**JUMLAH PERDAGANGAN MALAYSIA BERNILAI RM239.5 BILION DAN  
LAPAN NEGERI MENCATATKAN PENINGKATAN PADA  
BULAN OKTOBER 2023**

**PUTRAJAYA, 28 November 2023** – Malaysia mencatatkan jumlah perdagangan bernali RM239.5 bilion pada Oktober 2023 dengan nilai eksport RM126.2 bilion dan import bernali RM113.3 bilion seperti yang dilaporkan hari ini dalam **STATISTIK EKSPORT IMPORT MENGIKUT NEGERI OKTOBER 2023**.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata prestasi eksport Malaysia pada Oktober 2023 bernali RM126.2 bilion, menurun sebanyak RM5.8 bilion (-4.4%) berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Penurunan eksport dipengaruhi oleh eksport yang lebih rendah di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Johor (-RM2.4 bilion), Sarawak (-RM1.9 bilion), Sabah (-RM1.5 bilion), Melaka (-RM495.0 juta), Negeri Sembilan (-RM328.9 juta), W.P. Labuan (-RM241.6 juta), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM196.3 juta) dan Perlis (-RM12.7 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai eksport meningkat di Kedah sebanyak RM745.2 juta, Selangor (+RM478.6 juta), Terengganu (+RM281.5 juta), Pahang (+RM94.2 juta), Pulau Pinang (+RM67.3 juta), Perak (+RM60.6 juta) dan Kelantan (+RM23.3 juta).

Pulau Pinang kekal sebagai pengeksport utama dengan sumbangan 30.9 peratus, diikuti oleh Johor (20.9%), Selangor (18.2%), Sarawak (7.9%) dan W.P. Kuala Lumpur (4.3%).

Beralih kepada prestasi import mengikut negeri, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin memaklumkan import pada bulan Oktober 2023 juga menurun RM193.1 juta (-0.2%) berbanding bulan yang sama pada 2022. Penurunan import disebabkan oleh import yang lebih rendah di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Johor (-RM4.3 bilion), Pulau Pinang (-RM1.9 bilion), Kedah (-RM1.2 bilion), Melaka (-RM487.2 juta), Sarawak (-RM64.5 juta) dan Kelantan (-RM5.3 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai import meningkat di W.P. Kuala Lumpur sebanyak RM2.9 bilion, Selangor (+RM2.2 bilion), Negeri Sembilan (+RM1.4 bilion), Pahang (+RM743.5 juta), Perak (+RM328.2 juta), W.P. Labuan (+RM304.3 juta), Sabah (+RM229.3 juta), Terengganu (+RM99.3 juta) dan Perlis (+RM7.9 juta).


Selangor terus mendominasi import Malaysia dengan 25.9 peratus, diikuti oleh Johor (24.3%), Pulau Pinang (19.2%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (8.2%) dan Kedah (5.5%).


**Carta 1: Data Siri Masa Eksport dan Import bagi negeri Johor, Pulau Pinang dan Selangor,

**MALAYSIA'S TOTAL TRADE AMOUNTED TO RM239.5 BILLION AND EIGHT STATES RECORDED AN INCREASE FOR OCTOBER 2023**

**PUTRAJAYA, 28 November 2023 –** Malaysia's total trade for October 2023 amounted to RM239.5 billion with exports and imports recorded RM126.2 billion and RM113.3 billion, respectively as reported today in **EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE OCTOBER 2023**.

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said exports was valued at RM126.2 billion in October 2023, decreased RM5.8 billion (-4.4%) as compared to the same month of the previous year. The decrease in exports was attributed to the lower exports in most states such as Johor (-RM2.4 billion), Sarawak (-RM1.9 billion), Sabah (-RM1.5 billion), Melaka (-RM495.0 million), Negeri Sembilan (-RM328.9 million), W.P. Labuan (-RM241.6 million), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (-RM196.3 million) and Perlis (-RM12.7 million). However, exports increased in Kedah by RM745.2 million, Selangor (+RM478.6 million), Terengganu (+RM281.5 million), Pahang (+RM94.2 million), Pulau Pinang (+RM67.3 million), Perak (+RM60.6 million) and Kelantan (+RM23.3 million).

Pulau Pinang remained as the top exporter with 30.9 per cent share, followed by Johor (20.9%), Selangor (18.2%), Sarawak (7.9%) and W.P. Kuala Lumpur (4.3%).

Looking at the performance of imports by state, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said imports also decreased RM193.1 million (-0.2%) in October 2023 as compared to the same month in 2022. The decrease in imports was attributed by the lower imports in most states such as Johor (-RM4.3 billion), Pulau Pinang (-RM1.9 billion), Kedah (-RM1.2 billion),

*Melaka (-RM487.2 million), Sarawak (-RM64.5 million) and Kelantan (-RM5.3 million). However, imports increased in W.P. Kuala Lumpur by RM2.9 billion, Selangor (+RM2.2 billion), Negeri Sembilan (+RM1.4 billion), Pahang (+RM743.5 million), Perak (+RM328.2 million), W.P. Labuan (+RM304.3 million), Sabah (+RM229.3 million), Terengganu (+RM99.3 million) and Perlis (+RM7.9 million).*


*Selangor continued to dominate Malaysia's imports with a share of 25.9 per cent, followed by Johor (24.3%), Pulau Pinang (19.2%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (8.2%) and Kedah (5.5%).*


