INDEKS PENGELUARAN PERINDUSTRIAN, MALAYSIA DISEMBER 2023

**Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian menyusut 0.1 peratus pada Disember 2023
dipengaruhi oleh sektor Pembuatan**

PUTRAJAYA, 7 Februari 2024 – Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian menyusut 0.1 peratus tahun ke tahun pada Disember 2023 dipengaruhi oleh sektor Pembuatan. Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia melaporkan dalam keluaran **Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian (IPP), Malaysia, Disember 2023** pada hari ini. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik IPP yang terdiri daripada tiga sektor iaitu Perlombongan, Pembuatan dan Elektrik.

Menurut Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian menyusut 0.1 peratus pada Disember 2023 selepas merekodkan pertumbuhan positif bagi dua bulan berturut-turut (November 2023: 0.6%; Oktober 2023: 2.4%). Penurunan tersebut disebabkan oleh penyusutan dalam sektor Pembuatan pada negatif 1.4 peratus (November 2023: -0.1%). Sebaliknya, sektor Perlombongan dan Elektrik masing-masing mengekalkan momentum positif dengan mencatatkan 3.6 peratus (November 2023: 1.9%) dan 4.6 peratus (November 2023: 4.3%). Perbandingan dengan bulan sebelumnya, IPP terus merosot kepada 1.3 peratus berbanding negatif 0.9 peratus yang direkodkan pada bulan sebelumnya."

Ketua Perangkawan mengulas lanjut, "Kemerosotan pengeluaran Pembuatan adalah dipengaruhi oleh penurunan yang berterusan dalam industri berorientasikan eksport yang menurun sebanyak 4.1 peratus (November 2023: -2.7%). Penguncupan tersebut disebabkan terutamanya oleh kejatuhan dalam Pembuatan komputer, produk elektronik & optikal (-7.2%); Pembuatan kok & produk petroleum bertapis (-4.6%); dan Pembuatan kelengkapan elektrik (-7.6%). Penurunan ini juga mencerminkan prestasi eksport negara, yang mengalami kejatuhan secara berterusan kepada negatif yang lebih besar iaitu 10.0 peratus pada Disember 2023. Perbandingan bulan ke bulan, industri berorientasikan eksport menyusut 3.3 peratus."

Sebaliknya, industri berorientasikan domestik mengekalkan prestasi kukuh sebanyak 4.2 peratus pada Disember 2023 berbanding 5.8 peratus pada bulan sebelumnya.

Pengembangan ini dipacu terutamanya oleh pertumbuhan 9.7 peratus dalam Pembuatan produk logam yang direka, kecuali mesin & kelengkapan; diikuti oleh Pembuatan produk prosesan makanan pada 6.2 peratus; dan Pembuatan produk galian bukan logam lain sebanyak 5.3 peratus. Perbandingan dengan bulan sebelumnya, industri berorientasikan domestik menurun kepada negatif 1.1 peratus berbanding peningkatan 3.7 peratus pada November 2023.”

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin turut menambah, “Pengeluaran sektor Perlombongan berkembang sebanyak 3.6 peratus pada Disember 2023 berbanding 1.9 peratus yang direkodkan pada November 2023. Peningkatan ini didorong oleh pengembangan 5.0 peratus dalam pengeluaran Gas Asli (November 2023: 1.7%) dan Minyak Mentah & Kondensat yang tumbuh 1.6 peratus (November 2023: 2.1%) pada bulan tersebut. Berbanding November 2023, indeks Perlombongan meningkat 2.8 peratus berbanding negatif 1.8 peratus yang dicatatkan pada bulan sebelumnya.”

Pada masa yang sama, penjanaan Elektrik tumbuh 4.6 peratus pada Disember 2023 selepas mencatatkan peningkatan 4.3 peratus pada bulan lalu. Berbanding bulan sebelumnya, indeks Elektrik memulih kepada 1.1 peratus daripada negatif 4.7 peratus yang direkodkan pada November 2023.

Secara keseluruhan, pada suku tahun keempat 2023, IPP mencatatkan peningkatan 1.0 peratus tahun ke tahun berbanding negatif 0.05 peratus yang direkodkan pada suku tahun ketiga 2023. Pada tempoh tersebut, sektor Perlombongan dan Elektrik meningkat masing-masing sebanyak 4.3 peratus dan 4.9 peratus. Sebaliknya, sektor Pembuatan menurun secara marginal sebanyak 0.2 peratus pada suku tahun tersebut, meneruskan trend negatif untuk dua suku tahun berturut-turut. Perbandingan dengan suku tahun ketiga 2023, IPP tumbuh 2.5 peratus disokong terutamanya oleh sektor Perlombongan dan Pembuatan masing-masing pada 11.6 peratus dan 0.6 peratus.

Merumuskan kenyataannya mengenai prestasi IPP bagi tahun 2023, Ketua Perangkawan berkata, “IPP mencatatkan pertumbuhan marginal sebanyak 0.9 peratus pada tahun 2023 berbanding 6.7 peratus pada tahun 2022. Semua sektor mencatatkan pertumbuhan positif iaitu indeks Elektrik (2.5%); indeks Perlombongan (0.8%); dan indeks Pembuatan (0.7%).”

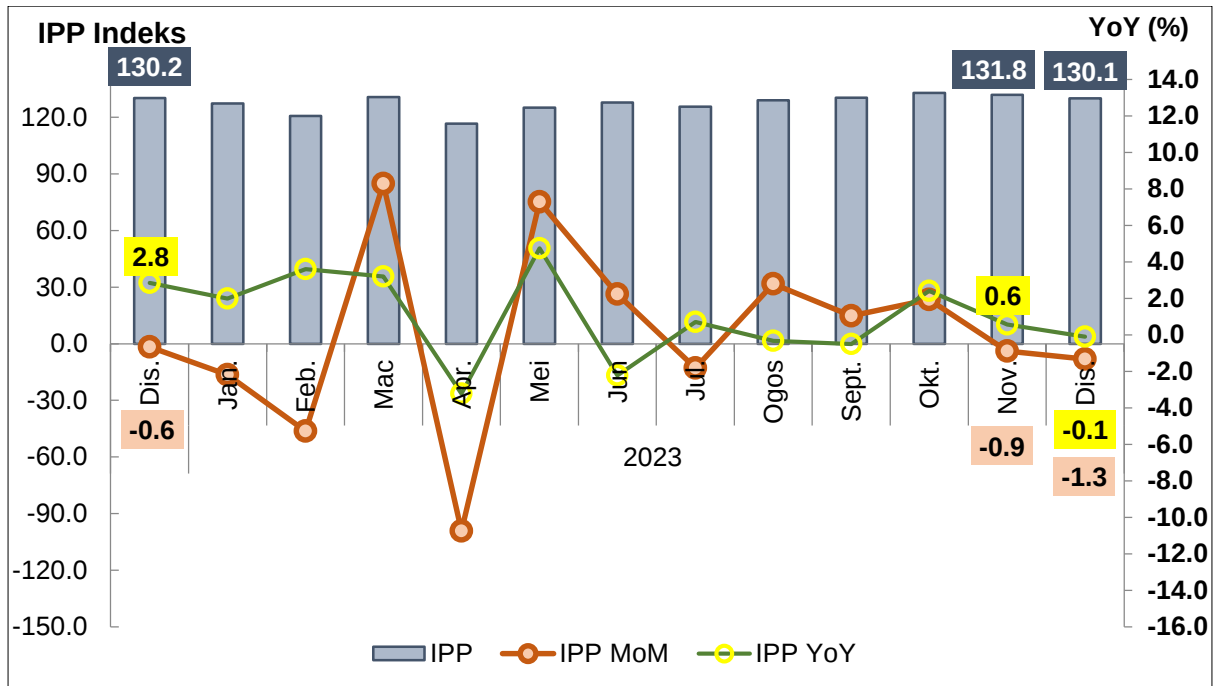

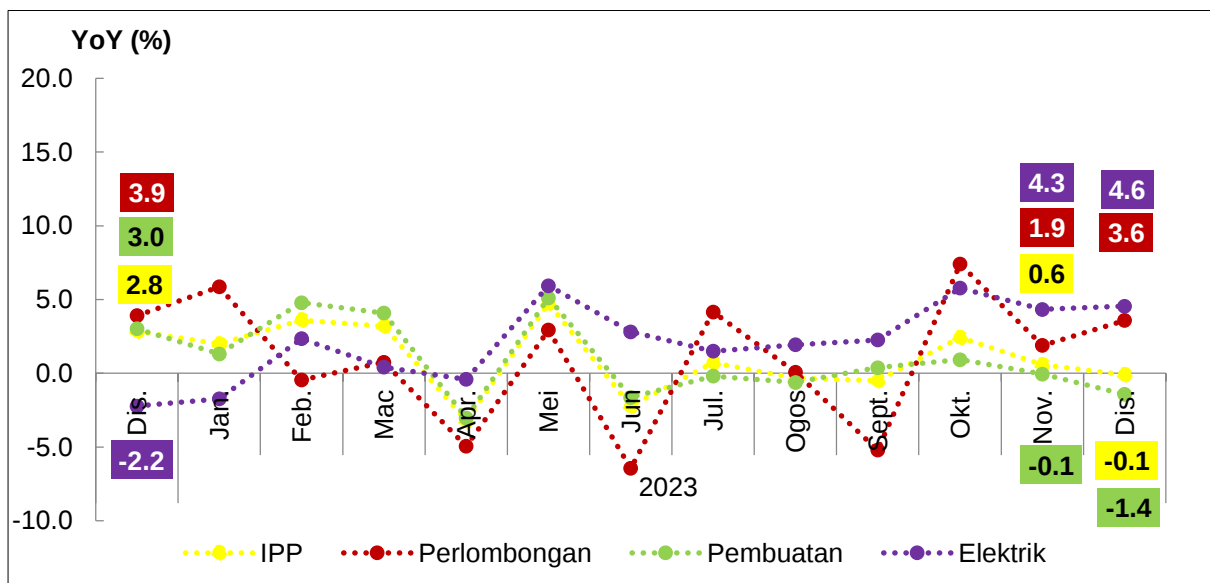

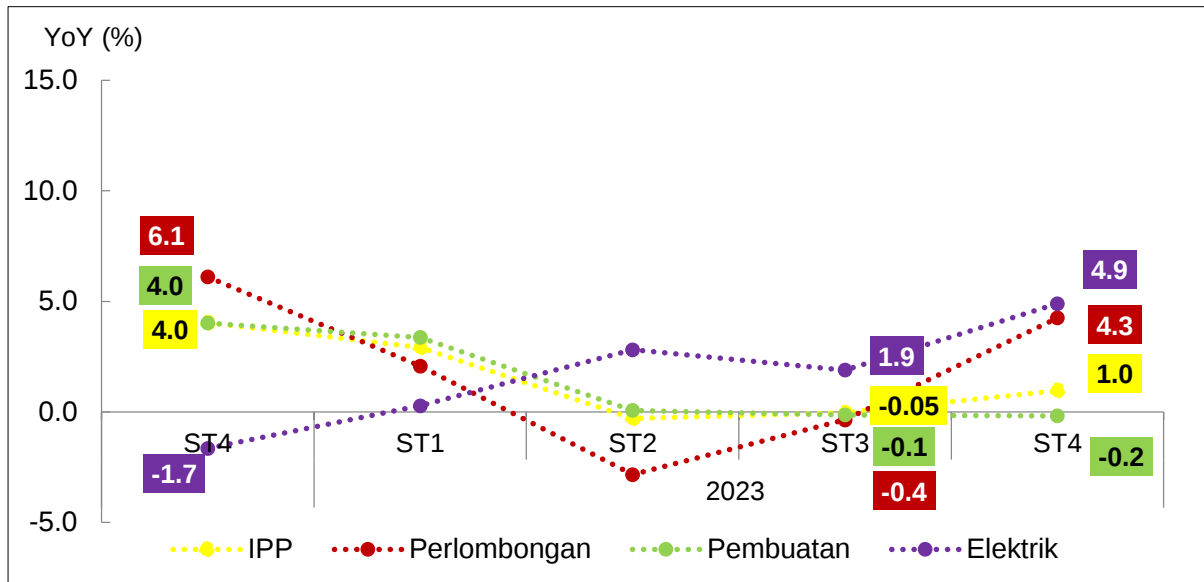
**Carta 1: Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian, Malaysia,
Disember 2022 - Disember 2023**



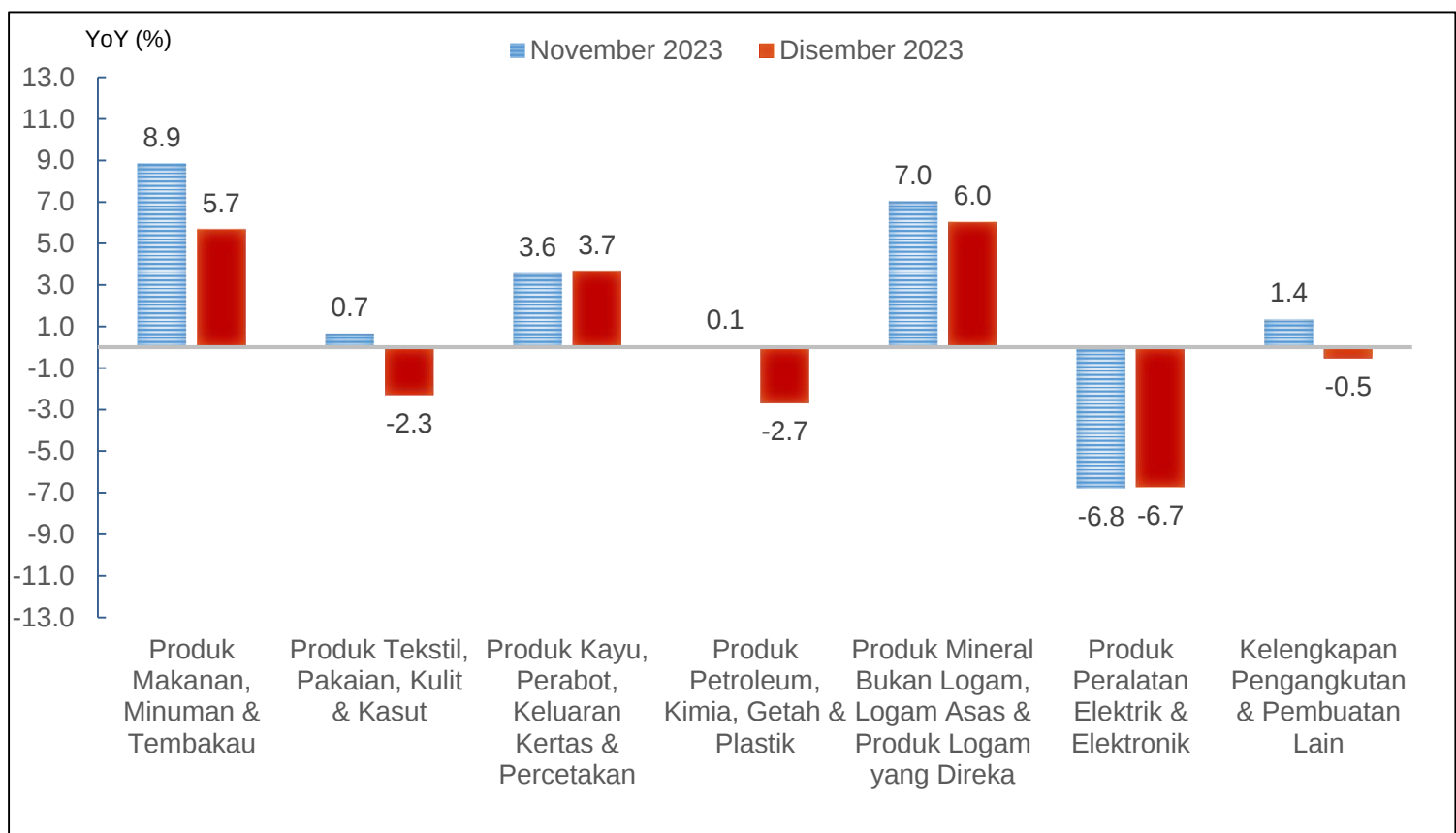
**Carta 2: Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian dan Komponennya, Malaysia
Disember 2022 - Disember 2023**



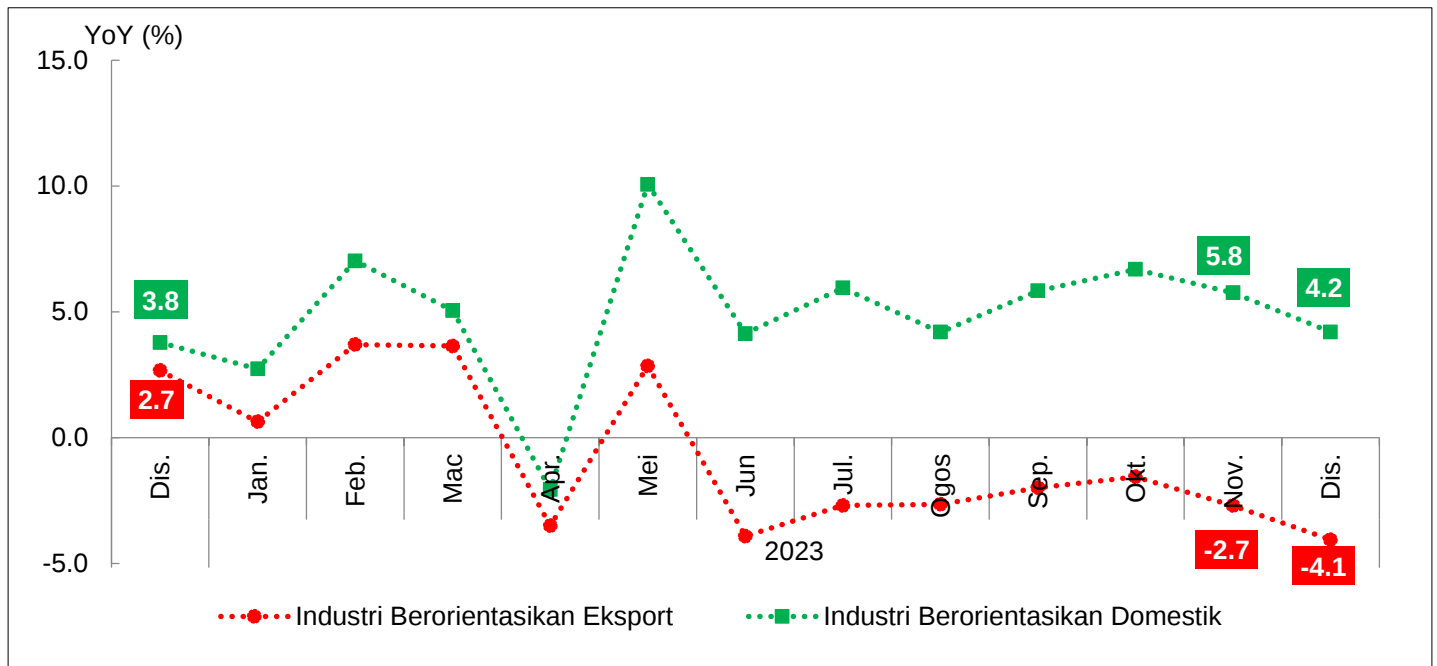
**Carta 3: Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian, Malaysia
ST4 2022 – ST4 2023**



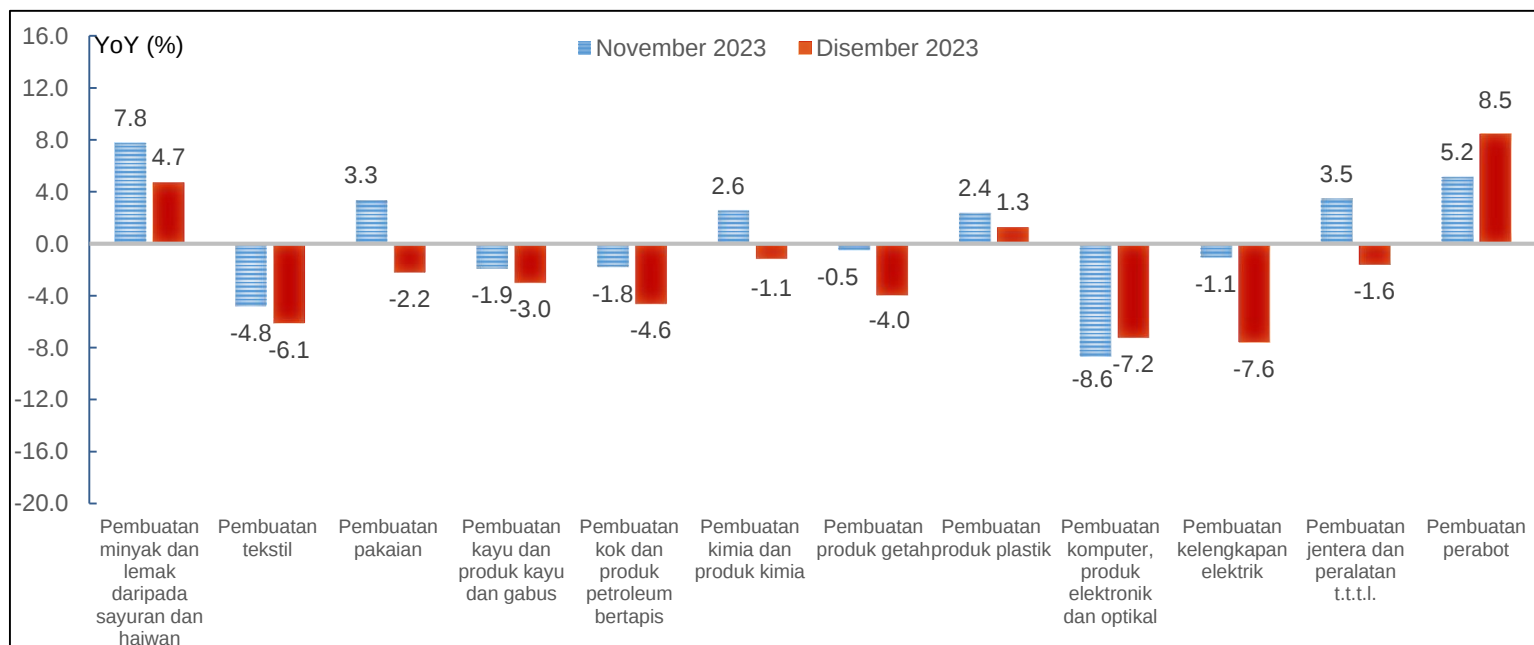
**Carta 4: Pertumbuhan Indeks Pembuatan Mengikut Subsektor, Malaysia
November dan Disember 2023**



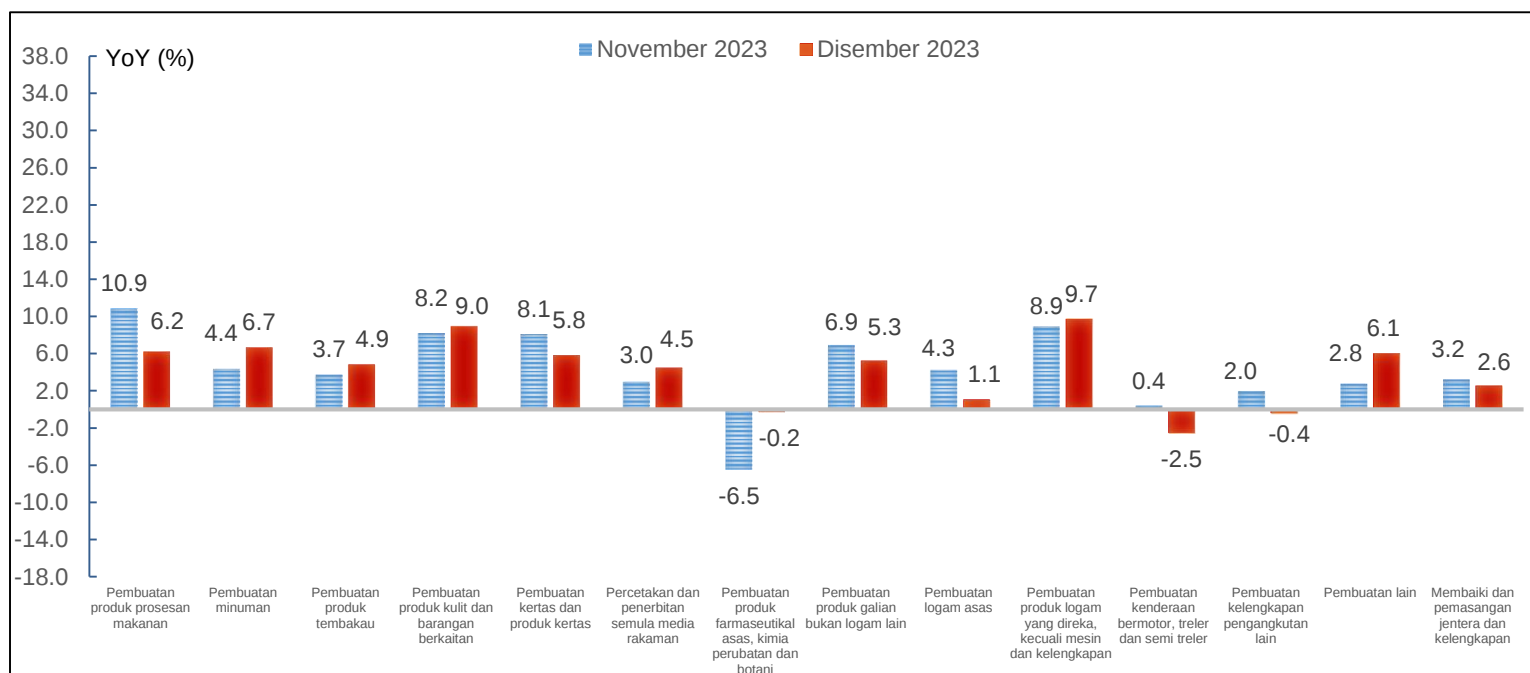

INDEX OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION MALAYSIA
DECEMBER 2023

The Industrial Production Index dipped by 0.1 per cent in December 2023, weighed down by the Manufacturing sector

PUTRAJAYA, 7 February 2024 - The Industrial Production Index dipped by 0.1 per cent year-on-year in December 2023, weighed down by the Manufacturing sector. The Department of Statistics, Malaysia (DOSM) reported today in the release of the **Industrial Production Index (IPI), Malaysia, December 2023**. This publication presents IPI statistics, consisting of three sectors namely Mining, Manufacturing and Electricity.

According to the Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, "The Industrial Production Index slipped by 0.1 per cent in December 2023 after recording positive growth for two consecutive months (November 2023: 0.6%; October 2023: 2.4%). The decrease was attributed to a contraction in the Manufacturing sector at negative 1.4 per cent (November 2023: -0.1%). On the other hand, the Mining and Electricity sectors sustained positive momentum, registering 3.6 per cent (November 2023: 1.9%) and 4.6 per cent (November 2023: 4.3%) respectively. In comparison with the preceding month, the IPI continued to decline by 1.3 per cent as compared to the negative 0.9 per cent recorded in the previous month."

The Chief Statistician further commented, "The deterioration in the Manufacturing output was influenced by the persistent decrease in export-oriented industries which dropped by 4.1 per cent (November 2023: -2.7%). The contraction was mainly attributable to the fall in the Manufacture of computer, electronics & optical products (-7.2%); Manufacture of coke & refined petroleum products (-4.6%); and the Manufacture of electrical equipment (-7.6%). This decline mirrored the country's export performance, which continuously fell to a larger negative of 10.0 per cent in December 2023. On a month-on-month comparison, the export-oriented industries weakened by 3.3 per cent."

On the contrary, the domestic-oriented industries maintained a steady performance at 4.2 per cent in December 2023 as against 5.8 per cent in the previous month. The expansion was anchored mainly by the growth of 9.7 per cent in the Manufacture of

fabricated metal products, except machinery & equipment; followed by the Manufacture of food processing products at 6.2 per cent; and the Manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products by 5.3 per cent. In comparison with the preceding month, the domestic-oriented industries turned downward to a negative 1.1 per cent as opposed to the 3.7 per cent increase in November 2023.”

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin also added, “The production in the Mining sector expanded by 3.6 per cent in December 2023 as against 1.9 per cent recorded in November 2023. The increase was propelled by a 5.0 per cent expansion in Natural Gas production (November 2023: 1.7%) and Crude Oil & Condensate which grew by 1.6 per cent (November 2023: 2.1%) during the month. As compared to November 2023, the Mining index increased by 2.8 per cent in contrast to the negative 1.8 per cent registered in the previous month.”

In the meantime, the generation of Electricity grew by 4.6 per cent in December 2023 after registering an increase of 4.3 per cent in the preceding month. In comparison to the previous month, the Electricity index rebounded to 1.1 per cent from a negative 4.7 per cent recorded in November 2023.

Overall, in the fourth quarter of 2023, the IPI registered an increase of 1.0 per cent year-on-year as compared to the negative 0.05 per cent recorded in the third quarter of 2023. During the period, the Mining and Electricity sectors rose by 4.3 per cent and 4.9 per cent respectively. Conversely, the Manufacturing sector edged down marginally by 0.2 per cent in this quarter, continuing the negative trend for two consecutive quarters. In comparison with the third quarter of 2023, the IPI grew by 2.5 per cent predominantly supported by the Mining and Manufacturing sectors at 11.6 per cent and 0.6 per cent respectively.

Summarising his statement on the IPI performance for the year 2023, the Chief Statistician said, “The IPI registered a marginal growth of 0.9 per cent in 2023 as compared to 6.7 per cent in 2022. All sectors posted positive growth namely Electricity index (2.5%); Mining index (0.8%); and Manufacturing index (0.7%).”

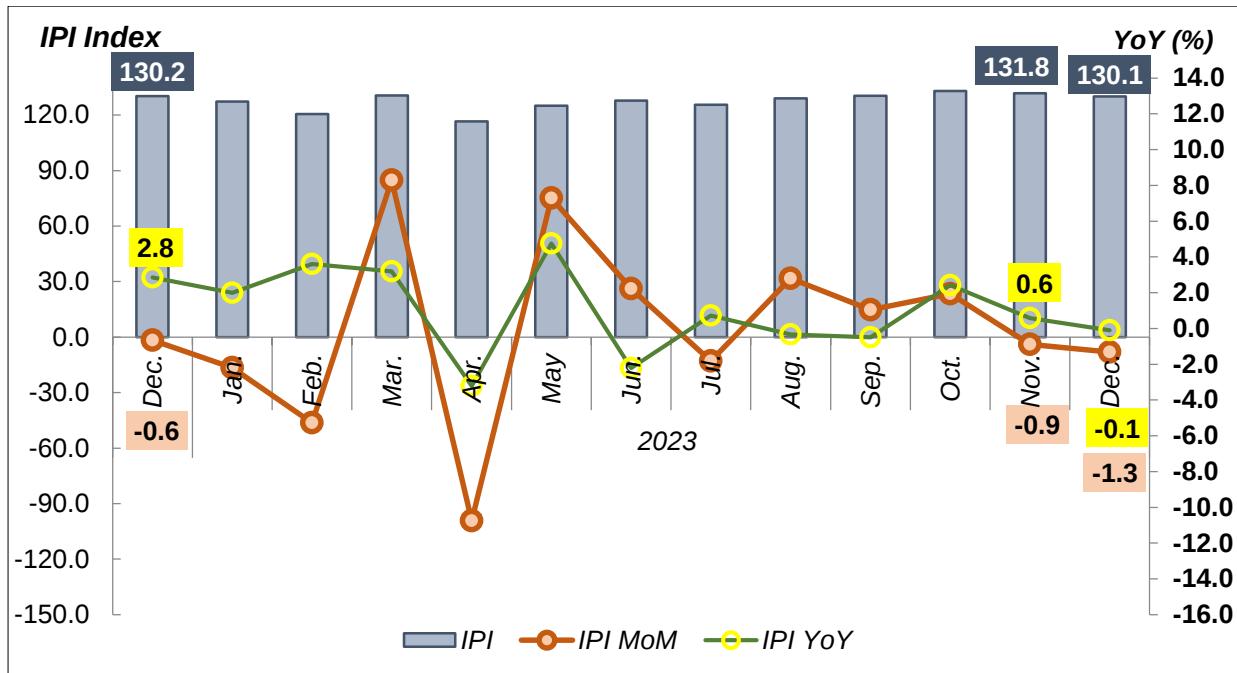

The Government of Malaysia has declared National Statistics Day (MyStats Day) on October 20th each year. MyStats Day theme is “Statistics is the Essence of Life”.

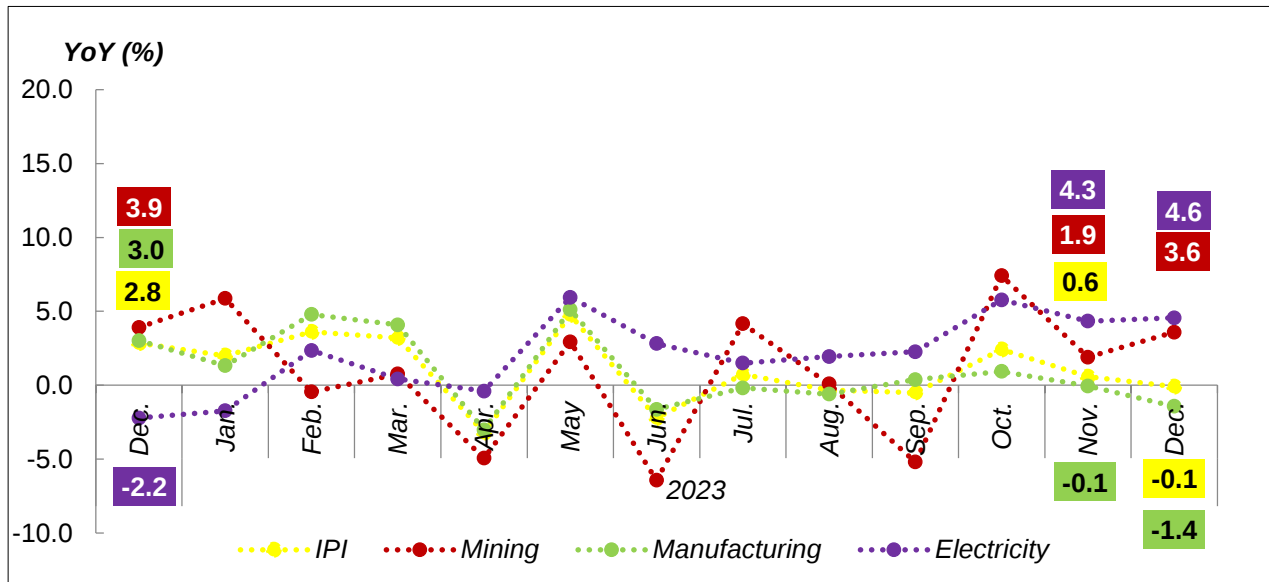

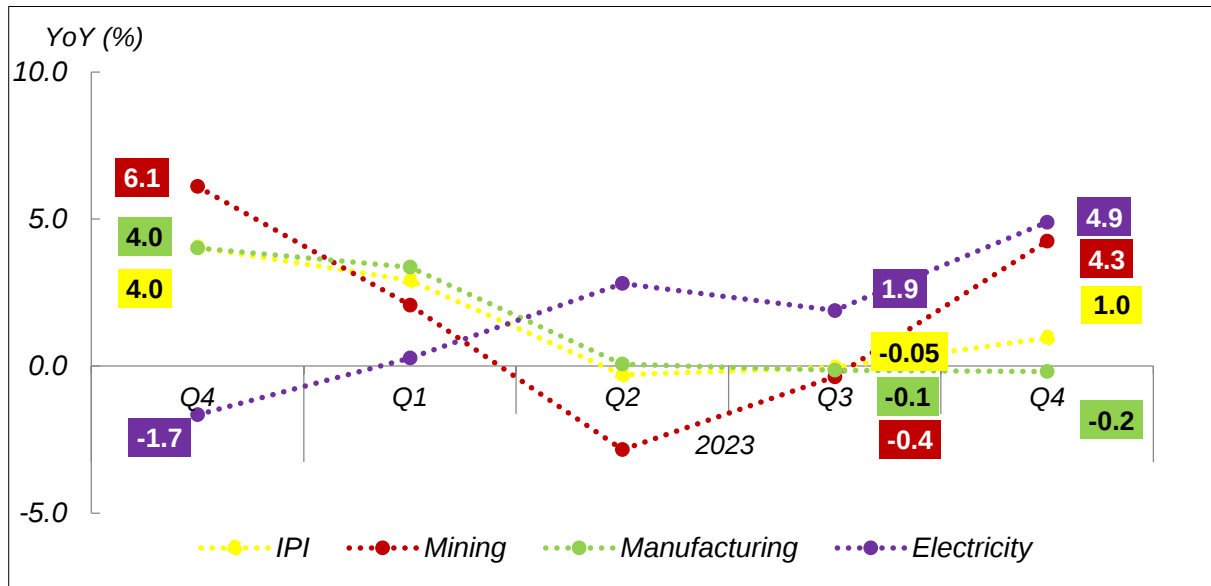
**Chart 1: Industrial Production Index, Malaysia,

November and December 2023**

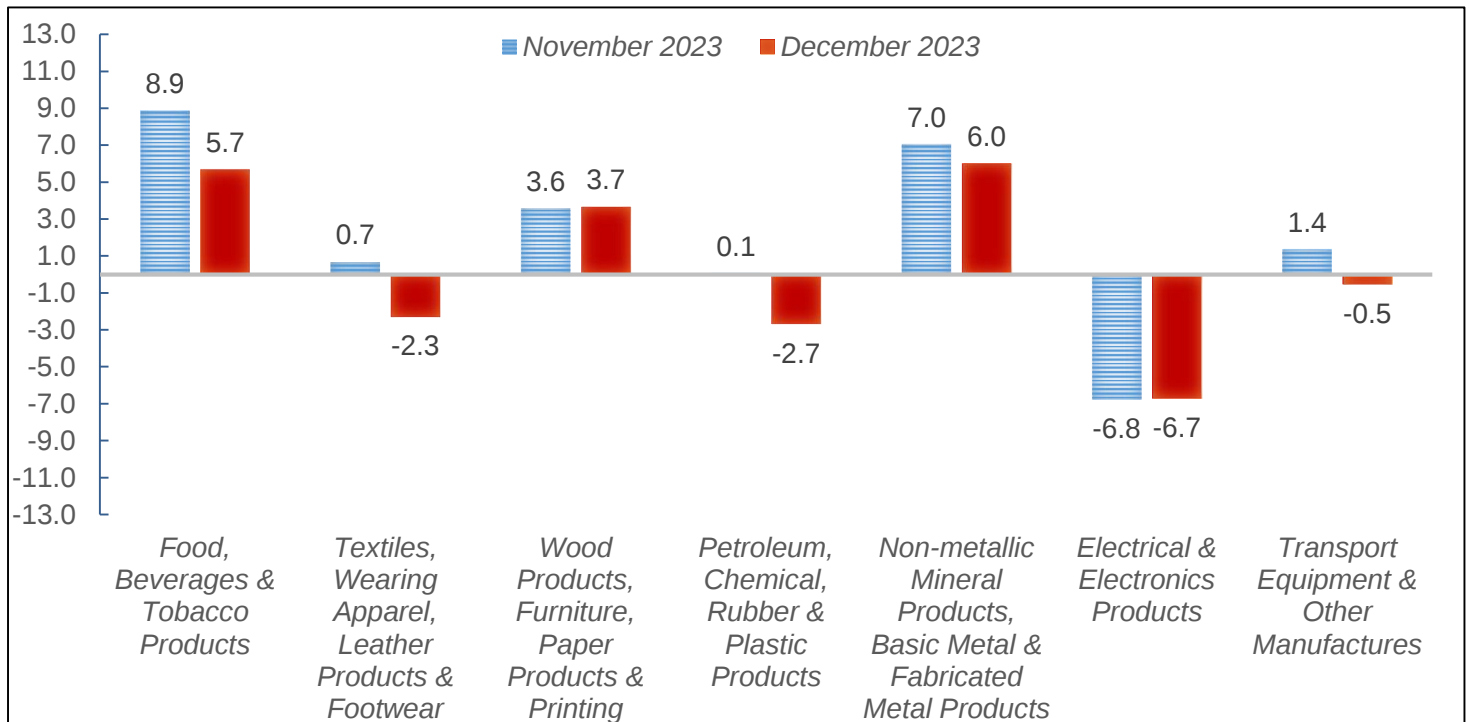


Chart 5: Manufacturing Index by Export and Domestic Oriented Industries, Malaysia, December 2022 – December 2023

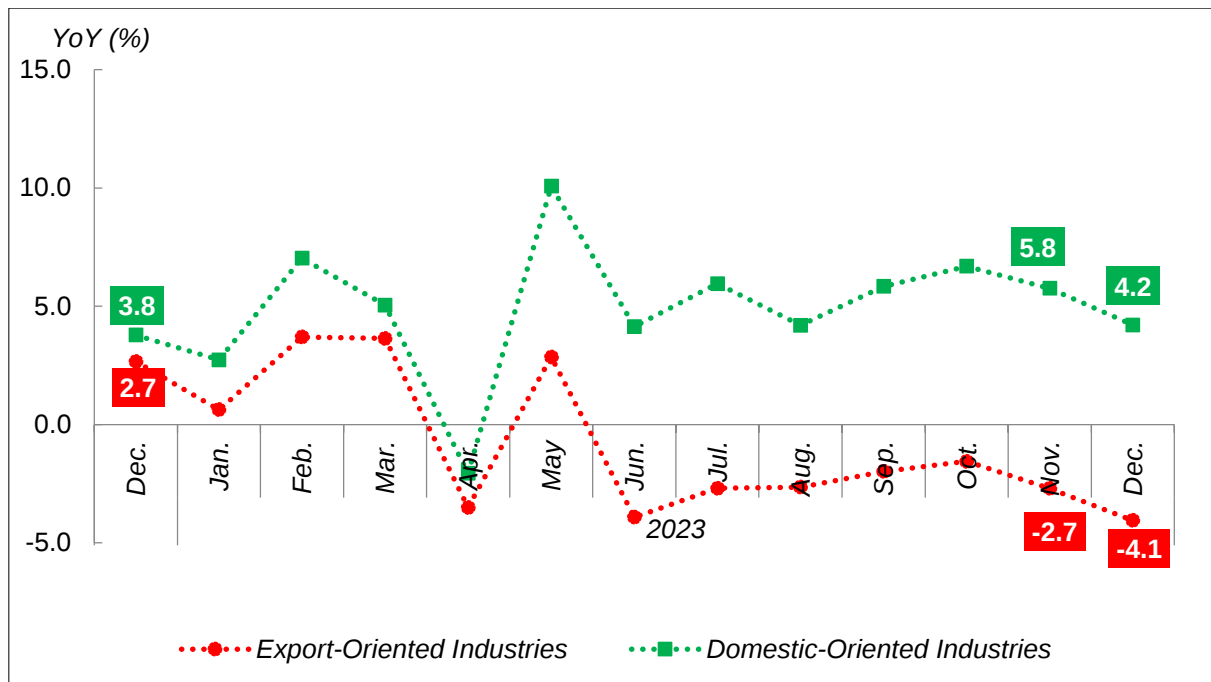
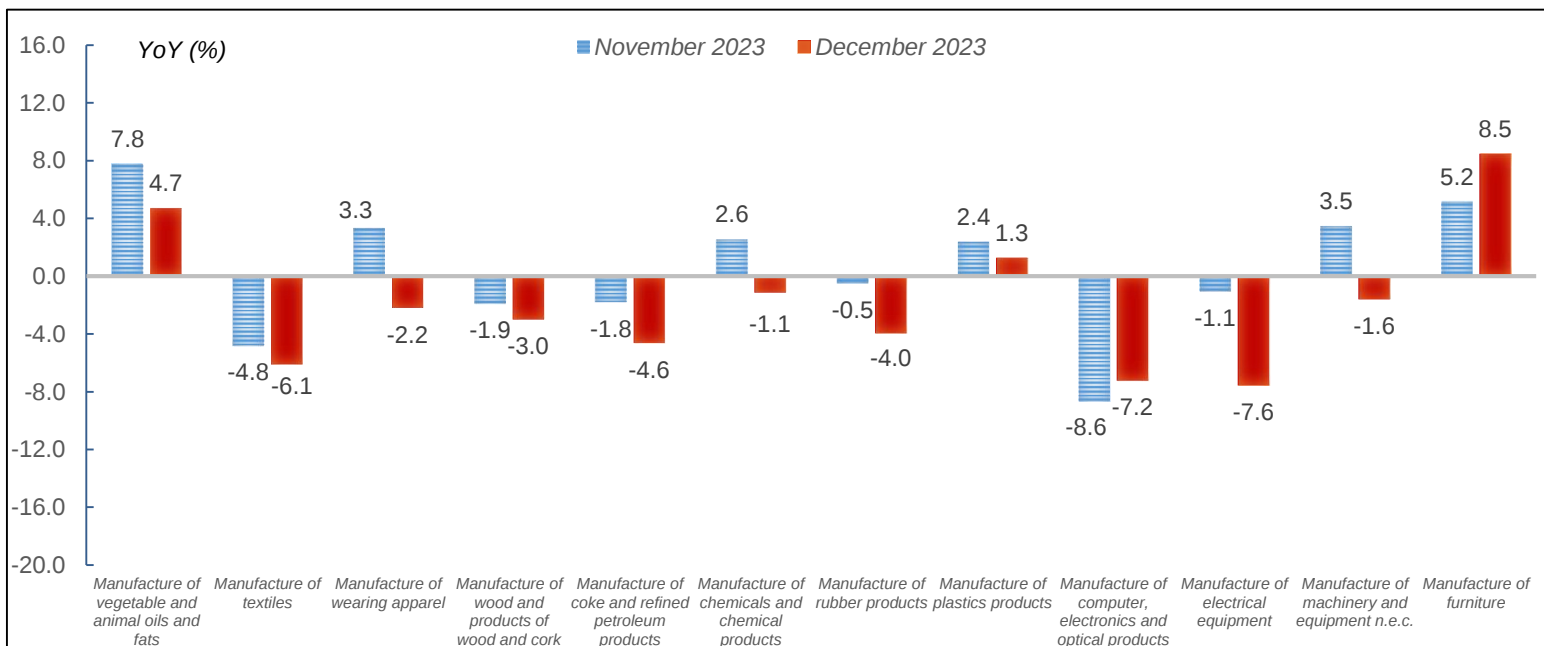
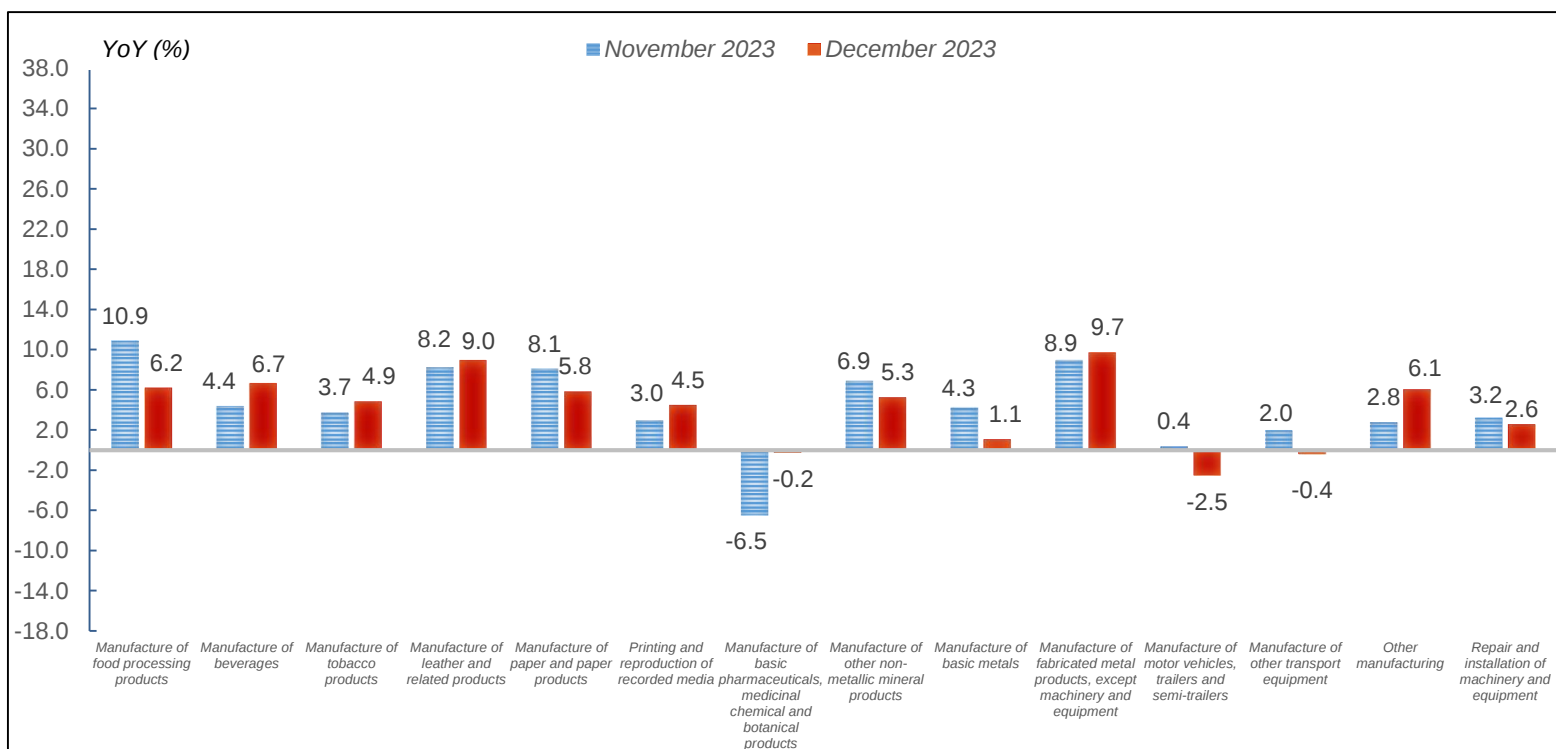


Chart 6: Manufacturing Export-Oriented by Group, Malaysia, November and December 2023
