NOVEMBER 2023

Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian meningkat marginal 0.6 peratus pada November 2023

PUTRAJAYA, 11 Januari 2024 – Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian meningkat marginal 0.6 peratus tahun ke tahun pada November 2023 dipengaruhi oleh pertumbuhan sederhana dalam sektor Perlombongan dan Elektrik, meskipun sektor Pembuatan mengalami penurunan. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia melaporkan dalam keluaran **Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian (IPP), Malaysia, November 2023** pada hari ini. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik IPP yang terdiri daripada tiga sektor iaitu Perlombongan, Pembuatan dan Elektrik.

Mengulas laporan tersebut, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia berkata, "Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian meningkat marginal 0.6 peratus tahun ke tahun pada November 2023 selepas mencatatkan pertumbuhan 2.4 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya. Peningkatan ini disokong oleh pengembangan sederhana dalam sektor Perlombongan sebanyak 1.9 peratus (Oktober 2023: 7.4%) dan sektor Elektrik sebanyak 4.2 peratus (Oktober 2023: 5.6%). Sementara itu, sektor Pembuatan menurun kepada negatif 0.1 peratus selepas tumbuh positif bagi dua bulan berturut-turut (Oktober 2023: 0.9%). Perbandingan bulan ke bulan menunjukkan IPP kembali kepada jajaran negatif (-0.9%) berbanding positif 1.9 peratus yang direkodkan pada bulan sebelumnya."

Ketua Perangkawan mengulas lanjut, "Penurunan pengeluaran Pembuatan adalah disebabkan oleh pengeluaran output yang lebih rendah dalam industri berorientasikan eksport yang merosot 2.7 peratus (Oktober 2023: -1.6%). Penyusutan ini dipengaruhi terutamanya oleh kejatuhan dalam Pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik & optikal (-8.6%); Pembuatan kok & produk petroleum bertapis (-1.8%); dan Pembuatan kayu & produk kayu & gabus (-1.9%). Trend ini selari dengan eksport negara yang mengalami kemerosotan sejak Mac 2023 dan merekodkan negatif 5.9 peratus pada November. Perbandingan dengan bulan sebelumnya, industri berorientasikan eksport menyusut 2.2 peratus.

Sebaliknya, industri berorientasikan domestik kekal kukuh dengan mencatatkan peningkatan 5.8 peratus pada November 2023 (Oktober 2023: 6.7%). Kenaikan ini didorong terutamanya oleh pertumbuhan dua digit 10.9 peratus dalam Pembuatan produk prosesan makanan; Pembuatan produk logam yang direka, kecuali mesin & kelengkapan sebanyak 8.9 peratus; dan Pembuatan produk galian bukan logam lain sebanyak 6.9 peratus. Perbandingan dengan bulan sebelumnya, industri berorientasikan domestik pulih kepada 3.7 peratus berbanding negatif 1.4 peratus yang direkodkan pada Oktober 2023.”

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin turut menambah, “Pertumbuhan pengeluaran sektor Perlombongan menyederhana kepada 1.9 peratus pada November 2023 (Oktober 2023: 7.4%) kesan daripada peningkatan sederhana dalam Gas Asli dan Minyak Mentah & Kondensat masing-masing sebanyak 1.7 peratus (Oktober 2023: 7.6%) dan 2.1 peratus (Oktober 2023: 7.2%). Berbanding Oktober 2023, indeks Perlombongan merosot 1.8 peratus berbanding pertumbuhan dua digit 15.3 peratus yang dicatatkan pada bulan sebelumnya.”

Pertumbuhan pengeluaran Elektrik menyederhana kepada 4.2 peratus pada November 2023 selepas mencatatkan peningkatan 5.6 peratus pada bulan lalu. Berbanding bulan sebelumnya, indeks Elektrik menurun 4.6 peratus berbanding positif 5.3 peratus yang direkodkan pada Oktober 2023.

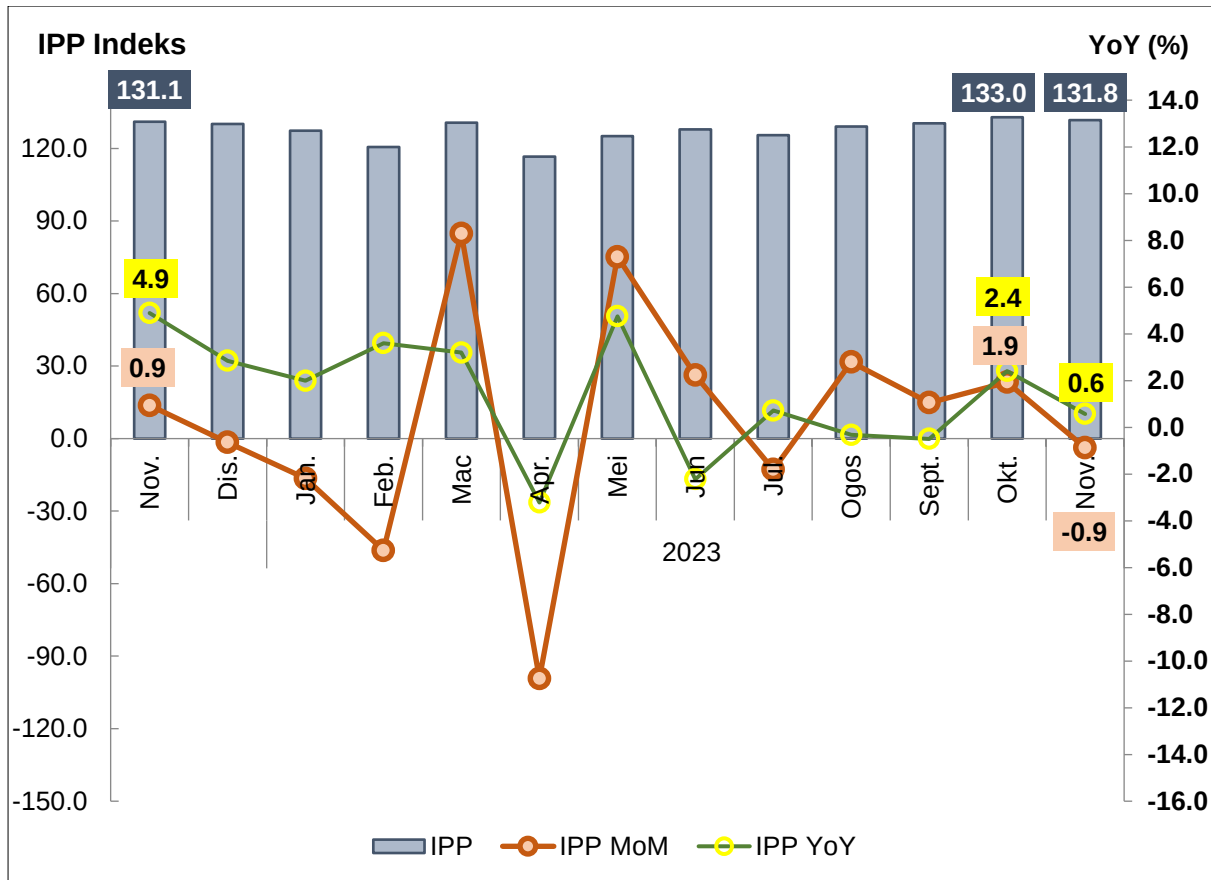
Merumuskan kenyataannya mengenai prestasi IPP bagi sebelas bulan pertama tahun 2023, Ketua Perangkawan berkata, “IPP meningkat pada kadar yang lebih perlahan sebanyak 1.0 peratus berbanding tempoh yang sama tahun sebelumnya (Januari – November 2022: 7.1%). Peningkatan ini disokong oleh indeks Elektrik (2.3%); indeks Pembuatan (0.9%); dan indeks Perlombongan (0.6%).”

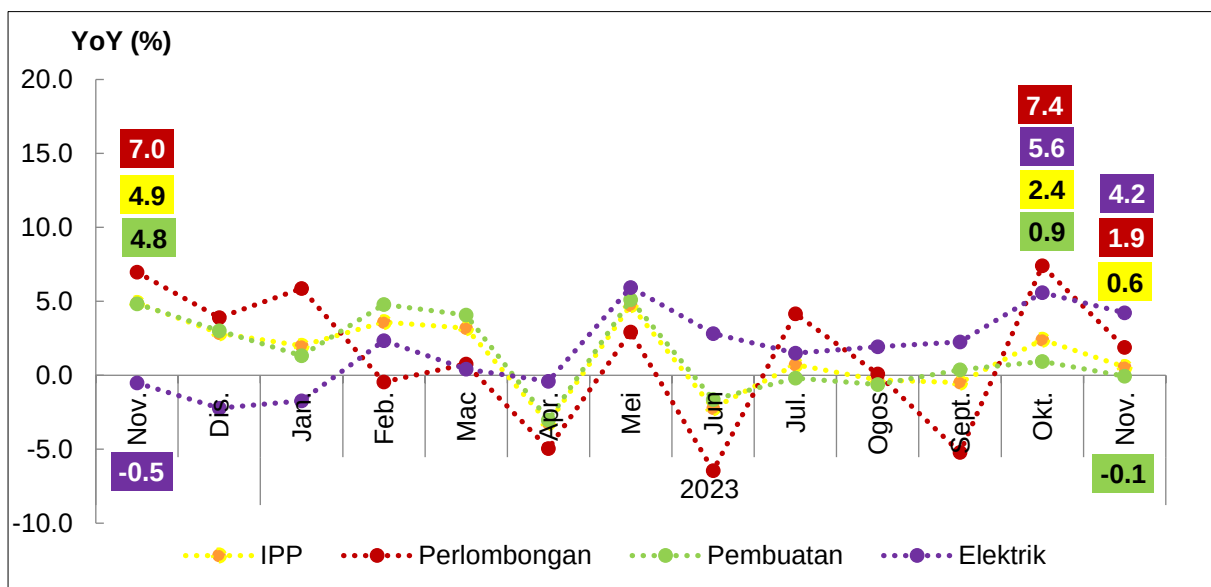

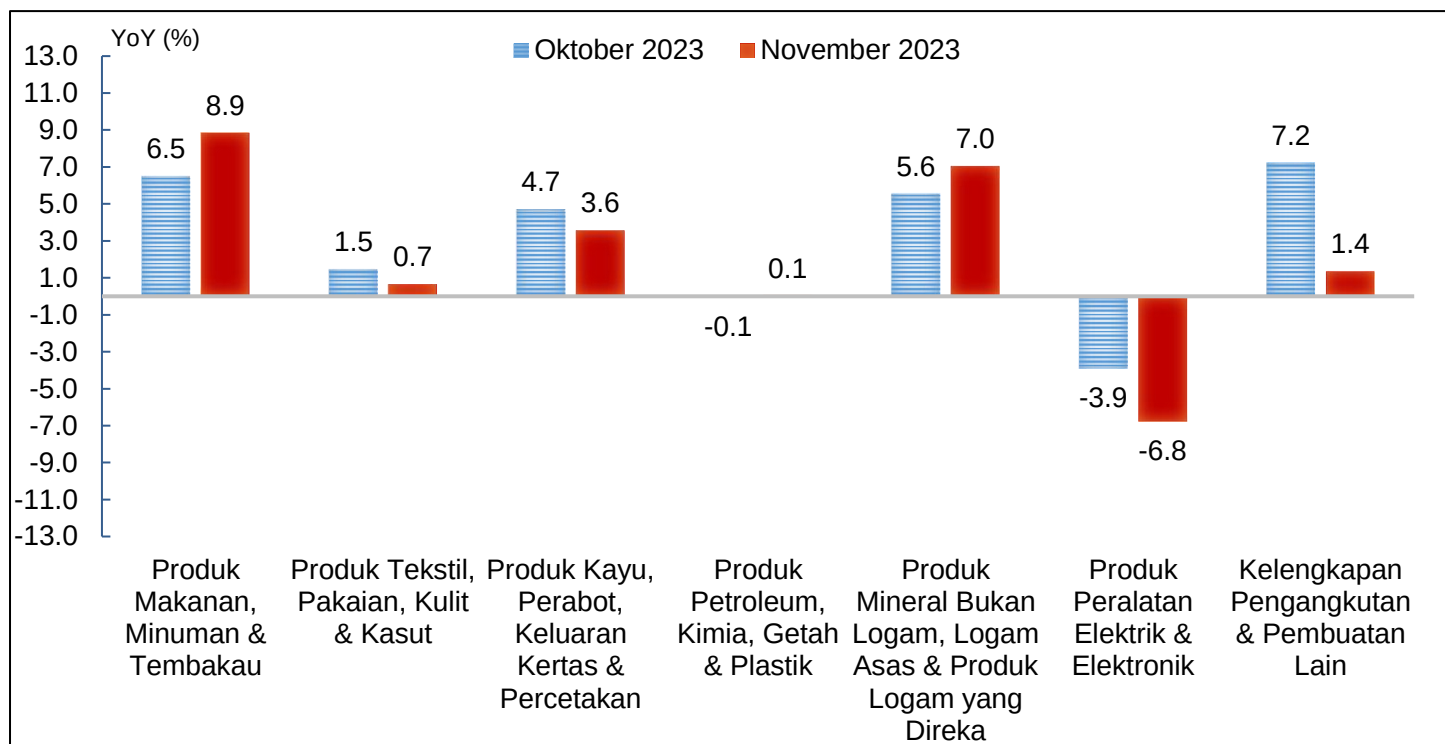
**Carta 1: Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian, Malaysia,
November 2022 - November 2023**



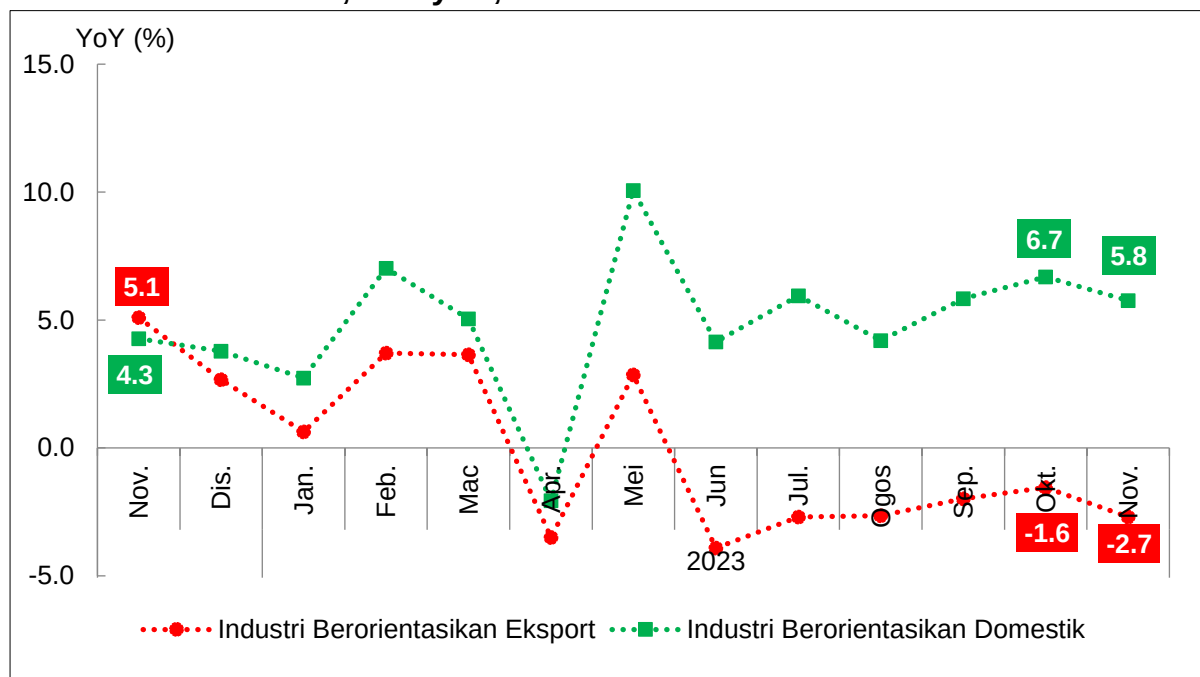
**Carta 2: Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian dan Komponennya, Malaysia
November 2022 - November 2023**



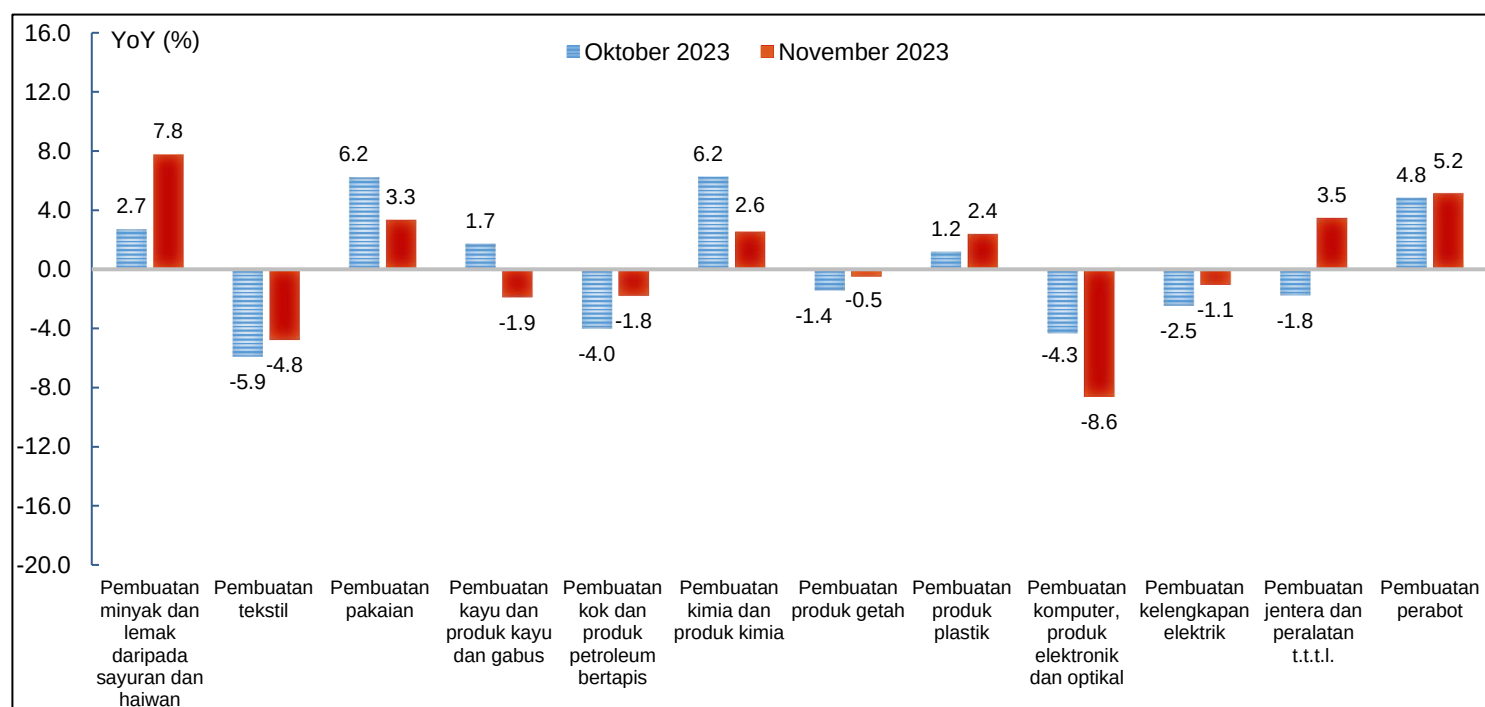
**Carta 3: Pertumbuhan Indeks Pembuatan Mengikut Subsektor, Malaysia
Oktober dan November 2023**



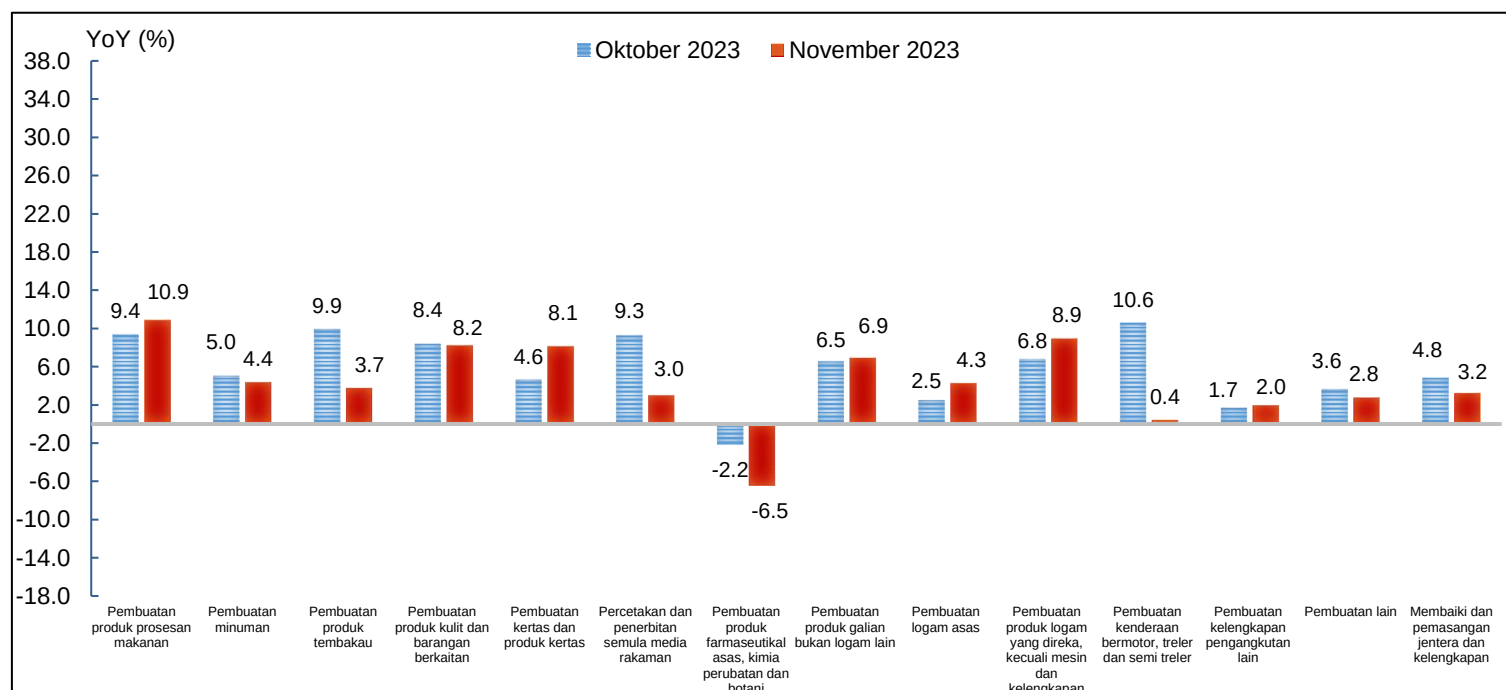
Carta 4: Indeks Pembuatan Mengikut Industri Berorientasikan Eksport dan Domestik, Malaysia, November 2022 - November 2023

The Industrial Production Index inched up marginally by 0.6 per cent in November 2023

PUTRAJAYA, 11 January 2024 - The Industrial Production Index inched up marginally by 0.6 per cent year-on-year in November 2023 attributed to modest growth in Mining and Electricity sectors, despite a decline in the Manufacturing sector. The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) reported today in the release of the **Industrial Production Index (IPI), Malaysia, November 2023**. This publication presents IPI statistics, consisting of three sectors namely Mining, Manufacturing and Electricity.

Commenting on the report, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, the Chief Statistician said, "The Industrial Production Index inched up marginally by 0.6 per cent year-on-year in November 2023 after recording a growth of 2.4 per cent in the previous month. The increase was backed by the modest expansion in the Mining sector at 1.9 per cent (October 2023: 7.4%) and Electricity sector by 4.2 per cent (October 2023: 5.6%). Meanwhile, the Manufacturing sector turned downward to a negative 0.1 per cent following positive growth for two consecutive months (October 2023: 0.9%). On a month-on-month comparison, the IPI returned to negative territory (-0.9%) as compared to the positive 1.9 per cent recorded in the previous month."

The Chief Statistician further elaborated, "The decrease in the Manufacturing output was due to the lower output production in the export-oriented industries which dropped by 2.7 per cent (October 2023: -1.6%). The contraction was mainly attributable to the fall in the Manufacture of computer, electronics & optical products (-8.6%); Manufacture of coke & refined petroleum products (-1.8%); and the Manufacture of wood & products of wood & cork (-1.9%). This was in line with the country's export performance, which had been trending downward since March 2023 and recorded a negative 5.9 per cent in November. In comparison with the preceding month, the export-oriented industries slipped by 2.2 per cent.

On the other hand, the domestic-oriented industries remained resilient by registering an increase of 5.8 per cent in November 2023 (October 2023: 6.7%). The rise was

spearheaded mainly by the double-digit growth of 10.9 per cent in the Manufacture of food processing products; Manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery & equipment by 8.9 per cent; and Manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products by 6.9 per cent. In comparison with the preceding month, the domestic-oriented industries rebounded to 3.7 per cent as against the negative 1.4 per cent registered in October 2023.”

Adding further, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, “The growth of output in the Mining sector slowed down to 1.9 per cent in November 2023 (October 2023: 7.4%) as a consequence of a modest increase in the Natural Gas and Crude Oil & Condensate at 1.7 per cent (October 2023: 7.6%) and 2.1 per cent (October 2023: 7.2%) respectively. As compared to October 2023, the Mining index decreased by 1.8 per cent in contrast to the double-digit growth of 15.3 per cent registered in the previous month.”

The growth of Electricity output moderated to 4.2 per cent in November 2023 after registering an increase of 5.6 per cent in the preceding month. In comparison to the previous month, the Electricity index declined by 4.6 per cent, as compared to the positive 5.3 per cent recorded in October 2023.

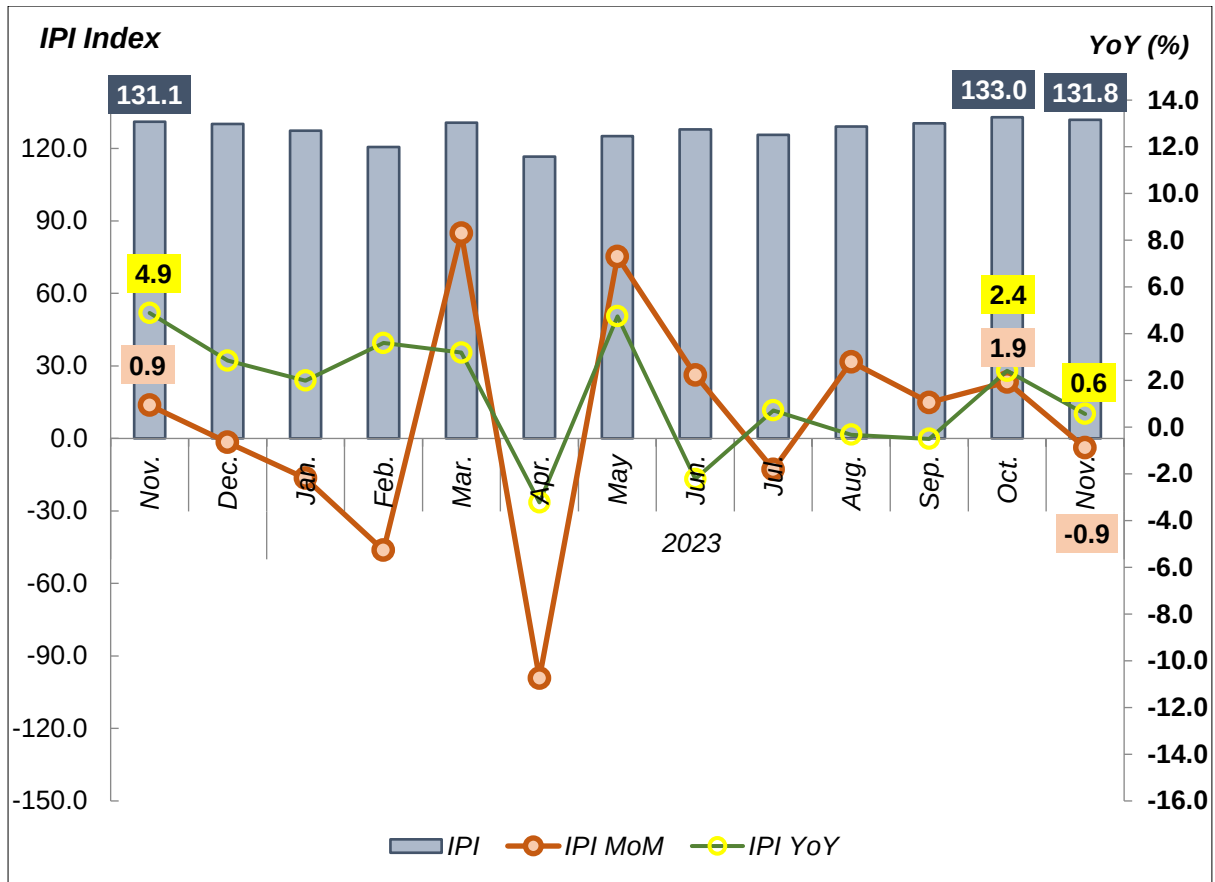
Concluding his statement on the IPI performance for the first eleven months of 2023, the Chief Statistician said, “The IPI rose at a slower rate of 1.0 per cent as compared to the same period of the previous year (January - November 2022: 7.1%). The increase was supported by the Electricity index (2.3%); Manufacturing index (0.9%); and Mining index (0.6%).”

November 2022 – November 2023**

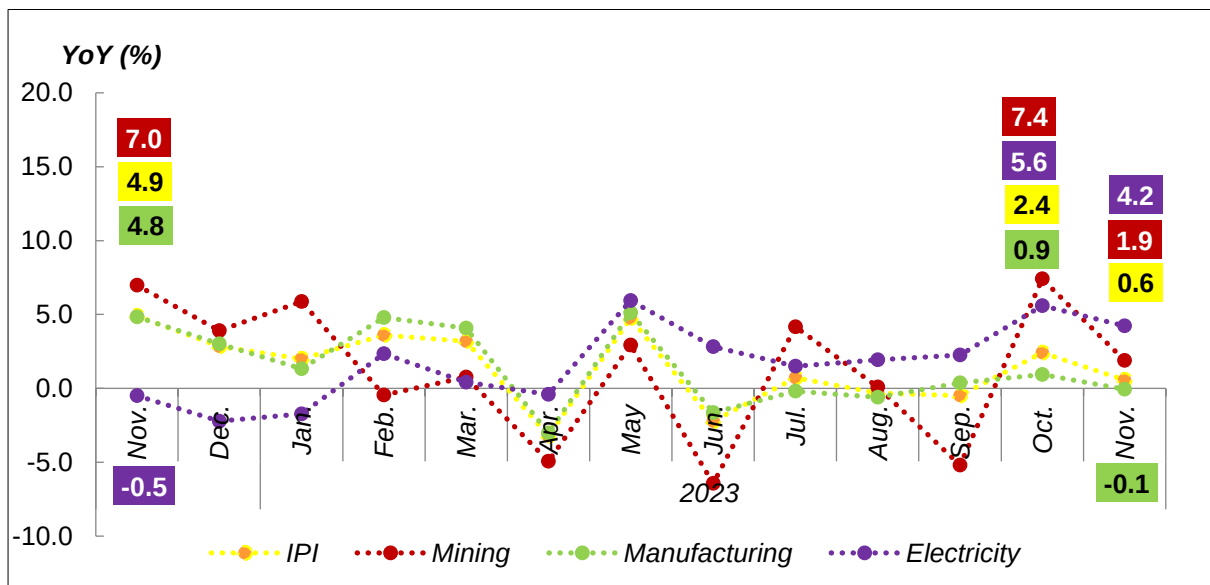


Chart 3: Manufacturing Index Growth by Subsector, Malaysia, October and November 2023

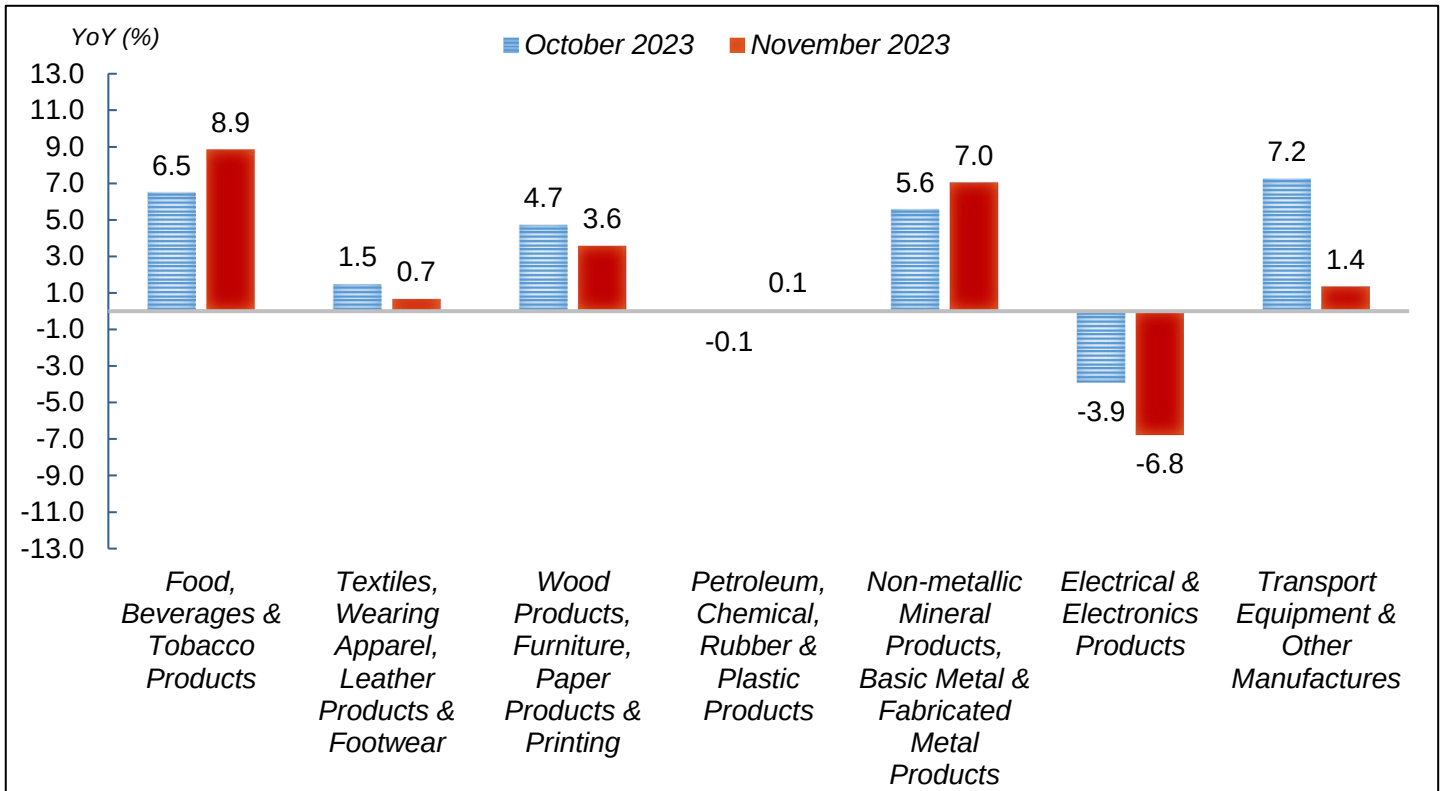
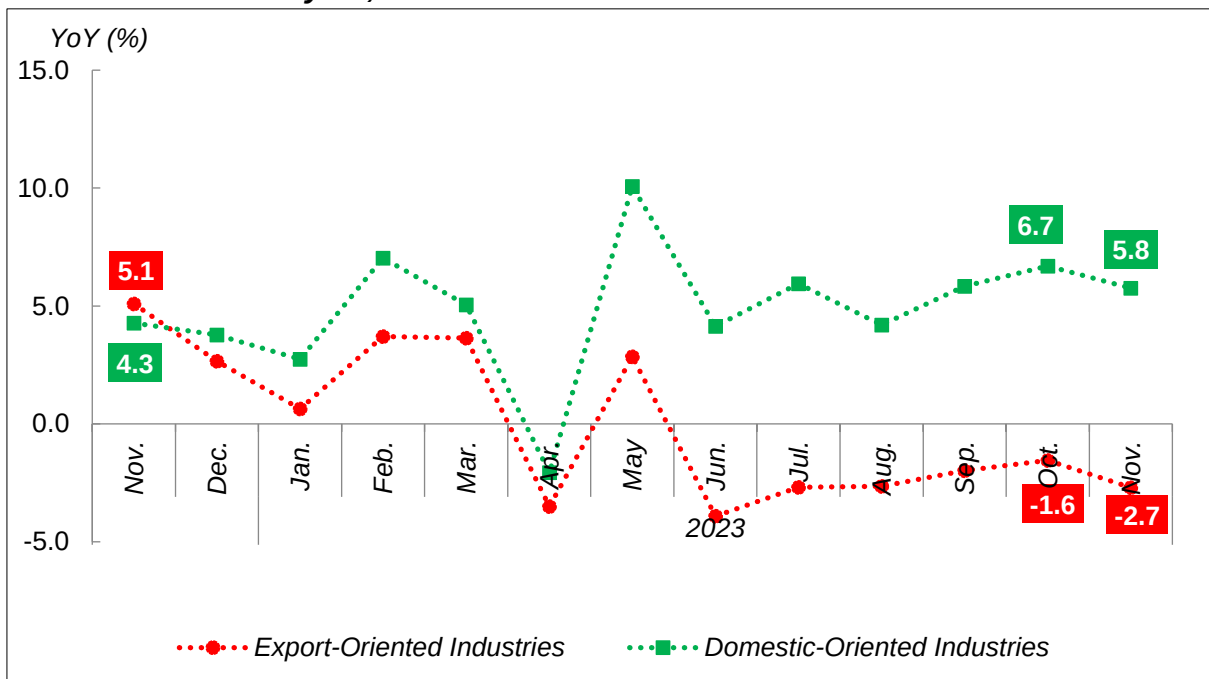
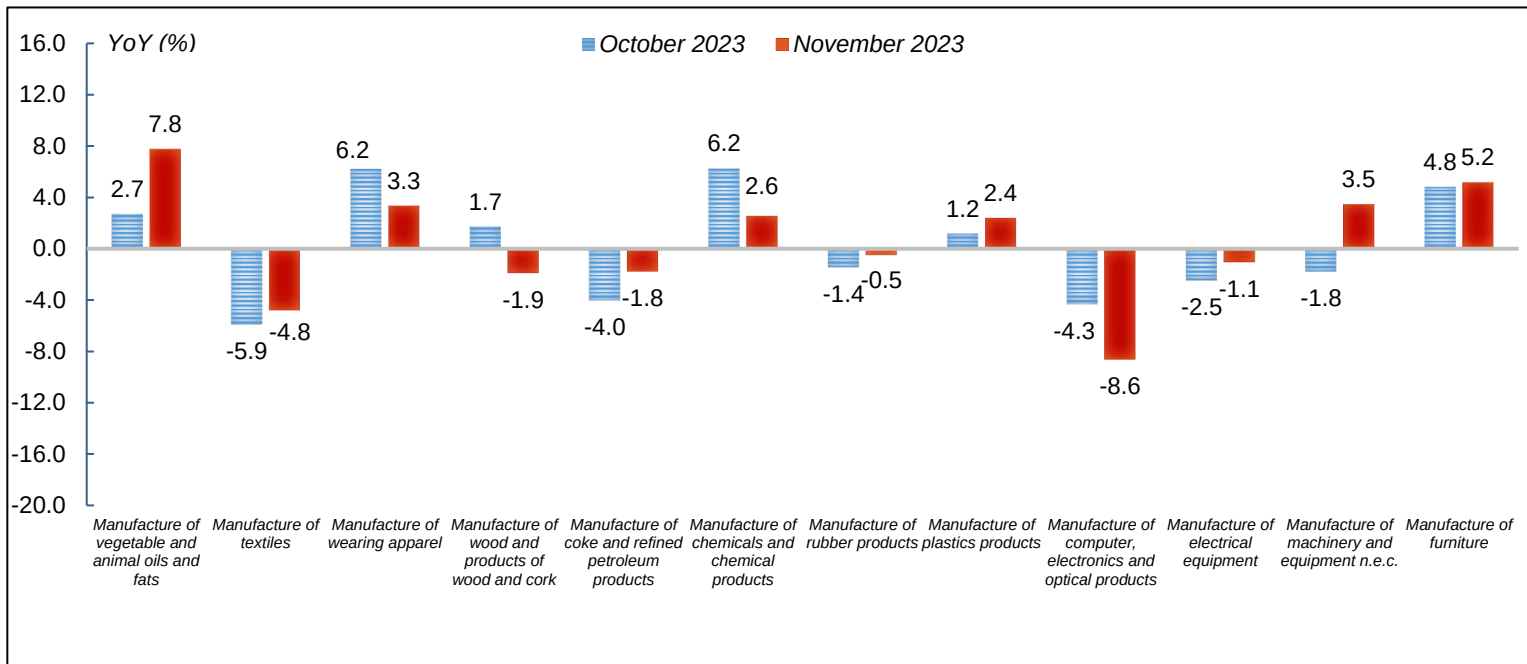


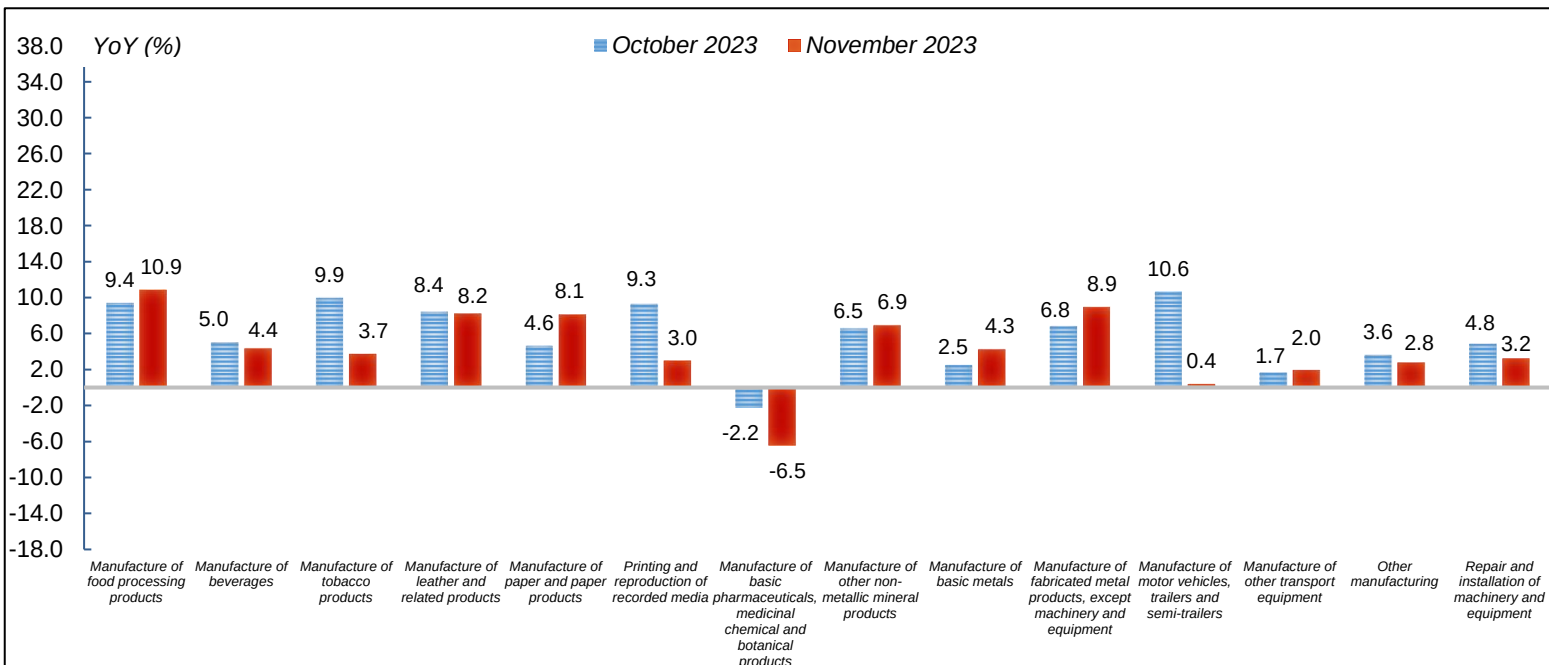
Chart 4: Manufacturing Index by Export and Domestic Oriented Industries, Malaysia, November 2022 – November 2023
