PERANGKAAAN PEMBUATAN BULANAN, MALAYSIA, OKTOBER 2023

**Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan susut 1.4 peratus kepada RM156.7 bilion
pada Oktober 2023**

PUTRAJAYA, 11 Disember 2023 - Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan susut kepada 1.4 peratus tahun ke tahun kepada RM156.7 bilion pada Oktober 2023. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) melaporkan dalam keluaran **Perangkaan Pembuatan Bulanan, Malaysia, Oktober 2023** pada hari ini.

Menurut Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, “Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan menurun 1.4 peratus pada Oktober 2023, namun pada kadar yang lebih kecil berbanding kemerosotan 2.4 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya. Penurunan tersebut sebahagian besarnya dipengaruhi oleh kejatuhan berterusan dalam subsektor Petroleum, kimia, getah & plastik sebanyak 9.5 peratus (September 2023: -12.3%); dan subsektor Peralatan elektrik & elektronik yang menyusut sebanyak 2.7 peratus (September 2023: -0.04%). Berbanding bulan sebelumnya, nilai jualan menurun sedikit 0.7 peratus berbanding RM157.8 bilion yang direkodkan pada September 2023 (3.7%).”

Nilai jualan industri berorientasikan eksport yang merangkumi lebih dua pertiga daripada jumlah jualan, menurun 5.2 peratus pada Oktober 2023, selepas penyusutan 5.9 peratus pada September 2023. Ini disebabkan terutamanya oleh penurunan dua digit dalam Pembuatan kok & produk petroleum bertapis kepada negatif 18.4 peratus. Tambahan lagi, Pembuatan minyak & lemak daripada sayuran & haiwan; dan Pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik & optikal turut mempengaruhi penurunan dengan masing-masing merekodkan negatif 3.6 peratus dan 2.8 peratus.

Namun begitu, industri berorientasikan domestik merekodkan pertumbuhan kukuh sebanyak 9.9 peratus pada Oktober 2023 (September 2023: 8.2%). Pengembangan yang stabil ini disokong terutamanya oleh pertumbuhan ketara 20.6 peratus dalam nilai jualan Pembuatan kenderaan bermotor, treler & semi treler. Tambahan lagi, Pembuatan produk makanan (10.5%); dan Pembuatan produk logam, kecuali mesin & kelengkapan (9.2%) juga menyumbang secara signifikan dalam merangsang prestasi industri berorientasikan domestik. Perbandingan bulan ke bulan, industri

berorientasikan eksport menyusut 2.1 peratus manakala industri berorientasikan domestik berkembang 3.2 peratus.

Mengulas mengenai bilangan pekerja, Ketua Perangkawan berkata, “Sektor Pembuatan melibatkan seramai 2.38 juta orang pada Oktober 2023, meningkat 2.5 peratus berbanding 2.32 juta orang yang dicatatkan pada Oktober 2022. Kenaikan tersebut didorong terutamanya oleh peningkatan bilangan pekerja dalam subsektor Makanan, minuman & tembakau (7.7%); Produk mineral bukan logam, logam asas & produk logam yang direka (2.5%); dan Produk elektrik & elektronik (1.6%). Bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, bilangan pekerja dalam sektor Pembuatan meningkat sedikit 0.2 peratus.”

Selaras dengan trend positif pekerja, gaji & upah yang dibayar dalam sektor Pembuatan berkembang sebanyak 3.4 peratus tahun ke tahun, berjumlah RM8.1 bilion pada Oktober 2023. Berbanding bulan sebelumnya, gaji & upah yang dibayar mencatatkan pertumbuhan marginal 0.1 peratus berbanding 1.7 peratus yang dicatatkan pada bulan September 2023. Tambahan lagi, nilai jualan bagi setiap pekerja menurun 3.7 peratus untuk merekodkan RM65,879 manakala purata gaji & upah bagi setiap pekerja pada Oktober 2023 adalah RM3,425 yang meningkat sebanyak 0.9 peratus tahun ke tahun.


Merumuskan prestasi bagi sepuluh bulan pertama tahun 2023, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata, “Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan mencecah RM1.50 trilion, menunjukkan pertumbuhan marginal 0.9 peratus berbanding tempoh yang sama tahun sebelumnya (Jan. - Okt. 2022: 17.1%). Pada tempoh tersebut, bilangan pekerja meningkat sebanyak 2.5 peratus, mencapai seramai 2.38 juta orang manakala gaji & upah menokok sebanyak 3.6 peratus, berjumlah RM80.9 bilion. Tambahan lagi, nilai jualan per pekerja berjumlah RM630,367, merekodkan penurunan 3.7 peratus.”




**Carta 1: Nilai Jualan Sektor Pembuatan, Malaysia
Oktober 2022 - Oktober 2023**




**Carta 2: Pertumbuhan Jualan Subsektor Pembuatan, Malaysia,
September dan Oktober 2023**





MONTHLY MANUFACTURING STATISTICS, MALAYSIA, OCTOBER 2023

The sales value of the Manufacturing sector dropped by 1.4 per cent to RM156.7 billion in October 2023

PUTRAJAYA, 11 December 2023 – The sales value of the Manufacturing sector dropped by 1.4 per cent year-on-year to RM156.7 billion in October 2023. The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) reported today in the release of **Monthly Manufacturing Statistics, Malaysia, October 2023**.

According to Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia, “The sales value of the Manufacturing sector declined by 1.4 per cent in October 2023, albeit at a smaller rate as compared to the 2.4 per cent drop in the preceding month. The decrease was predominantly influenced by the persistent decline in the Petroleum, chemical, rubber & plastic products sub-sector by 9.5 per cent (September 2023: -12.3%); and the Electrical & electronics products sub-sector which fell by 2.7 per cent (September 2023: -0.04%). As compared to the preceding month, the sales value inched down by 0.7 per cent as against RM157.8 billion recorded in September 2023 (3.7%).”

The sales value of export-oriented industries which accounted for more than two-thirds of total sales, decreased by 5.2 per cent in October 2023, following a 5.9 per cent contraction in September 2023. It was mainly attributed to the double-digit decrease in the Manufacture of coke & refined petroleum products by negative 18.4 per cent. In addition, the Manufacture of vegetable & animal oils & fats; and Manufacture of computer, electronics & optical products also influenced the deterioration by registering negative 3.6 per cent and 2.8 per cent respectively.

Nonetheless, the domestic-oriented industries recorded vibrant growth of 9.9 per cent in October 2023 (September 2023: 8.2%). The steady expansion was primarily spurred by the noteworthy 20.6 per cent growth in the sales value of the Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers & semi-trailers. Furthermore, the Manufacture of food products (10.5%); and the Manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery & equipment (9.2%) also contributed significantly in propelling the performance of domestic-oriented industries. On a month-on-month comparison,

export-oriented industries shrank by 2.1 per cent while domestic-oriented industries expanded by 3.2 per cent.

Commenting on the number of employees, the Chief Statistician Malaysia said, “The Manufacturing sector engaged 2.38 million persons in October 2023, an increase of 2.5 per cent as compared to the 2.32 million persons registered in October 2022. The increment was mainly attributable to the rise in the number of employees in the Food, beverages & tobacco (7.7%); Non-metallic mineral products, basic metal & fabricated metal products (2.5%); and Electrical & electronic products (1.6%) sub-sectors. On a month-on-month basis, the number of employees in the Manufacturing sector increased slightly by 0.2 per cent.”

Resembling the positive trend in employment, the salaries & wages paid in the Manufacturing sector rose by 3.4 per cent year-on-year, totalling RM8.1 billion in October 2023. As compared to the previous month, the salaries & wages paid posted a marginal growth of 0.1 per cent as against 1.7 per cent registered in September 2023. Furthermore, the sales value per employee decreased by 3.7 per cent to record RM65,879 while the average salaries & wages per employee in October 2023 was RM3,425 which rose by 0.9 per cent year-on-year.


Summarising the performance for the first ten months of 2023, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, “The Manufacturing sector achieved sales value worth RM1.50 trillion, showing a slight growth of 0.9 per cent as compared to the same period in the preceding year (Jan. - Oct. 2022: 17.1%). During this period, the number of employees increased by 2.5 per cent, reaching a total of 2.38 million persons while salaries & wages grew by 3.6 per cent, amounting to RM80.9 billion. Moreover, the sales value per employee stood at RM630,367, reflecting a decline of 3.7 per cent.”

September and October 2023**




Chart 3: Sales Value of the Export and Domestic-oriented Industries for Manufacturing Sector, Malaysia, October 2022 – October 2023




Chart 4: Manufacturing Export-Oriented by Group, Malaysia, September and October 2023





Chart 5: Manufacturing Domestic-Oriented by Group, Malaysia, September and October 2023
