Indeks Pelopor kembali pulih kepada 0.3 peratus dengan 110.1 mata pada Disember 2023, menjangkakan prospek ekonomi yang lebih baik dalam masa terdekat

PUTRAJAYA, 23 Februari 2024 – Pada hari ini, Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia menerbitkan **Penunjuk Ekonomi Malaysia: Indeks Pelopor, Serentak & Susulan bagi Disember 2023**. Indeks Pelopor (IP) ialah alat yang digunakan untuk meramalkan arah aliran ekonomi secara purata empat hingga enam bulan ke hadapan.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata, "Pertumbuhan ekonomi Malaysia dijangka menunjukkan prestasi yang lebih baik pada suku kedua 2024. Ini disokong oleh Indeks Pelopor yang pulih ke trajektori positif sebanyak 0.3 peratus untuk mencapai 110.1 mata pada Disember 2023 berbanding 109.8 mata pada bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya (**Paparan I**). Ini merupakan pertumbuhan positif yang pertama selepas penurunan sembilan bulan berturut-turut, didorong oleh lonjakan dalam Bilangan Unit Kediaman Yang Diluluskan Pembinaan (41.5%) berbanding negatif 25.8 peratus pada November 2023. Melihat kepada prestasi bulanan, IP juga meningkat sebanyak 0.3 peratus, disumbangkan oleh Indeks Perusahaan Bursa Malaysia dan Bilangan Unit Kediaman Yang Diluluskan Pembinaan, masing-masing menyumbang 0.5 peratus".

Kadar pertumbuhan IP terlicin bagi Disember 2023 kekal di bawah trend 100.0 mata. Meskipun masih berada di bawah trend, ekonomi Malaysia dijangka akan lebih baik dalam tempoh terdekat disokong oleh permintaan domestik yang berdaya tahan dan keadaan pasaran pekerjaan yang stabil (**Paparan II**).

Merujuk kepada senario ekonomi semasa, Indeks Serentak (IS) meningkat 2.3 peratus kepada 123.1 mata pada Disember 2023 berbanding 120.3 mata pada bulan yang sama tahun sebelumnya. Peningkatan ini disumbangkan oleh semua komponen kecuali Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian (-0.1%). Walau bagaimanapun, IS menyusut 0.5 peratus bulan ke bulan, disebabkan oleh prestasi Indeks Pengeluaran Perindustrian yang tidak memberangsangkan (-0.3%).

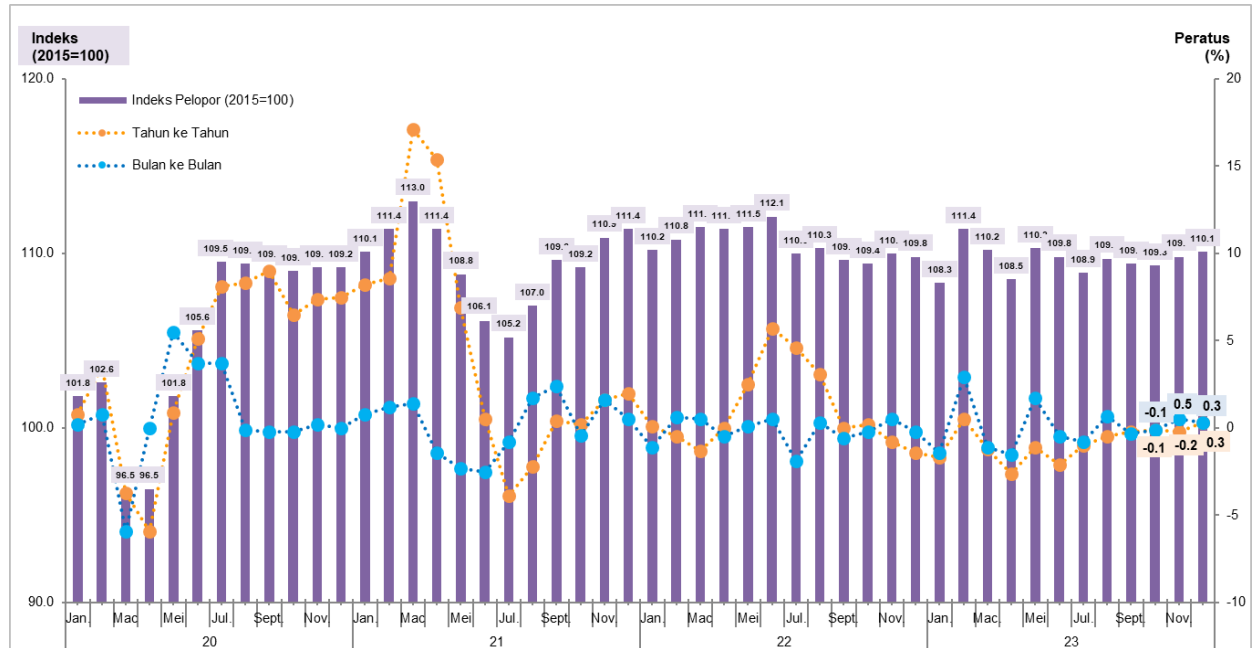

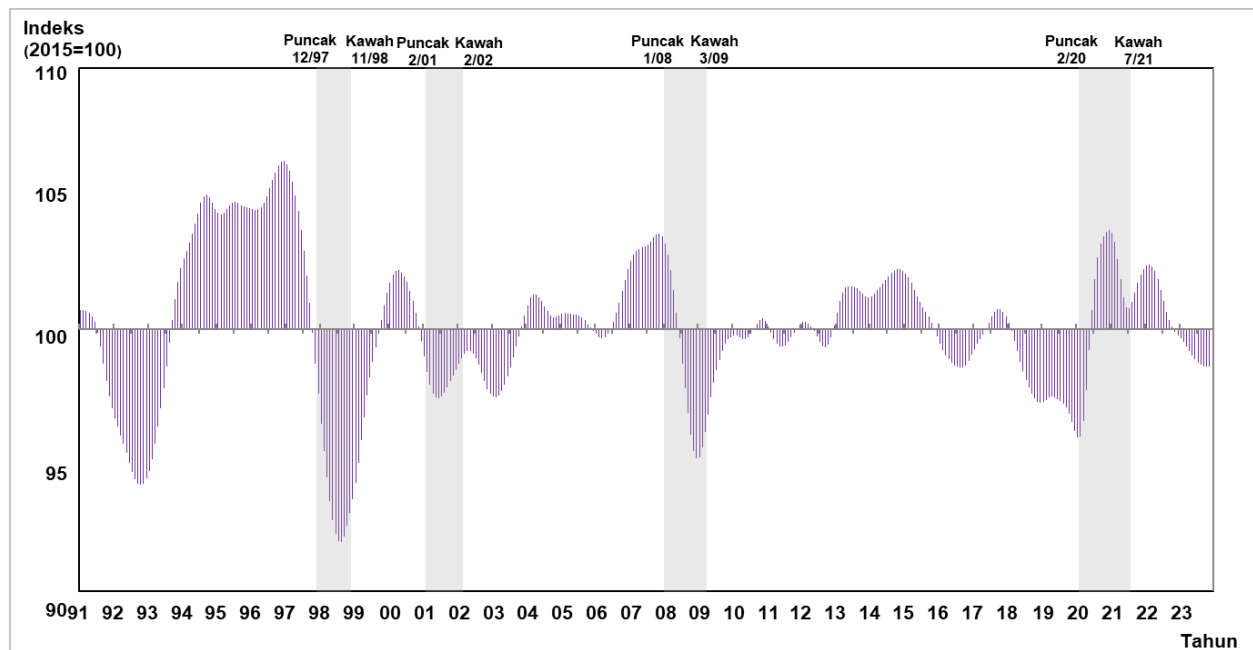

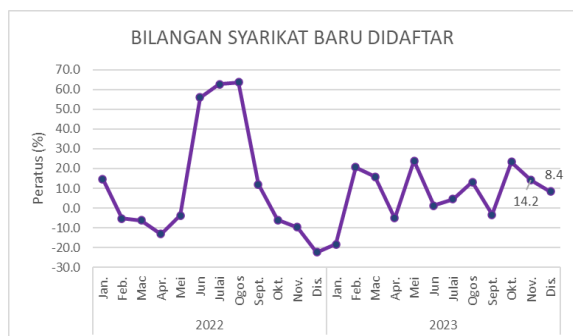
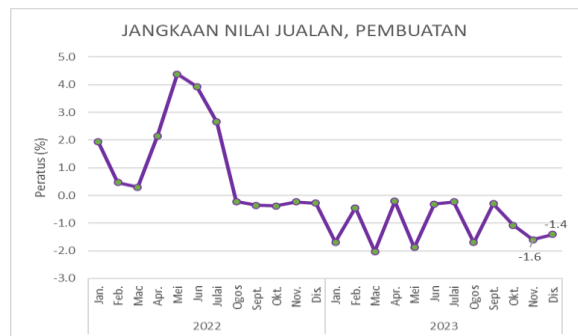
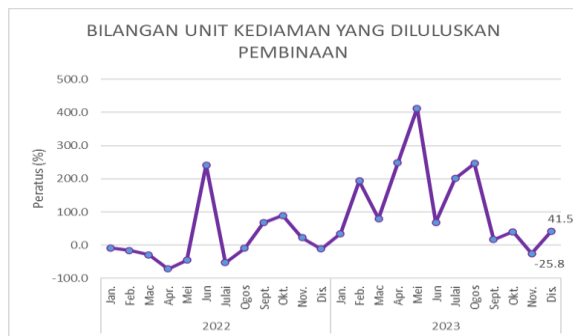
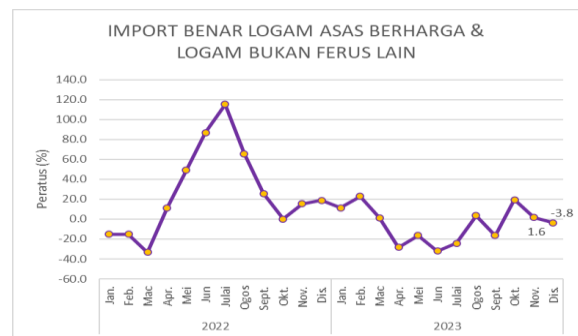
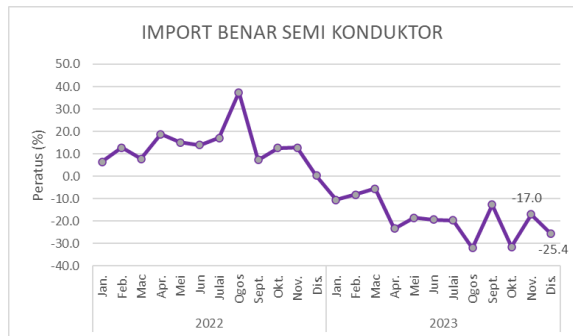
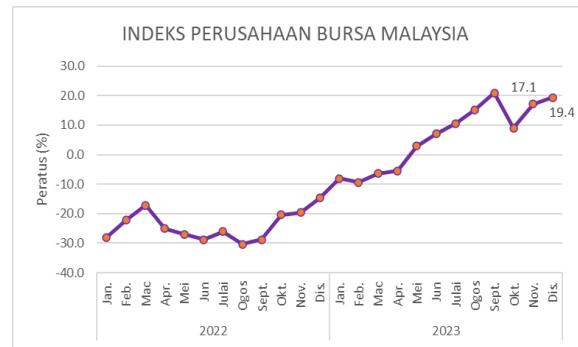
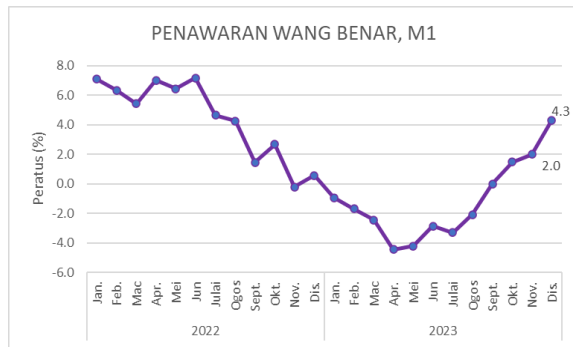
Paparan I: Indeks Komposit Pelopor

Leading Index rebounded to 0.3 per cent with 110.1 points in December 2023, anticipating a healthier economic prospect in the near future

PUTRAJAYA, February 23, 2024 - Today, the Department of Statistics Malaysia released the **Malaysian Economic Indicators: Leading, Coincident & Lagging Indexes for December 2023**. The Leading Index (LI) is a tool utilised for predicting economic trends for an average of four to six months ahead.

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, "The Malaysia's economic growth is expected to show a better performance in the second quarter of 2024. This is supported by the Leading Index which bounced back to a positive trajectory of 0.3 per cent to attain 110.1 points in December 2023 as compared to 109.8 points in the same month of the preceding year **(Exhibit I)**. This was the first positive growth after nine consecutive months of declines, driven by a rebound in the Number of Housing Units Approved (41.5%) as compared to negative 25.8 per cent in November 2023. Looking at the monthly performance, the LI also increased 0.3 per cent, contributed by the Bursa Malaysia Industrial Index and Number of Housing Units Approved, accounting for 0.5 per cent respectively".

The smoothed growth rate of the LI for December 2023 remained below the 100.0 points trend. Although it remained below the trend, the Malaysian economy is expected to improve in the near term supported by resilient domestic demand and stable labour market conditions **(Exhibit II)**.

Referring to the current economic scenario, the Coincident Index (CI) rose 2.3 per cent to 123.1 points in December 2023 as compared to 120.3 points in the same month of the previous year. The uptick was contributed by all components except the Industrial Production Index (-0.1%). However, the CI decreased by 0.5 per cent month-on-month, owing to the unfavourable performance of the Industrial Production Index (-0.3%).

Exhibit I: Leading Composite Index

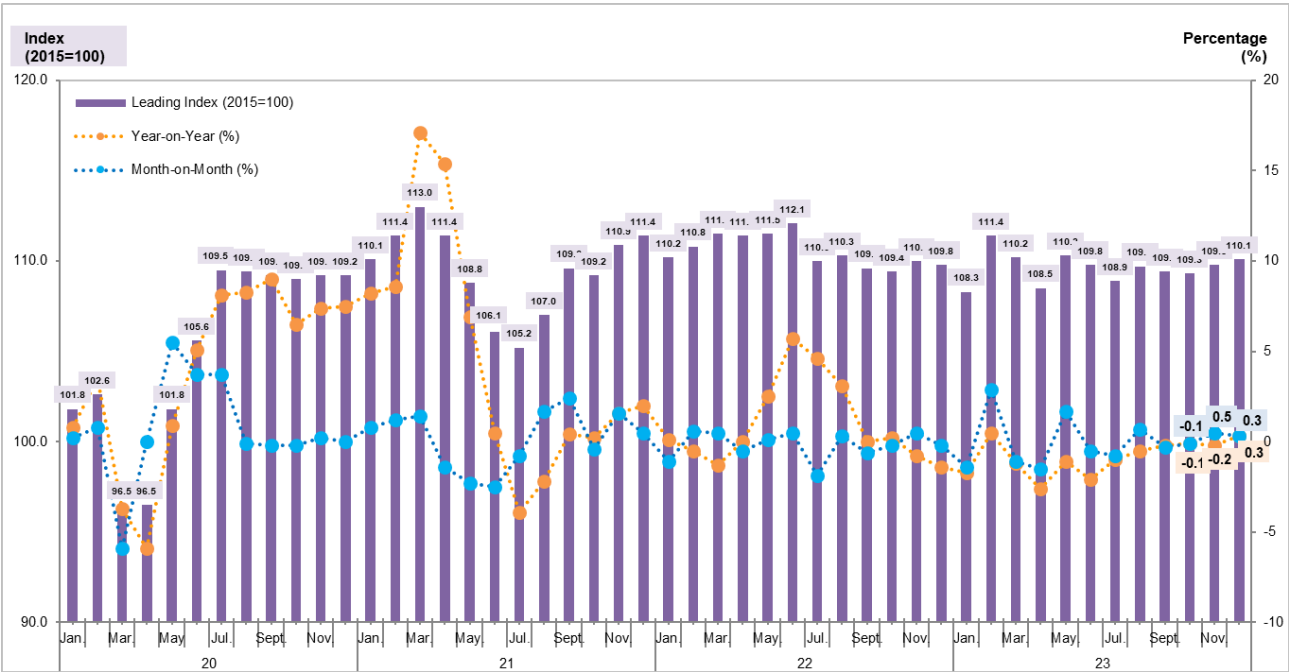


Exhibit II: Leading Composite Index (Long Term Trend = 100) and Business Cycle

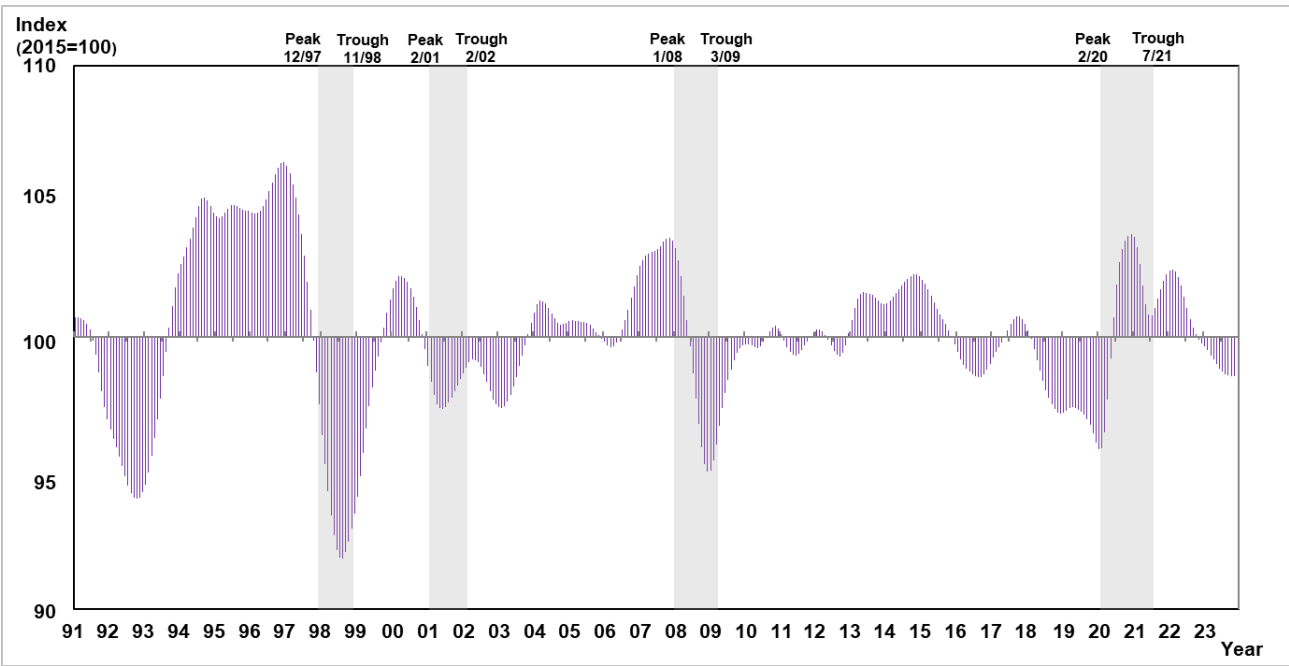


Exhibit III: Annual Changes of Leading Index Components
