PULAU PINANG, SELANGOR, JOHOR, SARAWAK DAN
W.P. KUALA LUMPUR MENGUASAI EKSPORT MALAYSIA DENGAN
MENYUMBANG 81.1 PERATUS PADA BULAN DISEMBER 2023

PUTRAJAYA, 26 Januari 2024 – Malaysia mencatatkan jumlah perdagangan bernilai RM225.1 bilion pada Disember 2023 dengan eksport dan import masing-masing bernilai RM118.5 bilion dan RM106.7 bilion seperti yang dilaporkan hari ini dalam **STATISTIK EKSPORT IMPORT MENGIKUT NEGERI DISEMBER 2023**.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata prestasi eksport Malaysia pada Disember 2023 bernilai RM118.5 bilion, menurun sebanyak RM13.2 bilion (-10.0%) berbanding bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Penurunan eksport dipengaruhi oleh eksport yang lebih rendah di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Johor (-RM5.0 bilion), Pulau Pinang (-RM3.3 bilion), Selangor (-RM3.0 bilion), W.P. Labuan (-RM2.1 bilion), Sarawak (-RM904.8 juta), Perak (-RM569.0 juta), Melaka (-RM529.7 juta), Sabah (-RM186.8 juta), Negeri Sembilan (-RM125.3 juta), Kelantan (-RM74.4 juta) dan Perlis (-RM16.6 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai eksport meningkat di Kedah sebanyak RM850.4 juta, Terengganu (+RM673.6 juta), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM539.8 juta) dan Pahang (+RM58.0 juta).

Pulau Pinang kekal sebagai pengeksport utama dengan sumbangan 31.5 peratus, diikuti oleh Selangor (17.4%), Johor (17.2%), Sarawak (9.4%) dan W.P. Kuala Lumpur (5.6%).

Beralih kepada prestasi import mengikut negeri, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin memaklumkan import pada bulan Disember 2023 meningkat RM3.0 bilion (+2.9%) berbanding bulan yang sama pada 2022. Peningkatan import disebabkan oleh import yang lebih tinggi di kebanyakan negeri iaitu Johor (+RM1.6 bilion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM1.5 bilion), Pulau Pinang (+RM926.0 juta), Negeri Sembilan (+RM343.0 juta), Pahang (+RM308.9 juta), Terengganu (+RM183.3 juta), Kelantan (+RM139.8 juta) dan W.P. Labuan (+RM16.0 juta). Walau bagaimanapun, nilai import jatuh di Sarawak sebanyak RM588.1 juta, Melaka (-RM462.1 juta), Selangor (-RM292.1 juta), Perak (-RM268.5 juta), Sabah (-RM184.3 juta), Kedah (-RM113.3 juta) dan Perlis (-RM21.9 juta).

Selangor terus mendominasi import Malaysia dengan sumbangan 26.2 peratus, diikuti oleh Pulau Pinang (22.0%), Johor (21.8%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (7.8%) dan Kedah (5.5%).

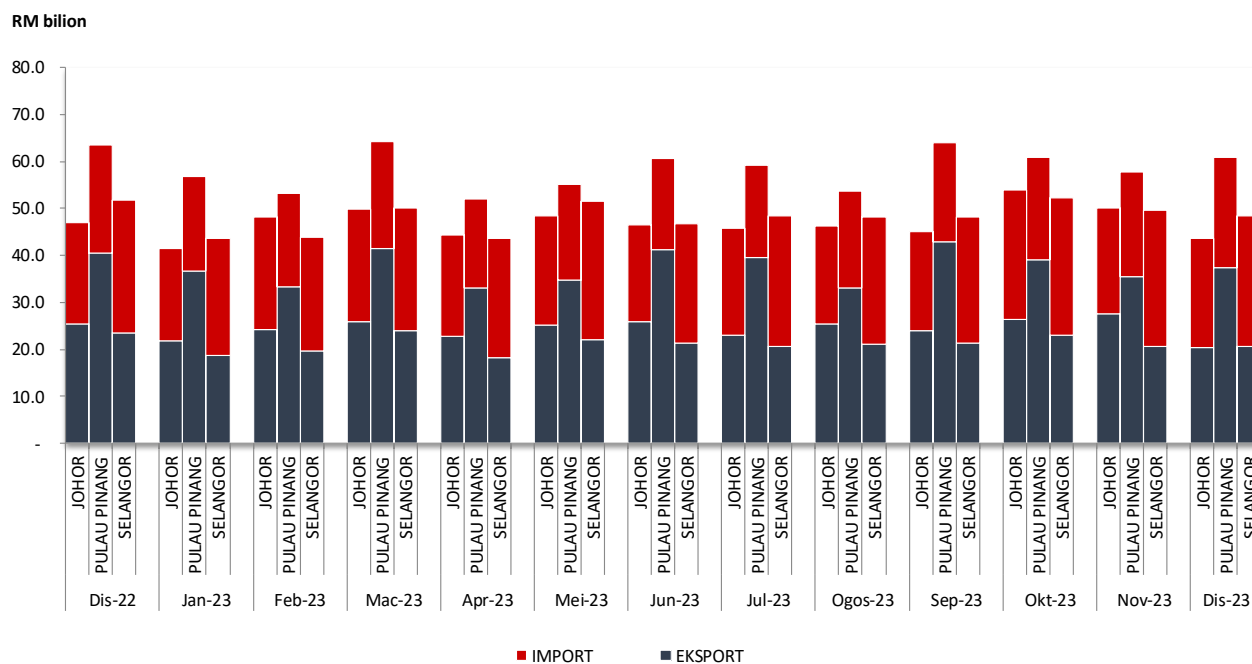

FOR EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE DECEMBER 2023

PULAU PINANG, SELANGOR, JOHOR, SARAWAK AND W.P. KUALA LUMPUR DOMINATE MALAYSIA'S EXPORTS ACCOUNTING FOR 81.1 PER CENT IN DECEMBER 2023

PUTRAJAYA, 26 January 2024 – Malaysia's total trade for December 2023 amounted to RM225.1 billion with exports and imports recorded RM118.5 billion and RM106.7 billion, respectively as reported today in **EXPORT IMPORT STATISTICS BY STATE DECEMBER 2023**.

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said exports was valued at RM118.5 billion in December 2023, decreased RM13.2 billion (-10.0%) as compared to the same month of the previous year. The decrease in exports was attributed to the lower exports in most states such as Johor (-RM5.0 billion), Pulau Pinang (-RM3.3 billion), Selangor (-RM3.0 billion), W.P. Labuan (-RM2.1 billion), Sarawak (-RM904.8 million), Perak (-RM569.0 million), Melaka (-RM529.7 million), Sabah (-RM186.8 million), Negeri Sembilan (-RM125.3 million), Kelantan (-RM74.4 million) and Perlis (-RM16.6 million). However, exports increased in Kedah by RM850.4 million, Terengganu (+RM673.6 million), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM539.8 million) and Pahang (+RM58.0 million).

Pulau Pinang remained as the top exporter with 31.5 per cent share, followed by Selangor (17.4%), Johor (17.2%), Sarawak (9.4%) and W.P. Kuala Lumpur (5.6%).

Looking at the performance of imports by state, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said imports in December 2023 increased RM3.0 billion (+2.9%) as compared to the same

month in 2022. The increase in imports was attributed by the higher imports in most states such as Johor (+RM1.6 billion), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (+RM1.5 billion), Pulau Pinang (+RM926.0 million), Negeri Sembilan (+RM343.0 million), Pahang (+RM308.9 million), Terengganu (+RM183.3 million), Kelantan (+RM139.8 million) dan W.P. Labuan (+RM16.0 million). However, imports decreased in Sarawak by RM588.1 million, Melaka (-RM462.1 million), Selangor (-RM292.1 million), Perak (-RM268.5 million), Sabah (-RM184.3 million), Kedah (-RM113.3 million) and Perlis (-RM21.9 million).

Selangor continued to dominate Malaysia's imports with a share of 26.2 per cent, followed by Pulau Pinang (22.0%) Johor (21.8%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (7.8%) and Kedah (5.5%).

Chart 1: Time Series Data on Exports and Imports in Johor, Pulau Pinang and Selangor, December 2022 – December 2023 (RM Billion)

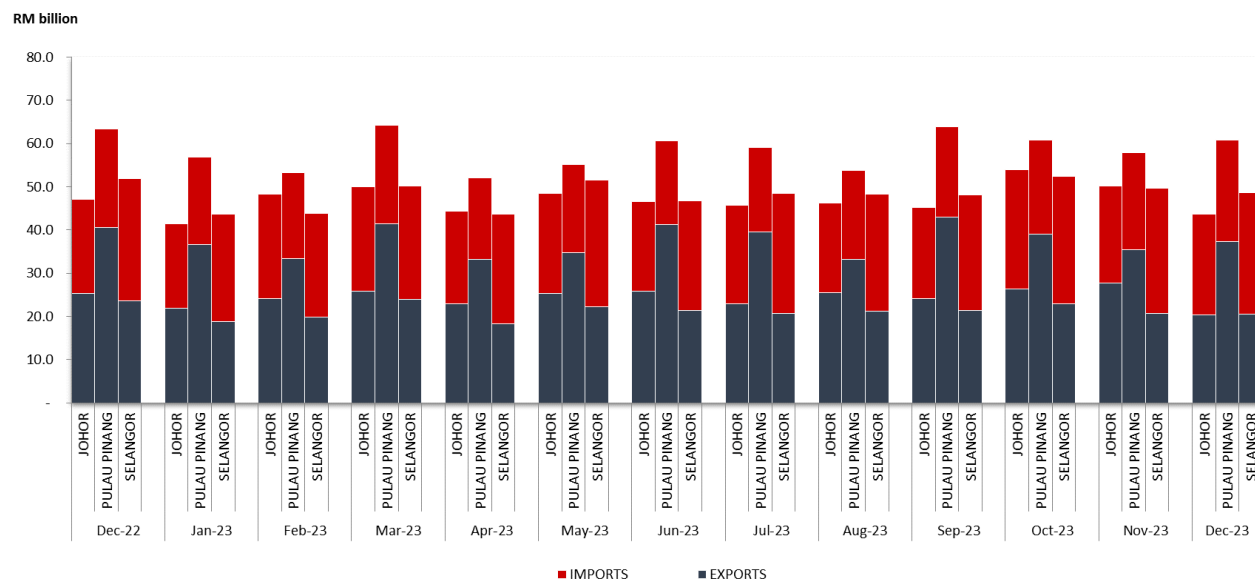


Exhibit 1: Infographic on Export Import Statistics by State, December 2023
