Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan susut 2.6 peratus kepada RM155.0 bilion pada November 2023

PUTRAJAYA, 11 Januari 2024 - Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan susut 2.6 peratus tahun ke tahun kepada RM155.0 bilion pada November 2023. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) melaporkan dalam keluaran **Perangkaan Pembuatan Bulanan, Malaysia, November 2023** pada hari ini.

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia menyatakan, "Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan terus menyusut sebanyak 2.6 peratus pada November 2023 daripada penurunan 1.4 peratus yang dicatatkan pada bulan sebelumnya. Penurunan tersebut disebabkan terutamanya oleh kejatuhan ketara dalam subsektor Petroleum, kimia, getah & plastik sebanyak 10.8 peratus (Oktober 2023: -9.5%); dan subsektor Peralatan elektrik & elektronik yang susut 5.3 peratus (Oktober 2023: -2.7%). Berbanding bulan sebelumnya, nilai jualan menurun sebanyak 1.1 peratus berbanding RM156.7 bilion yang direkodkan pada Oktober 2023 (-0.7%)."

Nilai jualan industri berorientasikan eksport yang merangkumi lebih dua pertiga daripada jumlah jualan, mencatatkan penurunan yang lebih besar iaitu sebanyak 6.9 peratus pada November 2023 berbanding negatif 5.2 peratus yang direkodkan pada Oktober 2023. Penurunan tersebut dipengaruhi terutamanya oleh penyusutan dalam Pembuatan kok & produk petroleum bertapis pada negatif 10.0 peratus, diikuti dengan Pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik & optikal (-6.6%); dan Pembuatan minyak & lemak daripada sayuran & haiwan (-3.8%).

Namun begitu, industri berorientasikan domestik terus mengekalkan momentum positif dengan merekodkan 8.8 peratus pada November 2023 (Oktober 2023: 9.7%). Pengembangan itu didorong terutamanya oleh pertumbuhan kukuh dalam Pembuatan produk makanan sebanyak 11.4 peratus; Pembuatan kenderaan bermotor, treler & semi treler (11.3%); dan Pembuatan produk logam, kecuali mesin & kelengkapan (11.3%). Perbandingan bulan ke bulan, industri berorientasikan eksport menyusut 3.6 peratus manakala industri berorientasikan domestik berkembang sebanyak 5.3 peratus.

Mengulas mengenai bilangan pekerja, Ketua Perangkawan menambah, “Sektor Pembuatan melibatkan seramai 2.38 juta orang pada November 2023, meningkat 2.1 peratus berbanding 2.33 juta orang yang dicatatkan pada November 2022. Kenaikan tersebut didorong terutamanya oleh peningkatan bilangan pekerja dalam subsektor Makanan, minuman & tembakau (6.9%); Produk mineral bukan logam, logam asas & produk logam yang direka (2.3%); dan Produk elektrik & elektronik (0.7%). Perbandingan bulan ke bulan, bilangan pekerja dalam sektor Pembuatan menurun sedikit 0.04 peratus.”

Selari dengan pertambahan bilangan pekerja, gaji & upah yang dibayar dalam sektor Pembuatan meningkat sebanyak 3.3 peratus tahun ke tahun yang berjumlah RM8.1 bilion pada November 2023. Bagi perbandingan bulan ke bulan, gaji & upah yang dibayar mencatatkan pertumbuhan marginal 0.04 peratus berbanding 0.1 peratus yang dicatatkan pada Oktober 2023. Tambahan lagi, nilai jualan bagi setiap pekerja menurun 4.7 peratus untuk merekodkan RM65,193 manakala purata gaji & upah bagi setiap pekerja pada November 2023 adalah RM3,428 dengan peningkatan sebanyak 1.1 peratus tahun ke tahun.


Merumuskan prestasi bagi sebelas bulan pertama tahun 2023, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin mengulas, “Nilai jualan sektor Pembuatan mencecah RM1.65 trilion, tumbuh marginal 0.6 peratus berbanding tempoh yang sama tahun sebelumnya (Januari - November 2022: 16.6%). Pada tempoh tersebut, bilangan pekerja bertambah 2.1 peratus dengan merekodkan seramai 2.38 juta orang manakala gaji & upah menokok sebanyak 3.6 peratus, berjumlah RM89.0 bilion. Sementara itu, nilai jualan per pekerja menurun sebanyak 1.8 peratus, berjumlah RM701,986.”




**Carta 1: Nilai Jualan Sektor Pembuatan, Malaysia
November 2022 - November 2023**




**Carta 2: Pertumbuhan Jualan Subsektor Pembuatan, Malaysia,
Oktober dan November 2023**





The sales value of the Manufacturing sector slipped by 2.6 per cent to register RM155.0 billion in November 2023

PUTRAJAYA, 11 January 2024 – The sales value of the Manufacturing sector slipped by 2.6 per cent year-on-year to register RM155.0 billion in November 2023. The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) reported today in the release of ***Monthly Manufacturing Statistics, Malaysia, November 2023.***

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, Chief Statistician Malaysia stated, “The sales value of the Manufacturing sector slipped further by 2.6 per cent in November 2023 from the 1.4 per cent decline registered in the preceding month. The decrease was primarily due to the substantial drop in the Petroleum, chemical, rubber & plastic products sub-sector by 10.8 per cent (October 2023: -9.5%); and the Electrical & electronics products sub-sector which fell by 5.3 per cent (October 2023: -2.7%). As compared to the preceding month, the sales value descended by 1.1 per cent as against RM156.7 billion recorded in October 2023 (-0.7%).”

The sales value of export-oriented industries which accounted for more than two-thirds of total sales, posted a wider decline by 6.9 per cent in November 2023 as compared to the negative 5.2 per cent registered in October 2023. The decline was predominantly attributable to the decrease in the Manufacture of coke & refined petroleum products at negative 10.0 per cent, followed by the Manufacture of computer, electronics & optical products (-6.6%); and Manufacture of vegetable & animal oils & fats (-3.8%).

Nonetheless, the domestic-oriented industries sustained the positive momentum by recording 8.8 per cent in November 2023 (October 2023: 9.7%). The expansion was fueled primarily by the strong growth in the Manufacture of food products by 11.4 per cent; Manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers & semi-trailers (11.3%); and Manufacture of fabricated metal products, except machinery & equipment (11.3%). On a month-on-month comparison, export-oriented industries dropped by 3.6 per cent while domestic-oriented industries expanded by 5.3 per cent.

Commenting on the number of employees, the Chief Statistician Malaysia added, “The Manufacturing sector engaged 2.38 million persons in November 2023, an increase of 2.1 per cent as compared to the 2.33 million persons registered in November 2022. The increment was mainly attributable to the rise in the number of employees in the Food, beverages & tobacco (6.9%); Non-metallic mineral products, basic metal & fabricated metal products (2.3%); and Electrical & electronic products (0.7%) sub-sectors. On a month-on-month basis, the number of employees in the Manufacturing sector declined slightly by 0.04 per cent.”

In tandem with the addition in the number of employees, the salaries & wages paid in the Manufacturing sector rose by 3.3 per cent year-on-year, totalling RM8.1 billion in November 2023. On a month-on-month comparison, the salaries & wages paid posted a marginal growth of 0.04 per cent as against 0.1 per cent registered in October 2023. Furthermore, the sales value per employee decreased by 4.7 per cent to record RM65,193 while the average salaries & wages per employee in November 2023 was RM3,428 which rose by 1.1 per cent year-on-year.


Summarising the performance for the first eleven months of 2023, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin commented, “The sales value of the Manufacturing sector attained RM1.65 trillion, grew marginally by 0.6 per cent as compared to the same period in the preceding year (January – November 2022: 16.6%). During this period, the number of employees added by 2.1 per cent, to record a total of 2.38 million persons while salaries & wages advanced by 3.6 per cent, amounting to RM89.0 billion. Meanwhile, the sales value per employee declined by 1.8 per cent, amounting to RM701,986.”

October and November 2023**




Chart 3: Sales Value of the Export and Domestic-oriented Industries for Manufacturing Sector, Malaysia, November 2022 – November 2023




Chart 4: Manufacturing Export-Oriented by Group, Malaysia, October and November 2023





Chart 5: Manufacturing Domestic-Oriented by Group, Malaysia, October and November 2023
