MALAYSIA, JANUARI 2024

Indeks nilai seunit eksport dan import masing-masing merosot 0.5 peratus dan 0.1 peratus pada Januari 2024.

PUTRAJAYA, 28 FEBRUARI 2024 – Harga eksport Malaysia pada Januari 2024, menurun 0.5 peratus daripada 148.0 mata pada bulan sebelumnya kepada 147.2 mata. Begitu juga, harga import jatuh 0.1 peratus daripada 128.7 mata kepada 128.5 mata manakala terma perdagangan Malaysia juga merosot 0.4 peratus bulan ke bulan kepada 114.5 mata pada Januari 2024, sebagaimana dipaparkan oleh laporan **INDEKS PERDAGANGAN LUAR NEGERI (2010=100), Januari 2024** pada hari ini. Penerbitan ini memaparkan statistik indeks nilai seunit, indeks volum dan terma perdagangan meliputi 10 seksyen komoditi produk barangan selaras dengan Klasifikasi Standard Perdagangan Antarabangsa (SITC).

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin berkata, "Indeks nilai seunit eksport turun 0.5 peratus pada Januari 2024 berbanding bulan sebelumnya, disumbangkan oleh penurunan indeks minyak galian (-2.8%), barang-barang keluaran kilang (-0.2%) dan alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (-0.2%). Namun begitu, indeks volum eksport naik 4.0 peratus selaras dengan kenaikan indeks minyak

galian (+30.4%), barang-barang keluaran kilang (+9.6%) dan bahan kimia (+2.4%). Indeks volum eksport pelarasan bermusim berkembang 16.1 peratus daripada 140.8 mata kepada 163.5 mata. Merujuk kepada perbandingan tahunan, indeks nilai seunit dan indeks volum masing-masing bertambah 3.1 peratus dan 5.4 peratus.

Indeks nilai seunit import menurun 0.1 peratus pada Januari 2024, disumbangkan oleh penurunan indeks minyak galian (-2.6%), bahan mentah tidak boleh dimakan (-0.3%) dan barang-barang keluaran kilang (-0.2%). Sementara itu, indeks volum import naik 5.6 peratus pada Januari 2024 berbanding bulan sebelum, disumbangkan oleh kenaikan dalam indeks makanan (+20.8%), barang-barang keluaran kilang (+13.6%) dan minyak galian (+6.0%). Indeks volum import pelarasan bermusim meningkat 9.8 peratus daripada 189.8 mata kepada 208.4 mata. Perbandingan tahun ke tahun menunjukkan indeks nilai seunit dan indeks volum import masing-masing berkembang 0.4 peratus dan 18.5 peratus.”

Di samping itu, terma perdagangan Malaysia susut 0.4 peratus bulan ke bulan kepada 114.5 mata pada Januari 2024, didorong oleh penurunan indeks minyak & lemak binatang & sayur-sayuran (-1.3%), alat jentera & kelengkapan pengangkutan (-0.4%) dan minyak galian (-0.2%). Terma perdagangan Malaysia tahun ke tahun naik 2.7 peratus daripada 111.5 mata pada Januari tahun lalu.

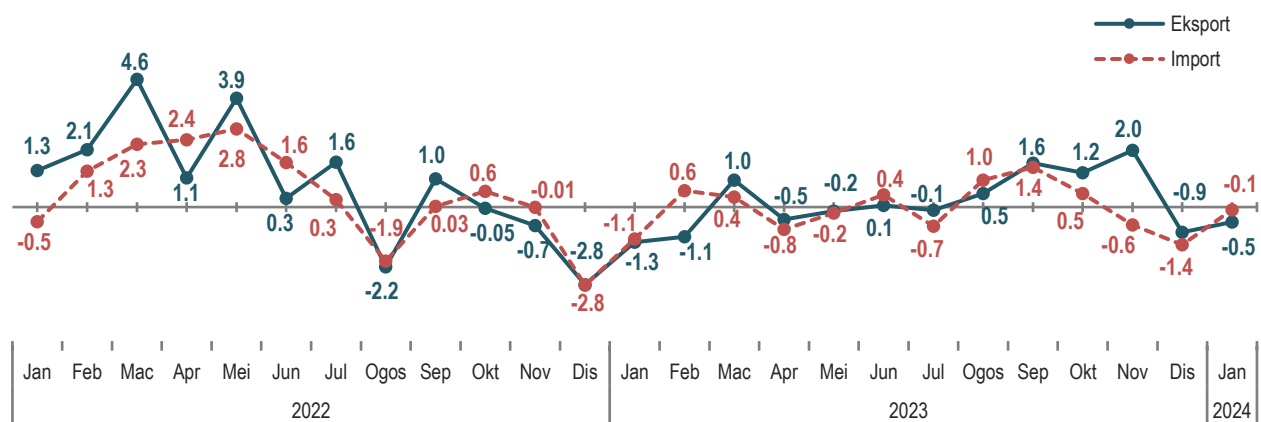

Export & Import unit value indices decelerated by 0.5 per cent and 0.1 per cent, respectively in January 2024.

PUTRAJAYA, FEBRUARY 28, 2024 – Malaysia's export prices in January 2024 slipped by 0.5 per cent from 148.0 points in the previous month to 147.2 points. Likewise, import prices decreased by 0.1 per cent from 128.7 points to 128.5 points and Malaysia's terms of trade also dropped by 0.4 per cent month-on-month to 114.5 points in January 2024 as reported today in **EXTERNAL TRADE INDICES (2010=100), January 2024**. This publication presents the unit value index, volume index and terms of trade for 10 commodity sections of merchandise products in accordance with the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC).

Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin said, "The export unit value index fell by 0.5 per cent in January 2024 as compared to the previous month, led by the decrease in the index of mineral fuels (-2.8%), manufactured goods (-0.2%) and machinery & transport equipment (-0.2%). However, the export volume index went up by 4.0 per cent in line with the increase in the index of mineral fuels (+30.4%), manufactured goods (+9.6%) and chemicals (+2.4%). The seasonally adjusted export volume index grew by

16.1 per cent from 140.8 points to 163.5 points. Concerning the annual comparison, the unit value index and volume index increased by 3.1 per cent and 5.4 per cent, respectively.

The import unit value index shrank by 0.1 per cent in January 2024, contributed by the decrease in the index of mineral fuels (-2.6%), inedible crude materials (-0.3%) and manufactured goods (-0.2%). Meanwhile, the import volume index grew by 5.6 per cent in January 2024 as compared to the previous month, attributed from the increment in the index of food (+20.8%), manufactured good (+13.6%) and mineral fuels (+6.0%). The seasonally adjusted import volume index edged up by 9.8 per cent from 189.8 points to 208.4 points. Year-on-year comparison showed that the import unit value index and volume index rose by 0.4 per cent and 18.5 per cent, respectively."

In addition, Malaysia's terms of trade decreased by 0.4 per cent month-on-month to 114.5 points in January 2024, driven by the decrement in the index of animal & vegetable oils & fats (-1.3%), machinery & transport equipment (-0.4%) and mineral fuels (-0.2%). Malaysia's terms of trade grew by 2.7 per cent year-on-year from 111.5 points in January of the previous year.

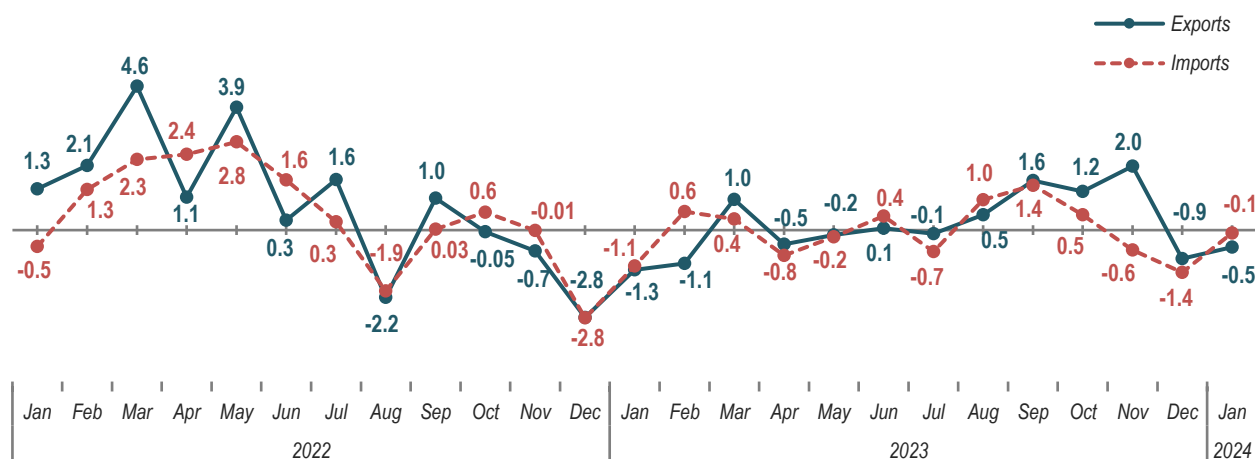


Chart 1: Month-on-Month Percentage Change of Export & Import Unit Value Indices
