**Indeks Pelopor merekodkan 109.8 mata pada November 2023,
menggambarkan pertumbuhan ekonomi yang sederhana dalam masa terdekat**

PUTRAJAYA, 24 Januari 2024 – Pada hari ini, Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia menerbitkan **Penunjuk Ekonomi Malaysia: Indeks Pelopor, Serentak & Susulan bagi November 2023**. Indeks Pelopor (IP) ialah alat yang digunakan untuk meramalkan arah aliran ekonomi secara purata empat hingga enam bulan ke hadapan.

Ketua Perangkawaran Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata, “Malaysia menyaksikan penurunan bagi Indeks Pelopor sebanyak negatif 0.2 peratus kepada 109.8 mata pada November 2023 berbanding 110.0 mata pada bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya (**Paparan I**). Penurunan ini disebabkan oleh prestasi kurang memberangsangkan dalam Bilangan Unit Kediaman Yang Diluluskan Pembinaan (-25.8%) dan Import Benar Semi Konduktor (-18.3%). Walau bagaimanapun, Indeks Perusahaan Bursa Malaysia menunjukkan pertumbuhan sebanyak 17.1% dan kekal positif sejak Mei 2023. Prestasi bulanan IP pula melonjak semula kepada 0.5 peratus berbanding negatif 0.1 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya, didorong oleh peningkatan ketara dalam Import Benar Semi Konduktor (1.0%)”.

Melihat kepada arah aliran jangka panjang terlicin pada November 2023, IP kekal berada di bawah trend 100.0 mata. Sehubungan itu, ekonomi Malaysia dijangka mengekalkan pertumbuhan yang sederhana disokong oleh prestasi berdaya tahan industri berorientasikan domestik meskipun terus berdepan dengan ketidakpastian pasaran antarabangsa (**Paparan II**).

Bagi kedudukan ekonomi semasa, Indeks Serentak (IS) mencatatkan 123.7 mata, meningkat 2.6 peratus berbanding 120.3 mata pada bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Prestasi ini

disumbangkan oleh kesemua komponen terutamanya Nilai Caruman Benar, KWSP (13.7%). Berbeza dengan prestasi tahunan, IS bulanan menyusut negatif 0.3 peratus dipengaruhi oleh prestasi hambar kesemua komponen kecuali Gaji & Upah Benar, Pembuatan (0.1%).

Pangkalan Data Utama (PADU) telah diluncurkan pada 2 Januari 2024. PADU mengandungi profil individu dan isi rumah meliputi warganegara dan pemastautin tetap di Malaysia. Matlamat utama PADU untuk memastikan rakyat Malaysia tidak tercincir daripada setiap inisiatif berpaksikan rakyat yang dilaksanakan oleh Kerajaan. 




Paparan I: Indeks Komposit Pelopor

***The Leading Index recorded 109.8 points in November 2023,
reflecting a modest economic growth in the near future***

PUTRAJAYA, January 24, 2024 - Today, the Department of Statistics Malaysia released the **Malaysian Economic Indicators: Leading, Coincident & Lagging Indexes for November 2023**. The Leading Index (LI) is a tool utilised for predicting economic trends for an average of four to six months ahead.

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, "Malaysia witnessed a decrease in the Leading Index by a negative 0.2 per cent to 109.8 points in November 2023 as compared to 110.0 points in the same month of the previous year (**Exhibit I**). This decline is owing to the unfavourable performance in the Number of Housing Units Approved (-25.8%) and Real Imports of Semiconductors (-18.3%). However, the Bursa Malaysia Industrial Index showed a growth of 17.1 per cent and remained positive since May 2023. The monthly performance of the LI rebounded by 0.5 per cent as compared to negative 0.1 per cent in the previous month, driven by a significant increase in Real Imports of Semi Conductors (1.0%)".

Looking at the smoothed long-term trend in November 2023, LI remained below the 100.0 point trend. Accordingly, Malaysia's economy is foreseen to maintain its moderate growth supported by the resilient performance of domestic-oriented industries despite continuing to face the uncertainty of the international market (**Exhibit II**).

As for the current economic position, the Coincident Index (CI) recorded 123.7 points, an increase of 2.6 per cent as compared to 120.3 points in the same month of the

preceding year. This performance was contributed by all components, mainly the Real Contributions Value, EPF (13.7%). In contrast to the annual performance, the monthly CI shrank by a negative 0.3 per cent, influenced by lackluster performances in all components except for Real Salaries & Wages in Manufacturing (0.1%).

Exhibit I: Leading Composite Index




Exhibit II: Leading Composite Index (Long Term Trend = 100) and Business Cycle




Exhibit III: Annual Changes of Leading Index Components
