**Pengeluaran getah asli Malaysia  
menurun 6.9 peratus pada November 2023**

PUTRAJAYA, 12 Januari 2024 – Pada hari ini, Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) menerbitkan **Perangkaan Getah Bulanan, Malaysia, November 2023**. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik pengeluaran, import, eksport, penggunaan domestik, stok, harga, bilangan pekerja, gaji & upah dan produktiviti bagi estet getah.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata, pengeluaran getah asli menurun 6.9 peratus pada bulan November 2023 (30,669 tan metrik) berbanding pada bulan Oktober 2023 (32,944 tan metrik). Perbandingan tahun ke tahun menunjukkan pengeluaran getah asli meningkat 9.3 peratus (November 2022: 28,048 tan metrik). Pengeluaran getah asli Malaysia pada November 2023 disumbangkan terutamanya oleh sektor pekebun kecil (85.3%) berbanding sektor estet (14.7%).

Jumlah stok getah asli pada November 2023 meningkat 13.2 peratus kepada 172,335 tan metrik berbanding 152,196 tan metrik pada Oktober 2023. Kilang pemproses getah menyumbang stok akhir sebanyak 89.8 peratus diikuti kilang pengguna getah (10.1%) dan estet getah (0.1%).

Eksport getah asli Malaysia berjumlah 51,437 tan metrik pada November 2023, menurun 8.9 peratus berbanding Oktober 2023 (56,460 tan metrik). China terus kekal sebagai destinasi utama untuk eksport getah asli iaitu berjumlah 48.3 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan eksport pada November 2023 diikuti Jerman (8.9%), Iran (5.7%), Amerika Syarikat (4.0%) dan Pakistan (2.8%). Prestasi eksport disumbangkan oleh produk berasaskan getah asli seperti sarung tangan getah, tayar, tiub, benang getah dan kondom. Produk sarung tangan getah merupakan eksport utama dengan nilai sebanyak RM1.01 billion pada November 2023, meningkat 1.0 peratus berbanding Oktober 2023 (RM1.0 billion).

Analisis perbandingan harga purata bulanan menunjukkan Lateks Pekat merekodkan peningkatan iaitu 3.3 peratus (November 2023: 549.67 sen sekilogram; Oktober 2023: 532.20 sen sekilogram) manakala Sekerap meningkat 2.4 peratus (November 2023: 562.24 sen sekilogram; Oktober 2023: 548.84 sen sekilogram). Harga bagi semua jenis Getah Mutu Malaysia (G.M.M) pula meningkat antara 1.0 peratus hingga 3.2 peratus. *The World Bank Commodity Price Data* melaporkan harga bagi jenis TSR 20 (*Technically Specified Rubber*) meningkat 2.2 peratus (daripada USD 1.45/kg kepada USD1.48/kg) dan SGP/MYS (Singapura/Malaysia) meningkat 4.2 peratus (daripada USD1.61/kg kepada USD1.67/kg).

Menurut *Malaysia Rubber Board Digest* pada November 2023, pasaran getah Kuala Lumpur menunjukkan trend bercampur-campur. Secara keseluruhannya, sentimen positif disumbangkan oleh langkah rangsangan yang diumumkan oleh China dan sasaran ekonomi positif bagi tahun 2024 walaupun kekurangan bekalan getah asli oleh pengeluar utama terutamanya oleh Thailand.





**Malaysia natural rubber production  
decreased by 6.9 per cent in November 2023**

PUTRAJAYA, 12 January 2024 – The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) today released the **Monthly Rubber Statistics, Malaysia, November 2023**. This publication consists of statistics on production, imports, exports, domestic consumption, stocks, prices, number of employees, salaries & wages and productivity of rubber estates.

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, Natural Rubber (NR) production decreased by 6.9 per cent in November 2023 (30,669 tonnes) as compared to October 2023 (32,944 tonnes). Year-on-year comparison showed that the production of NR increased by 9.3 per cent (November 2022: 28,048 tonnes). Production of NR in November 2023 for Malaysia was mainly contributed by smallholders sector (85.3%) as compared to estates sector (14.7%).

Total stocks of NR in November 2023 increased by 13.2 per cent to 172,335 tonnes as compared to 152,196 tonnes in October 2023. Rubber processors factory contributed 89.8 per cent of the stocks followed by rubber consumers factory (10.1%) and rubber estates (0.1%).

Exports of Malaysia's NR amounted to 51,437 tonnes in November 2023, decreased 8.9 per cent as against October 2023 (56,460 tonnes). P.R. China remained as the main destination for NR exports which accounted 48.3 per cent of total exports in

November 2023 followed by Germany (8.9%), Iran (5.7%), the United States of America (4.0%) and Pakistan (2.8%). The exports performance was contributed by NR-based product such as gloves, tyre, tube, rubber thread and condom. Gloves were the main exports of rubber-based products with a value of RM1.01 billion in November 2023, an increase of 1.0 per cent as compared to October 2023 (RM1.0 billion).

Analysis of the average monthly price showed that Concentrated Latex recorded an increase of 3.3 per cent (November 2023: 549.67 sen per kg; October 2023: 532.20 sen per kg) while Scrap increased by 2.4 per cent (November 2023: 562.24 sen per kg; October 2023: 548.84 sen per kg). Prices for all Standard Malaysian Rubber (S.M.R) increased between 1.0 per cent to 3.2 per cent. The World Bank Commodity Price Data reported the prices for TSR 20 (Technically Specified Rubber) has increased 2.2 per cent (from USD1.45/kg to USD1.48/kg) and SGP/MYS (Singapore/Malaysia) increased 4.2 per cent (from USD1.61/kg to USD1.67/kg).

According to the Malaysia Rubber Board Digest in November 2023, the Kuala Lumpur rubber market showed a mixed trend. Overall, the positive sentiment was contributed by the stimulus measure announced by China and its positive economic target for 2024 amid prospect of tight NR supply in major producer especially in Thailand.


The Government of Malaysia has declared National Statistics Day (MyStats Day) on November 20th each year. MyStats Day theme is "Statistics is the Essence of Life".


