding 0.9 peratus yang dicatatkan pada bulan sebelumnya. Tambahan lagi, nilai jualan bagi setiap pekerja menurun sebanyak 4.2 peratus kepada RM66,864 manakala purata gaji & upah bagi setiap pekerja pada September 2023 adalah RM3,429 yang meningkat sebanyak 0.8 peratus tahun ke tahun.

Pada suku tahun ketiga 2023, nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan terus menurun untuk dua suku berturut-turut, merosot 2.7 peratus tahun ke tahun berbanding penurunan 1.0 peratus yang dicatatkan pada suku tahun sebelumnya. Penyusutan tersebut dipengaruhi oleh subsektor Petroleum, kimia, getah & plastik (-13.3%), Makanan, minuman & tembakau (-5.3%); dan Kayu, perabot, keluaran kertas & percetakan (-0.5%). Sebaliknya, bilangan pekerja dan gaji & upah yang dibayar pada suku tahun berkenaan tumbuh masing-masing sebanyak 2.4 peratus dan 3.0 peratus. Berbanding suku tahun sebelumnya, nilai jualan memulih kepada 3.6 peratus berbanding negatif 2.3 peratus pada suku tahun sebelumnya.

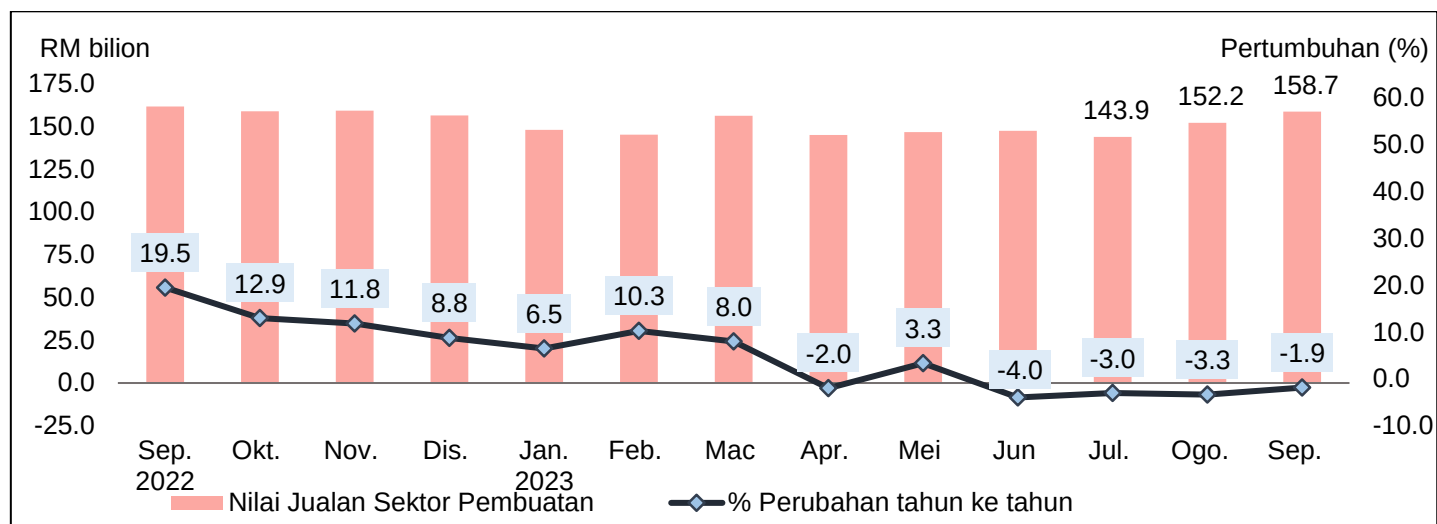
Merumuskan prestasi bagi sembilan bulan pertama tahun 2023, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata, “Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan mencecah RM1.34 trilion, berkembang sebanyak 1.3 peratus berbanding tempoh yang sama tahun sebelumnya (Jan. - Sept. 2022: 17.6%). Pada tempoh tersebut, bilangan pekerja meningkat sebanyak 2.4 peratus, mencapai seramai 2.37 juta orang manakala gaji & upah menokok sebanyak 3.6 peratus, berjumlah RM72.8 bilion. Sementara itu, nilai jualan per pekerja berjumlah RM566,014, yang merekodkan penurunan 1.1 peratus.”

DOSM telah melancarkan OpenDOSM NextGen sebagai medium yang menyediakan katalog data dan visualisasi bagi memudahkan pengguna menganalisis pelbagai data. OpenDOSM NextGen ialah platform perkongsian data sumber terbuka dan boleh diakses melalui portal <https://open.dosm.gov.my>.

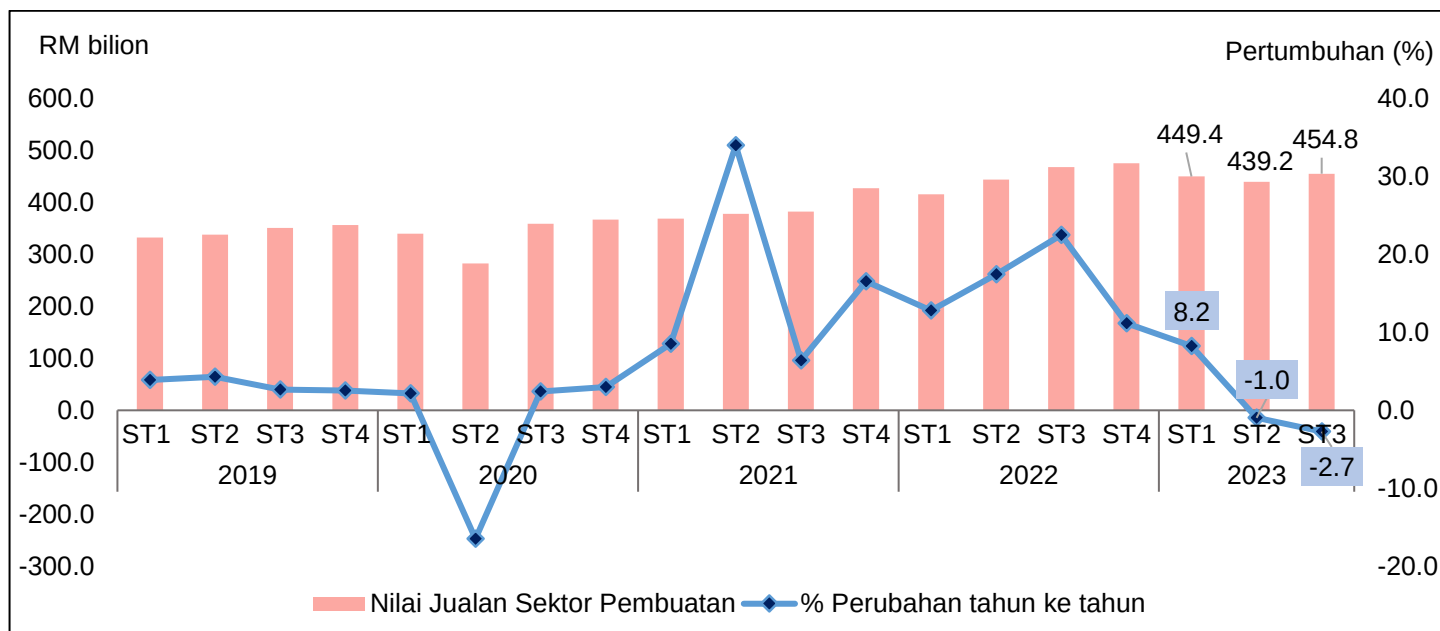

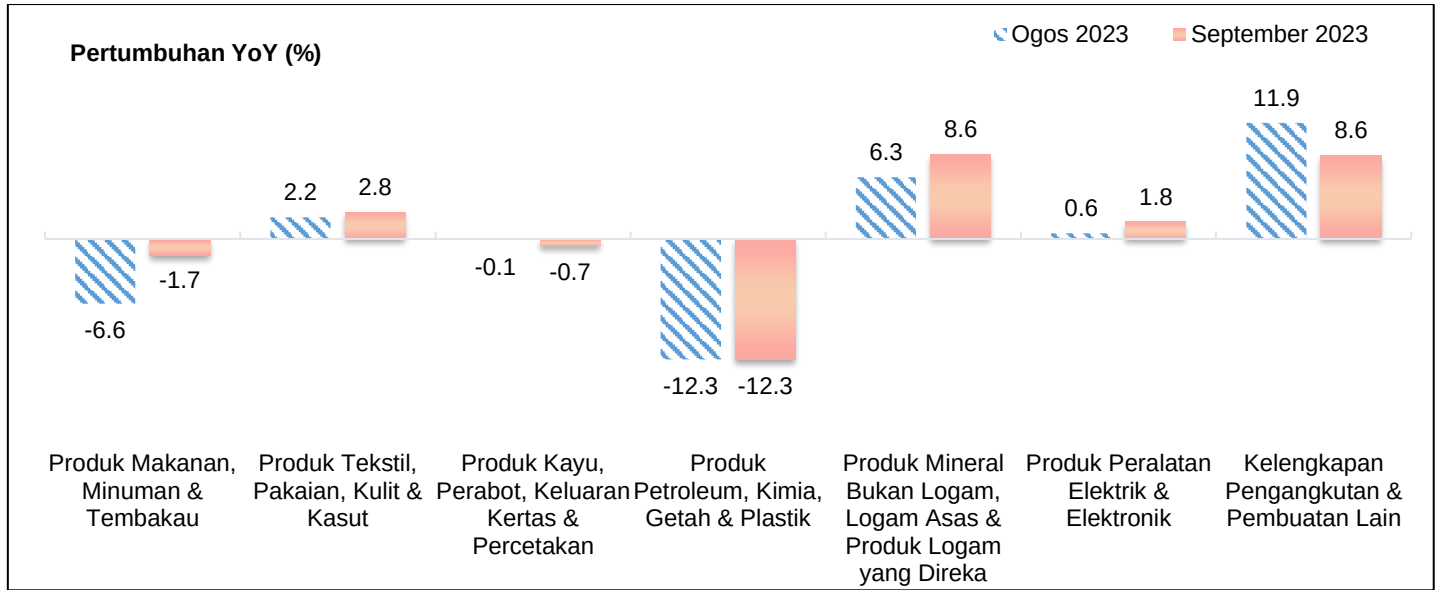
**Carta 1: Nilai Jualan Sektor Pembuatan, Malaysia
September 2022 - September 2023**



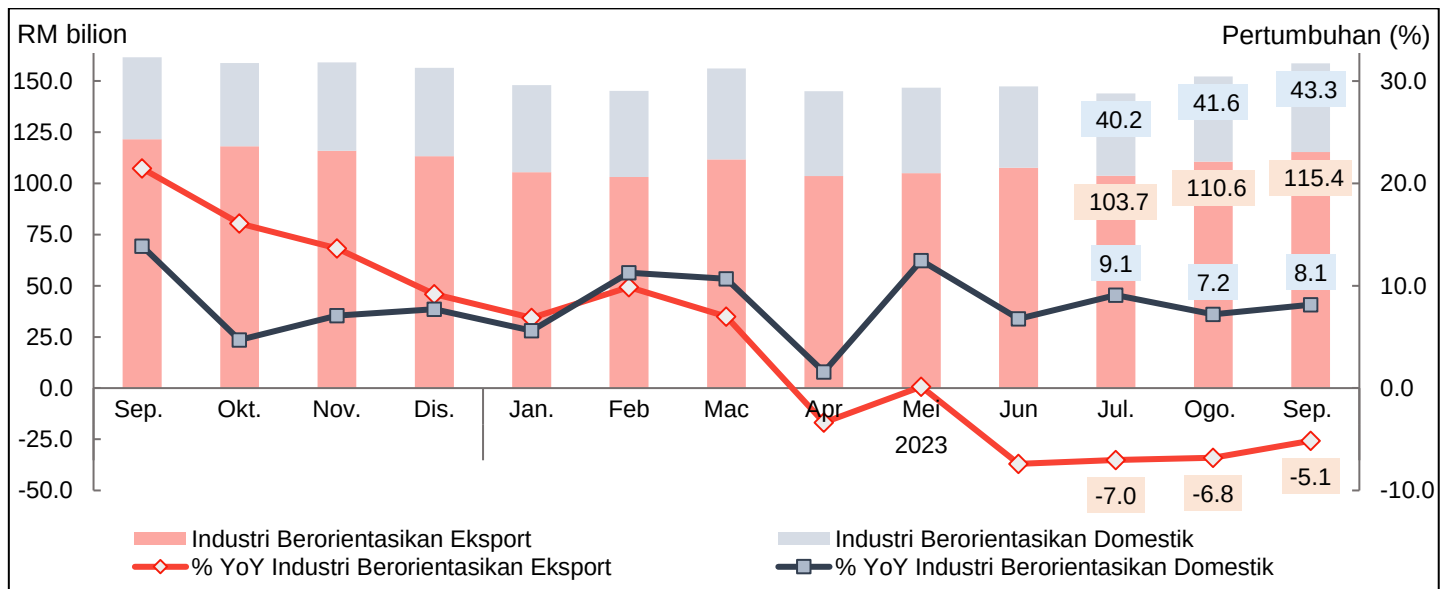
**Carta 2: Nilai Jualan Sektor Pembuatan, Malaysia
ST1 2019 – ST3 2023**



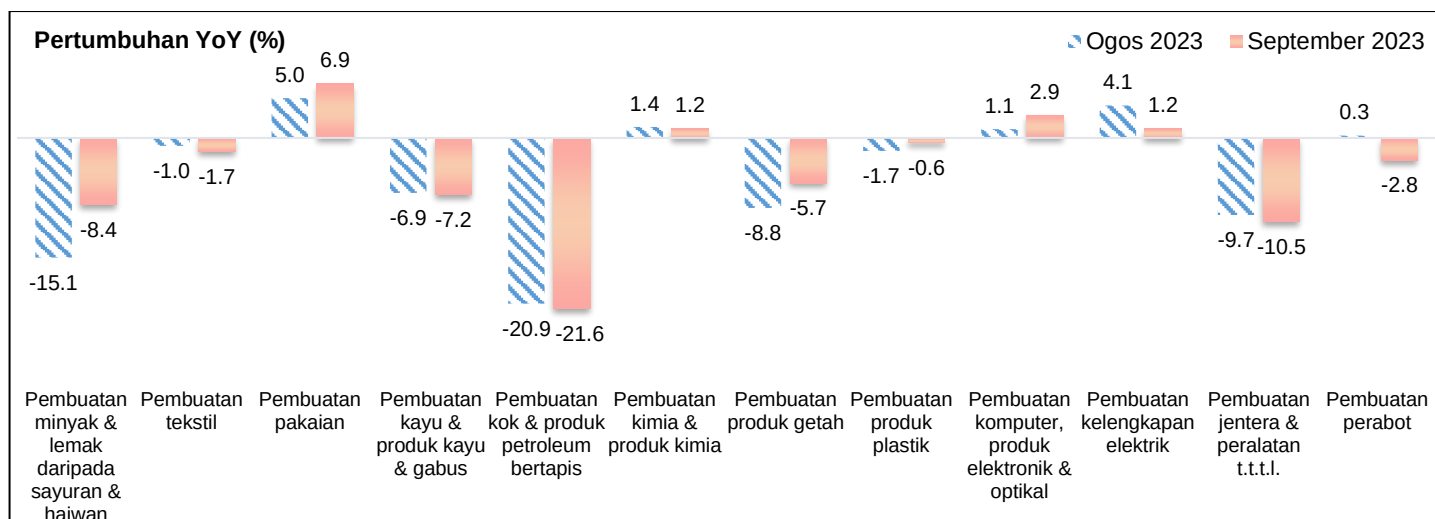
**Carta 3: Pertumbuhan Jualan Subsektor Pembuatan, Malaysia,
Ogos dan September 2023**



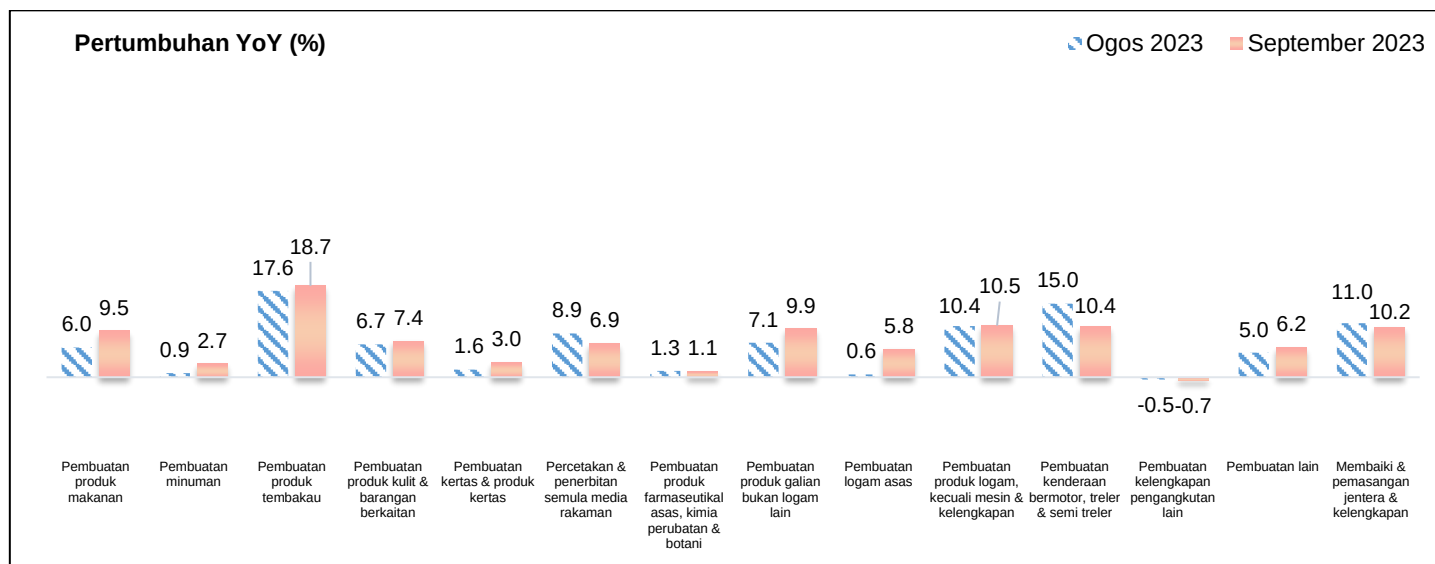

MONTHLY MANUFACTURING STATISTICS, MALAYSIA, SEPTEMBER 2023

Manufacturing sector's sales value dipped by 1.9 per cent to RM158.7 billion in September 2023

PUTRAJAYA, 7 November 2023 – Manufacturing sector's sales value dipped by 1.9 per cent year-on-year to RM158.7 billion in September 2023, but showed a 4.3 per cent increase compared to August 2023. The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) reported today in the release of **Monthly Manufacturing Statistics, Malaysia, September 2023**.

Commenting on the report, Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, "The sales value of the Manufacturing sector decreased at a slower pace of 1.9 per cent in September 2023 as compared to the 3.3 per cent deterioration in the preceding month. The decrease was predominantly influenced by the continuous 12.3 per cent decline in the Petroleum, chemical, rubber & plastic sub-sector. Additionally, the Food, beverages & tobacco sub-sector contracted by 1.7 per cent; and the Wood, furniture, paper products & printing sub-sector fell by 0.7 per cent. As compared to the preceding month, the sales value increased by 4.3 per cent as against RM152.2 billion recorded in August 2023 (5.7%)."

The sales value of export-oriented industries which represented more than two-thirds of total sales, declined by 5.1 per cent in September 2023 after shrinking by 6.8 per cent in August 2023. The downturn was mainly attributed to the decrease in the Manufacture of coke & refined petroleum products (-21.6%); Manufacture of machinery & equipment n.e.c. (-10.5%); and Manufacture of vegetable & animal oils & fats (-8.4%). Nonetheless, the domestic-oriented industries sustained resilience and grew 8.1 per cent in September 2023 (August 2023: 7.2%). The continuous expansion was primarily underpinned by the substantial rise in the sales value of the Manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery & equipment which rose by 10.5 per cent; as well as Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers & semi-trailers at 10.4 per cent; and Manufacture of food products at 9.5 per cent. On a month-on-month comparison, both export-oriented and domestic-oriented industries posted an increase of 4.4 per cent and 4.1 per cent, respectively.

Reviewing on the number of employees, the Chief Statistician stated, “The Manufacturing sector engaged 2.37 million persons in September 2023, an increase of 2.4 per cent as compared to the 2.32 million persons registered a year earlier. The rise was mainly supported by the Food, beverages & tobacco (7.4%); Non-metallic mineral products, basic metal & fabricated metal products (2.8%); and Electrical & electronic products (2.0%) sub-sectors. On a month-on-month basis, the number of employees in the Manufacturing sector increased by 0.8 per cent.”

On the same note, the salaries & wages paid in the Manufacturing sector also posted an increase by 3.2 per cent year-on-year, totalling RM8.1 billion in September 2023. As compared to August 2023, the salaries & wages paid grew by 1.7 per cent as against 0.9 per cent growth registered in the preceding month. Furthermore, the sales value per employee decreased by 4.2 per cent to record RM66,864 while the average salaries & wages per employee in September 2023 was RM3,429 which rose by 0.8 per cent year-on-year.

In the third quarter of 2023, the sales value of the Manufacturing sector continued to decelerate for two consecutive quarters, dropping by 2.7 per cent year-on-year as compared to the 1.0 per cent decline registered in the previous quarter. The decrease was attributed to the Petroleum, chemical, rubber & plastic (-13.3%), Food, beverages & tobacco (-5.3%); as well as the Wood, furniture, paper products & printing (-0.5%) sub-sectors. On the other hand, the number of employees and salaries & wages paid during the quarter grew by 2.4 per cent and 3.0 per cent, respectively. As compared to the previous quarter, the sales value rebounded to 3.6 per cent from negative 2.3 per cent in the preceding quarter.

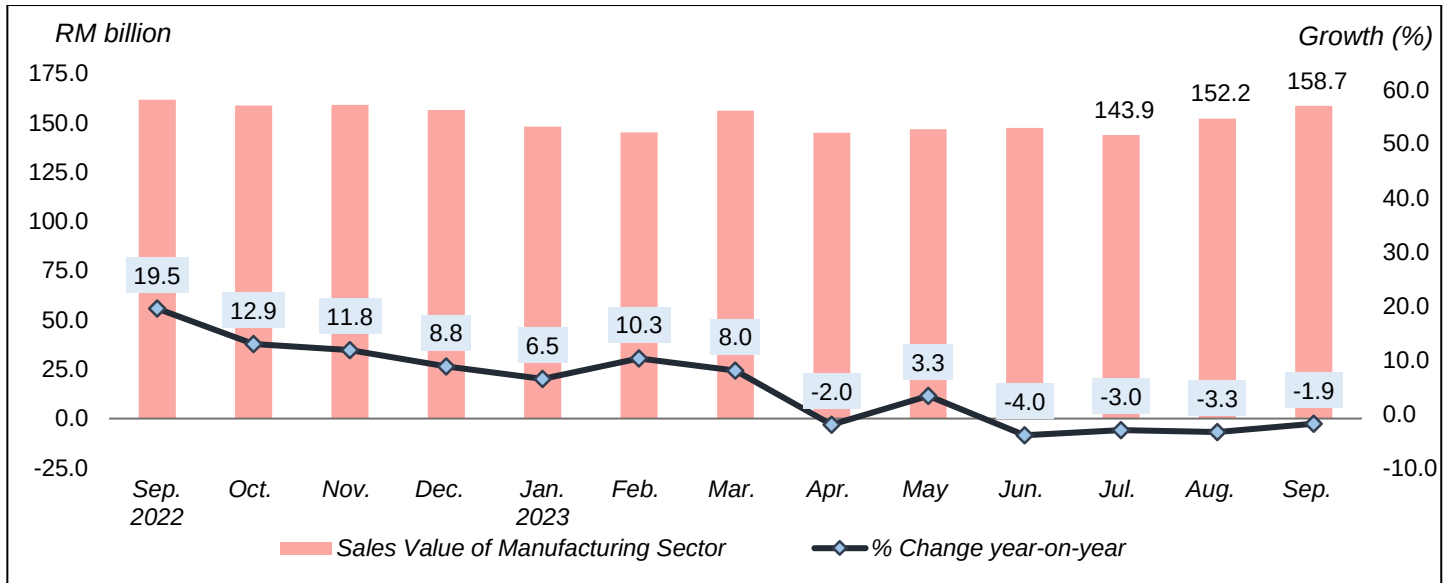
Summarising the performance for the first nine months of 2023, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, “The sales value of the Manufacturing sector hit RM1.34 trillion, rose by 1.3 per cent as compared to the same period in the preceding year (Jan. - Sept. 2022: 17.6%). During this period, the number of employees increased by 2.4 per cent, reaching a total of 2.37 million persons while salaries & wages grew by 3.6 per cent, amounting to RM72.8 billion. Moreover, the sales value per employee stood at RM566,014 which posted a decline of 1.1 per cent.”

DOSM has launched OpenDOSM NextGen as a medium that provides a catalogue of data and visualisation to facilitate users in analysing various data. OpenDOSM NextGen is an open source data sharing platform and accessible through <https://open.dosm.gov.my> portal.

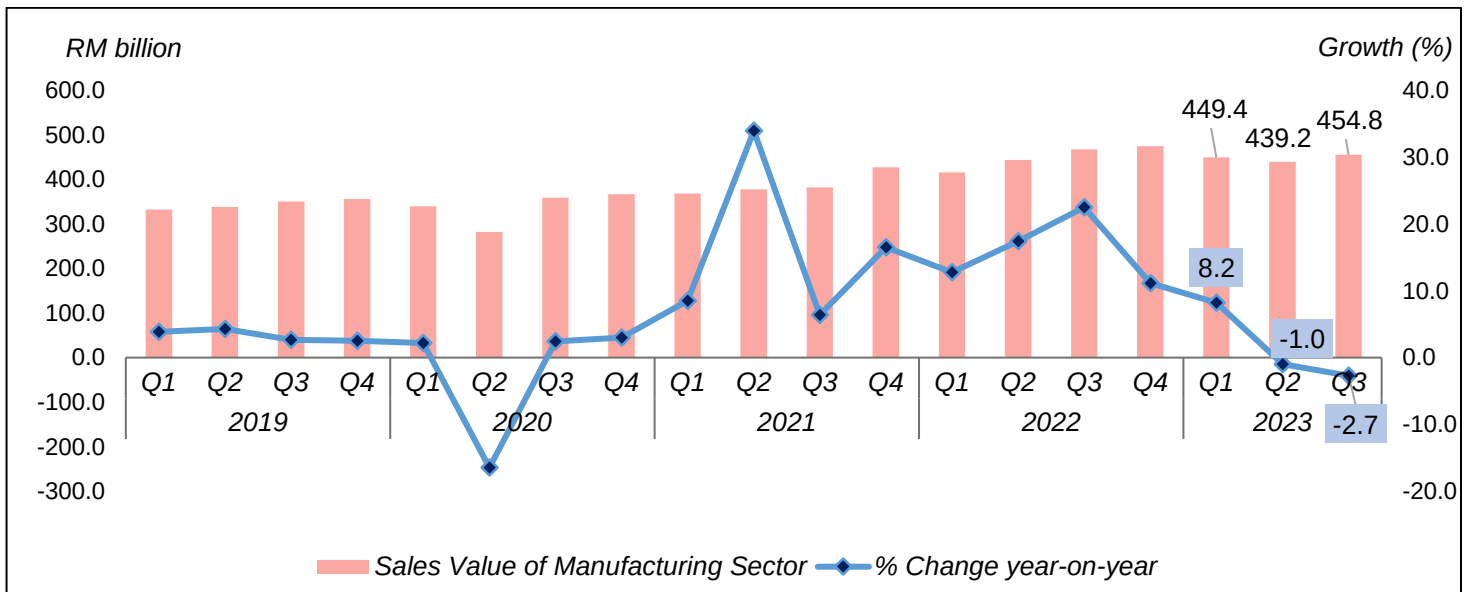

August and September 2023**

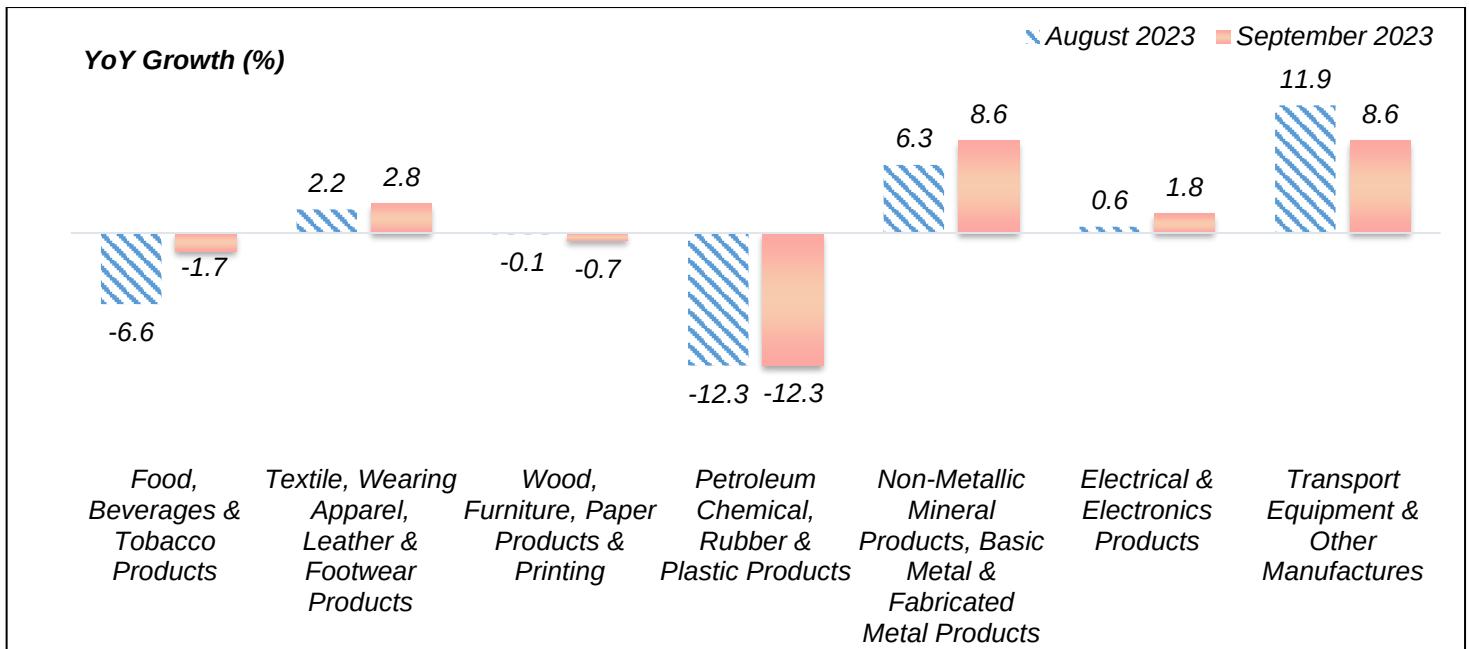


Chart 4: Sales Value of the Export and Domestic-oriented Industries for Manufacturing Sector, Malaysia, September 2022 – September 2023

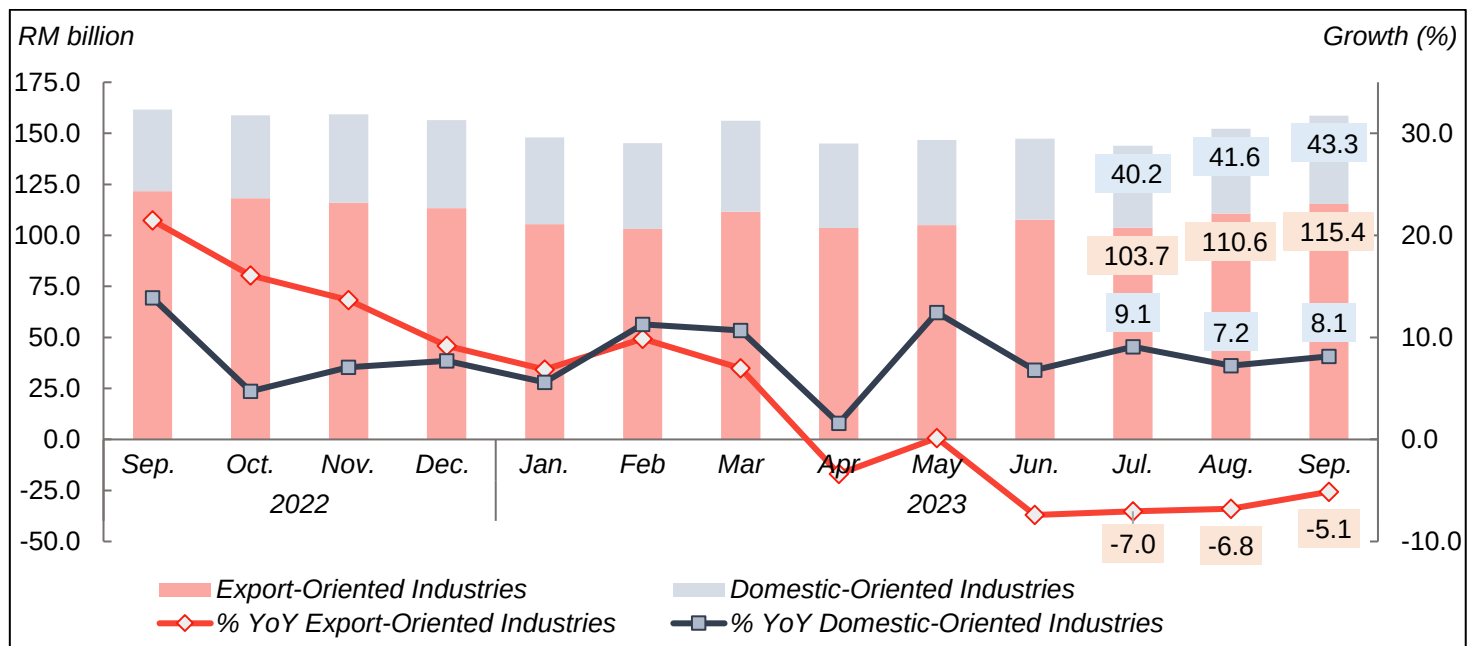


Chart 5: Manufacturing Export-Oriented by Group, Malaysia, August and September 2023

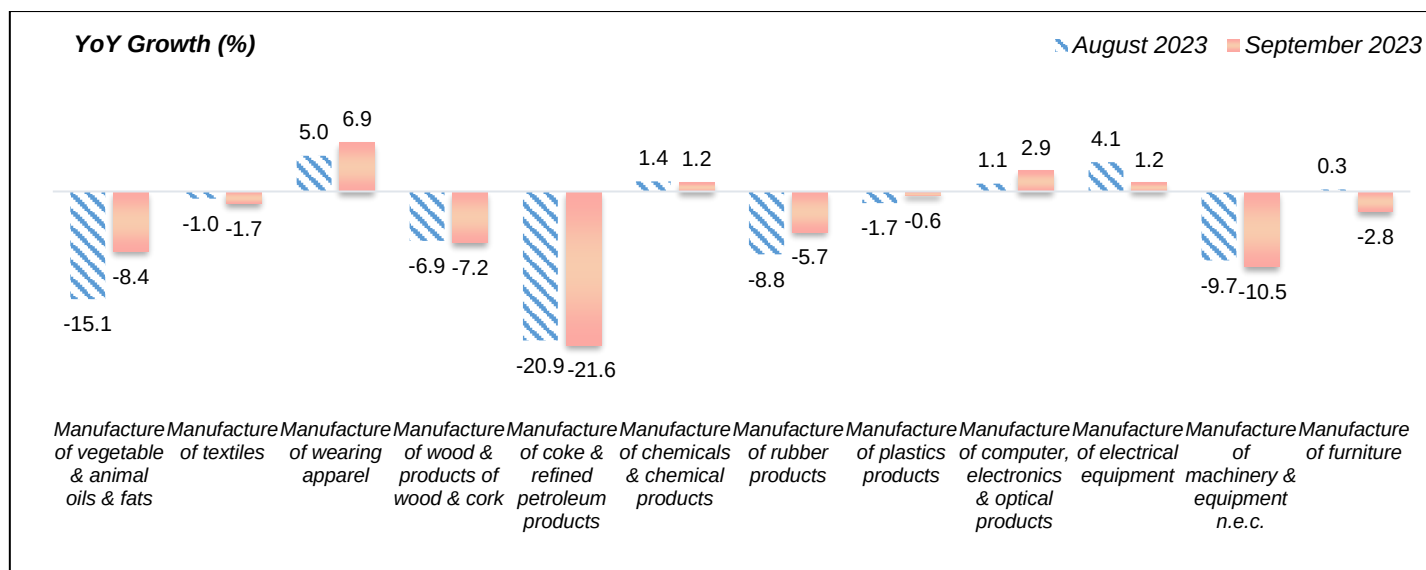
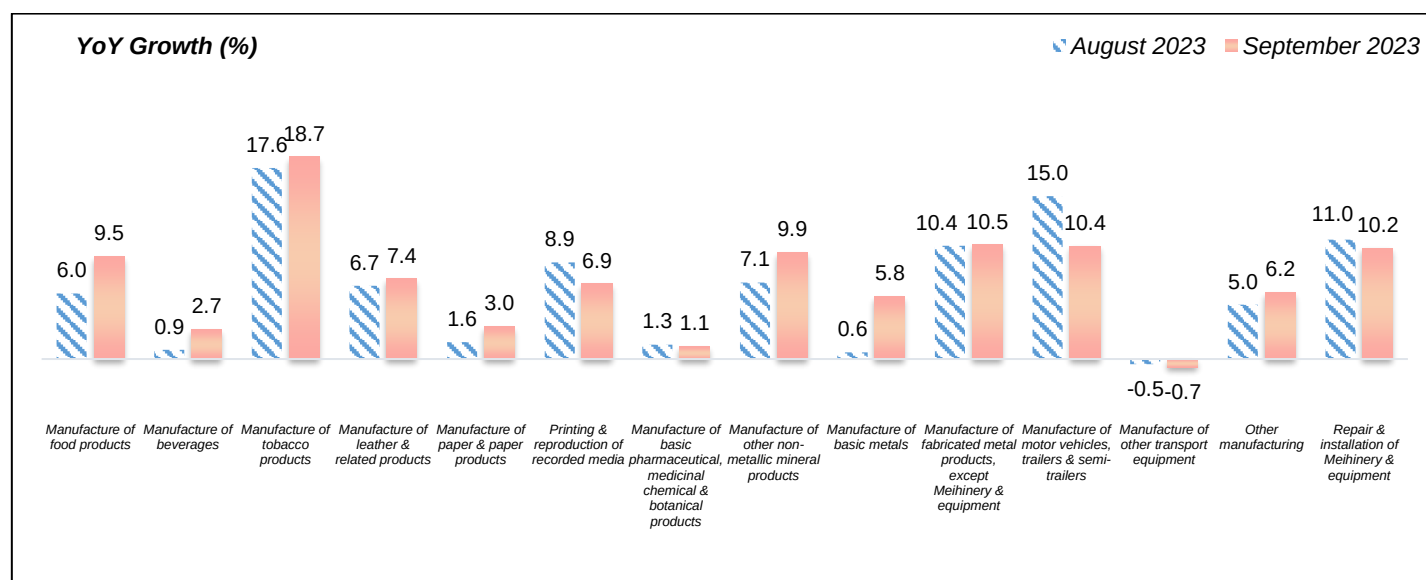


Chart 6: Manufacturing Domestic-Oriented by Group, Malaysia, August and September 2023
